THE OPENING KICK

The Ohio football team (3-8, 3-4 MAC) is back for another week of MAction this Friday, Nov. 26 when the Bobcats take on Bowling Green (3-8 1-6 MAC). Kickoff is set for 12:00 p.m. at Peden Doyt L. Perry Stadium. The game can be seen on CBSSN where Chris Lewis and Donte Whitner will have the call.

The Bobcats' matchup can also be heard on the Ohio Sports Network from Learfield. Russ Eisenstein returns for his 14th season as the "Voice of the Bobcats" and will be joined by Ohio alum Rob Cornelius, who has been a part of the broadcasts for two decades.

SERIES HISTORY VS. BOWLING GREEN

This is the 72nd all-time meeting between the Bobcats and Bowling Green, with Ohio behind in the all-time series, 30-40-2.

Ohio and Bowling Green met Nov. 28, 2020; the Bobcats dominated, defeating the Falcons 52-10.

LAST MATCHUP VS. BOWLING GREEN

Ohio and Bowling Green last met Nov. 28, 2020, as the Bobcats pulled out a 52-10 victory at home.

Ohio outgained Bowling Green, 436-306. Kurtis Rourke finished the contest with 63 passing yards with 10 completions on 11 attempts, and threw for one touchdown. De'Montre Tuggle rushed for 186 total yards on 15 attempts.

Bowling Green quarterback Matt McDonald completed 9 of 20 passes for 125 yards and a touchdown while running back Andrew Clair led the way with 120 rushing yards on 15 attempts. Darren Anders led the way defensively for Bowling Green, finishing with 13 total tackles and one forced fumble.

SCOUTING BOWLING GREEN

Bowling Green enters this matchup with the Bobcats with a 3-8 record overall and a 1-6 MAC record, good for sixth place in the MAC East division.

Bowling Green averages 21.45 points a game, and have scored 7 and 17 points in their last two games respectively. Their defense is 32.55 points a game. The Falcons average 103.1 rushing yards per game, while putting up an average of 211.18 yards per game through the air.

the way under center for Bowling Green, having played in all 11 games, going 212-of-356 with 11 touchdowns, 2300 yards and 7 touchdowns.

On the ground, McDonald also has the most attempts (75), while Terion Stewart has the most yards (414) on 61 attempts, with five touchdowns.

LAST TIME OUT

The Ohio Bobcats (3-8, 3-4) fell to Toledo (4-3, 6-5) on Tuesday night (Nov. 16) by a score of 23-35. The Bobcats were led offensively by Kurtis Rourke, who threw for 233 yards and threw one touchdown; while on the defensive side of the ball, Tariq Drake had seven total tackles, including three solo.

SCOUTING OHIO

Ohio is 3-8 overall and 3-4 in the MAC after falling to Toledo last Tuesday.

Overall, the Bobcats are averaging 23.73 points per game to go along with 384.9 total yards per game.

De'Montre Tuggle leads the ground game with 762 yards, while averaging 75.0 yards per game, with seven touchdowns on the ground. O'Shaan Allison adds 291 yards on the ground, while Armani Rogers adds 617 yards on 89 carries and six touchdowns.

Quarterback Kurtis Rourke is 157-of-235 with 1,698 yards, 11 touchdowns and four interceptions. Meanwhile, quarterback Armani Rogers is 29-of-49 with 350 yards.

Tyler Walton leads the receivers with 32 catches for 380 yards and two touchdowns.

COLLINS AND GERMANO ANNOUNCE RETIREMENT

Ohio football head coach Tim Albin announced that defensive coordinators/safeties coach Ron Collins and co-defensive coordinator/defensive ends coach Pete Germano will retire at the conclusion of the season.

Collins spent 10 seasons on the Ohio football coaching staff, including three as the program's defensive coordinator/safeties coach. He was elevated to defensive coordinator on Feb. 5, 2019, after spending seven years as linebackers coach and two as co-defensive coordinator.

