TEAM NOTES

- First meeting between the two teams since Jan. 18, 2006
- NU held Milwaukee to just 21 first-half points, the second fewest so far this season
- NU took over in the all-time series 4-3, snapping Milwaukee's three-game win streak over the 'Cats
- NU has held its opposition to less than 50 points on three occasions so far this season
- Northwestern improves to 8-0 on the season
- Starts the year 8-0 for the second time under head coach Joe McKeown
- Held Milwaukee to 20 shooting, the lowest mark of any team this season
- Held the opposition to under 30 percent shooting for the third time this year
- At least three Wildcats scored in double figures for the ninth-straight game
- The #BIGCats have had four different scoring leaders in eight games
- Northwestern remains undefeated at home this season
- Northwestern starters: Nia Coffey (F), Maggie Lyon (G), Christen Johnson (F), Christen Inman (G) and Ashley Deary (G)
- Halftime score: Northwestern 37, Milwaukee 21
- Attendance: 812

Nia Coffey • Junior • Forward

- Scored in double figures for the 23rd-consecutive game, dating back to Jan. 22, 2015
- Recorded her fourth-straight and fifth double-double of the season (27th of her career)
- Logged her fourth 20+ point game this season
- Led the 'Cats in scoring for the second time this year

Maggie Lyon • Senior • Guard

- Scored in double figures for the seventh straight game
- Led the team in assists (along with Ashley Deary) for the first time this season

Ashley Deary • Junior • Guard

- Scored in double-digits for the eighth-straight game
- Led the team in assists (along with Maggie Lyon) for the seventh time this season
- Led the team in steals for the sixth time this year
- Logged at least five steals for the fourth time this year
