### **Equity in Athletics Report**

#### **Northwestern Oklahoma State University Athletic Department**

*The Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA) was designed to make prospective students and prospective student-athletes aware of an institution of higher education's commitment to providing equitable athletic opportunities for its men and women students. The EADA requires the disclosure of information about varsity teams and the financial resources and personnel that the school dedicates to those teams.*

*Any co-educational institution of higher education that participates in a federal student aid program must prepare an EADA report by October 15. Institutions must also report data to the U.S. Department of Education via an online survey. This is a mandatory survey.*

The Northwestern Oklahoma State University Athletic Department offers a comprehensive program with a variety of varsity sports for both men and women.

The Ranger men's teams compete in baseball, basketball, cross-country, football, golf, outdoor track and field, and rodeo. The women's teams compete in basketball, cross-country, golf, soccer, softball, rodeo, outdoor track & field, and volleyball. Northwestern Oklahoma State University is a member of the Great American Athletic Conference where they compete in all sports but rodeo. For rodeo, they compete in the Central Plains Region of the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association (NIRA). The university is an active member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), Division II.