Germano spent five seasons in his second stint on the Ohio football coaching staff. Prior to the 2019 season, head coach Frank Solich promoted Germano to co-defensive coordinator to go along with his duties coaching the defensive ends.

AN NCAA RECORD THAT MIGHT NEVER BE BROKEN

On Oct. 16 at Buffalo, quarterback Armani Rogers, on the first play of Ohio's second drive, took the ball to his left, sprinting 99 yards for the touchdown. The run set a new NCAA record for the longest run by a quarterback. The mark was previously held by Mark Malone who ran for a 98-yard touchdown in 1979.

ROURKE SOLID VS MIAMI

Kurtis Rourke was solid against Miami, going 23-of-32 for 288 yards and three touchdowns.

ROURKE RETURNS vs. KENT STATE

Quarterback Kurtis Rourke led Ohio against Kent State on Saturday, Oct. 23.

Rourke led the Bobcats against Kent State. After entering the game in the first quarter, Rourke set career highs by completing 31-of-38 passes, good for an 81 percent completion

ROGERS STEPS UP AGAINST CMU

Quarterback Armani Rogers earned his first start of the season on Saturday against CMU and made the most out of it.

Rogers went 13-of-18 for 190 yards. He also ran for 37 yards on 15 carries, scoring one touchdown.

A GREAT WEEK FOR DE'MONTRE

Running back De'Montre Tuggle had a great week in the awards category for his play on Oct. 2 at Akron. He was named the MAC East Offensive Player of the Week and Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award National Player of the Week Honorable Mention

Tuggle led Ohio offensively this weekend, helping the Bobcats open MAC play with a 34-17 victory at Akron - the first for first year head coach Tim Albin. Tuggle, a redshirt fifth year from Channelview, Texas, finished the game with a career-high 201 yards on 17 carries and one touchdown. Tuggle rushed for an average of 11.8 yards per carry and rattled off a 63-yard rush on the Bobcats' second drive of the game.

MAC EAST DEFENSIVE POW

Defensive end Will Evans was named the MAC East DPOW on Oct. 4.

Evans led Ohio on the defensive end. The redshirt fifth year from Augusta, Ga., finished the game with six total tackles, all solo. He also finished the game with two sacks for 11 yards and two tackles for loss. Evans also registered one pass breakup and forced one fumble in the win.

MAC EAST SPECIAL TEAMS POW

Punter Jonah Wieland was named the Mid-American Conference East Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 20.

The redshirt 5th year transfer led Ohio on special teams on Thursday (Sept. 16) at Louisiana. Wieland recorded four punts 165 yards for an average of 41.2 yards per punt, while recording a long punt of 46 yards, while placing two punts within the 20.

WIN #1 FOR ALBIN

First year head coach picked up his first victory as the Bobcats' head coach on Oct. 2 in the 34-17 victory over Akron.

MONSTER DAY FOR TUG

Running back De'Montre Tuggle registered a career day on the ground for the Bobcats against Akron.

Tuggle ran for a career-high 201 yards on only 17 carries and scored one touchdown in the 35-17 victory.

ROGERS FINDING HIS OWN

Quarterback Armani Rogers is finding his way into the Bobcat's offense.

Against Akron, Rogers ran for 106 yards and two touchdowns.

Against CMU, Rogers went 13-of-18 for 190 yards. He also ran for 37 yards on 15 carries, scoring one touchdown.

In his second-straight start against Buffalo, Rogers went 6-of-10 for 75 yards, while leading Ohio on the ground, rushing for 183 yards on 22 carries and two touchdowns. The highlight being his 99-yard NCAA record setting touchdown run in the first quarter.

WHAT A DEBUT FOR SIEH

True freshman running back Sieh Bangura made the most out of his first collegiate carry on Oct. 9 against CMU.

With his first career carry in the fourth quarter, Bangura took the ball 40 yards for his first career touchdown, at the time, giving Ohio the lead.

HOUSTON WE HAVE A PROBLEM

Redshirt junior linebacker Bryce Houston has taken advantage of his first season starting.

