MOVER OF CHAINS

When the Wildcats need a first down, senior wide receiver **Christian Jones** has developed as a reliable target. The Texan missed the 2014 season with an injury, but in 2013 72.2 percent (39-of-54) of his receptions resulted in a first down. Further, 27.8 percent of his catches came on either third or fourth down. Jones is NU's active leader with 105 receptions, 60 percent (63) of which have moved the chains for the 'Cats.



OPENING BELL

Northwestern has played well in its season-opening game under head coach **Pat Fitzgerald**, who begins his 10th season at the helm. The Wildcats are 8-1 in season openers under Fitzgerald. From 2010-2013, Chicago's Big Ten Team rattled off impressive road victories against Power-5 foes Vanderbilt ('10), Boston College ('11), Syracuse ('12) and Cal ('13). NU is 15-5 in its last 20 opening games and 78-45-4 all-time in lid lifters.

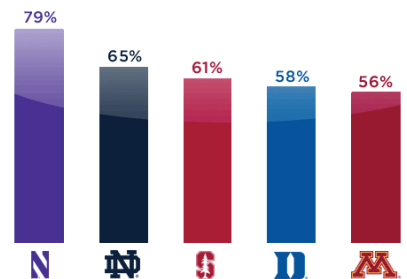
JACKSON JUICES OFFENSE

Justin Jackson, who ranked fourth nationally among all Power-5 conference freshmen in yards per game a year ago with 98.9, became just the second freshman in Northwestern history to rush for 1,000 yards and is the Big Ten's second leading returning rusher this fall behind Ohio State's Ezekiel Elliott.

BEST AND BRIGHTEST

Northwestern currently ranks as the FBS school with the highest percentage of its teams to receive NCAA Public Recognition Awards. Fifteen of 19 Northwestern teams (79%) were recognized in May when the announcement was made. Stanford ranked third on the list with 61% of its athletics teams honored.

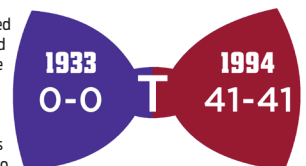


SWAT TEAM

2014 All-Big Ten selection **Nick VanHoose** ranked second in the Big Ten, and 26th nationally, with 1.20 passes defended a year ago and currently ranks fourth in NU program history with 25. Defensive end **Dean Lowry** also disturbed team's aerial attacks with eight PBU's to lead all Big Ten linemen in 2014. The two combined rank as the Big Ten's highest returning duo in 2015.

NO MORE TIES

The last time a Northwestern team finished a game in a tie, it came against the Stanford Cardinal on Sept. 10, 1994 when the game ended with 41 points a side. The Wildcats and 24th-ranked Cardinal combined for 862 yards on 155 offensive plays in front of a national audience on ESPN. The first meeting in this series, which took place on Oct. 14, 1933, also ended in a tie...without either side scoring a point.

HEAD COACH PAT FITZGERALD

Already the second-longest tenured Big Ten head coach at the age of 40, Pat Fitzgerald's nine seasons at the helm of Northwestern have been spent building upon the tradition he helped establish as a Hall-of-Fame linebacker for the Wildcats in the mid-1990's. Characterized by his motivational skills, enthusiasm and passion for all things Northwestern, Fitzgerald has shaped Chicago's Big Ten Team into one that consistently achieves excellence in all three phases of the student-athlete experience: academics, athletics and community outreach.

Taking over as head coach in 2006 after the sudden passing of his friend and mentor, Randy Walker, Fitzgerald provided leadership and stability in a trying time and has continued Walker's legacy of producing winning football teams while preparing young men for long-term success in life.

Beginning in 2008, Fitzgerald guided the Wildcats to five consecutive bowl berths, most recently in 2012 when NU capped a tremendous 10-win season with a landmark victory over Mississippi State in the TaxSlayer.com Gator Bowl. The 2012 'Cats, who played in a New Year's Day bowl game for the third time in five years, earned a No. 17 year-end ranking in the USA Today/Coaches Poll, the best positioning for any Big Ten team.

