GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

PROBABLE STARTERS

NORTHERN STATE STORYLINES

- Northern State was picked tenth in the 2025-26 NSIC Preseason Poll (107 points) and fifth in the North Division (27 points)
- A season ago, the Wolves finished with a 19-11 (15-7 NSIC) record, featuring three ranked wins
- The NSIC named Izzy Moore, who averaged 8.1 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.4 assists last year, as NSU's Player to Watch going into the 2025-26 campaign
- Northern State took down Valley City State in an exhibition game 60-53 on Oct. 23
- Moore finished the game with 12 points, ten rebounds and three assists, while Morgan Fiedler and Taylor Tool notched 11 points apiece
- All but two of Fiedler's points came from deep, shooting 75% from beyond the arc
- On defense, Tool led the charge with two steals and a block
- Telia Graham, who transferred in from Alaska Anchorage, and Carli Kuyper finished with 10 boards each
- As a team, Northern State went 34.3% from the field and 31.3% from range
- The Northern State Wolves are led by head coach Paula Krueger, who is in her eighth season with the team

PITTSBURG STATE STORYLINES

- The Gorillas were picked third in the MIAA 2025-26 Coaches Poll (five votes)
- In 2024-25, Pittsburg State went 33-4 (18-1 MIAA) and received a No. 1 seed in the 2025 Division II Women's Basketball Championship
- After beating Harding, Minnesota State, Southwest Minnesota State and Lubbock Christian, the Gorillas lost 68-61 to Grand Valley State, the overall winner of the tournament in the semifinals
- Pittsburg State averaged 75 points, 41.2 rebounds and 15.3 assists per game last season and made 46.4% of their field goals and 33.2% of their 3-pointers
- Macie Mays and Harper Schreiner return to the starting lineup, where Mays tallied 11.2 points, 3.3 boards and 1.2 assists per game in 2024-25
- Schreiner recorded 54 steals last season, leading the team in the category
- The Gorillas are led by eighth-year head coach Amanda Davied, who holds a 148-62 record

WOLVES AND GORILLAS HISTORY

- Pittsburg State is 3-0 against Northern State, beating the Wolves 85-55 on Nov. 8, 2024

NEBRASKA KEARNEY STORYLINES

- The Lopers are 2-1 on the season with wins tallied against Colorado School of Mines (72-70) and UT Tyler (56-46)
- UNK's only loss on the season came by way of Colorado State Pueblo (84-80)
- Nebraska Kearney is averaging 69.3 points per game and has outscored its opponents 208-200, shooting 40.2% from the field and 30% from range as a team
- Freshman Myleigh Weers has been an offensive threat for the Lopers, averaging 16 points, 6.3 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game and shooting 50% from the field and from beyond the arc
- With seven rebounds per game, center Tara Biocanin leads the team in boards (12 offensive rebounds) and averages 9.7 points on 64.7% from the floor
- Jordan Seers leads the team in steals with six and blocks with four while also averaging 14 points, 6.7 rebounds and one assist per game
- Drew Johnson is in his third year with the program, accumulating a 41-21 record with the team

WOLVES AND LOPERS HISTORY

- Northern State holds a 7-4 advantage over Nebraska Kearney, losing its last matchup 69-65 in the 2024-25 season at home

HEAD COACH PAULA KRUEGER



Paula Krueger enters her eighth season at the helm of the Northern State women in the fall of 2024 and 16th overall with the program. A former NSU standout, Krueger returned to the Northern State sidelines after 12 years at the NCAA Division II and high school levels in 2015-16.

The Wolves went 19-11 overall and 15-7 in the Northern Sun, earning a first round bye into the NSIC Tournament in 2024-25. NSU tallied nationally ranked victories over No. 6 Minnesota State, No. 16 Concordia-St. Paul, and No. 17 Southwest Minnesota State during the regular season. Northern went undefeated in NSIC play from Wachs Arena and spent the final weeks of the season ranked in the NCAA Central Region. Three Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams in Rianna Fillipi, Madelyn Bragg, and Michaela Jewett, while Jewett earned CSC Academic All-District honors.

