OPENING TIP

- Northwestern hosts Midland for its final home game of the semester.
- The Raiders hold a 37-8 advantage in the all-time series and have won the last seven meetings.
- In the last meeting, the Raiders took down the Warriors 74-71 on the road.
- Alex Van Kalsbeek led the way with a 31-point, 13-rebound double-double.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek scored 19 points and grabbed seven boards.

LAST TIME OUT

- Northwestern used its offensive firepower to drive past Waldorf, 96-82.
- The Raiders shot 60.7% from the field, marking the sixth time this season that they shot over 60%.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek scored 38 points on 14-for-19 shooting, his fifth 30-point game this year.
- Jalen Langsy added 27 points.
- Kaleb Booth was in double-figures for the third time in the last four games, scoring 10 points.
- Northwestern had 50 points in the paint to Waldorf's 26.

BREAKING OUT

- Brennan Reid has been a consistent contributor since being inserted into the starting lineup over Thanksgiving break.
- Reid collected his first career double-double with 15 points and 10 boards against Morningside.
- He added 6 points and a team high 10 rebounds in the victory over the Broncos..

NEAR THE TOP

- Northwestern's 6-0 start catapulted them to the No. 3 ranking in the first regular season poll.
- The No. 3 ranking is tied for the program's highest in the NAIA's one-division era (2020-pres.).
- They are fourth in the NAIA in field goal percentage (55.1%) and are fourth in points per game (94.3).
- Individually, Jesse Van Kalsbeek leads the NAIA in points per game (30.0) and is fourth in rebounds (12.3).
- Jalen Langsy is second in the nation in points per game (27.4).

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Jesse Van Kalsbeek has been named NAIA Offensive Player of the Week twice this season after averaging 42.5 points per game against William Penn (Iowa) and Doane.
- In November 11's win over the Statesmen, Van Kalsbeek posted a career-high 47 points and grabbed 14 rebounds.
- On December 3 he recorded the program's first triple-double since 1988 with 24 points, 12 boards, and 10 assists.
- He currently leads the NAIA in points per game (32.6) and is fourth in the country in rebounds per game (13.9).

NEWCOMER NOTABLES

- The Raiders have received strong contributions from their newcomers through the early part of the season.
- Transfer guard Manny Hammonds is third on the team in scoring, contributing 10.4 points per game.
- The junior from Des Moines, Iowa shoots an impressive 48.1% from three-point range.
- Isaac Cordes has filled in the backup point guard spot with an 8:1 assist to turnover ratio.
- Cordes has also played well defensively, averaging 1.5 steals per contest.

BUILDING THE ROSTER

- The Raiders bring plenty of experience back for first-year head coach Colton Kooima.
- Kaleb Booth, Mason Gerleman, Marcus Kelderman, and Carter Van Hulzen bring senior leadership to the roster.
- First Team All-GPAC selections Jesse Van Kalsbeek and Jalen Langsy will look to spark the offense.
- The Raiders have three true freshmen on the varsity roster in Isaac Cordes, Max Dearborn, and Blake Aalbers, as well as transfer junior Manny Hammonds.
- Hammonds comes to Northwestern from William Penn (Iowa), where he was the 2024 Heart of America Freshman of the Year.

PASSING THE BATON

- After 25 seasons under Kris Korver, Northwestern will be led by first-year head coach and former NAIA All-American Colton Kooima.
- Kooima returns to Northwestern after serving as an assistant for Korver from 2021-24.
- Most recently, Kooima was the top assistant at Augustana (S.D.).
- During his career, he was a four-time First Team All-Conference performer, also receiving the GPAC Player of the Year award for the 2017-18 season and GPAC Freshman of the Year accolades in 2014-15.
- Kooima was inducted into the Northwestern Athletics Hall of Fame in 2023.

NAIA HALL OF FAMER

- Kris Korver was named to the NAIA Hall of Fame this fall after a 25-year career at Northwestern.
- He won two NAIA Division II national titles ('01, '03), made 19 trips to the NAIA tournament, finished atop the GPAC standings nine times, and won the GPAC tournament title six times.
- Korver accumulated a 574-225 record on the sidelines.
- He is the second Raider men's basketball player or coach to be inducted to the NAIA Hall of Fame, joining Brandon Woudstra ('03).
