## GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

### NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves return home on a 3-game win streak knocking down Winona State, Bemidji State, and Minnesota Duluth
- The wins over the Beavers and Bulldogs were the first since 2014 and 2015
- Northern is averaging 14.6 points, 137.7 yards rushing, 114.6 yards passing, and 252.3 yards of total offense per game
- The Wolves defense has 15 sacks, six interceptions, and two forced fumbles on the year
- In addition, NSU ranks top-5 in the NSIC in total defense (329.7), sacks by (15), and interceptions (6)
- Daniel Britt paces the Northern State offense with three passing touchdowns, one rushing score, a 64.6 pass completion percentage, and an average of 117.6 yards of total offense per game
- Hank Kraft and Wyatt Block lead the rushing attack for NSU with 350 and 302 yards respectively, combining for five rushing touchdowns
- Ty Wiley surpassed 200 season yards last weekend and leads the NSU receivers averaging 28.9 yards per game
- Jake Adams continues to lead the country in total tackles this season at 95 and ranks second averaging 13.6 tackles per game
- Matthew Baker and Max Van Landingham have come alive in the last two games for the Wolves and account for a combined 11.5 tackles for a loss; nine of which are sacks
- In the kicking game, Tom Ellard sits second in the league averaging 42.9 yards per punt and Jeremy Caruso sank his second longest field goal of the season (38-yards) to win the game against the Bulldogs

### SOUTHWEST MINNESOTA STATE MUSTANGS

- The Mustangs enter the weekend with a record of 0-6 on the year, including five losses in the NSIC
- SMSU is averaging 5.5 points, 82.5 yards rushing, 100.0 yards passing, and 182.5 yards of total offense per game
- The defense has forced seven sacks, four fumbles, and two interceptions this season; however, their opponents are converting by rates of 45.6% on third down and 54.6% on fourth down
- Kendon Krogman has 397 yards passing, averaging 79.4 per game with two touchdowns and a 54.0 pass completion percentage
- Jacob Honstetter leads the rushers with 227 total yards, while Colin Maher leads the receiving core with 154 yards and two touchdowns
- The Mustang defense is led by Josiah Hedensten with 47 total tackles, including 5.5 tackles for a loss and two sacks
- Parker Knutson has each of the team's interceptions this season and Avery Johnson leads the team with 3.5 sacks for a loss of 29 yards
- Southwest Minnesota State is led by head coach Scott Underwood in his third season at the helm

### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE MUSTANGS

- The Wolves defeated the Mustangs, 24-17 on the road in the fall of 2023
- Northern is 25-10-1 all-time against Southwest Minnesota and is 4-1 in the last five meetings

## HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.

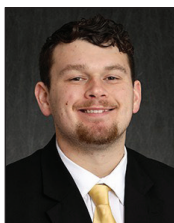
