OPENING TIP

- Northwestern is on the road to continue GPAC play, facing a pair of top-10 opponents in No. 10 Dakota Wesleyan and No. 9 Concordia.
- The Raiders and Bulldogs are meeting for the second time this season, as Concordia won 88-66 on November 22 in Orange City.
- Northwestern is facing Dakota Wesleyan for the first time this season, searching for its first win over the Tigers since December 6, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Raiders went 1-1 in Kansas, taking down Benedictine in double overtime and falling to No. 11 MidAmerica Nazarene.
- In the 2OT win on December 19, Ashtyn Wobig scored a career-high 32 points.
- Allison Piercy (18) and Emily TerWee (16) also scored in double figures.
- Kylie Foss pulled down 13 rebounds in the win, matching her career high.
- TerWee (16) and Wobig (13) were the Raiders' top scorers in December 20's loss to the Pioneers.

SCORING MACHINE

- Ashtyn Wobig scored a career-high 32 points in December 19's win at Benedictine.
- She was the first Raider since Molly Schany in 2023 to post a 30-point game.
- Her 15.6 points per game are 10th in the GPAC.

"UNTIL SHE PUT ON THE MASK"

- Allison Piercy has been leading the Raiders in scoring since donning the face mask.
- In the last nine games, she is averaging 13.8 points per game and had a near triple-double on December 10 against Waldorf.
- The week of December 13, Piercy averaged 24.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 4.5 assists.

RETURN TO FORM

- Since her return to the starting lineup, Emily TerWee has been a key part of the offensive attack.
- She has scored in double figures in the last four games and has matched a season-high 16 points in back-to-back games.
- TerWee is shooting an efficient 51.1% from the field in her most recent stretch.

STIFLING DEFENSE

- Senior guard Kylie Foss has brought versatility to the lineup so far this season.
 - The Salem, S.D. product is leading the Raiders in rebounding (7.2), steals (2.2), and assists (3.8).
 - She was named the GPAC Defensive Player of the Week for her performance the week of November 3-8.
 - Foss was a defensive presence on the ball and on the boards, totaling eight steals, two blocks, and 27 rebounds.
 - She also had a career-high seven steals in Northwestern's win over John Brown.
- ### HISTORY OF EXCELLENCE
- The Northwestern women's basketball program has had a history of success, compiling over 1,000 wins since its inception in 1970.
 - The Raiders own five national titles, have made the NAIA tournament 21 times, and have won the GPAC seven times.
 - Northwestern's last national title came in 2012 under head coach Chris Yaw.

HE'S BACK!

- Head coach Chris Yaw returns to the sidelines this season, coming back to Northwestern after a four-year hiatus.
- In Yaw's first stint, his teams qualified for the national tournament seven times, won the national title in 2012, and reached the Fab Four three times ('13, '18, '19).
- Northwestern also won the GPAC regular season title in 2014 and 2019, and won the tournament in 2014.

NAIA HALL OF FAME

- Earlier this fall, Becca (Hurley) Kramer ('11) was inducted into the NAIA Hall of Fame.
- A three-time First Team All-American and the 2011 NAIA Player of the Year, Hurley scored 2,315 points in a Raider uniform.
- Hurley was a three-time national champion ('08, '10, '11), leading the team through one of the best stretches in program history.
- She is the third Northwestern women's basketball player to enter the NAIA Hall of Fame, joining Rachel (Binneboese) Leavitt and Deb Remmerde-Leusink.
