THE OPENING DRIVE

B1G BOUNCE BACK -- Northwestern snapped a three-game losing streak with a big time Big Ten road win at No. 20 Michigan State, 29-19. The victory was the Wildcats' third-straight over the Spartans and their second inside Spartan Stadium in the last three years. NU picked up its ninth win in its last 10 Big Ten contests and extended its road winning streak to five games.

BIG TEN ROAD WARRIORS -- The Wildcats have won five-straight Big Ten road contests dating back to last season. The Wildcats are averaging 34.0 points per game over their last five road games. NU's last road loss came over an entire calendar year ago at No. 10 Wisconsin on Sept. 30, 2017, 33-24.

50 BIG TEN WINS - Dan and Susan Jones Family Head Football coach Pat Fitzgerald earned his 50th career Big Ten victory with the Wildcats defeating Michigan State. With a win over Nebraska, Fitzgerald would even his Big Ten record at 51-51.

DON'T BLINK - The Wildcats opened up the offense in their victory over Michigan State, scoring three touchdowns in under a minute for the first time in 10 years.

FOR THORSON, GREEN MEANS GO - Senior quarterback Clayton Thorson improved to 3-0 in his career versus Michigan State. Thorson averaged 336 yards and three eight touchdowns while completing 70 percent of his passes in his career versus the Spartans.

Northwestern extended its Big Ten road win streak to five games with a 29-19 win at MSU.

Senior quarterback Clayton Thorson matched his career high for the 10th time with three touchdown passes versus Michigan State.

Clayton Thorson has started 44-straight games at quarterback. He is second among active FBS quarterbacks behind Jake Browning.

Senior wide receiver Flynn Nagel's 23-game catch streak is the second longest in the Big Ten behind only Ohio State's KJ Hill.

Junior Joe Gaziano has registered 15 of his 17 career sacks during Big Ten play.

FIRST DOWN

#FEEDFLYNN — Senior wide receiver Flynn Nagel recorded his second double-digit catch performance of the season with 10 receptions for 11 yards at No. 20 Michigan State. Nagel consecutive games with a catch streak of 23 is second in the Big Ten behind only Ohio State's K.J. Hill. The senior enters this week's contest versus Nebraska ranked 12th nationally and second in the Big Ten with 7.2 receptions per game is fourth in the Big Ten in both receiving yards (402 and receiving yards per contests (80.4). Nagel is also just one of two Big Ten players with 10-plus catches in a pair of games this season (Rondale Moore, Purdue).

THORSON SETTLING IN – After splitting time in the first three contests of the season while returning from offseason surgery, **senior quarterback Clayton Thorson** has played every snap over the last two weeks. Thorson had his best game of the season versus No. 20 Michigan State, completing 31-of-47 passes for 373 yards and a career-high tying three touchdowns, while also rushing for a score. He is the only quarterback in the Big Ten with two games of 350-plus yards passing this season.

MR. RELIABLE – Senior quarterback Clayton Thorson has started all 44 games of his career, compiling a 29-15 career record as the program's all-time winningest quarterback. He is fourth among active FBS quarterbacks with 810 career completions, fifth with 8,848 career passing yards and 14th with 50 career passing touchdowns.

CHASING HISTORY – With a two-yard quarterback sneak in the fourth quarter versus Michigan State, **senior quarterback Clayton Thorson** became just the third Big Ten player ever to pass for 8,500 yards and rush for 20 touchdowns. Thorson needs just 152 passing yards to join J.T. Barrett (Ohio State) as the only players in conference history to pass for 9,000 yards and score 20 touchdowns on the ground.

AND FINALLY... – **Thorson** has led the Wildcats to a 9-1 record over their last 10 Big Ten games, completing 61 percent of his passes (211-for-348) for 232.5 yards per game with 11 passing touchdowns and another eight on the ground.

B1G TIME PLAYER – Junior defensive end Joe Gaziano recorded a sack in the victory at Michigan State, giving him a team-high 3.5 this season. Gaziano moved into a tie with Dwayne Missouri (1997-2000) for sixth in program history with 17 career sacks. More impressively, of Gaziano has reached the mark in just 18 career sacks with 14 of them coming versus conference opponents. The Scituate, Massachusetts, native became just the fifth sophomore since 2000 to lead the Big Ten in sacks last season with nine, eight of which came during conference play.

SOMETHING IN THE NUMBER - Sophomore linebacker Blake Gallagher, who wears the same No. 51 made famous by head coach Pat Fitzgerald, recorded his second-straight double-digit tackle performance with a team-high 11 at Michigan State. Gallagher now leads the Big Ten with 9.8 tackles per game [ranks 25th nationally] and is second in total tackles with 49. He is one of only two players in the Big Ten with 10-plus tackles in three games this season (Mohamed Barry, Nebraska).