Houston leads Ohio in total tackles with 94, while registering 44 assisted, 50 solo tackles, 6.5 tackles for loss, two sacks and one quarterback hurries.

Houston set a career-high mark at Buffalo, recording 15 tackles, including 11 solo and four assisted.

ELAD STEPPING UP

Redshirt sophomore safety Jett Elad stepped up defensively against Duquesne, setting career marks in total tackles (11), solos (6) and assisted tackles (5).

He also added one tackle for loss, two pass breakups and one quarterback hurry.

On the season he now has 35 total tackles, 2.5 tackle for loss, three pass breakups and one quarterback hurry.

ALVINNNNNNN

Redshirt senior Alvin Floyd is helping lead the Bobcats on the defensive end as well.



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He is third on the team with 57 total tackles, 28 assisted and 29 solo. He also has one forced fumble, one pass break up and has one interception.

MAN THE CANNONS

Redshirt sophomore linebacker Cannon Blauser has made the most out of moving into a starting role. On the season, Blauser has 77 tackles, 35 solo and 42 assisted - with 7.5 tackles for loss, two sacks, five quarterback hurries and one fumble recovery.

On Sept. 25 at Northwestern, Blauser led Ohio with seven total tackles and six solo, with a tackle for loss, quarterback hurry and his first fumble recovery of the season.

At Akron on Oct. 2, Blauser added two sacks.

On Oct. 23 against Kent State, Blauser set a career mark with 14 tackles, with six solo and eight assisted and 1.5 tackles for loss.

A MASSIVE PUNT

Grad transfer punter Jonah Wieland showed his range on Saturday at Buffalo, registering a punt of 64 yards late in the fourth quarter.

It was the first punt from an Ohio kicker of over 60 yards since 202 when Paul Hershey booted one 61 yards at New Mexico State.

SACK MACHINES

On Oct. 4 at Akron, the Bobcats defense was able to get to the quarterback constantly, registering seven sacks for over 49 yards, while also recording eight tackles for loss for 50 yards.

OHIO GETS THE WIN AT AKRON

Ohio football picked up their first win of the 2021 season on Oct. 2, defeating the Akron Zips by a score of 34-17 at InfoCision Stadium.

The Bobcats leaned heavily on their rushing attack, spearheaded by running back De'Montre Tuggle and quarterback Armani Rogers, to start conference play 1-0. Tuggle set a career high in rushing yards (201) on just 17 carries, good for an 11.8 yard/carry average while also adding a touchdown, while Rogers put two scores on the board on the ground.

EVANS IS SUPER

Redshirt fifth year defensive tackle Will Evans is making the most out of his final year.

So far Evans has 31 tackles, seven tackles for loss for 31 yards, 4.5 sacks for 28 yards, while also recording two pass breakups, four quarterback hurries and one forced fumble.

DRAKE WITH THE PICK

Redshirt senior safety Tariq Drake had a career day against CMU, snagging two interceptions for 23 return yards.

On the season, Drake has 46 tackles, 25 solo and 21 assisted, one QB hurry and 2.5 tackles for loss to go with those three INTs.

MILESTONES HIT

Redshirt fifth year wide receiver Cameron Odom surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards on Sept. 11 against Duquesne, catching a 60-yard pass in the first quarter to secure the milestone. Odom has played in 45 games at Ohio, collecting 78 receptions for 1,066 yards and five touchdowns.

Meanwhile, redshirt junior running back O'Shaan Allison also surpassed 1,000 career rushing yards on Sept. 11 against Duquesne.

ALBIN TAKES OVER

Tim Albin enters his first season as head coach in 2021 after serving as Ohio's offensive coordinator for the past 16 years under Frank Solich.

Albin joined the Ohio Football coaching staff as offensive coordinator in 2005, reuniting with Frank Solich after four seasons together at Nebraska. The 2021 season will mark Albin's 17th year in Athens. Since his arrival in Athens, Albin has produced offensive units that have consistently ranked among the top of the Mid-American Conference. He also has directed an offensive attack that has practically rewritten all of Ohio's rushing, passing records, and scoring records. In the past 10 seasons, Albin's offensive units rank No. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 on the Ohio all-time Top-10 single season scoring list. The Bobcats 368 points in 2018 rank fourth on the all-time list.

