## GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

### NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves enter the weekend looking for their first win of the fall season after a pair of losses to #5 South Dakota and Sioux Falls
- Northern is averaging 154.0 yards rushing, 95.5 yards passing, and 249.5 yards of total offense per game
- In the return game, NSU is averaging 18.0 yards per kickoff and 6.3 yards per punt return
- The defense ranks fifth in the NSIC in total defense and third in passing defense through the first two games; holding their opponents to conversion rates of 40.0% on third down and 0.0% on fourth down
- Daniel Britt and Colton Hackel have each seen time under center with Britt leading the team with 128 yards passing and a 58.3% pass completion percentage
- Hackel threw the team's first touchdown of the season last weekend to Hank Kraft and has 63 total yards on the year
- Kraft is the leading rusher for NSU with 148 total yards, averaging 74.0 yards per game and 5.9 yards per carry
- Ty Wiley and Tanner Branson have led the receiving front in the first two games with 41 and 38 yards respectively this season
- The defense is led by Jake Adams who put together back-to-back eight tackle games for the Wolves; in addition, he holds one of the team's two sacks this season
- Lynden Williams and Logan Grossiner follow with 11 and ten tackles respectively, while Kegan Mountain tallied the first interception of the year last Saturday

### MINOT STATE BEAVERS

- The Beavers welcome the Wolves for their homecoming contest with a 2-0 record, notching wins over Valley City State (38-7) and Southwest Minnesota State (42-9)
- Minot is averaging 40.0 points, 309.0 yards rushing, 16.0 yards passing, and 325.0 yards of total offense per game this season
- Their defense is holding opponents to a 29.2% conversion rate on third down, however their foes have been victorious on fourth down converting on 5-of-6 attempts
- In addition, the Beaver offense has scored five touchdowns in the red-zone and tallied points on six of their seven red-zone attempts
- Carson Chrisman directs the offense leading the team with 32 yards passing and four rushing touchdowns, while sitting second on the team with 167 yards rushing
- Evan Lovett is the Beavers leading rusher with 176 total yards this season, averaging 88.0 yards per game and 5.2 yards per carry
- Nalu Cordeiro earned D2Football National Player of the Week honors following the match-up with the Mustangs where he tallied two pick-sixes; he leads the nation with three interceptions
- Myzel Williams leads the defense with ten tackles, followed by Brayan Augustin and Cody Raetzman with nine apiece
- Minot State is led by Ian Shields in his second season at the helm

### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE BEAVERS

- The Wolves defeated the Beavers 46-9 from Dacotah Bank Stadium last season
- Northern is 20-6-1 all-time against Minot State, dating back to the first contest in 1932
- Since MiSU joined the Northern Sun, NSU is 10-0 all-time

HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.

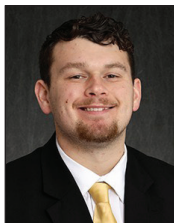

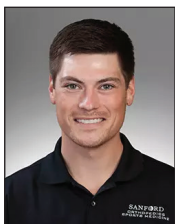