Four of the last five senior classes to graduate from the Northwestern football program have set or tied the school record for most career wins by a five-year senior class, with the 2012 group going out as the winningest NU senior class in history with 40 victories to its credit. Likewise, Fitzgerald's Gator Bowl victory on Jan. 1, 2013, marked the 50th of his career, officially making him the winningest head coach in Northwestern Football history.

Away from the gridiron, Fitzgerald's players have achieved at the highest levels in the classroom, last fall placing 38 players on the Academic All-Big Ten team and collecting top national honors in the AFCA Academic Achievement Award for the seventh time since 1998. Additionally, Fitzgerald's program ranked second among all FBS programs in the recently released multi-year Academic Progress Rating (APR), posting a score of 992 out of a possible 1,000 in the measure of player retention and eligibility.

As a player in 1995, Fitzgerald was the leader of a suffocating Wildcats defensive unit that led the nation in scoring defense and anchored NU's storybook run to the Big Ten championship and Rose Bowl. He capped the year by winning both the Nagurski and Bednarik Awards as the nation's top defensive player and also was the Big Ten, Chevrolet and Sports Illustrated Defensive Player of the Year. Fitzgerald accomplished all of this despite suffering a broken leg in the penultimate regular-season game.

Fitzgerald recovered from that injury and in 1996 he again led the Wildcats to a share of the Big Ten title. He repeated as recipient of the Nagurski and Bednarik Awards, becoming the first two-time winner of both honors and laying the groundwork for his selection in 2008 to the College Football Hall of Fame.

In May of 2011, NU Director of Athletics Jim Phillips announced that Fitzgerald and the school agreed to a new 10-year deal that will keep him on the Northwestern sidelines through 2020. The 10-year deal is unprecedented in Northwestern Athletics history.

"I'm humbled and appreciative of the commitment shown by Northwestern," said Fitzgerald. "With this support from our administration, our coaches and players expect to compete for championships."

NORTHWESTERN GAME NOTES

• 2015 marks the 128th season of intercollegiate competition for the Northwestern Wildcats. NU has won 508 games since it began play in 1882 with a 1-1 record against Lake Forest.

• For the second consecutive year, but only the second time since 2009, the Northwestern Wildcats will hit the gridiron at home on Ryan Field for their season opener against the Stanford Cardinal Saturday. NU is 8-2 in its last 10 home openers dating back to a 38-14 victory over Ohio on Sept. 3, 2005.

• Chicago's Big Ten Team is 29-7 (.806) in nonconference games under the direction of head coach **Pat Fitzgerald**. The Wildcats went 2-2 against non-Big Ten foes in 2014 with wins coming at home over Western Illinois (24-7 on Sept. 20) and at No. 15/16 Notre Dame (43-40 in OT on Nov. 15).

• Northwestern is a founding member of the Big Ten Conference, and is in its second season in the West Division. The Wildcats are not slated to meet the league's two newest teams until they take a road trip to Piscataway, N.J. to play Rutgers in 2017 before a visit to College Park, Md., to face the Terrapins the following year. NU will travel to Michigan (Oct. 10) and host Penn State (Nov. 7) in its two 2015 crossover games.

2015 WILDCATS AT A GLANCE

- 20 seniors (three true seniors, 17 fifth-year seniors)

• The following six different players have started 20 or more career games: **Dan Vitale** (34), **Nick VanHoose** (32), **Christian Jones** (29), **Geoff Mogus** (23), **Dean Lowry** (21) and **Traveon Henry** (20). In all, 25 players on the current roster have made at least one career start for the Wildcats.

• Northwestern said goodbye to five starters on the offensive side of the ball and three more on defense after the 2014 season. Of the eight departed starters, six received an opportunity to continue playing with NFL teams, including safety **Ibraheim Campbell** and quarterback **Trevor Siemian**, who were drafted by the Cleveland Browns and Denver Broncos, respectively, in May.

