### **GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS**

#### **NORTHERN STATE WOLVES**

- Northern State returns home averaging 8.5 points, 126.0 yards rushing, 94.3 yards passing, and 220.3 yards of total offense per game this season
- In addition, the Wolves are averaging 18.3 yards per kick return and 7.3 yards per punt return through the first four games
- In the kicking game, Northern is averaging 46.1 yards per punt and 2-for-5 in field goal attempts
- The Wolves defense has five sacks, three interceptions, and has forced two fumbles
- Hank Kraft and Ty Wiley lead the rushers and receivers with 219 and 105 yards respectively; Kraft is averaging 54.8 yards per game, while Wiley is averaging 26.3 with one touchdown
- Colton Hackel started under center last week against the Vikings; he has 165 total yards and two touchdowns this season
- Jake Adams anchors the Wolves defense and leads the league with 51.0 total tackles this season, including 3.5 tackles for a loss
- Kegan Mountain holds two of the team's three interceptions, while Charlie Larson is the team leader with 2.0 sacks
- Tom Ellard leads the NSIC in punting this season, averaging 46.1 yards per punt with a 73-yard long

#### **WINONA STATE WARRIORS**

- Winona State returns to Aberdeen with a 1-2 record overall and 1-1 mark in the Northern Sun
- The Warriors are averaging 22.0 points, 138.0 yards rushing, 258.0 yards passing, and 396.0 yards of total offense this season
- In addition, they are averaging 25.0 yards per kick return, 6.5 yards per punt return, and 39.8 yards per punt
- The WSU defense has nine sacks, one interception, and one forced fumble; they are holding their opponents to a 36.1% conversion rate on third down
- Cole Stenstrom leads the Warrior offense with 749 passing yards, completing 61.5% of his passing attempts with four touchdowns
- Sylvere Campbell is Stenstroms main passing target with 291 total yards, averaging 97.0 yards per game and 20.8 yards per catch
- Cair'ron Hendred leads the rushers with 212 total yards, averaging 70.7 yards per game and 5.6 yards per carry with three touchdowns
- Brent Jeske and Kyjuan Vengrowsky lead the WSU defense with 18 tackles apiece, including a team best 2.5 tackles for a loss by Vengrowsky
- The Warriors are led by head coach Brian Bergstrom in his third season at the helm

#### LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE WARRIORS

- Winona State came away with a 39-16 victory at home last fall
- The Wolves are 19-26 all-time against the Warriors with their last win coming in the fall of 2022 (42-21)

### **HEAD COACH MIKE SCHMIDT**



Mike Schmidt enters his fifth season as the head football coach at Northern State in the fall of 2024.

The fall of 2023 saw the Wolves going 5-6 overall. They tallied a comeback victory over Wayne State in mid-October (28-26), tallied home victories against UMary (41-10) and Minot State (46-9) over Gypsy Days, spoiled Southwest Minnesota State's homecoming (24-17), and sealed their season with a 44-20 victory over Northern Michigan in their first non-conference contest in over ten years. Seven single game, season, and career school records were tied or broken in 2023, while four Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. Dewaylon Ingram rounded out the season as an All-American, while Dakota

Larson earned the third CSC Academic All-America honors of his career.

In 2022, the Wolves went 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the North Division. Northern tallied their first NFCA Top-25 victory in the Schmidt-era with a 23-22 win over No. 24 Minnesota State. It was the first win over the Mavericks in over 50 years. Seven single game, single season, and career school records were broken, while six Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams including NSIC Defensive Newcomer and Defensive Player of the Year, Ian Marshall. Marshall also earned D2CCA Super Region 4 Defensive Player of the Year, NFCA, D2CCA, and Don Hansen All-America, and a finalist for the Cliff Harris Award.

In his first season on the field (2021), the Wolves posted a 7-4 record from Dacotah Bank Stadium. Northern tallied their first win over USF in the Division II era and first win over Winona since 1999 (breaking a 14 game losing streak). In addition, it was the first time receiving votes in AFCA Top-25 Poll and first NCAA Regional Ranking in program history. Eight Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and four tallied earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors. Dakota Larson and Chance Olson advanced to the Academic All-America team. In addition, Olson was named to the AFCA All-America second team, as well as the Don Hansen All-American team alongside teammate Dewaylon Ingram.

Schmidt's .675 winning percentage at La Crosse ranked third in school history. A total of 47 All-WIAC selections were earned in Schmidt's four seasons at UWL, including nine first team honors. The Eagles placed third in the conference standings in 2019, including a 31-3 victory over eventual co-champion UW-Oshkosh.

A native of Menomonie, Wisconsin, Schmidt served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at UW-Platteville, linebackers and defensive backs at the University of Dubuque (Iowa), and defensive line at Minnesota State. Schmidt was named the 2013 AFCA Division III Assistant Coach of the Year while at Dubuque.

A 2008 graduate of UWL, Schmidt was a 4-year football and baseball letter winner for the Eagles. He earned his bachelor's degree in marketing from LaCrosse and earned all-conference honors in both sports. Schmidt and his wife, Morgan, have three children.
