The Preview

Northwestern takes a brief respite from its four-weekend April homestand this Wednesday, April 13, for a 5 p.m. CT doubleheader at Illinois live on BTN.

The Wildcats are bringing a four-game winning streak with them to Champaign after sweeping Iowa last weekend at Sharon J. Drysdale Field. NU also captured the series finale against then-No. 21 Minnesota the weekend before. The Illini are coming off a sweep at the hands of the Gophers last weekend in Minneapolis. Both teams are ranked in the top-50 of the current RPI, with Illinois at No. 45 and Northwestern at No. 49.

NU is halfway through a stretch of four-straight Big Ten weekends being played in Evanston, a string that continues April 15-17 against Nebraska. Northwestern will host a Women's College World Series reunion that weekend for all five of its WCWS teams; special ceremonies and festivities will be held during the April 16 contest.

Northwestern, which was one of the nation's top slugging teams after the first three weekends of the 2016 season, turned the juice back up against the Hawkeyes, banging out eight home runs in the three-game series including five from fifth-year seniors **Andrea Filler** and **Amy Letourneau**. Letourneau had an outstanding series, especially in the first game when she was two RBIs short of a double-double: she struck out 11 while earning the win in the circle and knocked in eight at the plate on three hits including a grand slam.

NU's most feared slugger in Big Ten play, however, has been senior **Fran Strub**, who is batting .600 and slugging 1.200 in league play—both team highs. Strub, who doubled twice at No. 2 Michigan and hit a walk-off home run against then-No. 21 Minnesota—contributed another double and home run to her resume during the Iowa series.

Freshman **Morgan Nelson** slammed another three-run home run out of the park against the Hawkeyes, giving the April 4 Big Ten Freshman of the Week more league accomplishments. She has raised her batting average 64 points since the beginning of the conference play—and impressive feat considering six of NU's nine games have come against the ranked Wolverines and Gophers.

In the circle, freshman **Kenzie Ellis** is really stepping up. She figured in every decision for the Wildcats against the Hawkeyes, picking up a save in Game One before earning the win as a starter in Game Two and a reliever in Game Three.

LEADING OFF

Strength of Schedule the Calling Card of the 'Cats

Year in and year out, no team seeks out stronger opponents than NU. That scheduling strategy helped the 'Cats earn No. 2 and No. 4 overall national seeds during its Women's College World Series runs of 2006 and 2007, and it bore fruit again in 2012 when NU had the No. 1 rated nonconference strength of schedule to help it earn an NCAA Tournament berth. Last year, NU had the nation's sixth-toughest nonconference SOS. A few notes on this year:

- Northwestern has played 25 of its 34 games against teams in the top-100 of the current NCAA RPI (74 percent). This schedule has NU currently ranked No. 49 in the RPI despite a 14-20 record.
- Of those contests, 14 have been against top-25 RPI opponents (41 percent of the schedule) with a road win over the No. 1 team, Michigan, and victories over No. 15 UCLA and No. 19 Minnesota
- NU recently completed a stretch of seven-straight games against teams currently ranked in the top-25 of the national polls, winning a pair of those contests (at No. 1 Michigan; No. 19 Minnesota)

Numbers Point to Breakout Big Ten Despite Rocky Nonconference

NU's record of 14-20 has come against its typically stout schedule, but it's the way some of these games have been lost that have the Wildcats poised for big things with a few adjustments. NU has outscored its opponents 188-185 despite being six games under .500, largely due to a 4-10 record in games decided by two runs or less. What's more, NU is just 8-4 when leading after six innings (five of NU's wins have come via the run-rule, ending before the seventh); the #BIGCats have taken leads on nearly every opponent on its schedule, and once they are able to hold those advantages the wins will follow.

Ace-Like Seasons for Letourneau, Wood in the Circle

Northwestern's two senior pitchers have been snakebitten a little in terms of their records this year, but both **Amy Letourneau** and **Kristen Wood** have pitched like the healthy aces they can be. Wood has a career-best 1.94 ERA despite a 1-5 mark, ranking among the nation's leaders once again with an 8.2 strikeout per seven inning rate. Letourneau, meanwhile, who has drawn the majority of NU's starts against ranked foes, has seen her walk rate plummet and her ERA drop to levels not seen since her outstanding sophomore campaign of 2013. Belying an overall troubling trend that has seen defense hurt the 'Cats, 26 of the runs Letourneau and Wood have surrendered have been unearned (31 percent).

Fifth-Year Seniors Slugging Their Way Through Final Season

Northwestern's two fifth-year seniors, **Andrea Filler** and **Amy Letourneau**, are often referred to as the team's "grandmas," though they are pounding the ball like they're still in the prime of their careers.

Filler leads the team in batting (.347) and slugging (.802) while Letourneau is second in both (.333 BA, .711 slugging); the pair also leads the team with identical home run (10) and RBI totals (37) this year. Their back-to-back pairing in the lineup gives a solid 1-2 punch for opposing pitchers to think twice about.