• Geographically speaking, more than 25 percent (27 of 107) of Northwestern's roster hails from right here in Illinois. Ohio is the second most-represented state (18), ahead of Texas (11) and California (9). In all, the Wildcats call 20 different states home: Illinois (27), Ohio (18), Texas (11), California (9), New Jersey (7), Pennsylvania (5), Florida (4), Michigan (4), Kansas (3), Georgia (3), Indiana (3), Maryland (3), Wisconsin (2), Massachusetts (2), Missouri (2), Hawaii (1), Kentucky (1), Louisiana (1), New York (1) and Tennessee (1).

FAMILIAR FACES SURROUND FITZGERALD

In a profession that is known for its year-to-year turnover, **Pat Fitzgerald** has assembled an assistant coaching staff that is characterized instead by its continuity. Consider:

- Fitzgerald retained all nine of his assistant coaches for the fourth straight offseason, making Northwestern the only FBS program in the country to boast the same full-time coaching staff in five consecutive years entering the 2015 campaign.
- Northwestern is the only FBS school to have the same offensive and defensive coordinator in place for the eighth consecutive season. Both **Mick McCall** (offense) and **Mike Hankwitz** (defense) joined the Wildcats in 2008.
- Assistant head coach **Jerry Brown** has been on staff 23 years at Northwestern. Brown is also a 1972 graduate of Northwestern's School of Education.

FOUR SENIORS ELECTED 2015 TEAM CAPTAINS

With summer workouts and training camp behind them, head coach **Pat Fitzgerald** and the Wildcats named the four individuals who are serving as team captains for the duration of the 2015 campaign. The quartet is composed of two true seniors and two fifth-year seniors, with a pair from both the offensive and defensive sides of the ball. They are: DE **Deonte Gibson**, S **Traveon Henry**, WR **Christian Jones** and SB **Dan Vitale**. All four are first-time captains and also members of NU's 14-player Leadership Council.

LEADERSHIP COUNCIL ELECTED

Determined through a team-wide voting process, the 14-member NU Leadership Council regularly meets with **Pat Fitzgerald** throughout the year to discuss issues that affect the entire program and maintain lines of communication with the coaching staff. The player-elected group has significant input on team goal-setting, uniform design, optimal game-day schedules and more. 'CATS POST RECORD-SETTING PERFORMANCES IN CLASSROOM IN 2014-15

Long recognized as leaders among Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) programs in academic performance, Northwestern student-athletes achieved at record rates in the classroom during the 2013-14 academic year. Collectively, the members of the Northwestern football program posted a stellar team GPA of 3.02 for the entirety of 2014-15. NEW ATHLETICS/RECREATION COMPLEX COMING TO NORTHWESTERN'S SCENIC LAKEFRONT

Northwestern University is in the early stages of construction of a major complex for athletic and recreational activities on the north end of its main Evanston campus. A large indoor multipurpose facility will provide room for major events, such as the University's annual new student convocation; indoor practice and a competition venue for intercollegiate sports; and space for recreation, club sports and intramurals. NU has already raised more than \$170 million in support of the project.

In addition, three more current Wildcats have had older brothers come through the program. SEPTEMBER SUCCESS

Head coach **Pat Fitzgerald** has been the most successful during his tenure in Evanston in the month of September. Entering his 10th season, NU's head coach has won 71.4 percent of the games he has coached during the ninth month of the calendar year. He is 25-10 and has gone unbeaten four times in September, most recently in 2013 when the 'Cats went 3-0 with victories over Syracuse, Western Michigan and Maine.

WATCH OUT

Sophomore running back **Justin Jackson** was named to a pair of prestigious watch lists this summer. The second-year player was named a player to watch for the Maxwell Award, which is bestowed upon the nation's top player, and the Doak Walker Award, which goes to the top running back in the country. Defensive end **Dean Lowry** was named to the Lott IMPACT Award watch list. That trophy goes to a defensive player of strong talent and high character.