Albin spent the 2004 season as offensive coordinator and running backs coach at North Dakota State, helping the Bison to an 8-3 record and No. 25 national ranking in their first season at the Division I-AA level. NDSU finished the season averaging 378.5 yards of total offense, including 192.4 on the ground, and had four offensive players named first-team All-Great West Football Conference. Albin served with Solich at Nebraska from 2000 to 2003. He started with the Cornhusker program as a graduate assistant, a position he held for three seasons before being promoted to running backs coach and passing game coordinator for the 2003 season. Prior to his stint at Nebraska, Albin was the head coach at Northwestern Oklahoma State for three seasons, winning the NAIA national championship in 1999 with a 13-0 record. He was named NAIA Football Coach of the Year by Rawlings and American Football Coach Magazine as the Rangers recorded their first undefeated season in history.

THE KING OF KICKOFFS

For the second time in three games dating back to 2020, redshirt fifth year running back

De'Montre Tuggle returned a kickoff for a touchdown.

The latest one game against Duquesne as he took the opening kick 86 yards to the house for his first touchdown of the season.

He last kickoff return touchdown came last November against Bowling Green.

QBs vs. SYRACUSE

Starting quarterback Kurtis Rourke made his fourth career start on Saturday and his first against a Power 5 opponent.

Rourke went 21-of-28 with 142 yards and an interception late in Ohio's 29-9 loss.

Armani Rogers went 1-for-2 with a long pass of 32 yards.

Meanwhile, wide receiver Cam Odom recorded his first career pass attempt and completion with a 38-yard toss to Rourke in the second quarter.

SO LONG TO A LEGEND

Long-time Ohio head coach Frank Solich stepped down as the Bobcats head coach on July 14 after leading Ohio for the last 16 years.

Solich owns a career coaching record of 173-101. His 173 overall wins rank as the fourth most among active NCAA FBS head coaches. He is the winningest head coach in Mid-American Conference history with 115 overall victories while his 77 conference-only wins rank second to former Central Michigan head coach Herb Deromedi's 90. His 16 years of service match Deromedi's (1978-93) for the most in MAC history. Ohio is 115-82 during the Solich era. His 115 victories are the second-most in program history behind Don Peden (121; 1924-46). Ohio has gone 77-46 in conference play since Solich's arrival in Athens in 2005.

Ohio has had a run of 12-straight non-losing seasons that has included 11 winning campaigns and six years with at least nine victories -- including a 10-win campaign in 2011. The 2012 season began with the Bobcats earning a signature win at Penn State, upsetting the Nittany Lions by a score of 24-14. Ohio captured division titles in 2006, 2009, 2011 and 2016. Solich led the Bobcats to 11 of their 13 bowl appearances and the first five bowl victories in program history, with back-to-back wins in the 2011 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl and '12 Independence Bowl and back-to-back-to-back victories in the 2017 Bahamas Bowl, '18 DXL Frisco Bowl and '20 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl (2019 season).

NEW STAFF TITLES

Ohio football head coach Tim Albin announced the promotions of quarterbacks coach Scott Isphording and offensive line



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coach Allen Rudolph. Isphording has been elevated to the position of offensive coordinator, while Rudolph will now serve as the Bobcats' co-offensive coordinator.

Isphording enters his ninth season at Ohio and had served as the Bobcats' quarterbacks coach since 2014.

In 2016, Ohio's quarterbacks set single-season records in pass attempts with 458 combined. They also completed the second-most passes in school history with 250. Ohio passed for 3,142 yards which was second-most in school history and threw for 22 touchdown passes which ranks fourth all-time.

Rudolph enters his third season at Ohio and had served as the Bobcats offensive line coach since fall 2019.

