GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves return to Aberdeen for the final home game of 2023 with a 4-5 record overall and in the NSIC
- Northern is averaging 25.4 points, 149.1 yards rushing, 235.9 yards receiving, and 385.0 yards of total offense this season
- In addition, NSU is converting above 40.0% on both third and fourth down this season, scoring 25 of the 35 times they entered the red-zone
- The Wolves defense has 14 sacks on the year, as well as nine interceptions and eight forced fumbles
- Colton Hackel enters his ninth game of the year with a pass completion percentage of 53.7, throwing for 1,285 yards and eight touchdowns
- Brett Brenton leads the ground attack with 530 rushing yards and five touchdowns, averaging 5.0 yards per carry and 58.9 yards per game
- Dewaylon Ingram and Dakota Larson continue to lead the team and sit in the top half of the NSIC with 990 and 666 yards receiving respectively, as well as a combined 12 touchdowns
- Ingram is averaging 18.3 yards per reception and 110.0 yards per game
- The defense is led by Trey King with 57.0 tackles, including 11.0 tackles for a loss and two forced fumbles
- Lynden Williams is second on the team with 50.0 tackles and leads the defense with four break-ups and two interceptions
- Drew Smook and Ethan Barnett are averaging 59.5 yards per kickoff and 38.3 yards per punt in 2023, while Smook is 7-of-11 in field goal attempts

NO. 21 AUGUSTANA UNIVERSITY VIKINGS

- The Vikings suffered their first loss of the season last weekend to Wayne State, dropping nine spots in the AFCA Top-25 Poll
- AU holds an 8-1 record overall and 7-1 mark in the Northern Sun
- Augustana is averaging 32.8 points, 156.8 yards rushing, 240.0 yards passing, and 396.8 yards of total offense per game this season
- The Viking defense has 18 sacks, eight interceptions, and six forced fumbles
- Casey Bauman paces the offense with 2,144 yards passing and 20 touchdowns with a 64.8 pass completion percentage
- Jack Fisher leads the receivers with 493 total yards and four touchdowns, averaging 20.5 yards per catch and 54.8 yards per game
- Jarod Epperson leads the rushers with 735 total yards and eight touchdowns, averaging 5.8 yards per carry and 81.7 yards per game
- The Viking defense is led by Peyton Buckley with 54.0 tackles, including 5.5 tackles for a loss, as well as seven break-ups
- Will Davis and Gradee Sherman lead the line with 3.5 sacks apiece, combining for 34 yards lost
- Avery Book leads the NSIC averaging 44.0 yards per punt with a 69 yard long, while Jake Pecina is 7-of-8 in made field goal attempts in 2023
- Augustana is led by head coach Jerry Olszewski in his 11th season

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE VIKINGS

- Augustana tallied a 21-13 victory over Northern last season at home
- Trey King led the Wolves defense with eight tackles and one tackle for a loss, while Luke Gunderson tallied five tackles
- Stanley Haskins Jr. is the lone offensive stat returner for the Wolves, recording 29 yards rushing
- NSU is 6-33-1 all-time against AU and currently on a 13-game loss streak

HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fourth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2023. He joined the Wolves after spending four seasons as head coach at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse (UWL), where he posted a 27-13 record overall.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall

also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. UWL won 15 league games over the past three seasons, matching the most league victories in a three-year span since 2004-06. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh. UWL was ranked 25th in the final regular-season D3football.com Top-25 Poll while receiving votes in the final American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Top-25 Poll.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville in 2015. Prior to arriving at UW-Platteville, Schmidt was the defensive coordinator and coached the linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa) from 2011-14. He also served as the recruiting coordinator from 2009-14. Named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year, Schmidt coached running backs (2009-10), defensive backs (2009) and offensive line (2010) at Dubuque (Iowa). He served as a graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University Mankato in 2008, coaching the defensive line.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
