GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves are coming off a 14-13 victory at home last Saturday against Bemidji State
- NSU is 2-4 overall and 2-3 in the Northern Sun
- Northern is averaging 13.0 points, 137.5 yards rushing, 107.2 yards passing, and 244.7 yards of total offense per game this season
- The NSU defense has 26.0 tackles for a loss, 12 sacks, five interceptions, and two forced fumbles through the first half of the season
- Hank Kraft leads the Northern State rushers with 308 total yards, averaging 4.6 yards per carry and 51.3 yards per game
- Wyatt Block has had a pair of strong showings for the Wolves as of late; he's rushed for 225 yards and two touchdowns, averaging 4.8 yards per carry and 37.5 per game
- Daniel Britt is averaging 72.8 yards passing and 38.2 yards rushing, he holds a 61.8 pass completion percentage with two touchdowns
- Ty Wiley leads the receivers with 20 catches for 170 yards and two touchdowns; he is averaging 28.3 yards per game
- The Wolves defense is led by NCAA leader Jake Adams with 86.0 total tackles, including 45 solo stops
- Matthew Baker leads the defense with 5.5 tackles for a loss, including 4.0 sacks
- Kegan Mountain leads the secondary with two interceptions, while Lynden Williams, Luke Gunderson, and Trevor Johnson each have one
- Tom Ellard continues to lead the league this season, averaging 41.7 yards per punt with a 73-yard long

MINNESOTA DULUTH BULLDOGS

- The Bulldogs enter the weekend with a 3-2 record overall and 2-2 mark in the Northern Sun with losses to MSU Moorhead and Augustana
- UMD is averaging 38.6 points, 182.6 yards rushing, 270.2 yards passing, and 452.8 yards of total offense per game
- The Duluth defense has 53.0 tackles for a loss, 25.0 sacks, six interceptions, and six forced fumbles this season
- The Bulldogs lead the NSIC in scoring offense, scoring defense, total defense, rushing defense, offensive efficiency, defensive efficiency, punt returns, kickoffs, sacks, and opponent third down conversions
- Kyle Walljasper leads the offense averaging 231.6 yards passing and 47.0 yards rushing per game with a combined 14 touchdowns and a 66.7 pass completion percentage
- DaShaun Ames leads the receivers with 481 total yards and six touchdowns, averaging 26.7 yards per reception and 96.2 per game
- Mac Strand leads the UMD defense with 23.0 tackles on the year, followed by Alex Sylvester with 22.0
- 14 players have recorded a sack this season for the Bulldogs, led by Matt Weerts and Drew Hennessey with 3.5 apiece
- UMD is led by head coach Curt Wiese in his 12th season at the helm

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE BULLDOGS

- The Wolves fell to the Bulldogs 41-21 in their 2023 home opener
- Northern is 13-27 all-time against Minnesota Duluth, with their last win coming in the fall of 2015

HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.

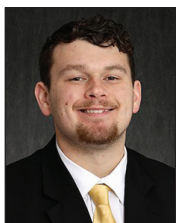
