## GAME DAY STORYLINES AND QUICK HITS

### NORTHERN STATE WOLVES

- The Wolves hit the road with a 7-11 record overall and 7-5 mark in the NSIC
- Northern is averaging 74.8 points, 34.6 rebounds, 13.6 assists, 10.6 turnovers, 3.9 steals, and 1.8 blocks per game
- They are shooting 43.9% from the floor, 33.7% from the 3-point line, and 74.5% from the foul line
- Joshua Book leads four Wolves in double figures, averaging 14.0 points per game with a team leading 80 assists
- James Glenn and Marshawn Smith follow averaging 12.6 and 11.0 points per game respectively, with Smith leading the team off the bench
- Simon Akena is the final Wolf in double figures, notching 10.7 points per contest
- Tobi Obiora leads the team in efficiency, shooting 61.8% from the floor, and is averaging a team best 7.5 rebounds per contest
- Ty Rogers rounds out the starting five adding 9.1 points and 4.3 rebounds per game

### MINNESOTA STATE MAVERICKS

- The Mavericks enter the weekend with an 11-9 record overall and 5-7 mark in the Northern Sun
- They are shooting 44.1% from the floor, 32.0% from the 3-point line, and 73.8% from the foul line
- MSU is averaging 77.2 points, 37.7 rebounds, 12.0 assists, 10.8 turnovers, 6.1 steals, and 3.4 blocks per game; out-scoring and out-rebounding their opponents 3.4 points and 2.4 boards per game
- Malcom Jones leads four in double figures, notching 13.2 points per game, as well as a team leading 8.0 rebounds per game
- Jones is shooting a team leading 55.9% from the floor
- Trajan Sain is averaging 12.7 points, while Caden Kirkman and Arhman Lewis are adding 10.7 and 10.2 respectively
- Minnesota State is led by head coach Matt Margenthaler in his 26th season at the helm

### LAST MEETING

- The Wolves fell to the Mavericks 87-59 last season
- Northern is 11-12 all-time against Minnesota State

### ST. CLOUD STATE HUSKIES

- The Huskies head into the weekend with a 13-5 record overall and 10-2 mark in the NSIC
- They are averaging 76.3 points, 42.4 rebounds, 12.5 assists, 11.7 turnovers, 6.9 steals, and 3.4 blocks per game; out-scoring and out-rebounding their opponents by a league leading 9.6 points and 7.8 boards per game
- They are shooting 42.1% from the floor, 28.5% from the 3-point line, and 70.1% from the foul line this season
- Luke Winkel leads the team averaging 19.3 points per game with 71 assists this season
- Bob Griechen and Wyatt Hawks follow, adding 11.7 and 11.6 points respectively per game, with Hawks shooting a team leading 51.9% from the floor
- In addition, Hawks leads the team averaging 8.7 rebounds per contest, followed by Nate Dahl averaging 7.0
- SCSU is led by head coach Quincy Henderson in his fourth season

### LAST MEETING

- The Wolves suffered a 67-57 loss at St. Cloud State last season
- Northern is 30-32 all-time versus the Huskies

## HEAD COACH MATT WILBER



South Dakota native Matt Wilber enters his first season leading the Northern State men's basketball program, as the 23rd head coach in men's basketball history, heading into the 2025-26 season. He is just the seventh head coach since the 1945-46 season and fifth in the NCAA Division II era. Wilber joined the Wolves after spending the 2024 season as an assistant coach with the WNBA Phoenix Mercury, under the direction of head coach Nate Tibbets, and the previous 11 seasons as the head men's basketball coach at Dakota Wesleyan University.

As an assistant coach with the Mercury, Wilber was assigned as the personal player coach to UConn, WNBA, and USA Basketball legend Diana Taurasi and WNBA veteran guard Rebecca Allen. The Mercury went 19-21 overall in 2024, finishing fourth in the Western Conference. Taurasi played in her 11th WNBA All-Star game in 2024 prior to announcing her retirement in February of this year.

Wilber built the Dakota Wesleyan Tigers into a perennial contender at the NAIA level, going 224-125 in his 11 seasons at the helm. DWU made six consecutive trips to the NAIA National Tournament from 2014 to 2020, including a NAIA National Runner-up finish in 2015 with a 32-5 record overall. He earned GPAC Coach of the Year, Rawlings NAIA National Coach of the Year, and South Dakota Sports Writers Coach of the Year honors following that national championship game appearance. Wilber's DWU squads tallied eight winning seasons and six with 20-plus wins.