Rudolph, a 24-year coaching veteran, has run an O-line that helped the Bobcats score a program record 521 point in 2018, while averaging 40.1 points per game. His second year at Ohio saw the Bobcats score 446 total points (34.3 ppg), which is third in program history.

Prior to his time at Ohio, Rudolph spent the previous three years as the offensive line coach at Arkansas State, helping to lead the Red Wolves to 23 victories and three bowl appearances – including a 31-13 win over UCF in the Cure Bowl in 2016.

RETURN OF TETT

Former Ohio football standout quarterback Tyler Tettleton has joined the Ohio football staff as an Assistant Football Coach/Passing Game Coordinator/Running Backs coach.

In three years as the Bobcats' starting quarterback, he helped guide Ohio to the 2011 Mid-American Conference East Division crown, a pair of bowl victories, including its first-ever bowl triumph in the 2011 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl and the program's first 10-win season since 1968.

Tettleton also set 27 Ohio football program records and became the first quarterback in school history to surpass 9,000 yards through the air. He also threw 67 touchdown passes during his career in Athens. In 2011, Tettleton set records for highest passer rating (148.9), most completions (265), most touchdown passes (28), most pass yards (3,306) and most total yards (3,960).

Tettleton spent the last season at LSU as an offensive assistant and spent 2019 as an offensive quality control coach with the Cleveland Browns.

After graduating from Ohio, Tettleton returned to his hometown of Norman, Okla. Where he served as a graduate assistant from 2014-17

SUPER SENIORS

With the ability to take an extra year of eligibility due the COVID-19 pandemic, a number of Bobcats chose to come back for one final ride with Ohio.

Cam Odom, Will Evans, Alex Wolff, Jarren Hampton, Armani Rogers, Julian Ross, De'Montre Tuggle, Adam Luehrman, Nick Sink, Hagen Meservy, Chase Cokley, Ryan Luehrman, Jonah Wieland and Zach Burks will all be back for one more yet.

Those players will be wearing a special patch on their jerseys to honor those Super Seniors

A LOOK BACK AT 2020

Ohio is coming off of a 2020 season that was shortened by the Covid-19 pandemic. Ohio finished the year 2-1, recording a pair of home wins over Mid-American Conference East Division rivals Akron (24-10) and Bowling Green (52-10) at Peden Stadium.

CONTINUITY ON OFFENSIVE STAFF

Wide receivers coach **Dwayne Dixon** (15 years) and offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach **Scott Isphording** (nine years). Co-offensive coordinator/offensive line coach **Allen Rudolph** is in his third year at Ohio. Tight ends coach **Brian Metz**, is in his second year with the Bobcats, however, Metz is no stranger to the Bobcats, having spent time as an intern with the program from 2013-14 and as an offensive graduate assistant from 2016-18. The newest addition to the staff in former Ohio quarterback Tyler Tettleton who will serve as Ohio's running backs coach/passing coordinator.

AYE AYE, CAPTAIN

The Ohio football team has named seven team captains for the 2021 season – redshirt fifth-year running back Julian Ross (Kansas City, Mo.), redshirt fifth-year wide receiver Cameron Odom (Bedford, Ohio), redshirt fifth-year offensive lineman Nick Sink (Fishers, Ind.), redshirt senior defensive tackle Kai Caesar (Cache, Okla.), redshirt senior safety Alvin Floyd (North Miami Beach, Fla.), redshirt junior linebacker Bryce Houston (Lewis Center, Ohio) and redshirt sophomore quarterback Kurtis Rourke (Oakville, Ontario, Canada)

Odom enters his third season serving as a team captain, while Caesar and Ross enter their second season. Meanwhile, Sink, Floyd, Houston and Rourke are all serving as captains for the first time.

The Bobcats also had seven captains during the 2011 and 2018 seasons.

Safety Jarren Hampton led Ohio with eight total tackles, including a team-high seven solo stops.

