THE KICKOFF

- Northwestern will celebrate homecoming this week, welcoming alums and the Hastings Broncos to De Valois Stadium.
- In the all-time series, Northwestern leads the Broncos 27-10.
- The Raiders have won the last 18 meetings dating back to October 22, 2005.
- Last season, Northwestern opened the season with a 41-7 win over the Broncos.
- Hayden Groos led the passing attack, throwing for 310 yards and three touchdowns.
- Austyn Gerard caught six passes for a career-high 136 yards and a score.
- Tanner Schouten was on the receiving end of two touchdowns.

LAST TIME OUT

- An instant classic took place in Orange City, as Northwestern fell 21-20 to then-No. 14 Dordt.
- The Raiders forced three first-half turnovers, with two interceptions from Ben Egli and a pick-six by Jordan
- Kylar Fritz led Northwestern with nine tackles.
- Ben Egli had seven tackles and two picks.
- Gardner Casey rushed for 59 yards and a score, also catching four passes for 55 yards.
- Sam Remmerde took two receptions for 45 yards.
- Colby Duncan was 14-for-19 with 162 yards behind center.
- Jackson Smythe totaled six tackles.

DOMINANT DEFENSE

- Northwestern's defense has held up strong despite graduation and staff changes.
- Their scoring defense ranks third in the GPAC, allowing 11.3 points per game.
- The Raider D has shut out two opponents in four games.
- They have the second-best defense by yardage in the GPAC, allowing 228.8 yards per contest.
- Jackson Smythe is Northwestern's tackling leader, posting 22.0 on the season.
- Ben Egli is tied for second in the GPAC with two interceptions.
- Levi Egli, Jaxson Hildebrand, and Trystin Voss are tied for sixth in the GPAC with 3.0 sacks on the year.
- Voss leads the Raiders with 4.5 tackles for loss.
- The Raider defense is led by first-year defensive coordinator Brett Moser.

VOSS THE BOSS

- All-American defensive lineman Trystin Voss returns to lead in the trenches in 2025.
- In his junior season, Voss tied for fourth in the GPAC with seven sacks.
- He was sixth in the conference in tackles for loss (13.0).
- The CSC Academic All-District selection also recorded seven sacks and recovered a fumble in 2024.
- Voss is a semifinalist for the 2025 Campbell Trophy, college football's premier scholar-athlete award.

DUAL THREAT

- Red Raider quarterback Colby Duncan sparked the offense in his return to the starting role against Dakota Wesleyan.
- The sophomore signal caller posted a career-high 145 rushing yards, also recording his longest career rush of 63 yards.
- He leads the Raider rushing attack with 230 yards and a touchdown.
- In 12 career appearances, Duncan has passed for 1,242 yards and eight touchdowns.

WIDEOUT WONDERS

- Northwestern's wide receiver corps has put up solid numbers this season.
- Tanner Schouten, returning from injury last season, has hauled in 13 passes for 190 yards and two touchdowns.
- Schouten is 62 yards away from 1,000 career receiving yards.
- Freshman Carson Ness scored his first career touchdown in his hometown of Yankton, South Dakota earlier this year.
- He leads the team with 250 receiving yards at 62.5 per game.
- Sam Remmerde has moved into the starting tight end position, leading Raider TEs with eight receptions for 112 yards.
- He posted a career-high 45 yards last weekend against Dordt.
- Junior Austyn Gerard was fourth in the GPAC with 872 receiving yards and eight touchdowns last

KICKING BY COMMITTEE

- The Raiders have utilized a pair of kickers this year in Gianna Bennett and Jovany Kabongo.
- Bennett knocked in three field goals in the win at Dakota Wesleyan, hitting from 25, 30, and 33.
- Last year, Bennett became the first female to score in a GPAC football game with her extra point in the season-opening win at Hastings.
- Kabongo has been balancing duties with the football and men's soccer teams, playing in two football games and notching two goals and two assists in soccer this season.
- Miquel Gonzalez also handled kickoff duties against Dakota Wesleyan, kicking off six times for 359 yards.

