## 'CATS PREP FOR LAND OF LINCOLN SHOWDOWN IN CHAMPAIGN

Northwestern will travel just over 150 miles south down Interstate 57 this weekend to take on the Illinois Fighting Illini in a three-game series in Champaign. All three games of the crucial conference set at Illinois Field will be televised on the Big Ten Digital Network.

### SERIES HISTORY

The Wildcats have met the Illini on the diamond nearly 250 times and, to date, Illinois owns the edge in the all-time series 160-82-1. Northwestern's downstate rival swept a three-game series in Evanston last season, winning all three contests by a combined four runs. The last time NU played at Illinois Field in 2010, it took two-of-three ballgames.

### SCOUTING THE ILLINI

Illinois has been one of the top hitting clubs in the Big Ten this season. Head coach **Dan Hartleb's** squad is batting .307 and ranks second in the Big Ten in batting average, slugging percentage and on-base percentage. Individually, **Justin Parr** is the top batter in the conference with an average of .435 and 98 total bases entering the weekend. The Illini boast six regulars batting .283 or better, including Justin's twin brother, **Jordan Parr** (.310). Illinois' pitching staff maintains a 3.76 ERA and is led by senior RHP **Kevin Johnson**. Johnson is tied for the team lead with six wins in 10 starts and boasts the lowest ERA on the staff at 2.45. He has 44 strikeouts in 66.0 IP and opponents are batting .247 off the Midlothian, Ill., native.

BIG TEN'S BEST

As the second half of Big Ten play continues, the Wildcats remain in the top half of the Big Ten in several key statistical categories. Offensively, Northwestern ranks third in the Big Ten in slugging percentage (.364), fourth in batting average (.283) and fifth in on-base percentage (.360). On the mound, Northwestern's pitching staff ranks second in the Big Ten with 7.3 strikeouts per game. The 'Cats also rank third with a pair of complete games on the bump.

FARRELL FETCHES BIG TEN HONOR

Senior **Luke Farrell** was named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week on Monday, April 22. The Westlake, Ohio native was brilliant as he fired a complete-game, three-hit shutout against the Michigan Wolverines at Wrigley Field on April 20. The 6-foot-6-inch standout struck out nine and did not issue a free pass in the victory that saw his ERA sink to 1.88, a mark that ranks fourth in the Big Ten. Farrell's 59 strikeouts this season lead the conference.

MIGHTY MORTON

Fifth-year senior **Zach Morton** has found ways to get it done both on the mound and at the dish for the Wildcats. The fifth-year standout is 3-2 with a 1.98 ERA and 35 strikeouts in nine starts and one relief appearance. His low ERA currently ranks sixth in the Big Ten. Between Feb. 22 and March 22, the Evanston, Ill., native posted a streak of 26.2 consecutive innings without surrendering an earned run. At the plate, Morton is batting .295 and leads Northwestern with 26 RBI. Recently he led NU with three hits, including a pair of RBI doubles, in a 6-0 victory over the Michigan Wolverines at Wrigley Field on April 20.

EVERETT BROTHER

Northwestern senior third baseman **Colby Everett** has been on fire in the batter's box during the month of April. After scuffling at the plate through his first 13 games, the Scottsdale, Ariz., native is batting .400 (18-for-45) with five doubles and eight RBI in nine games entering the final full week of the month. He had a 12-game hitting streak that was snapped at Milwaukee on Wednesday and ranks second on the team with nine runs scored in April.

TWICE IS NICE

Freshman **Zach Jones** picked up his second Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor on Monday, April 9. The Glenview, Ill., native hit .522 with four RBI and five runs scored that week as NU went 4-1. Jones tallied a career-high three RBI on April 6 and followed that up with a personal-best four hits against the Boilermakers on April 7. Jones, who becomes the first Northwestern player ever to win multiple Freshman of the Week honors in one season, hit safely in 10 consecutive games at one point for the Wildcats.

CROOKED NUMBERS

When Northwestern has scored this season, it has tended to do so in bunches. The Wildcats have posted 44 multi-run innings this year. Twice this season the 'Cats have scored eight runs in a single inning; first on March 16 in the fifth inning against Bucknell and again on April 2 against St. Francis, when they scored eight times in the sixth. The Wildcats are 16-8 when scoring at least three runs in a game in 2013.

