GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

#24 NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves kick off NSIC play with an 8-0 record and 24th ranking in the AVCA Top-25 Poll
- Northern is hitting .288 this season, averaging 13.6 kills, 12.9 assists, 17.2 digs, 2.1 aces, and 2.5 blocks per set
- They are holding their opponents to a .162 attack percentage
- Natalia Szybinska leads the team this season with 94 total kills, averaging 3.36 per set
- Abby Brooks sits top-5 in the NSIC and leads the Wolves hitting .443 on the year; she is also adding a team best 34.0 blocks
- Keri Walker holds down the offense with 322 assists this season averaging 11.50 per set
- Walker is also second on the team with 13 aces, behind Reese Johnson with 15
- Abby Meister enters her second season leading the defense with 155 digs thus far, averaging a leage leading 5.54 per set

SIOUX FALLS COUGARS

- Sioux Falls heads into the weekend with a 5-3 record overall
- The Cougars are hitting .290 this season, averaging 13.4 kills, 12.7 assists, 15.8 digs, 1.4 aces, and 1.8 blocks per set
- Sadie Voss leads the offense with 103 kills this season, averaging 3.68 kills per set with a .332 attack percentage
- Jordan Kuper is second on the team with 88 kills and leads USF with a .427 attack percentage
- Elise Gillen and Liz Kopp manage the setting duties with 214 and 127 assists respectively this season
- Jordyn Hamm is the lone Cougar with double digit aces this season, recording 12
- The defensive effort is led by Gillen and Faith Van Eck with 89 and 82 digs respectively; while Kuper leads the team at the net with 31.0 blocks
- USF is led by head coach Dan Mathews in his fourth season

- The Wolves swept the Cougars from Wachs Arena in 2023
- Northern is 19-5 all-time versus Sioux Falls

#8 WAYNE STATE WILDCATS

- The Wildcats hit the road with a 6-2 record overall and eighth ranking in the AVCA Top-25 Poll
- Wayne State is hitting .281, averaging 13.7 kills, 12.3 assists, 15.2 digs, 1.7 aces, and 2.1 blocks per set
- Taya Beller leads the offense with 105 kills, averaging 3.89 per set, while Maggie Brahmer is hitting a team leading .507
- Molly Romano has dished out 305 total assists this season, averaging 11.30 per set
- Brooke Peltz and Beller lead the defense with 116 digs and 31.0 blocks respectively this season
- WSC is led by head coach Scott Kneifl in his 20th season at the helm

Brent Aldridge enters his 14th season with the Wolves in the fall of 2024. Aldridge has brought the NSU volleyball program to new heights as the Wolves have been recognized on the AVCA Top-25 and as a top-5 finisher in the NSIC.

The Wolves went 19-9 overall, 11-7 in the NSIC, and 8-2 from Wachs Arena in 2023, finishing fifth in the NSIC. Abby Meister, Abby Brooks, Keri Walker, and Natalia Szybinska were each named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and the CSC Academic All-District team.

In the fall of 2022, the Wolves went 18-11 overall and 13-7 in the league, finishing seventh in the Northern Sun. Three Wolves tallied NSIC All-Conference honors and Sally Gaul concluded her Northern State career as an AVCA All-America honorable mention team member.

Northern posted an 18-11 mark in 2021, notching top-25 victories over No. 25 Rockhurst, No. 10 Winona State, No. 6 Southwest Minnesota State, and No. 10 Concordia-St. Paul. The Wolves finished the year in fifth in the NSIC standings, holding a 13-7 league record. In addition, three Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams.

The Wolves won their second NSIC Championship in 2019, taking the out-right crown with a 17-3 league mark. NSU posted a 25-6 record overall, advanced to their third straight NCAA Tournament, and finished the year ranked at No. 8 in the AVCA Top-25 Poll. Seven Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams; the most selection in a single season for the Wolves. Laura Snyder garnered the first Offensive Player of the Year honors in program history and went on to be named the AVCA and D2CCA Central Region Player of the Year. She was named an AVCA First Team All-American, while Ashley Rozell and Jenna Reiff grabbed second team accolades. Rozell capped off the year for the Wolves, being named the second CoSIDA Academic All-American in program history.

2018 brought the first NSIC Conference Championship in program history, as the Wolves won a school record 26 matches. Aldridge earned the third NSIC Coach of the Year honor of his career and five Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. The 2018 Wolves advanced to the NCAA Central Region Tournament for the second straight season. Hailey Busch, Ashley Rozell, and Laura Snyder finished the year as AVCA All-Americans; the most in one year for NSU.

In 2017, Aldridge led the Wolves to the third NCAA Regional appearance in school history, earning the fourth seed out of the Central Region. Four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference first team, including NSIC Freshman of the Year Laura Snyder. Hailey Busch garnered both All-Region and All-American honors from the AVCA.

The Wolves remained in the AVCA Top-25 throughout the 2016 season, finishing the year ranked No. 21 in the country with a 16-12 record overall. Tori Biach became the first CoSIDA Academic All-American^(R) for Wolves volleyball in 2016 with a cumulative GPA of 4.00.

Aldridge led the Wolves to new heights in 2015, tying the school record for single season wins with 25 and breaking the school record with a 21 game win streak to open the season. Aldridge was named the NSIC, AVCA Central Region, and South Dakota Sportswriters Association's Collegiate Women's Coach of the Year. He tallied four All-NSIC performers and the program saw its first ever AVCA First Team All-Americans in Drew Smith and Kelsey Chambers. The Wolves finished the season leading the nation in hitting percentage (.320) and second in the nation in assists per set (14.00). Senior setter Drew Smith paced the NSU offense under the direction of Aldridge, and led the nation in assists per set for the entirety of the 2015 season, ultimately finishing the year averaging 13.13.

Aldridge was named the NSIC Coach of the Year and the South Dakota Sportswriters Association's Collegiate Women's Coach of the Year in 2013 after he led the Wolves to a 22-8 record and a trip to the NCAA Regional Tournament. Kelsey Chambers became the first AVCA All-American in school history in 2013, honored on the third team. In addition, three Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference accolades.

Aldridge led NSU to a 19-11 record in 2012, including going 13-7 in the NSIC. Both marks were the Wolves' best finish since 2001. 2012 was also Northern's first winning season since 2006. Three student-athletes were named All-NSIC performers under Aldridge. Aldridge's 2011 squad finished the year 13-14 and 8-12 in the league with one NSIC All-Conference honoree.

Aldridge came to NSU after three years as the top assistant coach for Arizona State under head coach Jason Watson. At ASU, Aldridge served as the defensive coordinator, helping the Sun Devils to a 13th place ranking in the nation in blocks per set (2.74) in 2009.

Aldridge also has Division I coaching experience at the Brigham Young University (2006-07), University of New Mexico (2002-05), and Northern Arizona University (2001-02). Aldridge spent the 1999 and 2000 seasons at the helm of St. Mary's College in Leavenworth, Kan., building that program from scratch.

A native of Spirit Lake, Iowa, Aldridge is a 1992 graduate of the University of South Dakota, where he served as an assistant coach from 1994-96. He and his wife, Mary, have three children: Madison, Brayden, and Maisy.