HEAD COACH KATE DROHAN

Northwestern head coach Kate Drohan is in her 15th season at the helm of the Wildcats' program alongside her twin sister, Caryl Drohan. A 1995 graduate of Providence who earned three All-BIG EAST honors as a player, Drohan spent three seasons as an assistant with Boston College before coming to NU as an assistant prior to the 1998 season. She was promoted to head coach in 2002 after the retirement of NFCA Hall of Fame Coach Sharon J. Drysdale. Below are several need-to-know numbers about Kate and Caryl Drohans' Northwestern tenure:

THE MIDDLE INNINGS

500 Wins on the Horizon for the Drohans

Now in their 15th year at Northwestern, head coach **Kate Drohan** and associate head coach **Caryl Drohan**, her twin sister, enter this weekend's series just six wins away from the major milestone of Win No. 500. The pair have won 494 games with the Wildcats, averaging over 34 wins per year during their tenure. That total includes 185 Big Ten victories, 29 postseason wins and five at the Women's College World Series. The Drohans have never had a losing season with NU.

Kate Drohan's current .632 career winning percentage ranks her third in Big Ten history among coaches with more than 10 years at a single conference institution. In terms of most overall wins at their respective schools, Drohan ranks ninth overall.

Additionally, along with her mentor Sharon J. Drysdale's 640 wins as the longtime coach of the Wildcats, once Drohan reaches 500 wins Northwestern will be the only school in the Big Ten with two different coaches to reach 500 victories at that school.

Morgan Nelson Named Big Ten Freshman of the Week

She has alternately displayed flashes of brilliance and youth, but the beginning of Big Ten play has seen **Morgan Nelson** heat up significantly, raising her batting average 64 points in the first three weeks. After driving in four runs in a three-game series at No. 2 Michigan, Nelson returned home for the first time and was named the Conference's Freshman of the Week with a .625 series against No. 21 Minnesota in which she slugged 1.500. Nelson drove in five runs and scored four times, helped by a double and a pair of home runs.

Andrea Filler Named One of 30 Candidates for Senior CLASS Award

Andrea Filler is one of 30 candidates for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award for softball, which honors student-athletes who excel both on and off the field. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence -- community, classroom, character and competition.

Northwestern softball has a long history of success with this award, earning top-10 finalists in 2007 (Garland Cooper), 2009 (Tammy Williams) and 2010 (Nicole Pauly). In addition, Adrienne Monka (2012), Emily Allard (2013) and Mari Majam (2014) have been named candidates for the honor.

The #B1GCats Welcome Two Bandits to the Coaching Staff

With former pitching coach Courtney Foster now the head coach at Bucknell, Northwestern turned to the NPF's Chicago Bandits to fill out its coaching staff. 2013 NCAA champion and 2015 NPF champion **Michelle Gascoigne** now directs the pitching staff; the lefty tossed a three-hit shutout in the title game of the 2013 WCWS and brings a new approach to the circle for the Wildcats. Her Bandits teammate and 2015 Iowa graduate **Megan Blank** is NU's volunteer assistant after a career as one of the Big Ten's best all-around players in the current decade.

The #B1GCats Were Red Hot at the Plate To Start 2016

Northwestern's offense has been capable of big bursts in 2016, ranking in the top-25 in the nation in four different categories: doubles per game (12th), home runs per game (17th), scoring (21st) and slugging (24th) after the first three weekends of play. Though NU's offense has adjusted to more small-ball, extra-bases still are a thing, led by an absurd start to the year by **Andrea Filler**, who has 24 extra base hits among her 35 total (69 percent). Take slappers **Sabrina Rabin** (38 hits) and **Krista Williams** (30 hits) out of that mix, and the rest of the Wildcats have recorded extra bases on 44 percent of their safe knocks.

Northwestern to Celebrate its World Series Teams in April

During Northwestern's home series April 15-17 against Nebraska at Sharon J. Drysdale Field, the Wildcats will welcome back members from all five of their Women's College World Series teams. 2016 marks the 10-year anniversary of the 2006 squad that finished second in the nation and the 30-year anniversary of the 1986 team that qualified for the WCWS for third year in a row, capping an incredible run of success from 1984-86. The 2007 NU team that finished third in the country also will be celebrated during the weekend-long festivities. THE CLOSER

• Northwestern's 14-20 record does not truly reflect the team's talent. NU has outscored its opponents 188-185 but has struggled to close the door in tight games, going 4-10 in contests decided by two or fewer runs. Fourteen of its 20 losses have come to teams currently in the NCAA RPI top-50 (NU is in the top-50 at No. 49 despite being six games under.)

• Northwestern's leading batter and slugger in Big Ten play is...**Fran Strub**? Heck yes it is. The senior and career pinch-runner is red hot in her first regular action at the plate, starting eight of NU's nine league games so far and batting .600 (9-for-15) and slugging 1.200.