HOT WHEELS

Fifth-year senior **Trevor Stevens** had a prolific weekend on the basepaths for the Wildcats at Purdue. The leadoff man swiped four bases, including a career-high three in a 10-6 victory over the Boilermakers on April 6. With two outs in the top of the ninth, the fifth-year senior stole second and third before scoring the winning run. Stevens also stole third base with two outs to set up the game-tying run against Michigan on April 11. The shortstop leads the team and ranks tied for 11<sup>th</sup> in the Big Ten with 13 stolen bases.

MIDWEEK MAVENS

Northwestern received back-to-back fantastic starts on the mound from a pair of left-handed freshmen in midweek games this month. On April 3, **Reed Mason** fired seven shutout innings at the UIC Flames. The Solana Beach, Calif., native tallied a career-high five strikeouts in a 3-1 win. **Matt Portland** stifled Wheaton with seven shutout innings of his own on April 16. The New Yorker racked up a career-high eight strikeouts and retired 15 in a row between the second and seventh innings.

RUCHIM RAKES AND FIRES

Junior **Kyle Ruchim** has been one of the most prolific batters in the Big Ten this season. The Buffalo Grove, Ill., native currently ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.459) and slugging percentage (.577) and sixth in batting average (.375). In addition, Ruchim is 3-1 with two saves, a 0.72 ERA and 23 strikeouts in 25.0 innings on the mound this year. He has allowed only two earned runs in 11 appearances and none since March 29 at Nebraska when he went 4.1 innings in relief.

FARRELL FANS A DOZEN

In his first official start of the season, senior **Luke Farrell** struck out a career-high 12 Lipscomb Bisons in six innings of work during an 11-4 victory on Feb. 24. The right-hander caught half of his 12 victims looking and struck out five of six batters over his final two frames. The mark of 12 Ks is the second-highest output of any Big Ten pitcher this season and the most for a Wildcat hurler since **J.A. Happ** punched out 16 Iowa Hawkeyes in a seven-inning complete game on May 3, 2003. Farrell has also fanned nine hitters in three starts this season: against North Dakota State (March 15), Iowa (March 23) and Michigan (April 20).

HAVEY LIFTING

**Jack Havey** returned to the lineup against Minnesota on April 12 after missing five games and is currently hitting .359, a number that ranks him ninth in the Big Ten. Havey's on-base percentage of .438 is also good for sixth in the league. The Wilmette, Ill., native drove in the game-winning run against Michigan on April 21; he owns 12 multi-hit efforts this year, including four three-hit performances.

DOUBLE DOWN

Northwestern's lineup has produced 64 doubles this season or 2.1 per game. That number ranks the 'Cats atop the Big Ten and 34<sup>th</sup> in the entire country. Seven players have at least five doubles in 2013, led by **Kyle Ruchim**, who has nine. On the flip side, the Wildcats pitching staff has surrendered only 36 two-base hits, by far the fewest per game in the conference. NU's three primary starting pitchers have allowed only 19 doubles in 175 innings pitched.

**ZERO EQUALS W**

Northwestern is 10-1 this season when not committing an error in the field. The 'Cats are 2-3 with one error on the scoresheet, but when charged with two or more errors, NU's record falls to 5-11 this season. The 'Cats did not have a single error in the entire series against Michigan, April 20-21.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED**

**Kyle Ruchim** enjoyed a memorable opening day at the plate in an 8-1 victory against Miami. The Buffalo Grove, Ill., native notched hits in his first four plate appearances of the season, including a sixth-inning double, to match a career high for the second time. Ruchim last tallied four hits on May, 15, 2012 against Notre Dame when three of those knocks went for doubles. He also accomplished the feat as a freshman against Army on March 19, 2011.

**CLOSING COMMITTEE**

Four different pitchers have combined to earn six saves for Northwestern this season. **Ethan Bramschreiber** and **Kyle Ruchim** each have two saves to their credit, while **Jack Quigley** and **Dan Tyson** have also nailed down victories for the Wildcats this season. Ruchim also has two wins this season as he was the pitcher of record during extra-inning victories against both North Dakota State (3/15) and Iowa (3/22).

**SOMETHING CLICKS IN FIVE AND SIX**

The Wildcats have had a successful time in the fifth and sixth innings this season. Northwestern is outscoring the opposition 45-21 in those two innings combined. The most problematic frame for NU has been the seventh when it has a differential of -9 (28-19). On the whole, the 'Cats are outscoring opponents 172-142 through 32 games.

**TWO-WAY TALENT**

In addition to being a member of the baseball program, freshman outfielder **Jack Mitchell** is also a member of Northwestern's football team under the direction of head coach **Pat Fitzgerald**. Mitchell, a kicking specialist, did not see any game action as a true freshman in the fall and received a redshirt for his service on the gridiron. NU's football team won the 2013 Gator Bowl on New Year's Day over Mississippi State, 34-20. At Torrey Pines High School, Mitchell starred in both football and baseball on his way to being named the school's 2012 Athlete of the Year.

