THE OPENING TIP

- » Northwestern has started a season 4-0 for the eighth time in the last nine years.
- » The Wildcats are playing Chattanooga and Georgetown for the first time in program history. Auburn holds a 3-1 lead in the all-time series, but the teams have not met since Nov. 24, 1991, a 73-49 NU win over No. 11 Auburn.
- » Chicago's Big Ten Team is 2-0 at home and 2-0 on the road. These will be the first neutral site games of the year.
- » McKeown, now in his 10th season at NU, holds an 88-26 (.772) record in non-conference play.
- » Northwestern is 7-2 in regular season non-conference neutral contests under McKeown.

WILD FACTS

- » Named sixth head coach in Northwestern women's basketball history in 2008 after 19 successful season at George Washington.
- » Second-winningest coach in NU history (152).
- » 662 wins in 31 seasons ranks 12th among active D-1 coaches.
- » 18 NCAA tournament appearances (2 NMSU, 15 GW, 1 NU).
- » Proud native of Philadelphia, Pa. He is married to his wife, Laura, and they have three children, Meghan, Joey, and Ally.

COACHING CAREER

- » Amassed more wins in his first six seasons at Northwestern (94) than the team had in the previous 11 before his arrival (77 from 1997-2008).
- » Coached the first First-Team All-Big Ten selection by a first-year student-athlete in program history (Nia Coffey - 2014).
- » Developed the 2013 Big Ten Freshman of the Year (Maggie Lyon).
- » Led Ashley Deary to back-to-back Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year awards (2016, 2017).
- » Oversaw the first Wildcats' student-athlete to be taken in the WNBA draft (Amy Jaeschke, 2011).
- » 41 combined victories in 2014-15 and 2015-16 are the best back-to-back seasons in program history.
- » Taken Northwestern to five postseason tournaments, including the 2015 NCAA Tournament, the team's first appearance in the tournament since 1997.
- » Reached the Big Ten Tournament semifinals in consecutive years (2015, 2016).
- » Coached 11 student-athletes to multiple All-Big Ten honors.
