GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- Northern returns to Dacotah Bank Stadium for the final time this season currently on a 5-game win streak
- The Wolves sit fifth in the league standings with a 5-3 NSIC record
- NSU is averaging 168.8 yards rushing, 123.8 yards passing, and 292.6 yards of total offense per game; converting at rates of 39.5% on third down and 33.3% on fourth down
- The Northern State defense has 22.0 sacks, seven interceptions, three forced fumbles, and two fumble recoveries
- Daniel Britt leads the offense averaging 93.0 yards passing and 43.2 yards rushing per game; he has a 62.0 pass completion percentage and is nearing 1000 passing yards for the year
- Hank Kraft and Wyatt Block each had 100-yard game last weekend and lead the team averaging 54.9 and 52.2 yards rush respectively per contest
- Tanner Branson and Ty Wiley lead the receivers with 255 and 249 yards each this season, with a combined five touchdowns
- The defense is led by national leader and single season record holder Jake Adams with 116 tackles this season
- Max Van Landingham sits second in the NSIC with 6.0 sacks, followed by Gabe Gutierrez and Matthew Baker with 5.0 each
- Kegan Mountain is also tied for the league lead with his four interceptions this season

#22 MINNESOTA STATE MAVERICKS

- Minnesota State enters the weekend with a 6-2 record overall and 5-2 mark in the Northern Sun
- They are averaging 31.4 points, 186.5 yards rushing, 245.3 yards passing, and 431.8 yards of total offense per game
- The Mavericks hold conversion rates of 43.6% on third down and 51.9% on fourth down
- MSU leads the NSIC in total offense, net kickoff yards, sacks against, and first downs per game
- The defense has 14.0 sacks this season, five interceptions, seven forced fumbles, and three fumble recoveries
- Hayden Ekern leads the offense averaging 239.1 yards passing per game with 1,913 yards this season and a 64.1 pass completion percentage
- Sam Backer leads the rushing attack with 513 total yards, averaging 64.1 per game and 6.2 per carry
- Ekern's main targets are TreShawn Watson and Gabe Hagen with a combined 893 yards and 12 touchdowns this season
- Antonio Alzheimer leads the defense with 63.0 total tackles, while Cody Brown has a team leading 4.0 sacks
- Minnesota State is led by head coach Todd Hoffner in his 14th season at the helm

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE MAVERICKS

- The Wolves defeated the Mavericks 23-22 from Dacotah Bank Stadium in 2022
- It was the first win for NSU over MSU since the fall of 1971
- Northern is 2-10 all-time against Minnesota State

HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.

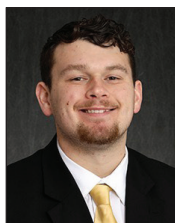
