GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves return to Dacotah Bank Stadium looking for their first win of 2023 after a pair of contest against postseason contenders Bemidji State and Minnesota Duluth
- Northern is averaging 17.0 points, 119.5 yards rushing, 265.0 yards passing, and 384.5 yards of total offense this season
- The Wolves are hold conversion percentages of 40.6% on third down and 20.0% on fourth down
- The NSU defense forced one fumble in the season opener and has one interception and one sack on the year
- Colton Hackel stepped into the starting role last week and leads the team with 167 rushing yards and two touchdowns, averaging 83.5 per game, and 360 passing yards with two touchdowns
- Brett Brenton is second on the team with 49 rushing yards, averaging 4.9 yards per carry and 24.5 yards per game
- Dewaylon Ingram and Dakota Larson led the Wolves receiving front with 285 and 130 yards respectively, as well as a combined three touchdowns
- Larson broke the school record last weekend for career receiving yards with 2,836 overall
- Trey King and Charlie Larson led the defensive attack with 12.0 tackles apiece this season; Larson has a team high 2.5 tackles for a loss, while King has the squad's lone sack

UNIVERSITY OF MARY MARAUDERS

- UMary enters the weekend with an 0-2 record falling to Augustana (38-7) and Sioux Falls (36-17) to open 2023
- The Marauders are averaging 12.0 points, 49.0 yards rushing, 206.5 yards passing, and 255.5 yards of total offense this season
- They hold conversion percentages of 29.2% on third down and 33.3% on fourth down
- The Mary defense has three fumble recoveries, two sacks, and one interception through the first two games
- Sofian Massoud and Jesse Forknell tag team the quarter back position with over 100 yards a piece; Massoud leads the attack with 253 yards passing, one touchdown, and a 76.3 completion percentage
- Andrew Trandahl is the team's main rusher with 23 attempts and 45 total yards in 2023, while Mujeeb Rufai leads the receivers with 144 total yards and one touchdown
- Reginald Morrow holds a team high 13.0 tackles, followed by Mason Phillips
- Phillips is also the team leader with 2.0 sacks for a total loss of 14 yards and one forced fumble
- The Marauders are led by head coach Shann Schillinger in his first season with the program

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE MARAUDERS

- The Wolves fell to the Marauders 27-26 a season ago on the road
- The contest headed to overtime where each team scored a touchdown, however UMary secured the extra point and the win
- Stanley Haskins Jr. was the lone returner to score in the contest
- NSU recorded a game high 192 yards rushing, 20 first downs, and 307 yards of total offense
- In addition, the defense recorded five sacks for a loss of 29 Marauder yards
- Northern is 8-8 all-time against the University of Mary, falling in the last two match-ups

HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fourth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2023. He joined the Wolves after spending four seasons as head coach at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse (UWL), where he posted a 27-13 record overall.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall

also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. UWL won 15 league games over the past three seasons, matching the most league victories in a three-year span since 2004-06. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh. UWL was ranked 25th in the final regular-season D3football.com Top-25 Poll while receiving votes in the final American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Top-25 Poli.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville in 2015. Prior to arriving at UW-Platteville, Schmidt was the defensive coordinator and coached the linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa) from 2011-14. He also served as the recruiting coordinator from 2009-14. Named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year, Schmidt coached running backs (2009-10), defensive backs (2009) and offensive line (2010) at Dubuque (Iowa). He served as a graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University Mankato in 2008, coaching the defensive line.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
