GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- Northern State heads into the weekend with a 10-6 overall record and a 7-3 mark in the NSIC
- The Wolves are averaging 71.4 points, 41.1 rebounds, 16.0 assists, and 14.6 turnovers per game this season
- NSU is shooting 44.6 percent from the floor, 30.0 percent from beyond the three-point line, and 70.9 percent from the foul line, currently ranking 30th in the nation from the floor
- Madelyn Bragg is first on the team, averaging 14.1 points and 7.1 rebounds per game, along with a 44.0 percent shooting percentage from the floor
- Michaela Jewett and Rianna Fillipi follows behind, adding 11.5 and 11.4 points, and 8.3 and 6.3 rebounds per game, respectively
- In addition, Fillipi leads the league with 87 assists on the year and leads the team with 24 steals
- First off the bench is Decontee Smith, contributing 8.9 points per game while shooting 45.5 percent from the floor

#23 SOUTHWEST MINNESOTA STATE MUSTANGS

- Wayne State heads into the week with a 7-6 overall record and a 4-5 record in the NSIC
- Southwest Minnesota State enters the week with a 14-2 overall record and an 8-2 mark in the NSIC
- They are averaging 85.2 points, 43.3 rebounds, 16.1 assists, and 14.7 turnovers per game
- The Mustangs are shooting 48.4 percent from the floor, 37.3 percent from beyond the three-point line, and 76.5 percent from the foul line
- Bri Stoltzman is first on the team, averaging 17.1 points and 6.1 rebounds per game while shooting 55.4 percent from the floor and leading the team with 63 assists
- Peyton Blandin and Audrey Swanson follow behind, averaging 16.4 and 14.1 points per game while both shooting better than 45.0 percent from the floor
- First off the bench for SMSU is Nichole Maenke, averaging 8.9 points and shooting 52.5 percent from beyond the three-point line
- The Mustangs are led by head coach Tom Webb, who enters his ninth season

THE WOLVES AND MUSTANGS HISTORY

- The Wolves lead the all-time series against the Mustangs, 53-19
- NSU fell to SMSU, 86-75, in their last matchup during the 2023-24 season

SIoux FALLS COUGARS

- Sioux Falls heads into the week with a 9-8 overall record and a 5-5 mark in the NSIC
- They are averaging 74.2 points per game and have a scoring margin of 7.1 on the season
- The Cougars are shooting 42.3 percent from the floor, 36.5 percent from beyond the three-point line, and 76.8 percent from the foul line
- Kami Wadsworth is first on the team, averaging 17.0 points and 4.6 rebounds per game while shooting 45.6 percent from the floor and 32.5 percent from beyond the three-point line
- First off the bench for USF is Alexis Rose, averaging 10.2 points and 3.4 rebounds per game
- The playmaker for Sioux Falls is Ayla Brown, with 64 assists on the season and a team-leading 33 steals, while averaging 7.7 points per game
- At the helm for the Cougars is Travis Traphagen, who enters his 17th season

THE WOLVES AND COUGARS HISTORY

- The Wolves lead the all-time series against the Cougars, 16-7 with their last win, 72-58 in the 2023-24

HEAD COACH PAULA KRUEGER



Paula Krueger enters her seventh season at the helm of the Northern State women in the fall of 2024 and 16th overall with the program. A former NSU standout, Krueger returned to the Northern State sidelines after 12 years at the NCAA Division II and high school levels in 2015-16.

The Wolves went 20-9 overall and 16-6 in the Northern Sun, finishing fourth in the league standings in 2023-24. They recorded big home victories against Minnesota Duluth, No. 14 Minnesota State, Winona, and Augustana, and closed out the season ranked top-5 in the NSIC in scoring, scoring defense, field goal percentage, field goal percentage defense, free throw percentage, and assist/turnover ratio. Two Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference accolades.

In 2022-23 the Wolves went 18-12 overall and 12-10 in the Northern Sun, qualifying for the NSIC Tournament. The Wolves recorded a first round win over Upper Iowa at home and fell to NCAA Regional participant Augustana from the Sanford Pentagon. Two Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and one earned CSC All-District honors.

