GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Northern State University football team is currently on a 4-game win streak, improving to .500 on the season last weekend with their 34-point victory over SMSU
- The Wolves are averaging 17.9 points, 155.1 yards rushing, 122.8 yards passing, and 277.9 yards of total offense this season
- They are converting at rates of 36.0% on third down and 31.3% on fourth down
- The NSU defense 20.0 sacks, seven interceptions, two forced fumbles, and three fumble recoveries
- Northern ranks fourth in the league in total defense, third in passing defense, fourth in sacks, and fifth in interceptions
- Daniel Britt anchors the offense averaging 88.3 yards passing and 39.3 yards rushing per game with six total touchdowns; he has a 64.0 pass completion percentage
- Hank Kraft and Wyatt Block lead the rushing attack with 393 and 368 yards respectively this season and three touchdowns each
- Ty Wiley leads the receiving core with 239 total yards and three touchdowns, averaging 29.9 yards per game and 9.2 yards per reception
- Jake Adams leads the nation with 100 total tackles, sits second averaging 12.5 tackles per game, and his third with 52 solo stops
- The trio of Gabe Gutierrez, Max Van Landingham, and Matthew Baker sit atop the league standings with 5.0 sacks each for a combined 87 yards lost by their opponents; Baker also leads the team with 9.0 tackles for a loss
- Kegan Mountain recorded the first defensive touchdown of the season for the Wolves last weekend on a 55-yard pick-six and leads the NSIC with four interceptions this season
- Jeremey Caruso is coming off back-to-back NSIC Special Teams Player of the Week awards; he has six made field goals and a team leading 35 points scored in 2024

CONCORDIA-ST. PAUL GOLDEN BEARS

- The Golden Bears enter the weekend with a 2-5 record overall and 2-4 mark in the NSIC
- CSP is averaging 19.9 points, 174.3 yards rushing, 157.6 yards passing, and 331.9 yards of total offense per game with 17 offensive touchdowns
- They are converting 36.8% of the time on third down and 60.0% on fourth
- The defense has 12.0 sacks, five interceptions, two forced fumbles, and two fumble recoveries this season
- Jackson Compton leads the quarterback room with 695 yards passing and five touchdowns, he is averaging 173.8 yards passing and 21.8 yards rushing per game
- Jaylin Richardson leads the team and the NSIC averaging 117.6 yards rushing per game with 823 yards and eight touchdowns
- Drew Enke is the team's leading receiver with 396 total yards and three touchdowns
- The CSP defense is led by Richard Wauer and Brayden Hilgemann with 43.0 and 34.0 tackles respectively this season
- Concordia-St. Paul is led by head coach Shannon Currier in his 12th season at the helm

- The Golden Bears defeated the Wolves 20-14 last season in St. Paul
- Northern is 10-8 all-time against Concordia-St. Paul

HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota

Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
