### NORTHWESTERN RED RAIDERS

#### OPENING TIP

- The Raiders will look to extend their winning streak to four games as they host Morningside on Wednesday night.
- Northwestern won the last meeting in Sioux City 86-80 on December 3.
- Allison Piercy led the team with 17 points.
- Ellie Karolevitz scored a career-high 16 off the bench.
- Ashtyn Wobig neared a double-double with 13 points and nine boards.
- Morningside holds a 30-24 lead in the series, but Northwestern has won the last four meetings.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Northwestern survived a fourth-quarter push from Mount Marty, winning 62-61 on Saturday.
- Allison Piercy led all scorers with 15 points.
- Ashtyn Wobig scored 14 and grabbed seven boards.
- Margo Schuiteman was also in double figures with 10.
- Kylie Foss scored seven points, totaled seven rebounds, and had a pair of steals.

#### LATE-SEASON SPARK

- Jenna Kluxdal has provided a spark off the bench since her return from injury.
- She scored a career-high 19 points in Northwestern's win at Briar Cliff last Wednesday.
- Since her return vs. Dordt, Kluxdal has scored 13, 17, and 19, and 7, respectively, in four games.

#### SCORING MACHINE

- Ashtyn Wobig scored a career-high 32 points in December 19's win at Benedictine.
- She was the first Raider since Molly Schany in 2023 to post a 30-point game.
- Wobig has eclipsed 20 points five times this season.
- Her 14.4 points per game leads the team.
- Wobig has also been efficient at the line, sitting fourth in the GPAC at 82.5% from the stripe.

#### RANGE MAKER

- Allison Piercy is Northwestern's top three-point shooter, hitting at a 42.5% clip from downtown.
- She has made 3+ threes in 14 games this season.
- Piercy is third in the GPAC in three-point percentage.

#### PROTECTING THE PAINT

- The Raiders have protected the basket, sitting second in the GPAC in blocks per game (4.6).
- Individually, freshman Aubrey Metzger (1.5) and junior Jenna Kluxdal (1.1) each average over a block per game.

#### STIFLING DEFENSE

- Senior guard Kylie Foss has brought versatility to the lineup this season.
- The Brandon, S.D. product is leading the Raiders in rebounding (7.0), steals (2.0), and assists (4.0).
- Foss is third in the conference in assists, sixth in rebounds, and 11th in steals.
- She was named the GPAC Defensive Player of the Week for her performance the week of November 3-8.

#### HISTORY OF EXCELLENCE

- The Northwestern women's basketball program has had a history of success, compiling over 1,000 wins since its inception in 1970.
- The Raiders own five national titles, have made the NAIA tournament 21 times, and have won the GPAC seven times.
- Northwestern's last national title came in 2012 under head coach Chris Yaw.

#### HE'S BACK!

- Head coach Chris Yaw returns to the sidelines this season, coming back to Northwestern after a four-year hiatus.
- In Yaw's first stint, his teams qualified for the national tournament seven times, won the national title in 2012, and reached the Fab Four three times ('13, '18, '19).
- Northwestern also won the GPAC regular season title in 2014 and 2019, and won the tournament in 2014.

#### NAIA HALL OF FAME

- Earlier this fall, Becca (Hurley) Kramer ('11) was inducted into the NAIA Hall of Fame.
- A three-time First Team All-American and the 2011 NAIA Player of the Year, Hurley scored 2,315 points in a Raider uniform.
- Hurley was a three-time national champion ('08, '10, '11), leading the team through one of the best stretches in program history.
- She is the third Northwestern women's basketball player to enter the NAIA Hall of Fame, joining Rachel (Binneboese) Leavitt and Deb Remmerde-Leusink.
