### GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

#### **NORTHERN STATE WOLVES**

- The Wolves are coming off a 30-24 win at home last weekend versus Winona State
- NSU is averaging 12.8 points, 138.8 yards rushing, 102.4 yards passing, and 241.2 yards of total offense per game this season
- The defense has forced four interceptions, eight sacks, and one fumble
- Daniel Britt returned to his starting role last week and leads the team averaging 61.2 yards passing and 42.4 yards rushing per game
- Hank Kraft leads the rushers with 257 total yards and one touchdown, averaging 4.5 yards per carry and 51.4 yards per game
- Ty Wiley continues to lead the receivers with 162 total yards, averaging 9.5 yards per catch and 32.4 per game with two touchdowns
- Jake Adams has been a defensive powerhouse in the league and at the national level; he leads the NSIC and sits second in the nation with 66 total tackles
- Gabe Gutierrez is coming off a 2.0-sack game against the Warriors and Luke Gunderson notched his first interception of the season last Saturday
- Tom Ellard leads the league and ranks third in the country, averaging 45.9 yards per punt

### (RV) BEMIDJI STATE BEAVERS

- The Beavers enter the weekend with a 4-1 record overall and 3-1 mark in the Northern Sun
- BSU is averaging 30.0 points, 197.8 yards rushing, 236.2 yards passing, and 434.0 yards of total offense per game
- The Bemidji offense leads the NSIC in third down conversions, going 38-74 (51.4%) this season
- The Beaver defense has three interceptions, 12 sacks, and four forced fumbles through the first five games
- Sam McGath paces the offense averaging 228.2 yards passing 44.0 yards rushing per game; he's thrown 12 touchdown passes and rushed for two scores
- Jayden Washington leads the rushers with 322 total yards, averaging 5.6 yards per carry and 64.6 yards per game with two touchdowns
- Brice Peters leads three with triple figure receiving yards this season, notching 542 total yards and eight touchdowns: he's averaging just over 100 yards per game
- The BSU defense is led by Colton Hinrichs with 32 total tackles, while Stephan Hoffman and Marcus Hansen each have a team leading 4.5 tackles for a loss
- Bemidji State is led by head coach Brent Bolte in his 13th season at the helm

#### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE BEAVERS

- Northern fell to Bemidji 49-13 last season with the Beavers taking the last eight contests
- Charlie Larson led the defense with 11 tackles, including 2.5 tackles for a loss
- Colton Hackel entered in relief and passed for 136 yards and a touchdown
- The Wolves are 20-26-1 all-time against the Beavers

### **HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT**



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota

Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