Wilber produced 35 GPAC All-Conference honorees, 30 NAIA Scholar Athletes, 13 NAIA All-Americans, including six first team recipients, three GPAC Players of the Year, two GPAC Defensive Players of the Year, two GPAC Freshman of the Year, and two CoSIDA Academic All-Americans®. In addition, his teams advanced to the sweet sixteen round in three seasons and earned the 2016 NAIA National Tournament Team Sportsmanship Award.

Wilber opened his collegiate coaching career with assistant stops at Augustana, Sioux Falls and South Dakota State. Following his playing career, Wilber was a student assistant for the Augustana Vikings under the direction of head coach Perry Ford. He then moved across town, serving as the head junior varsity coach and assistant coach at the University of Sioux Falls for Shane Murphy. From 2004 to 2006, Wilber was on staff as a graduate assistant for Scott Nagy and the South Dakota State Jackrabbits. He was on staff at SDSU for the NCAA Division I transition assisting in all areas of the program.

From 2006 to 2013, Wilber owned and directed TIBBS Basketball alongside Tibbets, building a year-round basketball development program. TIBBS worked with 800 to 1,000 participants annually, as Wilber grew the program from a residential home gym set-up to a basketball powerhouse in Southeast South Dakota and beyond. Sanford Health bought the TIBBS developmental program in 2013 and hired Wilber as the director of the newly named Sanford POWER TIBBS Basketball Academy. The program continued to grow in his year on staff, developing the academy to 1,200 area players, seven season teams and nine summer teams, and 17 summer camp sessions all taking place from the Sanford Pentagon.

Wilber earned his bachelor's degree from Augustana College; a walk-on that earned both a scholarship and starting role, Wilber played for the Vikings from 1997 to 2002. He closed out his collegiate career in the top-10 all-time in 3-point field goals made and earned Academic All-Conference honorable mention accolades in 2001. In addition, Wilber was a 4-year starter for the Augustana baseball team as a pitcher and utility player.

Wilber is married to Dakota Wesleyan head volleyball coach Lindsay Wilber. The pair have five children Benjamin, A.J., Nathan, Tyson, and Lizzie.

## ASSISTANT COACH JACK NELSON



Jack Nelson enters his first season on staff at Northern State in the fall of 2025. Nelson joins the Wolves after serving as the associate head coach at the University of Sioux Falls and head coach at the University of Mary.

From 2021 to 2025, Nelson served as the head coach at the University of Mary where he developed one NSIC Newcomer of the Year and one NSIC All-Conference first team recipient. In addition, 16 Marauders earned Academic Honor Court accolades, his team's earned the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award twice, and five were named to the CSC Academic All-District® Team. Prior to his stint with the Marauders, Nelson was the associate head coach at the University of Sioux Falls. USF posted a 48-24 record in his three seasons on staff. They won the 2020 NSIC South Division title with six NSIC All-Conference performers and one All-Region recipient.

Nelson opened his coaching career as an assistant at Saint Mary's University during the 2007-08 season. He moved on to assistant coaching stops at Sioux Falls from 2008 to 2011, Bellevue University in 2011-12, and Minot State University from 2012 to 2016. He led the Central Wyoming College Rustlers from 2016 to 2018 as the head coach, posting a 41-21 record overall. CWC advanced to the quarterfinal round of the NJCAA Regional tournament in back-to-back seasons. He coached three all-region selections and all of his student-athletes went on to play at the 4-year level.

Nelson holds an Associate of Arts from Black Hawk College, Bachelor of Arts in Sports Management from Saint Mary's University, and Master of Science in Education Leadership from Winona State University. Jack and his wife Jamie have two children, Raelynn and Kai.

## ASSISTANT COACH WES SMITH



Wes Smith enters his first season with the Northern State University men's basketball program in the fall of 2025. Smith will fill the team's second assistant role heading into the 2025-26 season, after three seasons in as an assistant at Missouri Western State.

Smith has spent the entirety of his collegiate coaching career at Missouri Western on staff with head coaches Brent Weiberg, Sundance Wicks and Will Martin. He spent the past three seasons as an assistant for the Griffons. Smith opened his career as a graduate assistant at MWSU from 2020-2022 after serving as a student assistant from 2016-2020.

In his time at MoWest, Smith worked with seven MAIA All-Conference performers and saw the program grow into a contender in the MAIA. The Griffons qualified for the NCAA Central Region Tournament hosted in Aberdeen in 2021, opened the 2023-24 season with seven wins, the best start since 1999, were ranked as high as No. 17 in the NABC Top-25 poll in 2024-25, and recorded the most regular season victories in over 20 years this past season with 18.

Smith earned both his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Master of Business Administration from Missouri Western State University. Wes is married to Maggie Smith.