BOBCATS IN THE CFL

Five former Bobcats are currently active in the CFL, starting with former QB **Nathan Rourke** (BC Lions). Running back **Maleek Irons** and wide receiver **Papi White** are both with the Hamilton Tiger-Cats, while running back **AJ Ouellette** (Toronto Argonauts) and defensive tackle **Casey Sayles** (Winnipeg Blue Bombers) are also active.

BOBCATS IN THE NFL

Three former Ohio football student-athletes are representing the Bobcats at the highest level of the sport – Indianapolis Colts cornerback **T.J. Carrie**, Dallas Cowboys outside linebacker **Tarell Basham** and Arizona Cardinals safety **Javon Hagen**.

Since his arrival in Athens, Albin has produced offensive units that have consistently ranked among the top of the Mid-American Conference. He also has directed an offensive attack that has practically rewritten all of Ohio's rushing, passing records, and scoring records.

In the past 10 seasons, Albin's offensive units rank No. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 on the Ohio all-time Top 10 single season scoring list. The Bobcats 368 points in 2016 rank fourth on the all-time list.

In 2016, the Bobcats had the most pass attempts (458) and second-most completions (250) in school history. The offense totaled 5,492 yards of total offense which is third all-time at Ohio. The Bobcats also compiled the second-most pass yards in school history (3,142) and the fourth most touchdown passes (22).

In 2015, the offense totaled 5,378 yards, which ranks third all-time in program history. The Bobcat quarterbacks passed for 3,026 yards, which ranks third all-time in program history as well.

In 2014, the offense totaled 4,443 yards of offense which ranked fifth all-time in program history. The combination of Derrius Vick and JD Sprague proved to be dynamic through the air as the quarterbacks combined to pass for 2,474 yards for the season which is sixth all-time in program history.

The Bobcat offense found a balanced attack with AJ Ouellette in the backfield. The freshman ran for 785 yards ranking him only behind Kareem Wilson for most yards on the ground for a freshman.

In 2013, under Albin's watchful eye, Ohio's offensive attack averaged 379.4 yards per game and surpassed 400 yards of total offense in seven games during the 2013 campaign. The Bobcats closed the year with 4,932 yards of total offense.

The 2013 campaign also marked the final season of Ohio's most prolific offensive trio in school history as quarterback Tyler Tettleton, running back Beau Blankenship and wide Donte' Foster all concluded their respective collegiate careers.

Albin recruited all three players and all three players flourished in his offensive scheme. At the end of their respective careers, Tettleton, Blankenship and Foster accounted for over 25,000 yards of total offense and 128 touchdowns.

Tettleton finished his career at Ohio with 27 school records and once again passed for over 2,500 yards through the air. He is the only quarterback in school history to pass for over 2,500 yards in three consecutive seasons.

Blankenship closed his senior campaign with 910 yards rushing and five touchdowns. He finished his career fifth on the all-time rushing list with 2,976 yards.

Foster concluded his senior campaign with his best single-season of his career as he finished with 1,018 yards receiving and seven touchdowns. The Guthrie, Okla., native became just the second wide receiver in school history to surpass 1,000 yards receiving. He also finished his career with the most all-time touchdown receptions (21). Following the year, Foster was selected to the All-MAC Second Team.

In 2012, Albin's offensive unit that accounted for 5,782 yards. In fact, Ohio was one of just four teams in the Mid-American Conference to post 5,500-yards or more of total offense in 2012 (Northern Illinois, Ball State and Toledo). Ohio had seven games in which it surpassed 450 yards of total offense.

Albin's offensive unit played a major role in Ohio's 45-14 victory in the Advocare V100 Independence Bowl. In the win, the Bobcats' 556 yards of total offense served as an Independence Bowl record, while their 45 points tied the Bowl record. Following the game, Blankenship and Tettleton were named Co-Offensive Most Valuable Players of the Independence Bowl.

Ohio's 2012 offensive unit averaged over 30 points per game for the second straight season and the third time in the last six years. In addition, the Bobcats scored 40-or-more points in four different games.

