The Preview

Riding an eight-game winning streak, Northwestern returns to Evanston this weekend to open its Big Ten and Sharon J. Drysdale Field schedules March 23-25 against Minnesota.

The Wildcats and Golden Gophers begin the conference season at 3 p.m. CT Friday, March 23, before continuing the series at 1 p.m. CT Saturday and noon CT Sunday. The first two games of the series will be streamed live via BTN Plus on BTN2Go, with WNUR alumni Dan Platt, Frank Tormey and Dr. Greg Bobak on the calls. Sunday's game is live on BTN and BTN2Go.

Northwestern has turned its hot conclusion to the pre-conference season into a 17-8 overall record and a top-40 RPI in the first official NCAA rankings that came out Monday. The Wildcats have faced the nation's 19th-toughest non-conference schedule and now turn their attention to a stacked Big Ten slate beginning this weekend against the defending conference champion Gophers.

Three-time All-Big Ten selection and 2015 league Rookie of the Year **Sabrina Rabin** remains as reliable as ever as the catalyst atop the NU lineup, currently leading the team with a .366 average and 18 stolen bases, which puts her in the top-30 nationally. Behind her, first-year **Rachel Lewis** has made an early name for herself as a source of power and speed entering her first conference season. She already has won a pair of Big Ten weekly honors.

As a team, Northwestern ranks second in the league in runs per game and is first in on-base percentage and steals, consistently creating scoring opportunities for itself. In the circle, sophomore **Morgan Newport** and first-year **Kenna Wilkey** have emerged as co-aces for the 'Cats, with each spinning a pair of a shutouts over NU's last eight games.

NU is heavy on experience in the lineup, and that experience has been a huge part of the Wildcats recent success. During Northwestern's current eight-game winning streak, senior **Sammy Nettling** is batting .375, junior **Morgan Nelson** is hitting .357 with three home runs and senior **Brooke Marquez** is batting .333.

The Wildcats (No. 38) and Gophers (No. 31) are two of EIGHT Big Ten teams that appear inside the top-50 of the first NCAA RPI rankings of the year, which indicates the conference is in for an exciting and deep league season. In addition to Minnesota, Ohio State (No. 14), Nebraska (No. 19) and Iowa (No. 41) all travel to Evanston this season, giving NU its best home schedule in recent memory. Season passes are available now!

Following this weekend, Northwestern heads to Illinois (RPI No. 50) for a March 28 doubleheader to be broadcast live on BTN before returning home March 30-April 1 to host the Cornhuskers.

LEADING OFF

To Be The Best, You Have To Beat The Best: W0000000000!

Year in and year out, no team seeks out stronger opponents than NU. That scheduling strategy helped the 'Cats earn No. 2 and No. 4 overall national seeds during its Women's College World Series runs of 2006 and 2007, and it bore fruit again in 2012 and 2016 when NU made the NCAA Tourney field with .500 records after compiling the nation's No. 1 and No. 6 nonconference strengths of schedule in those years.

This year, Northwestern has a top-20 non-conference SOS according to the current NCAA RPI data released Monday, earning wins over No. 25 Alabama and No. 45 Houston.

Rachel Lewis Quickly Becoming One of Nation's Top Newcomers

First-year second baseman **Rachel Lewis** has burst onto the scene in a powerful way not seen at Northwestern since the days of Tammy Williams (2006), Nicole Pauly (2007) and Adrienne Monka (2009). Lewis was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on March 12 after earning Freshman of the Week honors March 5 during a power surge that has launched her into the national conversation as a perfect package of power and speed.

Lewis is second in the Big Ten with 29 total RBIs and ranks 27th in the country with 1.16 per game, while also ranking second in the B1G in steals and runs scored. All told, she ranks among the Big Ten's top-5 in eight statistical metrics. A full list is available in her bio on Page 16 of these notes.

Morgan Newport, Kenna Wilkey Emerge As Gamers in the Circle

Sophomore **Morgan Newport** and first-year **Kenna Wilkey** have become NU's go-to hurlers in the circle. Newport earned a reputation as a bullpen stopper in 2017, but quickly shed that image with back-to-back shutouts March 4 and March 9: a four-hitter against No. 11 Alabama followed by a two-hitter in a 1-0 win over Iowa State.

Meanwhile, Wilkey is settling into the circle in a big way. After ranking among the nation's leaders in strikeouts early in the year, she has fine tuned her approach with tremendous success. She also has two shutouts this season, but most notably earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors March 12 after going 4-0 without allowing a single run in 20.2 innings at the Houston Hilton Plaza Classic March 9-11.