**STRAUB STARS**

Junior **Jake Straub** was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday, April 9. The Fishers, Ind., native hit .667 in five games and .727 in a three-game series at Purdue. The catcher went 4-for-4 with three RBI off the bench in Northwestern's 10-6 victory on April 6. Straub posted a seven-game hitting streak earlier this season and he reached base safely in 13-straight games at one point. It is the first weekly honor of Straub's career; he is the first Wildcat to earn the accolade since **Paul Snieder** on May 16, 2011.

**TOGETHER AGAIN**

Northwestern's roster features numerous players that played together in high school before coming to Evanston. Freshmen **Reed Mason** and **Jack Mitchell** both hail from Torrey Pines H.S. in San Diego. The Wildcats boast four players who attended nearby Glenbrook South H.S. in Glenview, Ill. Fifth-year senior **Trevor Stevens**, junior **Cody Stevens**, sophomore **Cody Libman** and freshman **Zach Jones** each roamed the halls of the school which sits less than 10 miles from Northwestern's campus.

**HEAD COACH PAUL STEVENS**



**Paul Stevens** is now in his 26<sup>th</sup> season as Northwestern's head baseball coach and 29<sup>th</sup> overall in a Wildcat uniform. He is the winningest coach in program history, having amassed more than 630 career wins. Win No. 600 came on March 4, 2012 in the Wildcats' 14-6 victory over Chicago State in Port Charlotte, Fla.

Entering the 2012 season, he had coached 1,202 games, 501 more than **George McKinnon** (701), who coached from 1962-81.

In his tenure as head coach, the Wildcats enjoyed 15-straight 20-win seasons and have reached the 30-win mark on three different occasions. NU has won 20 games in 20 of those years.

Stevens has tutored individuals to a total of 81 All-Big Ten honors during his time as head coach, including **J.A. Happ** who was a three-time first-team selection from 2002-04. Two players have been named Big Ten Freshman of the Year—**Jeremy Kurella** (1998) and **Eric Jokisch** (2008)—and two others have been named Big Ten Pitcher of the Year—**Chad Schroeder** (1995) and **Dan Brauer** (2006).

With a 21-11 conference record in 2006, NU demolished the previous season-high conference win total of 15. It also was the first time in school history the team earned a No. 2 seed in the postseason tournament and a first-round bye. For his efforts, Stevens was named the 2006 Big Ten Coach of the Year. The honor was the third of his career. He also was honored in 1991 and 1995.

A total of 62 players have been drafted or signed by a Major League club during Stevens' tenure.

Prior to joining the Wildcat staff, Stevens was a scout for the New York Mets. Before joining the scouting ranks, he played three years in the Kansas City Royals' organization and two seasons in the Oakland Athletics' farm system as a second baseman/shortstop. Stevens also played one season with the Athletics' Triple-A club in Ogden, Utah. In 1979, he was named to the Topps All-Minor League Team.

Coming out of college, Stevens was drafted by the Kansas City Royals following an outstanding career at Lewis University. At Lewis, he was named to the NAIA All-America squad in 1976. Stevens led Lewis to the 1975 and 1976 NAIA Championships and was named to the all-tournament squad both years. He was presented the Charlie Hustle Award at the 1975 tournament and earned a Golden Glove Award the following season. Elected to the Lewis Sports Hall of Fame in 1988, Stevens ended his career with a .346 batting average.

In 1975, following his junior season at Lewis, Stevens played for the United States in the Pan American Games in Mexico City, helping the squad to a silver medal. He also played on a U.S. team that toured the Orient that same year.

In 2001, Stevens enjoyed his second tour of duty with the National Team, this time as an assistant coach. The team was made up of collegiate all-stars who played 29 games in 40 days, compiling a 22-7 record which included a 12-game winning streak. The Red, White and Blue Tour spanned two continents, two countries and 10 different U.S. states.

Stevens is a native of Oak Lawn, Ill., graduating from Luther South High School in 1972. He played for two years under former Major Leaguer **Eddie Stanky** at South Alabama before transferring to Lewis.

Stevens, 58, graduated from Lewis in 1976 with a bachelor's degree in elected sciences. He and his wife, Kenan, live in Glenview with their children Trevor (a senior infielder/outfielder at Northwestern), Cody (a junior infielder/outfielder at NU) and Kara.