The Wolves went 20-9 overall and 16-6 in the Northern Sun, finishing fourth in the league standings in 2023-24. They recorded big home victories against Minnesota Duluth, No. 14 Minnesota State, Winona, and Augustana, and closed out the season ranked top-5 in the NSIC in scoring, scoring defense, field goal percentage, field goal percentage defense, free throw percentage, and assist/turnover ratio. Two Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference accolades.

In 2022-23 the Wolves went 18-12 overall and 12-10 in the Northern Sun, qualifying for the NSIC Tournament. The Wolves recorded a first round win over Upper Iowa at home and fell to NCAA Regional participant Augustana from the Sanford Pentagon. Two Wolves were named to the NSIC All-Conference teams and one earned CSC All-District honors.

Northern went 13-15 overall and 9-12 in the NSIC in 2021-22. Two Wolves earned NSIC All-Conference accolades. In the shortened 2021 season (due to COVID-19), Northern went 5-9 overall and two were honored on the NSIC All-Conference teams.

In her three seasons back with the Wolves as an assistant, Northern made three trips to the NCAA Central Region Tournament, won the 2016-17 NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament, won two NSIC North Division Championships and won a share of the 2017-18 NSIC Overall Championship. NSU went 73-21 overall in those three seasons, with four wins over nationally ranked opponents.

In 2003, Krueger stepped into her first NCAA head coaching role at the Colorado School of Mines. In nine seasons with the Orediggers, her teams tallied two runner-up finishes at the RMAC Championships (2005-06 and 2009-10), seven conference tournament first-round appearances, an NCAA Central Region appearance (2009-10), and an RMAC East Division Co-Championship (2008-09). She tallied the highest winning percentage/most wins in a coach's tenure (133-125) at Colorado Mines.

Krueger returned to the high school ranks in 2012 as the head girls' basketball coach at Arrupe Jesuit High School. After one season with the Generals, she became the head girls' basketball coach at ThunderRidge High School in Highlands Ranch, Colorado. In two seasons with the Grizzlies, Krueger's teams made two CHSAA 5A State Tournament appearances (2014-15 runner-up) and won the 2014-15 Continental League Championship. She was named the Continental League Girls' Basketball Coach of the Year and Head Coach of the Colorado High School Girls' Basketball All-Star Game that season.

Krueger is a 1995 and 1996 graduate of Northern State University with her Bachelor of Science in education and Master of Arts in teaching. She also received her principal certification from Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas, in April 2015. Krueger resides in Aberdeen with her husband, Brad.

ASSISTANT COACH KATIE BOURK



Katie Bourk enters her third season as an assistant coach for the Northern State University women's basketball program in 2025-26. Bourk spent the previous 12 seasons on staff at NSIC opponent Augustana University.

At Augustana, Bourk spent two seasons as a graduate assistant and ten seasons as a full-time assistant coach. The Vikings posted a record of 254-100 with Bourk on staff, making four NCAA Tournament appearances, including one Central Region Championship and Final Four appearance.

Bourk coached four WBCA All-Americans, two NSIC Players of the Year, and five NSIC Defensive Players of the Year in her tenure. In 2018, Bourk was honored by the WBCA with the 30 Under 30 Coaching Award.

Bourk opened her coaching career at Colman-Egan High School, assisting with the junior varsity and varsity programs. In addition to her assistant duties at Augustana, Bourk served as the team's recruiting coordinator. She is a 2011 graduate of Dakota State University, earning a bachelor's in Physical Education and 2013 graduate of Augustana University, earning a master's in Sports Administration and Leadership.

As the graduate assistant at TWU from 2023 to 2025, Chavira oversaw a variety of areas including facility scheduling, team travel, equipment, graphics work, and the program's team managers. In addition, he assisted with player development, recruiting, film breakdown, and scouting reports. Texas Woman's went 67-7 in his two seasons on staff, reaching the post season in both 2023-24 and 2024-25. TWU finished as the National Runner-up in 2024.

Chavira opened his collegiate career as a student manager at Eastern New Mexico University, assisting with skill development, opponent scouting, equipment, and team academics. Chavira has worked basketball camps at both Eastern New Mexico and Texas Woman's. Chavira holds a bachelor's degree in Business Administration – Personal Finance from Eastern New Mexico and master's degree in Business Administration from Texas Woman's.