MCEVILLY MOVES ON

After missing the entirety of the 2014 season, defensive tackle **Sean McEvilly** announced his retirement from football due to chronic orthopedic issues on August 12. The Yorba Linda, Calif., native appeared in 19 career games with 13 starts from 2011-13. McEvilly earned his undergraduate degree in economics from Northwestern with a minor in business institutions. He is currently pursuing a master's degree from the Kellogg School of Management.

TWO OF A KIND

Each individual has his reason for changing to a new look, but senior **Traveon Henry's** could be the most impactful. Following the retirement of former NU cornerback **Dwight White** during the 2014 campaign, Henry wore White's No. 2 jersey during a game at Iowa on Nov. 1, one in which he registered a career-high 14 tackles. White retired due a condition called renal agenesis because he only has one kidney. Henry, who had worn No. 10, has decided to continue to honor his teammate and close friend by permanently switching to No. 2 for the entire 2015 campaign.

WILDCATS RENEW PEANUT & TREE NUT ALLERGY AWARE PROGRAM

In order to create a safe environment for individuals with peanut and tree nut allergies, no products containing peanuts or tree-nuts will be sold at Ryan Field during the first three football games of the season against Stanford (Sept. 5), Eastern Illinois (Sept. 12) and Ball State (Sept. 26). The venue has undergone extensive cleaning to ensure that no peanut or tree nut material remains anywhere in the facility. On October 19, 2013, Ryan Field became the first college football venue to be entirely peanut-free when Northwestern hosted division rival Minnesota. The idea to hold a "peanut-free" game originated in 2013 with a simple request by a concerned parent, a father of a Northwestern freshman with a severe peanut allergy.

QUICK-HIT PREVIEWS

Pat Fitzgerald once again returns his entire full-time staff of assistant coaches (the fifth straight year the group has remained consistent), and the staff will be working with a similarly experienced corps of on-field talent.

Offense:

Following the graduation of the **Trevor Siemian**, who dotted his name across the Wildcats record book, Northwestern entered training camp with a competition to stand under center. Senior **Zack Oliver** brought experience to the race. He has appeared in 12 career games since 2012, including four a year ago. Oliver has thrown three career touchdown passes. Sophomore **Matt Alviti** was also in the mix. The Park Ridge, Ill., native played in four games as a redshirt freshman and scored a one-yard rushing touchdown on NU's opening drive of its upset at Notre Dame on Nov. 15. On Aug. 27, Fitzgerald announced that redshirt freshman **Clayton Thorson** would start the opener on Sept. 5 against Stanford. Coming out of Wheaton North High School in 2013, Thorson was rated as the nation's sixth-best dual-threat quarterback in the country.

As a freshman in 2014, **Justin Jackson** carried the load in the backfield. In his first collegiate season, Jackson earned All-Big Ten honorable mention as he ran for 1,187 yards and 10 touchdowns, becoming only the second freshman in program history to go over 1,000 yards on the ground. The veteran in Northwestern's backfield is junior **Warren Long**. The native Californian has averaged 4.1 yards per carry for the Wildcats in 18 career contests since 2013. The deep running back room also features sophomore **Solomon Vault** and redshirt freshman **Auston Anderson**.

Northwestern's corps of receivers should receive a boost when senior **Christian Jones**, who led NU with 668 receiving yards in 2013, returns from an injury that kept him out for the 2014 season. The top target from 2014, **Kyle Prater**, graduated, but plenty of weapons remain. Senior superback **Dan Vitale** caught 40 passes for over 400 yards and two touchdowns. Classmate **Cameron Dickerson**, who averaged 13.2 yards per catch a year ago, remains a threat on the outside for the 'Cats.