Sabrina Rabin Closing Her Career in Record Fashion

From 2010-14, Northwestern had one of the nation's premier leadoff hitters in Emily Allard. After she graduated, **Sabrina Rabin** stepped in so effectively that she became the first-ever slapper to win the Big Ten Rookie of the Year award when she did so in 2015. Now a senior and a three-time All-Big Ten honoree, Rabin is climbing the Wildcats' record books of her own accord. Her career batting average of .368 currently ranks fourth for NU, while she is also rising in these categories:

- Is five runs away from second all-time at NU
- Is five steals away from second all-time
- Is four hits away from fourth all-time at NU

Northwestern head coach Kate Drohan is in her 17th season at the helm of the Wildcats' program alongside her twin sister, Caryl Drohan. A 1995 graduate of Providence who earned three All-BIG EAST honors as a player, Drohan spent three seasons as

THE MIDDLE INNINGS

Drohans Embark on a Quest for The Next 500

Now in their 17th season together at the helm of the Northwestern program, head coach **Kate Drohan** and associate head coach **Caryl Drohan**, her twin sister, earned the 500th win of their careers in 2016. Their current total of 549 includes 205 Big Ten victories, 30 NCAA postseason wins and five at the Women's College World Series. Kate Drohan's .622 career winning percentage ranks her third in Big Ten history among coaches with more than 10 years at a single conference institution. In terms of most overall wins at their respective schools, Drohan ranks ninth overall. Additionally, along with her mentor Sharon J. Drysdale's 640 wins as the longtime coach of the Wildcats, NU is the only Big Ten team and one of just four nationwide with two different coaches to reach 500 victories at that school.

Northwestern's Offense Is Emergent

Northwestern's is scoring runs in bunches, ranking second in the Big Ten and 46th nationally with 5.4 runs per game thanks in large part to getting on base and getting over. The Wildcats are first in the B1G in on-base percentage, walks, hit by pitch and stolen bases, creating scoring opportunities in nearly every offensive inning.

Speed Returns to the Basepaths in 2018

Northwestern has been known as a power team in the past, but speed has become the identity of the Wildcats in recent seasons. In 2018, the Wildcats rank FIFTH in the NCAA with 2.56 steals per game and have 64 total, which is 18 more than the next highest Big Ten team (Indiana with 46). Led by senior **Sabrina Rabin**, who ranks first in the Big Ten and 23rd in the country with 18 steals total and 0.72 per game, the Wildcats have four of the top seven base stealers in the conference: **Rachel Lewis** (2nd, 13), **Morgan Nelson** (4th, 12) and **Marissa Panko** (7th, 9).

Trust the System, Then Step Up And Lead

Kate and **Caryl Drohan** have a proven history not only with Wildcats stepping in from Day One, but also in developing players who burst into the spotlight as juniors or seniors. Recently, Marissa Panko (2017), Fran Strub (2016) and Julia Kuhn (2015) have been major examples. So far in 2018, junior first baseman **Lily Novak** is living up to the billing, batting a .250 with a .425 on-base percentage while ranking third on the team with 14 RBIs.

Wildcats Show Defensive Flexibility, Great Team Approach

For the previous two seasons of 2016 and 2017, junior **Morgan Nelson** and senior **Brooke Marquez** were mainstays in the infield for Northwestern. In fact, Marquez has made 129 total starts at second base during her career, including playing every pitch at the position in 2016. With talented infielders arriving in the first-year class this season, both Nelson (LF) and Marquez (RF) have shifted their defensive abilities into the outfield. Nelson's athleticism and strong glove work allows her to track down balls deep in the gap, while Marquez has made several spectacular catches, continuing a trend she developed while drop-stepping and sprinting into the outfield as a second baseman.

Kaley Winegarner's Season Comes To Early Close

Junior **Kaley Winegarner** emerged as an ace among the Wildcats pitching staff in 2017 and earned the Opening Day start against No. 7 Arizona this season before picking up a key victory later that night with extra-inning relief against San Diego State. Her year has been cut short, however, by a season-ending injury suffered during the second weekend of the season.

