## GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

### NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves return to Dacotah Bank Stadium looking for their second home victory of 2023
- Northern is averaging 23.4 points, 133.0 yards rushing, 267.2 yards passing, and 400.2 yards of total offense this season; they are converting 42.7% on third down and 29.4% on fourth down
- The NSU defense has 11 sacks and three interceptions this season
- Anthony Vespo is back in the saddle for the NSU, averaging 206 yards passing per game with four touchdowns and a 59.0 pass completion percentage
- Stanley Haskins Jr. and Brett Brenton are a tag-team on the ground with 200 and 196 yards rushing respectively; the pair have two touchdowns apiece
- The Wolves one-two punch continues in the air with Dewaylon Ingram and Dakota Larson recording 536 and 440 yards receiving respectively
- Ingram leads the NSIC averaging 107.2 yards per games
- Drew Smook has taken on a larger kicking rolling with 5-of-6 made field goals, including a 47-yard long, and 752 total kicking yards
- The Northern State defense is led by Charlie Larson with 37.0 total tackles in 2023, including 4.0 tackles for a loss
- Trey King follows with 32.0 tackles, 3.0 tackles for a loss, and 1.0 sack
- Luke Gunderson and Logan Grossinger each have 2.0 sacks this season, while Lynden Williams, Trevor Johnson, and Corey Scott account for the team's three interceptions

### MINOT STATE BEAVERS

- The Beavers head to Aberdeen with a winless record, going 0-5 to open 2023
- Minot State is averaging 16.8 points, 199.4 yards rushing, 90.2 yards passing, and 289.6 yards of total offense per game
- They are converting 21.9% on third down and 46.2% on fourth down
- The Beaver defense has 11 sacks on the year, as well as two interceptions
- Myles West and Evan Lovett lead the rushing attack with 328 and 271 yards respectively this season; each recording two touchdowns and averaging 5.9 yards per carry
- Dawson Macleary is averaging 71.4 yards passing per game with three touchdowns and 357 total yards
- Daniel Stokes leads the receiving core with 176 total yards and two touchdowns, averaging 19.6 yards per catch
- Isaiah Bigby and Carson Cayko lead the Beaver defense with 35.0 tackles apiece, while Cayko has a team leading 7.0 tackles for a loss and 3.0 sacks
- Knylen Miller-Levi and Ike Mikaele have the team's two interceptions, while Emmett Espino matches Cayko's total with 3.0 sacks in 2023
- Isaiah Griffin and Stokes lead the returners averaging 20.0 and 21.0 yards per kick return this season
- Minot State is led by head coach Ian Shields in his first season at the helm

### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE BEAVERS

- The Wolves defeated the Beavers 38-10 on the road in 2022
- Returning scorers for the Wolves include Luke Gunderson on an 87-yard kick return and Payton Hughes on a 5-yard blocked punt and return
- NSU recorded 265 yards of total offense in the win
- The defense tallied eight sacks for a loss of 50 yards and Ian Marshall broke the single game school record with four sacks of his own
- Northern is 18-6-1 all-time against Minot State and on a 12-game win streak

## HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fourth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2023. He joined the Wolves after spending four seasons as head coach at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse (UWL), where he posted a 27-13 record overall.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall

also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. UWL won 15 league games over the past three seasons, matching the most league victories in a three-year span since 2004-06. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh. UWL was ranked 25th in the final regular-season D3football.com Top-25 Poll while receiving votes in the final American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Top-25 Poll.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville in 2015. Prior to arriving at UW-Platteville, Schmidt was the defensive coordinator and coached the linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa) from 2011-14. He also served as the recruiting coordinator from 2009-14. Named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year, Schmidt coached running backs (2009-10), defensive backs (2009) and offensive line (2010) at Dubuque (Iowa). He served as a graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University Mankato in 2008, coaching the defensive line.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
