## GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

### NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves head into the weekend following an NSIC opening loss at Minot State
- Northern is averaging 9.0 points, 155.7 yards rushing, 91.7 yards passing, and 247.3 yards of total offense per game
- The Northern State defense is holding their opponents to 13-of-35 on third down and leads the NSIC in passing defense, giving up 84.0 yards per game on average
- Daniel Britt leads the offense through the first three games averaging 70.7 yards passing and 54.3 yards rushing per game; he holds a 65.0 pass completion percentage
- Hank Kraft is the leading rusher this season with 179 total yards, averaging 5.4 yards per carry
- Ty Wiley leads the receiving core with 84 total yards, averaging 10.5 yards per catch and 28.0 yards per game
- Jake Adams not only leads the Wolves defense, but also the Northern Sun, with 36.0 total tackles this season, including 3.5 tackles for a loss
- Logan Grossinger follows with 22, while Elijah Jopp and Lynden Williams each have 21
- Tom Ellard sits atop the NSIC in punting, averaging 45.6 yards per punt with a 58-yard long
- In the return game, Ty Wiley is averaging 19.6 yards per kick return, while Kegan Mountain is averaging 7.3 yards per punt return; the pair rank the Wolves seventh in the NSIC in each category

### #18 AUGUSTANA UNIVERSITY VIKINGS

- The Vikings are coming off a 24-3 loss to 2023 NCAA FCS National Champion South Dakota State; they are 1-1 this season and ranked 18th in the AFCA Top-25 Poll
- Augustana is averaging 19.0 points, 62.5 yards rushing, 191.0 yards passing, and 253.5 yards of total offense per game
- The Viking defense is holding their opponents to conversion rates of 25.0% on third down and 0-3 on fourth down
- They lead the NSIC in opponent third down conversions and net yards on kickoffs (46.8)
- Gunnar Hensley leads four quarterback that have seen time this season with 219 yards passing, two touchdowns, and a 77.8 pass completion percentage
- Jarod Epperson leads the rushing attack with 67 yards this season, averaging 3.9 yards per carry and 33.5 yards per game; while Isaiah Huber leads the receivers with 93 total yards, averaging 8.5 yards per catch and 46.5 yards per game
- The defense is led by Logan Leonard with 13.0 tackles, followed by Peyton Buckley and Haden Wallace with 11.0 apiece
- Will Davis, Myles Taylor, and Christian Connelly each have 2.0 sacks on the year
- Augustana is led by head coach Jerry Olszewski in his 12th season

### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE VIKINGS

- The Wolves fell to the Vikings 31-21 from Dacotah Bank Stadium last season
- Northern is 6-34-1 all-time against Augustana and looking for their first win since 2003

## HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
