





### #1 FREED-HARDEMAN LIONS

### OPENING TIP

- The Raiders are set to face top-ranked Freed-Hardeman (Tenn.) in the Round of 16 at the NAIA Final Site.
- This year marks Northwestern's third consecutive trip to Municipal Auditorium and the Round of 16.
- It is the first-ever matchup between Northwestern and Freed-Hardeman.
- With a win, Northwestern would have its first win over a No. 1 opponent since 2021's NAIA division merger.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Northwestern advanced to the NAIA Final Site with an 80-62 win over defending champion College of Idaho.
- They shot 61.2% from the field, marking their 11th time this season shooting above 60 percent.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek posted 29 points, nine rebounds, seven assists, and four steals.
- Jalen Langsy added 23 points and four assists.
- Brennan Reid scored 11 points.

### IN LIKE A LION

- Northwestern is entering March as one of the hottest teams in the NAIA.
- Colton Kooima's squad has picked up 15 wins in a row, going 7-0 in the month of February and 3-0 so far in March.
- They won their 25th game in the GPAC semifinals, marking the 15th time in school history and third consecutive year of winning at least 25 games.
- Northwestern was announced as a host site for the NAIA First and Second Rounds, hosting for the second time in three seasons.
- The Raiders are making their 28th overall and seventh consecutive appearance in the national tournament.

### NEAR THE TOP

- Northwestern leads the NAIA in field goal percentage (56.8%), points per game (94.2), and three-point percentage (46.9%).
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek leads the NAIA in scoring average (27.9) and is second in rebounds per game (12.2).
- Jalen Langsy is second in the nation in points per game (27.4) and three-point percentage (51.4%).
- Five Raiders (Langsy, Reid, Hammonds, Booth, Cordes) are in the top 10 in the GPAC for three-point percentage, with Langsy in first, Reid in third, and Cordes in fifth.

### COLD LIKE MINNESOTA

- Jalen Langsy has solidified himself as one of the best players in the NAIA this season
- His 148 threes this season has broken Northwestern's single-season threes record.
- He is an efficient 51.4% from downtown, which is second in the NAIA.
- The sophomore from Shakopee, Minnesota has reached 30+ points in 13 games this season

### DOUBLE-DOUBLES ON DECK

- Jesse Van Kalsbeek is averaging a double-double, sitting at

27.9 points and 12.2 rebounds per game.

- He has recorded 26 double-doubles in 33 games this year.
- Van Kalsbeek leads all of college basketball in points per game (27.9) and is second in the NAIA in rebounding (12.2).
- The sophomore from Sheldon, Iowa has been named the NAIA Offensive Player of the Week three times this season.

### GREEN MACHINE

- Kaleb Booth has been automatic from downtown throughout his career, shooting a hot 52.8%.
- He is on pace to break both the Northwestern record (48.5%) and NAIA record (52.0%) for career three-point percentage.
- Booth recently reached 200 career threes as well, passing the mark on January 17.
- The senior from Carroll, Iowa is seven assists away from becoming the 12th Raider with 400 career assists.

### RECORD WATCH

- Northwestern is on pace to break season records in field goal percentage (55.2%) and three-point percentage (43.5%), and has already broken the record for made threes (374).
- Kaleb Booth is shooting 52.8% from three-point range for his career, which is on track to break the Northwestern (48.5%) and NAIA (52.0%) records.
- On February 25, Jalen Langsy broke the school single-season three-pointers record (148).
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek is sitting at 920 points this season, which is nearing the program record of 953 points (Alan Visser, 1989-90).
- Van Kalsbeek also has 701 career rebounds, becoming the 19th Raider with 700 career boards.

### PASSING THE BATON

- After 25 seasons under Kris Korver, Northwestern will be led by first-year head coach and former NAIA All-American Colton Kooima.
- Kooima returns to Northwestern after serving as an assistant for Korver from 2021-24.
- Most recently, Kooima was the top assistant at Augustana (S.D.).
- During his career, he was a four-time First Team All-Conference performer, also receiving the GPAC Player of the Year award for the 2017-18 season and GPAC Freshman of the Year accolades in 2014-15.
- Kooima was inducted into the Northwestern Athletics Hall of Fame in 2023.


