### OPENING TIP

- Northwestern and Dakota Wesleyan are set for a rematch in Wednesday's GPAC Quarterfinals.
- The Raiders swept the season series with the Tigers, winning 89-71 in Mitchell and 97-65 in Orange City.
- A 10-game winning streak is on the line, Northwestern's second double-digit winning streak in as many seasons.
- Northwestern earned the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament, securing a top-three seed for the 18th time in 26 years of the GPAC tournament.

### LAST TIME OUT

- The Raiders stayed hot with a 32-point win at home over Dakota Wesleyan, winning 97-65 on Saturday.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek recorded a 20-point, 10-rebound double-double, his 23rd double-double on the year.
- Jalen Langsy went 4-for-5 from long range, totaling 18 points.
- Isaac Cordes posted career-highs in points (15) and threes (5).
- Brennan Reid scored 15 points and added eight rebounds.
- Northwestern made 16 threes, marking the eighth time this season making at least 15 threes.

### NEAR THE TOP

- Northwestern leads the NAIA in field goal percentage (56.4%), points per game (94.2), and three-point percentage (46.1%).
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek leads the NAIA in scoring average (28.2) and is second in rebounds per game (12.3).
- Jalen Langsy is second in the nation in points per game (27.3) and is third in three-point percentage (51.7%).
- Four Raiders (Langsy, Hammonds, Booth, Cordes) are in the top 15 in the GPAC for three-point percentage, with Langsy and Hammonds at first and fifth, respectively.

### COLD LIKE MINNESOTA

- Jalen Langsy has solidified himself as one of the best players in the NAIA this season
- His 124 threes this season is four away from breaking Northwestern's single-season threes record.
- Langsy holds the sophomore record for three pointers in a season (124).
- He is an efficient 51.7% from downtown, which is third in the NAIA.
- The sophomore from Shakopee, Minnesota scored 30+ points in four games during January, with two 40-point performances.

### DOUBLE-DOUBLES ON DECK

- Jesse Van Kalsbeek is averaging a double-double, sitting at 28.2 points and 12.3 rebounds per game.
- He has recorded 23 double-doubles in 28 games this year.
- Van Kalsbeek leads all of college basketball in points per game (28.2) and is second in the NAIA in rebounding (12.3).
- The sophomore from Sheldon, Iowa has been named the NAIA Offensive Player of the Week three times this season.

### GREEN MACHINE

- Kaleb Booth has been automatic from downtown throughout his career, shooting a hot 52.8%.
- He is on pace to break both the Northwestern record (48.5%) and NAIA record (52.0%) for career three-point percentage.
- Booth recently reached 200 career threes as well, passing the mark on January 17.
- The senior from Carroll, Iowa is 15 assists away from becoming the 12th Raider with 400 career assists.

### RECORD WATCH

- Northwestern is on pace to break season records in field goal percentage (55.2%), three-point percentage (43.5%), and made threes (351).
- Kaleb Booth is shooting 52.8% from three-point range for his career, which is on pace to break the Northwestern (48.5%) and NAIA (52.0%) records.
- Jalen Langsy is four threes away from breaking the school single-season three-pointers record.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek is sitting at 789 points this season, which is nearing the program record of 953 points (Alan Visser, 1989-90).
- Van Kalsbeek also has 642 career rebounds and is on pace to become the 19th Raider with 700 career boards.

### PASSING THE BATON

- After 25 seasons under Kris Korver, Northwestern will be led by first-year head coach and former NAIA All-American Colton Kooima.
- Kooima returns to Northwestern after serving as an assistant for Korver from 2021-24.
- Most recently, Kooima was the top assistant at Augustana (S.D.).
- During his career, he was a four-time First Team All-Conference performer, also receiving the GPAC Player of the Year award for the 2017-18 season and GPAC Freshman of the Year accolades in 2014-15.
- Kooima was inducted into the Northwestern Athletics Hall of Fame in 2023.

### NAIA HALL OF FAMER

- Kris Korver was named to the NAIA Hall of Fame this fall after a 25-year career at Northwestern.
- He won two NAIA Division II national titles ('01, '03), made 19 trips to the NAIA tournament, finished atop the GPAC standings nine times, and won the GPAC tournament title six times.
- Korver accumulated a 574-225 record on the sidelines.
- He is the second Raider men's basketball player or coach to be inducted to the NAIA Hall of Fame, joining Brandon Woudstra ('03).