SECOND DOWN

GREENER PASTURES – Junior superback Cameron Green hauled in nine catches for 76 yards and his third touchdown of the season in the Wildcats' win at MSU. Green already has career highs this season with 26 catches, 259 yards and three scores. He ranks seventh in the Big Ten with 5.2 receptions per game is 10th in the league [2nd among tight ends] with three receiving scores.

FOR THE FIRST TIME – Sophomore wide receiver Kyric McGowan and true first-year wideout JJ Jefferson each hauled in the first touchdowns of their careers at MSU. McGowan caught a 77-yard touchdown pass from Clayton Thorson, marking the 'Cats longest score through the air since a 90-yard connection from Dan Persa to Jeremy Ebert against Rice in 2011. Jefferson made a diving catch in the end zone for a 34-yard score in the second quarter. The young wideouts have started to find their stride in the Wildcats' offense as of late, with McGowan recording 100-plus all-purpose yards in two of the last three games and Jefferson recording a catch of 34-plus yards in back-to-back games [36-yard catch versus Michigan].

TAKE THE TOP OFF THE DEFENSE – With McGowan's 77-yard touchdown and Jefferson's 34-yard score, Northwestern posted two-or-more touchdown passes of at least 30 yards for the first time since Nov. 12, 2016 at Purdue. [Austin Carr 33 yards and Garrett Dickerson 42 yards]

NEXT MAN UP -- With **senior linebacker Nate Hall** out of the lineup, **sophomore walk-on linebacker Chris Bergin** earned his first career start at his dad's alma mater last weekend. Bergin matched his career high for the second-straight week with eight tackles, including a career-high tying five assisted stops.

UNLOCKING THE VAULT - After missing all of 2017 and the first three games of 2018 due to injury, **senior Solomon Vault** has transition back from wide receiver to running back. Vault made his first career start in the backfield at Michigan State. Vault, the program's all-time leader with four kick return touchdowns, returned to the backfield versus Michigan on Sept. 29 and finished with seven carries for 18 yards. His seven carries were his most since carrying the ball eight times versus Minnesota on Oct. 3, 2015. Vault's last kick return for a touchdown came at MSU on Oct. 15, 2016.

THIRD DOWN

NO DIRTY LAUNDRY - Chicago's Big Ten Team continues to be one of the least penalized teams in the country, entering week seven as the nation's leader with just 16 penalties through five games. The Wildcats rank second in the country in fewest penalties per game (3.20), sixth in fewest penalty yards (171) and sixth in fewest penalty yards per contest (34.20).

FISHER IN RARE COMPANY — The first sophomore captain in the Fitzgerald era, **linebacker Paddy Fisher** is one of just seven sophomore captains in FBS entering the regular season. Fisher is one of just four Power 5 sophomore captains, including Louisville quarterback Jawon Pass, Virginia Tech quarterback Joshua Jackson and Ohio State linebacker Tuf Borland.

PAGE SETTER – Sophomore safety JR Pace continued to impress as a first-year starter with eight tackles, including a tackles for loss, in the Wildcats' 29-21 win at MSU. Pace and senior safety Jared McGee are tied for the team lead among defensive backs with 32 tackles, while Pace is second on the squad with five pass breakups. He recorded his third career interception in the Wildcats' season opener at Purdue.

McGEE MAKING HIS MARK - Senior safety Jared McGee recorded his fourth career interception and second at Spartan Stadium last week at MSU. McGee is just four tackles shy of his career high of 36 set in 2016 and already has a career-high three tackles for loss this season. The Mansfield, Texas, native is just one of two Big Ten defensive backs [Justin Layne, Michigan State] to have at least five tackles in every game this season.

NORTHWESTERN IN HIS BLOOD – True first-year running back Drake Anderson made his Northwestern debut at Michigan State, rushing five times for 12 yards with a long of 11. Anderson is the son of Damien Anderson, who ranks second in program history with 4,485 career rushing yards.

SPREAD THE WEALTH – Northwestern features three of the top 12 receivers in the Big Ten in terms of receptions per game. In addition to **senior Flynn Nagel** ranking second at 7.2 catches per contest, **junior superback Cam Green** ranks seventh with 5.2 and **junior wide receiver Bennett Skowronek** is 12th with 4.4. Skowronek caught five passes for 60 yards in the win at MSU. **Senior quarterback Clayton Thorson** ranks 14th nationally and is second in the Big Ten with 23.6 completions per game.

PINNED - **Graduate punter Jake Collins** posted his best game of the season at Michigan State, averaging 43.83 yards per punt with three punts inside the 20 and a pair of fair catches. Collins posted a pair of 50-plus yard punts, including a season-long 56 yarder.