Nicole Bond Returns for a Fifth Season in the Circle

As a first-year Wildcat in 2014, **Nicole Bond** was a perfect 7-0 in the circle with two shut-outs. Then, an injury prior to her sophomore campaign kept her out of 2015 and limited her to just 14.0 frames as a junior. Through it all, Bond kept training and that work paid off when she toed the rubber as NU's Opening Day starter in 2017. Bond allowed two runs in a rusty first inning before settling in to blank Tulsa the rest of the way in a 3-2 NU victory.

Bond was granted a medical hardship waiver for the lost 2015 season and now has by far the most years under her belt as a fifth-year senior among a group of pitchers comprising two juniors, a sophomore and a first-year besides herself.



THE CLOSER

- Northwestern enters this weekend with 1,199 wins in program history, just one away from all-time win No. 1,200. Since its inception in 1976, the Wildcats have an all-time record of 1,199-872-4, giving NU a .579 all-time winning percentage.
- Three different first-year 'Cats have been regular starters in the Northwestern lineup since Day One in 2018: **Mac Dunlap** (3B), **Rachel Lewis** (2B) and **Kenna Wilkey** (P/DP). The last time that many members of the first-year class saw starts on opening weekend and beyond? In 2012 with Olivia Duehr, Anna Edwards and Amy Letourneau.
- Northwestern matched its school single-game record for stolen bases with eight against St. John's on February 25. Earlier in the year, the Wildcats swiped seven bags versus South Dakota (February 11). On the year, NU ranks fifth in the NCAA with 2.56 steals per game.
- The Wildcats are experiencing a power surge like old times in recent games, already surpassing last year's home run total of 14 before the start of Big Ten play. After hitting five home runs in its first 18 games of 2018, NU has clobbered 10 in its last seven games to give it 15 total dingers on the year.
- Northwestern went 5-0 at the Houston Hilton Plaza Classic, its first 5-0 pre-conference tournament performance since going 5-0 at the 2013 Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic. NU shut out its first two opponents in Houston, giving it three-straight shutouts (including its shutout of No. 11 Alabama March 4) for the first time since 2013.
- After developing as a bullpen stopper in 2017, sophomore **Morgan Newport** drew the starting assignment against both No. 1 Washington and No. 11 Alabama at the March 2-4 Husky Classic, shutting out the Crimson Tide with a complete-game three-hitter. It was her first-career shutout and just the second time she had ever gone seven full innings in college. In her next start, she threw a 2-hitter in a 1-0 shutout of Iowa State March 9.
- Senior **Brooke Marquez** got hot at the plate in Houston, batting .462 (6-for-13) at the event to raise her season average to .286 entering this weekend.
- At the plate, **Kenna Wilkey** made an immediate impact. In her first college at-bat February 9 versus San Diego State, Wilkey smoked a 3-run homer. She is the first Wildcat to homer in her first college at-bat since Anna Petersen in 2014. Incredibly, Wilkey and Petersen accomplished the feat on the exact same field: Field 3 at the Tempe Sports Complex.
- Is that associate head coach Caryl Drohan coaching first base? No! It's volunteer assistant Fran Strub, who also filled that role last year when she was a student assistant for NU. Strub graduated from Northwestern in 2016 and is a true student of the game.



- Scheduling quirk: Northwestern played four non-conference games against fellow Big Ten teams during the pre-conference tournament schedule. NU faced Indiana and Penn State twice apiece (neither of those teams is on the Wildcats' regular Big Ten schedule this year), beginning right away at the Kajikawa Classic with a 5-1 win over IU. All-told, NU went 4-0 in those contests and has a 4-0 lead on the rest of the Big Ten (that's not true, but the Wildcats did outscore the Hoosiers and Nittany Lions by a combined 33-7!).
- Northwestern is Chicago's Big Ten Team and 2018 NU softball embraces that mantra in a way that was introduced during the 2016 season. The 'Cats have adopted the blue-collar attitude of Chicago as their team identity, so much so that the Chicago flag is stitched to the underseam of NU's jerseys and the Wildcats' batting helmets have embroidered N logos in homage to the embroidered C on the Cubs' helmets.

THE @NUSBCATS ROOF CLUB

Few clubs in sports are as small or exclusive as Northwestern's Sharon J. Drysdale Field Roof Club. Just six players are members after homering onto the roof of McGaw Hall, which houses Northwestern's Welsh-Ryan Arena and borders NU's softball park beyond left field. In the 37-year history of Sharon J. Drysdale Field, only 10 fair home run balls off the bats of NU players have reached the roof of the building—and all 10 of those blasts have come since 2007:
