### OPENING TIP

- The Raiders will come back to the Bultman for the final game of the regular season, hosting Dakota Wesleyan.
- Northwestern leads the all-time series 37-18.
- The last meeting saw the Raiders win 89-71 on December 17 in Mitchell.
- Jalen Langsy led all scorers with 35 points.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek recorded a double-double with 24 points and 15 rebounds.
- Luke Korver led the bench with seven points.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Northwestern won 89-74 on the road at Waldorf.
- Four Raiders scored in double figures in the win.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek posted a near triple-double with 25 points, 17 rebounds, and seven assists.
- Jalen Langsy added 21 points.
- Manny Hammonds went 5-for-6 from beyond the arc, contributing 15 points.
- Kaleb Booth had 13 points and made three triples.

### NEAR THE TOP

- Northwestern leads the NAIA in field goal percentage (56.3%), points per game (94.1), and three-point percentage (45.7%).
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek leads the NAIA in scoring average (28.5) and is second in rebounds per game (12.3).
- Jalen Langsy is second in the nation in points per game (27.6) and is fourth in three-point percentage (51.1%).
- Four Raiders (Langsy, Hammonds, Booth, Cordes) are in the top 15 in the GPAC for three-point percentage, with Langsy and Hammonds at first and third, respectively.

### COLD LIKE MINNESOTA

- Jalen Langsy has solidified himself as one of the best players in the NAIA in recent weeks.
- The sophomore from Shakopee, Minnesota scored 30+ points in four games during January, with two 40-point performances.
- January was kind to Langsy, as he averaged 31.3 points per game.
- Langsy holds the sophomore record for three pointers in a season (120).
- Langsy is an efficient 51.1% from downtown, which is fourth in the NAIA.

### DOUBLE-DOUBLES ON DECK

- Jesse Van Kalsbeek is averaging a double-double, sitting at 28.5 points and 12.3 rebounds per game.
- He has recorded 22 double-doubles in 27 games this year.
- Van Kalsbeek leads all of college basketball in points per game (28.5) and is second in the NAIA in rebounding (12.3).
- The sophomore from Sheldon, Iowa has been named the NAIA Offensive Player of the Week three times this season.

### GREEN MACHINE

- Kaleb Booth has been automatic from downtown throughout his career, shooting a hot 52.8%.

- He is on pace to break both the Northwestern record (48.5%) and NAIA record (52.0%) for career three-point percentage.
- Booth recently reached 200 career threes as well, passing the mark on January 17.
- The senior from Carroll, Iowa is 16 assists away from becoming the 12th Raider with 400 career assists.

### RECORD WATCH

- Northwestern is on pace to break season records in field goal percentage (55.2%), three-point percentage (43.5%), and made threes (351).
- Kaleb Booth is shooting 52.8% from three-point range for his career, which is on pace to break the Northwestern (48.5%) and NAIA (52.0%) records.
- Jalen Langsy is eight threes away from breaking the school single-season three-pointers record.

### PASSING THE BATON

- After 25 seasons under Kris Korver, Northwestern will be led by first-year head coach and former NAIA All-American Colton Kooima.
- Kooima returns to Northwestern after serving as an assistant for Korver from 2021-24.
- Most recently, Kooima was the top assistant at Augustana (S.D.).
- During his career, he was a four-time First Team All-Conference performer, also receiving the GPAC Player of the Year award for the 2017-18 season and GPAC Freshman of the Year accolades in 2014-15.
- Kooima was inducted into the Northwestern Athletics Hall of Fame in 2023.

### NAIA HALL OF FAMER

- Kris Korver was named to the NAIA Hall of Fame this fall after a 25-year career at Northwestern.
- He won two NAIA Division II national titles ('01, '03), made 19 trips to the NAIA tournament, finished atop the GPAC standings nine times, and won the GPAC tournament title six times.
- Korver accumulated a 574-225 record on the sidelines.
- He is the second Raider men's basketball player or coach to be inducted to the NAIA Hall of Fame, joining Brandon Woudstra ('03).
