**THE OPENING TIP:** Northwestern and Wisconsin are meeting for the 183rd time:

- Northwestern has won back-to-back games at the Kohl Center and is looking for its first three-game win streak in Madison since 1936-40.
- The Wildcats and Badgers split in their meetings last season, each team winning on the road.
- Dererk Pardon went a perfect 8-for-8 from the field to lead NU with 17 points in the 'Cats 60-52 win at the Kohl Center last season (2/1/18).

**FALZON FRENZY:** During his rookie campaign in 2015-16, Aaron Falzon appeared in 32 games, making 29 starts, and averaged 8.4 points and 3.4 rebounds. Since that season, the Newton, Mass., native has battled numerous injuries that limited him to 35 games over the course of the last three years. Entering Tuesday's contest versus Indiana, Falzon had appeared in three games this season, scoring six points in 18 minutes.

#### Versus Indiana, Falzon...

- Came off the bench to score a career-high 21 points in 20 minutes (first time scoring 20 points in a game since Jan. 9, 2016 (1,109 days).
- Went six-for-seven from behind the arc, matching his career-high for three-pointers. (The 85.7 3FG% is tied for fourth all-time on NU's single-game list).
- Matched a career-high with two blocks.

**ABOUT THE SKIP:** Sullivan-Ubben Head Men's Basketball Coach Chris Collins, now in his sixth season, picked up his 100th career victory with a 73-66 win over Indiana on 1/22/19. Collins...

- Became the third NU coach (Arthur Lonborg (1927-50; 236 wins) and Bill Carmody (2000-13; 192 wins) to reach this milestone and the fastest to do so in program history.
- Collins needs one more BIG win to claim his 40th league victory, which would place him in sole possession third all-time at NU.

**COMMA CLUB:** Northwestern is one of five teams in the country, and the lone BIG team, with three active 1,000-point scorers.

- Vic Law became the 36th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point plateau (11/8/18). He enters the game against Wisconsin with 1,286 points, which places him 19th all-time in the NU record books.
- Ryan Taylor boasts 1,467 career points (Ohio, Evansville, Northwestern).
- Dererk Pardon became the 37th player in program history to score 1,000 points (1/22/19). He ranks 36th all-time.
- Ball State, Hartford, Lipscomb and Washington are the only programs in the country with three active 1,000-point scorers.

**PARDON THE INTERRUPTION:** Senior center Dererk Pardon holds the NU record for career field goal percentage (.620).

#### PARDON, CONTINUED:

- Eighth most efficient offensive player (12.3 POS/G) (1.14 PTS/POS) among power conference players, per Synergy.
- His .620 career field goal percentage ranks 18th among active DI players and is tied for second in the Big Ten.
- His 7.6 rebounds per game ranks eighth in the Big Ten.
- Ranks second in the Big Ten with 3.05 offensive rebounds per game.
- One of two active players in the country with more than 1,000 points, 675 rebounds and 135 blocked shots in 100 games played or fewer.
- Ranks eighth in program history with 681 career rebounds.
- Owns 14 career double-doubles (4th in NU history).

**LOOKING AT LAW:** Vic Law is having a stellar senior year.

- Ranks 10th among all Big Ten players with 16.3 points per game. Law's career scoring average is 11.4 points per game.
- One of five active players in the country to tally over 1,200 points, 600 rebounds, 200 assists and 100 steals in a career. Only four NU players have accomplished this feat: Kevin Rankin ('90-'94), John Shurna ('08-'12), Drew Crawford ('09-'14).
- Has scored in double figures in 16 of 18 games and more than 15 points on 10 occasions.

Law is averaging above his career totals in nearly every major statistical category:

**DEFENSE, DEFENSE, DEFENSE:** The Wildcats are holding teams to just 64.4 points per game, which ranks 29th nationally and fourth in the Big Ten entering Saturday's game.

Northwestern has held major conference opponents under their season scoring average on 10 occasions.

**NO THREES FOR YOU:** Teams are shooting just 27.1 percent from behind the arc against NU, which places NU top-10 in the country in defending the 3-point line and first in the Big Ten.

- In wins, NU is holding teams to 23.8 percent from three (47-for-197). In losses, teams are shooting 33.8 percent (44-for-131).
- The Wildcats have not allowed more than five 3-pointers in a contest in 13 of their last 14 games.
- NU did not allow a 3-pointer (0-for-11) against Illinois (Jan. 6). It was the first time the Wildcats have done it with Collins and the helm and the first time it happened for an NU team since Nov. 23, 2011.

**DISH TO PASS:** Northwestern has been sharing the ball well all season.

- Northwestern has a 64.0 percent assist rate, the seventh-best mark in the nation ... Three of the last five seasons, NU has had a top-12 assist rate in the nation.
- Northwestern's 292 assists rank third in the Big Ten.
- The 'Cats rank third in the Big Ten with 15.4 assists per game.
- The 'Cats are 8-2 when tallying 15-plus assists in a game.
- NU has racked up 23 assists (season high) in two games this season (vs. Binghamton 11/16/18; vs. Chicago State 12/17/18)

**CLOSE CALLS:** Northwestern has played nine games this season that have been decided by 10 points or fewer and are 5-4 in those contests. Of those nine games, seven have been decided by seven points or fewer, including three by two points.

**GET TO THE LINE:** Northwestern is the third-best free throw shooting team in the Big Ten Conference. As a team, Northwestern is shooting 73.3 percent from the charity stripe.

