## GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

### #21 NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves return to Wachs Arena with a 1-4 record overall, notching an NSIC opening win over the University of Mary
- Northern is averaging 68.0 points, 30.6 rebounds, 11.4 assists, 10.0 turnovers, 4.2 steals, and 2.0 blocks per game this season
- They are shooting 42.4% from the floor, 28.6% from the 3-point line, and 72.7% from the foul line through five games
- Jackson Moni leads the team averaging 19.8 points and 5.8 rebounds per contest, shooting 41.0% from the floor
- Josh Dilling is also in double figures, averaging 17.4 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, shooting a team leading 50.8% from the floor
- Dilling has dished out a team leading 22 assists, followed by Moni with 15
- Michael Nhial and Augustin Reede are averaging just over eight points a game each and round out the main contingent of Wolves starters
- The key for NSU moving into the weekend and the heart of the season is to build production off the bench and continue to improve their 3-point shooting

### PERU STATE COLLEGE BOBCATSS

- Peru State heads to Aberdeen with a 6-1 record this season and 2-1 mark in their league
- The Bobcats are averaging 77.6 points, 38.4 rebounds, 13.1 assists, 13.1 turnovers, 6.3 steals, and 3.3 blocks per game this season
- They are shooting 45.8% from the floor, 36.8% from the 3-point line, and 78.0% from the foul line
- David Wingett Jr. leads the offense averaging 19.4 points per game, as well as a team leading 8.6 rebounds per game
- Ajantae Hogan and Sayvon Traylor follow notching 14.3 and 13.8 points per game respectively
- Hogan leads the offense shooting 54.2% from the floor, while Wingett Jr. is shooting a team best 43.6% from the 3-point line
- The Bobcats are led by head coach Roman Gentry in his second season at the helm

### LAST MATCH-UP

- Northern and Peru State last matched up in 1970-71 with the Bobcats notching a 95-82 victory

### TRINITY BIBLE COLLEGE LIONS

- Trinity Bible enters the weekend with a 4-2 record overall
- The Lions are shooting 41.4% from the floor, 30.1% from the 3-point line, and 72.1% from the foul line this season
- They are averaging 79.8 points, 37.3 rebounds, 11.7 assists, 13.8 turnovers, 8.0 steals, and 2.7 blocks per game
- Marcellus Mencarini leads three averaging double figures, notching 25.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game
- Quincy Wilson and Micah Christensen follow averaging 16.2 and 10.8 points per game respectively with Christensen leading the team off the bench
- Damien Walters Jr. is shooting a team leading 63.0% from the floor and 67.0% from the 3-point line with ten made from beyond the arc
- TBC is led by head coach Jordan Nowell in his 17th season at the helm

## HEAD COACH SAUL PHILLIPS



Saul Phillips enters his fifth year at the helm in the fall of 2023, as the 22nd head men's basketball coach in program history. Phillips came to Northern State after Division I head coaching stops at North Dakota State University and Ohio University. He is just the sixth head coach for the Wolves since 1946.

The Wolves returned to their position atop the NSIC in 2022-23 going 24-7 overall and 19-3 in the league. They qualified for their 15th NCAA postseason appearance as the second seed in the NCAA Central Region. The Wolves won the regular season NSIC Championship, their fifth in the last six seasons and Phillips garnered NSIC Coach of the Year honors, surpassing the 300

career win mark.

The postseason accolades were numerous for the program and kicked off with Sam Masten, Jackson Moni, and Jordan Belka named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Masten was named the North Division Player of the Year and went on to tally All-District honors from the D2CCA and NABC, as well as All-America awards. In addition, Belka and Masten recorded CSC Academic All-District® distinctions and Masten earned his way on to the Academic All-America® team. Belka capped off his award season as the NSIC/Bob Olson Outstanding Senior of the Year.

Northern State went 20-12 overall and 13-9 in the NSIC in the 2021-22 season. The Wolves season ended in the quarterfinal round of the NSIC/Sanford Health Basketball Tournament. The trio of Sam Masten, Jordan Belka, and Jackson Moni were named to the NSIC All-Conference second team for the Wolves

Northern went 19-2 overall in 2021 en route to their fourth straight NSIC North Division and NSIC Tournament Championships (overall champion was not awarded). In addition, NSU earned the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Central Region and played host, reaching the regional championship contest. Phillips was named the NSIC North Division Coach of the Year, while Parker Fox, Andrew Kallman, Mason Stark, and Tommy Chatman were named to the All-Conference teams. Fox was both the North Division Overall and Defensive Player of the Year. The junior duo of Fox and Stark were named to the All-Region teams and Fox went on to be the program's first NABC All-American since 2009.

Northern did not miss a beat in Phillips first season at the helm (2019-20), winning their third straight NSIC Overall and Tournament Championships with a 26-6 record. NSU earned a berth in the NCAA Central Region Tournament as the fourth seed, with their NSIC/Sanford Health Basketball Tournament Championships over Minnesota State. Three Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference honors (Fox, King, Stark), with Parker Fox being named the NSIC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition, Fox earned All-Region accolades from both the D2CCA and NABC.

Phillips spent the previous five seasons at Ohio University and seven at North Dakota State. He went 81-77 overall leading the Bobcats and 134-84 with the Bison. Phillips led the Ohio University Bobcats to the CBI semifinal round in his tenure with the program. OU saw 11 all-conference performances in five seasons under Phillips including one MAC Player of the Year honor (Antonio Campbell) and one MAC Freshman of the Year award (Jordan Dartis). Campbell was an Associated Press All-America selection following a stellar 2015-16 campaign, where the Bobcats tallied their best season under Phillips going 23-12 overall.

In his seven seasons at North Dakota State, Phillips led the Bison to two Summit League Championships, two Summit League Tournament Championships, and two appearances in the NCAA Tournament. A total of 14 Bison earned all-conference accolades in his seven seasons, while four were named to the NABC All-District team and two tallied All-American accolades. He coached two league players of the year and twice earned coach of the year accolades.

Phillips began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at NSIC counterpart Wayne State College as a member of Greg McDermott's staff. From there he made assistant coaching stops at Lake Superior and Milwaukee, before taking the Director of Basketball Operations post at Wisconsin. With the Badgers, Phillips handled the day-to-day scheduling, coordinated travel, budgeting and on-campus recruiting for Bo Ryan's staff. Phillips then joined former Northern State assistant, Tim Miles as an assistant at NDSU. He spent three years on Miles' staff before being elevated into his first head-coaching role in 2007.

A native of Reedsburg, Wis., Phillips graduated from Wisconsin-Platteville with a degree in business and psychology in 1996. He played basketball for four seasons at UWP under Bo Ryan and was captain of the Pioneers' undefeated national championship team in 1995. Phillips and his wife, Nicole, have one daughter, Jordan, and two sons, Charlie and Benjamin.