- Freshman running back Gardner Casey has emerged into the starting role through the first month of the season.
- He sits second in the GPAC with four touchdowns.
- Casey has rushed for 171 yards and has caught eight passes for 56 yards.

BREAKOUT GAMES

Northwestern's freshmen impressed in their first career games against Waldorf.

- The freshman running back group rushed for 186 yards, led by redshirt freshman Solomon Tea's 93 yards and two touchdowns.
- Gardner Casey added 36 yards and a touchdown.
- Wide receiver Carson Ness caught four passes for 102 yards.

NEW FACES, SAME PLACES

- Northwestern is set to insert returning players into new or larger roles this season.
- Returning on the offense, running back Solomon Tea, tight end Sam Remmerde, offensive lineman Caleb Noeske, and wide receivers Tyson Bajema and Cohen Jacobs are in line to be regular starters for the first time in their collegiate careers.
- Defensively, Caden Meyer, Levi Egli, Jackson Smythe, and Camden Kruse will increase their reps this season.
- Will Bunn, Brodie VanRegenmorter, and Hayden Groos switched to the defensive side of the ball, with all three slated in on this week's two deep.

GPAC ON THE RISE

- Although the GPAC has produced perennial contenders throughout the years, the conference has improved its depth in recent years.
- Four schools are represented in the NAIA Top 25.
- Morningside leads the way at No. 4, with Dordt at No. 13, Concordia at No. 19, and Northwestern at No. 22.
- Mount Marty and Briar Cliff are receiving votes.
- The Raiders will host two of the NAIA's top 25 in Dordt and Morningside, and will close the season at Concordia.

POLL PARTY

- The Red Raiders opened at No. 7 in this year's NAIA Preseason Coaches' Top 25.
- Northwestern has been ranked in the top 25 in 102 consecutive NAIA ratings dating back to August 7, 2017.
- · The ratings streak ranks fourth in the NAIA.
- The Raiders hold a 28-6 record in the regular season dating back to the start of the 2022 national title campaign.

LEGENDARY LARRY

- NAIA Hall of Fame Coach Larry "Bubb" Korver received the call to the NFF College Football Hall of Fame.
- Northwestern honored Korver on August 30 as part of an NFF's On-Campus Salute.
- Korver led the Raiders to two national titles ('73, '83), compiled a record of 212-77-6, and earned a postseason berth 11 times.
- He was named NAIA Coach of the Year in 1973 and 1985 and is currently 11th on the NAIA's all-time coaching wins list
- Only 237 coaches have been inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame.

ALL-GPAC HONORS

- The Red Raiders come in at No. 7 in this year's NAIA Coaches' Top 25. The Raiders had plenty of spots taken on the GPAC all-conference list in 2024.
- Five all-conference athletes return in Trystin Voss, Jacob Dragstra, Austyn Gerard, Ben Egli, and Korver Hupke.
- Parker Fryar led the way with GPAC Defensive Player of the Year honors, the second time in his career receiving the award
- Northwestern placed nine players on the First Team.
- Four athletes were named to the Second Team, and two as Honorable Mentions.
- Six players received their first career all-conference accolades.

POSTSEASON LEGACY

- Northwestern has appeared in 26 NAIA playoffs.
- They are one of seven NAIA programs to reach the

playoffs 20 or more times.

- The Raiders are tied for seventh among all NAIA programs with three national titles.
- Head coach Matt McCarty has made seven NAIA FCS appearances in 10 seasons at the helm.

2024 IN REVIEW

- The Raiders are coming off of a 9-3 campaign, tying for second in the GPAC with an 8-2 conference mark
- They picked up two wins over top-10 teams, defeating Dordt and Montana Tech.
- Northwestern advanced to the NAIA Quarterfinals for the 20th time in program history, falling 17-0 to Grand View.
- They took down Montana Tech 32-29 on the road in the NAIA Second Round.