• Though her 6-7 record belies it a bit, senior **Amy Letourneau** has regained the ace form in the circle she developed as a sophomore in 2013. At the Nutter Classic, she held high-octane Oregon State to only singles and kept No. 8 Georgia at bay until a two-out, top-of-the-seventh rally. Despite dropping both of those games, Letourneau returned to toss a complete-game five-hitter vs. No. 11 UCLA in a 7-2 NU win to close the tourney. She also had a complete-game shutout of Lehigh March 19 that included a five hour rain delay.

• At the plate, **Letourneau** has twice this year tied the NU single-game record for RBIs with eight, doing so Feb. 26 against New Mexico State and April 9 versus Iowa. In that Iowa game, she was two RBIs short of a double-double after fanning 11 in the circle.

• Senior **Andrea Filler** was unstoppable to start 2016. She began the year with an 11-game hitting streak and fully 69 percent (24-of-35) of her base hits this year have been for extra bases. She leads the team with 37 RBIs through 34 games, one season after recording 60 for the 'Cats.

• Freshmen pitchers **Kaley Winegarner** and **Kenzie Ellis** combined for a shutout of Quinnipiac on March 18, showing the future of NU in the circle. Ellis then had a tremendous showing at No. 2 Michigan on March 25, gutting out 5.2 innings of relief and keeping the powerful Wolverines at bay long enough to allow a come-from-behind NU win.

• **Ellis** had a hand in all three decisions during a sweep of Iowa, picking up the save in game one and the wins in games two and three.

• In a nice moment, senior **Aubrie May** hit her first-collegiate home run on Feb. 26 against New Mexico State. May played in 25 games as a freshman in 2013, but injuries limited her to just a single appearance in her sophomore and junior seasons. The would-be slugger is finally healthy and able to show her promise with five doubles and the homer in 2016.

• Freshman **Morgan Nelson** hit a walk-off grand slam in the eighth game of her college career Feb. 20, giving NU a come-from-behind 11-8 win against North Carolina. She then hit a game-tying 7th-inning homer at South Florida March 22, and a go-ahead, three-run triple in the fifth at No. 2 Michigan on March 25, revealing a flair for the dramatic.



• Northwestern is known as Chicago's Big Ten Team and the 2016 NU softball team is taking that mantra one step further. The Wildcats have adopted the workman-like, blue collar attitude that Chicago was built on as their team identity, so much so that the Chicago flag is stitched to the underseam of NU's jerseys.

• Northwestern made its 15th overall appearance in the NCAA Tournament last year including its 10th in the previous 14 years of the Drohan era. Together, **Kate Drohan** and **Caryl Drohan** have led NU to six NCAA Regional championship rounds in the last 10 years.

• #BIGCATS IN THE PROS: 2014 grad **Emily Allard** will continue to play professionally for the Chicago Bandits of National Professional Fastpitch in 2016. Allard, along with current Northwestern coaches **Michelle Gascoigne** and **Megan Blank**, and former Wildcat **Tammy Williams**, won the NPF Championship last year with the Bandits.

THE @NUSBCATS ROOF CLUB

Few clubs in sports are as small or exclusive as Northwestern's Sharon J. Drysdale Field Roof Club. Just six players are members after homering onto the roof of McGaw Hall, which houses Northwestern's Welsh-Ryan Arena and borders NU's softball park beyond left field. In the 35-year history of Sharon J. Drysdale Field, only nine fair home run balls off the bats of NU players have reached the roof of the building—and all nine of those blasts have come since 2007:

WORLD SERIES MEMORIES

During Northwestern's series against Nebraska April 15-17 at Sharon J. Drysdale Field, the Wildcats will honor all five of their Women's College World Series teams from 1984, 1985, 1986, 2006 and 2007. Each week in this space, we will feature a different moment from one of those World Series.



June 2, 2006

One day after the most storied moment in Northwestern Women's College World Series history (which we'll cover next week), another two-out, seventh-inning home run made waves for the Wildcats in Oklahoma City. Northwestern was facing Tennessee and its formidable ace, Monica Abbott, in the winner's bracket of the WCWS, and NU had just broken through to take the game's first lead in the top of the sixth inning. After beating back a Volunteer's rally in the bottom of the sixth, the Wildcats needed some insurance against what entered the WCWS as the nation's top offense. That insurance came in the form of No. 9 batter Darcy Sengewald, who annihilated a two-out Abbott offering over the fence in left field for a solo home run and a 2-0 NU edge in an eventual 2-0 win. The blast was just her third of the year, but it was easily the biggest of her career.

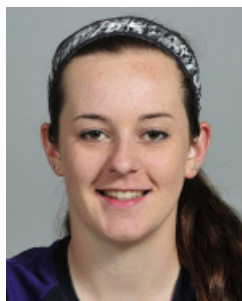