Northern went 13-15 overall and 9-12 in the NSIC in 2021-22. Two Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference accolades. In the shortened 2021 season (due to COVID-19), Northern went 5-9 overall and two were honored on the NSIC All-Conference teams.

The Wolves posted a 14-16 record overall in 2019-20. They advanced to the quarterfinal round of the NSIC/Sanford Health Basketball Tournament with an overtime win on the road at Concordia-St. Paul. The team closed out the season with two student-athletes named to the NSIC All-Conference teams. In her first season at the helm, Northern went 10-19 overall and 7-15 in the NSIC. Two Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference accolades.

In her three seasons back with the Wolves as an assistant, Northern made three trips to the NCAA Central Region Tournament, won the 2016-17 NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament, won two NSIC North Division Championships and won a share of the 2017-18 NSIC Overall Championship. NSU went 73-21 overall in those three seasons, with four wins over nationally ranked opponents.

In 2003, Krueger stepped into her first NCAA head coaching role at the Colorado School of Mines. In nine seasons with the Orediggers, her teams tallied two runner-up finishes at the RMAC Championships (2005-06 and 2009-10), seven conference tournament first-round appearances, an NCAA Central Region appearance (2009-10), and an RMAC East Division Co-Championship (2008-09). She tallied the highest winning percentage/most wins in a coach's tenure (133-125) at Colorado Mines.

Krueger returned to the high school ranks in 2012 as the head girls' basketball coach at Arrupe Jesuit High School. After one season with the Generals, she became the head girls' basketball coach at ThunderRidge High School in Highlands Ranch, Colorado. In two seasons with the Grizzlies, Krueger's teams made two CHSAA 5A State Tournament appearances (2014-15 runner-up) and won the 2014-15 Continental League Championship. She was named the Continental League Girls' Basketball Coach of the Year and Head Coach of the Colorado High School Girls' Basketball All-Star Game that season.

Krueger is a 1995 and 1996 graduate of Northern State University with her Bachelor of Science in education and Master of Arts in teaching. She also received her principal certification from Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas, in April 2015. Krueger resides in Aberdeen with her husband, Brad.

ASSISTANT COACH KATIE BOURK



Katie Bourk enters her second season as an assistant coach for the Northern State University women's basketball program in 2024-25. Bourk spent the previous 12 seasons on staff at NSIC opponent Augustana University.

At Augustana, Bourk spent two seasons as a graduate assistant and ten seasons as a full-time assistant coach. The Vikings posted a record of 254-100 with Bourk on staff, making four NCAA Tournament appearances, including one Central Region Championship and Final Four appearance.

Bourk coached four WBCA All-Americans, two NSIC Players of the Year, and five NSIC Defensive Players of the Year in her tenure. In 2018, Bourk was honored by the WBCA with the 30 Under 30 Coaching Award.

Bourk opened her coaching career at Colman-Egan High School, assisting with the junior varsity and varsity programs. In addition to her assistant duties at Augustana, Bourk served as the team's recruiting coordinator. She is a 2011 graduate of Dakota State University, earning a bachelor's in Physical Education and 2013 graduate of Augustana University, earning a master's in Sports Administration and Leadership.

ASSISTANT COACH JOSH LEES



Josh Lees enters his second season as an assistant coach for the Northern State University women's basketball program in the fall of 2024. Lees joined the Wolves after five seasons as the head coach at Oakland Community College.

At OCC, Lees was a 2-time MCCAAC Coach of the Year and led his team to a top-20 ranking in the NJCAA. Oakland made their first national tournament appearance in school history under his direction and led the league defensively in back-to-back seasons.

Lees opened his coaching career at Troy and Avondale High Schools in Michigan, serving in both assistant and head roles. Lees played collegiately at NCAA Division III Trine University. He received his associate's degree from Oakland Community College in 2018 and bachelor's degree in Leadership and Management from Rochester University in 2021.