RETURN OF SOME 'CATS – The Northwestern coaching staff saw its first change in over seven years with the addition of three familiar names in the offseason. Former NU assistant Jeff Genyk returned to campus as the program's Special Teams Coordinator, while alumni Lou Ayeni (Running Backs) and Tim McGarigle (Linebackers) were named assistant coaches in January. Veteran coach Matt MacPherson was elevated to Associate Head Coach and will lead the defensive backs in 2018. Despite the changes, the Wildcats eight coaches who have at least 10 years experience at the institution, marking the second most in the country behind only Navy (9).

LARKIN MEDICALLY RETIRING FROM FOOTBALL – Sophomore running back Jeremy Larkin announced his retirement from football on Monday, September 24 due to a recent diagnosis of cervical stenosis. Larkin led the Wildcats with 346 rushing yards and five touchdowns through the opening three games of the 2018 campaign, his first as the Wildcats' primary running back. The sophomore ranked first in the Big Ten in scoring (10 points/gm), second in the Big Ten in rushing touchdowns, third in receptions per game (6.3), fourth in rushing yards per game (115.3) and fifth in total rushing yards at the time of his retirement.

FORMER NO. 1 QUARTERBACK JOINS WILDCATS PROGRAM — **Sophomore quarterback Hunter Johnson**, the No. 1-rated quarterback in the Class of 2016 by ESPN, joined the 'Cats as a transfer from Clemson University in June. Johnson, the younger brother of former Wildcat Cole Johnson, appeared in seven games for the Tigers last season. He completed 21-of-27 passes for 234 yards and two touchdowns. The Brownsburg, Indiana, native will sit out the 2018 season due to NCAA transfer rules and will have three years of eligibility remaining beginning in 2019.

Already the second-longest tenured Big Ten head coach at the age of 43, Pat Fitzgerald's 12 seasons at the helm of Northwestern have been spent building upon the tradition he helped establish as a Hall-of-Fame linebacker for the Wildcats in the mid-1990's. Characterized by his motivational skills, enthusiasm and passion for all things Northwestern, Fitzgerald has shaped Chicago's Big Ten Team into one that consistently achieves excellence in all three phases of the student-athlete experience: academics, athletics and community outreach.

Fitzgerald has led the Wildcats to eight bowl appearances in his 12 seasons and has guided the 'Cats to three of their four bowl wins in program history. Most recently, Chicago's Big Ten Team defeated Kentucky in the 2017 Franklin American Mortgage Music City Bowl, 24-23, giving Northwestern back-to-back bowl wins for the first time in program history. Northwestern finished the season ranked No. 17 in both the Associated Press and USA Today/ Coaches Poll, as well as the College Football Playoff Poll.

The win over Kentucky capped off an eight-game winning streak for the Wildcats, who finished the 2017 season with 10 wins for the fifth time in program history and third time over the last six seasons. Northwestern has averaged nine victories over the last three seasons (27-12), setting a program record for wins during a three-year span. The previous high was 26 wins from 1903-05.

Away from the gridiron, Fitzgerald's players have achieved at the highest levels in the classroom, last fall placing a record 39 players on the Academic All-Big Ten team en route to posting a program-record 3.14 GPA for the 2015-16 academic year. In 2012, Northwestern collected top national honors in the AFCA Academic Achievement Award for the seventh time since 1998. Additionally, Fitzgerald's program ranked second among all FBS programs in the recently released multi-year Academic Progress Rating (APR), posting a score of 992 out of a possible 1,000 in the measure of player retention and eligibility.

NU also goes to great lengths to make a difference in the community. Fitzgerald, his family and his players partake in countless charitable events, impacting the NU and Evanston communities through their participation in Northwestern Dance Marathon, Special Olympics, Misericordia, the NU chapter of Uplifting Athletes, weekly school and children's hospital visits, and dozens of other organizations. Most recently, Fitzgerald was named the honorary coach of the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team.

As a player in 1995, Fitzgerald was the leader of a suffocating Wildcats defensive unit that led the nation in scoring defense and anchored NU's storybook run to the Big Ten championship and Rose Bowl. He capped the year by winning both the Nagurski and Bednarik Awards as the nation's top defensive player and also was the Big Ten, Chevrolet and Sports Illustrated-Defensive Player of the Year. Fitzgerald accomplished all of this despite suffering a broken leg in the penultimate regular-season game.

A graduate of Orland Park's (III.) Carl Sandburg High School and a 2003 inductee to the Northwestern Athletics Hall of Fame, Fitzgerald resides in Northfield with his wife, Stacy, and three sons, Jack, born in November 2004, Ryan, born in September 2006, and Brendan, born in February 2009.
