## GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

### NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves open their home slate coming off a loss at No. 11 Bemidji State last Thursday
- Dewaylon Ingram led the Wolves offense with 190 yards receiving and two touchdowns, a 59-yarder from Anthony Vespo and 7-yarder from Colton Hackel
- Northern led the contest with 309 yards passing, however the Beavers topped the Wolves in total offense with 420 yards to NSU's 377
- The Wolves quarterback room threw three interceptions for 125 yards last week and will look to shore that up in week two
- Dakota Larson followed Ingram with 66 yards receiving and Hackel led the rushers with 33 yards on the ground; Larson also added 26 yards on two kick returns in the loss
- The Northern defense held Bemidji State to 5-of-14 on third down, however the Beavers scored all five times they entered the red-zone
- Charlie Larson led the defense with 11 tackles, including six solo stops and 2.5 tackles for a loss; while Trevor Johnson grabbed the first interception of the 2023 season
- Trey King and Logan Grossinger added seven and six tackles respectively for the Wolves defense that was not at full strength in the 2023 opener
- The Wolves have traditionally played strongly from the confines of Dacotah Bank Stadium, going 8-3 in the first two seasons at their new home

### (RV) MINNESOTA DULUTH BULLDOGS

- The Bulldogs kicked off their 2023 campaign with a 47-10 victory over Northern Michigan at home
- UMD was picked fifth in the NSIC Preseason Coaches' Poll earning 109 total points with Treyvon Cahalan and Marcus Glodowski selected as the team's players to watch in 2023
- Duluth returns 2022 impact players Arik Johnson, Treyvon Cahalan, Aiden Williams, Sam Pitz, Kyle Walljasper, Landon Carter, Brad Dati, Marcus Glodowski, Drew Hennessey, Nathan Bursch, and Tim Pokornowski
- UMD also gained University of Mary transfers Ty'Rhae and Ty'Rese Gibson
- Duluth put up double figure points in each of the first three quarters, with Kyle Walljasper having his hand in five of the team's seven touchdowns
- The sophomore ran for 149 yards with two touchdowns and passed for 55 yards with three touchdowns
- UMD accumulated 492 yards of total offense converting on 9-of-13 third downs
- The Bulldog defense forced two interceptions, including a pick-6, and added two sacks for a loss of nine yards
- Ty'Rese Gibson scored for the UMD defense, while Mac Strand and Marcus Glodowski tallied a team leading eight and seven tackles respectively
- Minnesota Duluth is led by head coach Curt Wiese in his 11th season at the helm

### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE BULLDOGS

- The Wolves and Bulldogs closed out the 2022 regular season from Dacotah Bank Stadium in 2022 in what was later named the "Ice Game"
- Northern fell 28-7 in the game, falling to 13-26 all-time versus Minnesota Duluth
- Anthony Vespo connected with Ben Noland late in the fourth quarter for the Wolves first and only touchdown of the contest
- NSU converted on just 4-of-11 third downs and suffered eight penalties

## HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fourth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2023. He joined the Wolves after spending four seasons as head coach at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse (UWL), where he posted a 27-13 record overall.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall

also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. UWL won 15 league games over the past three seasons, matching the most league victories in a three-year span since 2004-06. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh. UWL was ranked 25th in the final regular-season D3football.com Top-25 Poll while receiving votes in the final American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Top-25 Poll.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville in 2015. Prior to arriving at UW-Platteville, Schmidt was the defensive coordinator and coached the linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa) from 2011-14. He also served as the recruiting coordinator from 2009-14. Named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year, Schmidt coached running backs (2009-10), defensive backs (2009) and offensive line (2010) at Dubuque (Iowa). He served as a graduate assistant coach at Minnesota State University Mankato in 2008, coaching the defensive line.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.

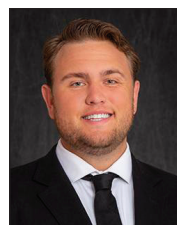