- Ryan Taylor is shooting 88.6 percent (31-for-35) from the line this season.
- Northwestern is one of two teams in the BIG to have three players in the top-15 for free throw percentage.
- Vic Law (6th; 83.5%), A.J. Turner (7th; 80%), Anthony Gaines (14th; 76.2%).

**TAYLOR TIME:** Ryan Taylor is a threat to hit from deep.

- The graduate transfer has knocked down 48 triples this season - 15 more than anyone else on the team.
- His 2.5 three-pointers per game is the fourth-best average in the league.
- Has made four or more triples in seven games this season - NU is 6-1 in those games.
- Shooting 38.0 percent (19-for-50) from behind the arc in Big Ten games.

**TURNOVER TIME:** The Wildcats have forced 10 or more turnovers 15 times this season and 15 or more on seven occasions. NU is unbeaten when the opposition turns it over 16 or more times (four games). Against Utah (11/29/18), Northwestern forced a season-high 21 turnovers, the most since NU also forced 21 against Valparaiso (Dec. 14, 2017).

**BLOCK PARTY:** Pardon has accumulated 141 career blocks, which places him second all-time at Northwestern. His 141 career blocks are the second most among active Big Ten players (Mike Watkins, PSU; 179) and 32nd among Division I players.

**GAINING GROUND:** Sophomore Anthony Gaines has made significant strides in his second collegiate campaign. As a rookie, Gaines averaged 18.6 minutes per game, 4.0 points and 2.5 rebounds per game. The 6-4 guard has surpassed those numbers and is playing 25.5 minutes per game this season, while scoring 5.8 points per game and bringing down 4.4 rebounds.

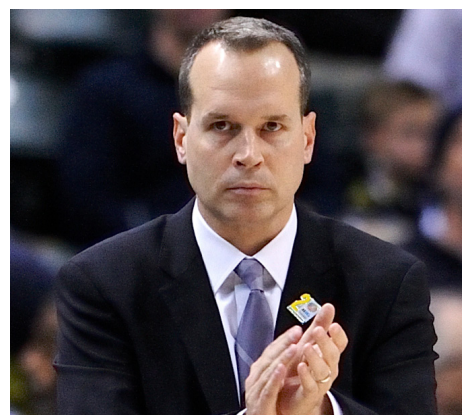
**More notes on Gaines:**

- Scored in double figures back-to-back games for the first time in his career (11 vs. Illinois; 13 vs. Iowa)
- Thirteen points vs. Iowa was a career high.
- Has recorded at least six rebounds in four straight games.
- Posted team-bests plus/minus lines in the last two games: at Rutgers (+17; 1/18/19) and vs. Indiana (+12; 1/22/19)

**NU 'CATS ON THE BLOCK:** The 2018 recruiting class is ranked 33rd in the NCAA (247Sports), its highest-ranked recruiting class in recorded history (since 1999) ... The class is also ranked seventh in the Big Ten, its highest-ranked class since the 2014 class (Scottie Lindsey, Bryant McIntosh, and Vic Law) ... First time NU has had two four-star recruits in its class (Nance/Kopp).

## CHRIS COLLINS

SULLIVAN-UBBEN HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Chris Collins is in his sixth season at Northwestern. He was named the University's 24th head men's basketball coach on March 27, 2013.

Collins guided the Wildcats to heights never before reached during the 2016-17 season. The unforgettable campaign saw Northwestern accumulate a school-record 24 wins while earning the program's first NCAA tournament berth and victory in school history.

NU captured the nation's attention with its outstanding start to the season. An 18-4 start, including a six-game winning streak in Big Ten Conference play - the program's first since 1933 - saw the team crack the top 25 of the AP poll on Jan. 30, the team's first national ranking in seven years. NU went on to record 10 wins in league play, its most since the 1932-33 campaign.

NU was rewarded with an NCAA tournament berth on Selection Sunday and the Wildcats earned a 68-66 victory over Vanderbilt in an opening-round contest in Salt Lake City. Northwestern pushed second-ranked and eventual national runner-up Gonzaga to the limits in the second round before eventually suffering a narrow loss.

Collins' contributions to the program were rewarded by being named one of four national finalists for the Naismith Men's Coach of the Year award. Following the season, Collins agreed to a contract extension that runs through the 2024-25 campaign.

Collins came to Evanston after serving on the coaching staff at Duke since July 22, 2000. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2008. During Collins' 13 seasons on the Blue Devils' staff, Duke posted an overall record of 385-77 while recording eight ACC tournament championships, four ACC regular season titles, eight in-season tournament titles and national championships in 2001 and 2010.

Before returning to his alma mater, Collins served as an assistant coach at Seton Hall for two years with Tommy Amaker. Collins spent the 1997-98 season as an assistant with the WNBA's Detroit Shock.

While attending Duke, Collins was a team captain as a senior and four-year letterman from 1993-96. He ranks 11th among Duke's all-time leaders in three-point field goals (209) and 10th in three-point field goal attempts (539). Collins averaged 9.1 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists as a collegian. He earned second-team All-ACC honors as a senior.

Collins is the son of former NBA All-Star, Doug Collins, who is currently a senior advisor for the Chicago Bulls. A native of nearby Northbrook, Illinois, Collins is a 1996 graduate of Duke with a bachelor's degree in sociology.