Northwestern's offensive line will have several new pieces in place for the 2015 campaign. **Brandon Vitabile** graduated after starting 50 consecutive games at center, as did left tackle **Paul Jorgensen**. The unit should be bolstered by a pair of fifth-year seniors in **Matt Frazier** and **Geoff Mogus**. That duo has played a combined 71 games since 2012, and both started every game during the 2014 season at the guard spots. Mogus, however, has kicked outside and is expected to be NU's starter at left tackle in 2015.

Defense:

Now in his eighth season at Northwestern, veteran coordinator **Mike Hankwitz** returns plenty of experience on his side of the ball, with only three starters graduated from a defense that grew as a unit in 2014. Despite losing All-Big Ten safety **Ibraheim Campbell**, the Wildcats' secondary has the potential to again be a playmaking force. Both cornerbacks - **Nick VanHoose** and **Matthew Harris** - are back in the fold, as is safety **Traveon Henry**. VanHoose joined Campbell on the All-Big Ten second team in 2014 and the Urbana, Ohio, native ranks fourth in program history with 25 pass breakups.

In addition to its three returning starters, the secondary retains the services of sophomore safety **Godwin Igwebuike**. He started four games in 2014, and in a 20-14 upset over 16th-ranked Wisconsin, he picked off three Badger passes. That performance earned him Big Ten Player of the Week recognition, plus a nod as the nation's Jim Thorpe Defensive Back of the Week.

The defense's largest turnover will likely occur with the linebacking corps. Senior **Drew Smith**, owner of 85 career tackles, including 12 for a loss, is back for the Wildcats. Sophomore **Anthony Walker** registered a team-high nine TFLs in 2014 and he returns as well. Walker also had two interceptions a year ago, including one he returned 49 yards for a touchdown at Penn State.

Northwestern's defensive line is arguably the deepest group on that side of the ball. Seniors **Deonte Gibson** and **Dean Lowry** figure to bookend the line. Lowry enters the season with 9.5 sacks through his first three years, ranking him 12th on NU's all-time list. Junior edge rusher **Ifeadi Odenigbo** has put down the quarterback 8.5 times in 25 career games with the 'Cats. On the inside, versatile veteran **Max Chapman** figures to play a vital role, as does classmate **C.J. Robbins**. The pair has played in a 57 combined games at Northwestern. **Greg Kuhar** also returns to bolster the interior of the d-line.

Special Teams:

Junior **Jack Mitchell** led the Wildcats with 68 points in 2014 after converting 14 field-goal attempts to go along with 26 extra points. Mitchell's biggest day came during NU's upset over Notre Dame in November when he booted a career-high four field goals, including the game-winner in overtime from 41 yards out. Three of his makes were at least 41 yards, including his career-best effort of 46. Mitchell is a two-sport standout who is also a member of the Northwestern baseball team.

Following the graduation of **Chris Gradone**, the Wildcats will have a new leg to rely upon in the punting game. The role figures to be filled by sophomore **Hunter Niswander**. The Peninsula, Ohio, product punted five times in 2014 and he averaged 36.0 yards per boot.

As a team, Northwestern blocked six kicks in 2014 to lead the NCAA. Cornerback **Nick VanHoose** led the way a year ago with three blocks, including one of an extra point at Notre Dame that he scooped up and scored. In addition to VanHoose, fellow corner **Keith Watkins II** blocked a punt against Western Illinois, while defensive lineman **Max Chapman** blocked a field-goal attempt in the same game. **C.J. Robbins** accounted for the other blocked kick in a 23-point triumph at Penn State.

In the return game, the Wildcats took back a punt and a kickoff in the last two games, respectively. **Tony Jones** returned a punt 64 yards for a score in Northwestern's win at Purdue in the final road game of the year. Speedster **Solomon Vault** ran back a kickoff 89 yards for a score in the season finale. It was the team's first kickoff return for a touchdown since **Vetric Mark** ran one back against Wisconsin in 2010.
