### OPENING TIP

- Northwestern and Concordia will square off on Championship Tuesday for the GPAC tournament title.
- The Raiders' last GPAC tournament title came in 2021, while Concordia last won in 2022.
- Northwestern is searching for its first win over the Bulldogs after Concordia swept the regular season series.
- The last meeting came down to the wire with Concordia winning 85-82 in Seward.

### LAST TIME OUT

- The Raiders punched their ticket to the GPAC Championship with a 78-71 win over Mount Marty on Saturday.
- Jalen Langsy led all scorers with 34 points on 12-for-18 shooting.
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek was instrumental with 24 points and 18 boards.
- Brennan Reid added 11 points and five rebounds.
- Northwestern broke its single-season program record for threes, now at 358 and counting.

### IN LIKE A LION

- Northwestern is entering March as one of the hottest teams in the NAIA.
- Colton Kooima's squad has picked up 12 wins in a row, going 7-0 in the month of February.
- They won their 25th game on Saturday, marking the 15th time in school history and third consecutive year of winning at least 25 games.
- Northwestern was announced as a host site for the NAIA First and Second Rounds, hosting for the second time in three seasons.
- The Raiders will make their 28th overall and seventh consecutive appearance in the national tournament.

### NEAR THE TOP

- Northwestern leads the NAIA in field goal percentage (56.6%), points per game (94.3), and three-point percentage (46.6%).
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek leads the NAIA in scoring average (28.0) and is second in rebounds per game (12.4).
- Jalen Langsy is second in the nation in points per game (27.3) and is second in three-point percentage (51.6%).
- Four Raiders (Langsy, Hammonds, Booth, Cordes) are in the top 15 in the GPAC for three-point percentage, with Langsy and Hammonds at first and fourth, respectively.

### COLD LIKE MINNESOTA

- Jalen Langsy has solidified himself as one of the best players in the NAIA this season
- His 132 threes this season has broken Northwestern's single-season threes record.
- He is an efficient 51.6% from downtown, which is second in the NAIA.
- The sophomore from Shakopee, Minnesota scored 30+ points in four games during January, with two 40-point

performances.

### DOUBLE-DOUBLES ON DECK

- Jesse Van Kalsbeek is averaging a double-double, sitting at 28.0 points and 12.4 rebounds per game.
- He has recorded 25 double-doubles in 30 games this year.
- Van Kalsbeek leads all of college basketball in points per game (28.0) and is second in the NAIA in rebounding (12.4).
- The sophomore from Sheldon, Iowa has been named the NAIA Offensive Player of the Week three times this season.

### GREEN MACHINE

- Kaleb Booth has been automatic from downtown throughout his career, shooting a hot 52.6%.
- He is on pace to break both the Northwestern record (48.5%) and NAIA record (52.0%) for career three-point percentage.
- Booth recently reached 200 career threes as well, passing the mark on January 17.
- The senior from Carroll, Iowa is 13 assists away from becoming the 12th Raider with 400 career assists.

### RECORD WATCH

- Northwestern is on pace to break season records in field goal percentage (55.2%) and three-point percentage (43.5%), and has already broken the record for made threes (358).
- Kaleb Booth is shooting 52.6% from three-point range for his career, which is on track to break the Northwestern (48.5%) and NAIA (52.0%) records.
- Last Wednesday, Jalen Langsy broke the school single-season three-pointers record (128).
- Jesse Van Kalsbeek is sitting at 840 points this season, which is nearing the program record of 953 points (Alan Visser, 1989-90).
- Van Kalsbeek also has 672 career rebounds and is on pace to become the 19th Raider with 700 career boards.

### PASSING THE BATON

- After 25 seasons under Kris Korver, Northwestern will be led by first-year head coach and former NAIA All-American Colton Kooima.
- Kooima returns to Northwestern after serving as an assistant for Korver from 2021-24.
- Most recently, Kooima was the top assistant at Augustana (S.D.).
- During his career, he was a four-time First Team All-Conference performer, also receiving the GPAC Player of the Year award for the 2017-18 season and GPAC Freshman of the Year accolades in 2014-15.
- Kooima was inducted into the Northwestern Athletics Hall of Fame in 2023.