The 2012 campaign also saw Blankenship rush for a single-season school record 1,604 yards and 15 touchdowns. He became the eighth running back in school history to rush for over 1,000 yards in a single season. Following the year, Blankenship was named All-MAC Second Team. Offensive lineman Skyler Allen and Eric Herman joined Blankenship on the All-MAC Second Team. Since taking over as offensive coordinator in 2005, Albin has coached 26 All-MAC players and All-Americans LaVon Brazill (2009) and Joe Flading (2011).

Tettleton once again posted a memorable season under Albin's direction as he passed for 2,844 yards and 18 touchdowns, while throwing just four interceptions in 12 games.

In April of 2013, Herman became the third offensive player to be selected in the NFL Draft over the last four years as he was drafted by the New York Giants in the seventh round.

In 2011, Albin's offensive scheme led to the most prolific year in school history. Ohio set eight team single-season offensive records, posting school standards for most yards gained (6,241), most passing yards gained (3,482), most offensive plays (1,026), average yards per game (445.8), passing attempts (429), most points scored (427), most passing completions (276) and most passing yards per game (248.7).

Under Albin's watchful eye, Tettleton re-wrote the Bobcats' single season record book in his first-year as a starting quarterback as he set 12 school standards, while becoming the first signal caller in program history to throw for over 3,000 yards. In addition, Tettleton accounted for 38 total touchdowns (28 passing and 10 rushing) and nearly 4,000 yards of total offense (3,960) en route to being named All-MAC Third Team.

The 2011 Ohio offensive unit also produced record-breaking performances from Brazill and Donte' Harden as the two combined to set eight single-season records. Brazill would go on to finish his career as the program's all-time leader for receiving yards (2,511) and receptions (189).

At the end of the year, a league-best six Bobcats were named to the MAC's All-League team on the offensive side of the ball.

In April of 2012, Brazill was selected in the sixth round of the NFL Draft by the Indianapolis Colts.

In 2010, Boo Jackson finished his career as Ohio's career leader in completion percentage (.604), pass efficiency (136.3), total offense per play (6.18), passing yards per attempt (7.7) and touchdown passes (38). He also finished the season responsible for 26 touchdowns, 48 in his career, which is fourth all-time, and with 18 passing touchdowns in 2010 (fourth all-time on the single-season list).

Ohio also had the best red zone efficiency among all MAC teams in 2010, converting 88.4 percent of its tries inside the 20-yard line. The Bobcats converted 38 times on 43 occasions, scoring 38 touchdowns and five field goals. Ohio was also outstanding at running the football, finishing second in the conference with 1,416 yards on the ground (177.0 per game average) for the 2010 season and 19 touchdowns.

In 2009, Albin's offense took aim at more of Ohio's all-time marks. Quarterback Theo Scott threw 20 touchdown passes, which stood as a school record until the 2011 season, while receiver Terrence McCrae tied Andrew Mooney's then single-season touchdown reception mark of nine.

The 2009 team also finished with passing yards (2,774), completions (228) and total offense (4,342) all of which rank among the program's top five all-time marks.

Albin mentored running back Calvin McRae who earned first-team All-MAC honors in 2005, 2006 and 2007. McRae is the first Bobcat in history to crack the 1,000-yard mark in three straight seasons. Under Albin's tutelage, McRae rushed for 4,398 yards and 45 touchdowns. McRae owns the second, fourth and sixth-highest single-season rushing totals in school history after setting the single-season rushing, touchdown and points scored records.

Albin spent the 2004 season as offensive coordinator and running backs coach at North Dakota State, helping the Bison to an 8-3 record and No. 25 national ranking in their first season at the Division I-AA level. NDSU finished the season averaging 378.5 yards of total offense, including 192.4 on the ground, and had four offensive players named first-team All-Great West Football Conference.

Albin served with Solich at Nebraska from 2000 to 2003. He started with the Cornhusker program as a graduate assistant, a position he held for three seasons before being promoted to running backs coach and passing game coordinator for the 2003 season. Working with the Nebraska tight ends as a graduate assistant, Albin helped Tracey Wistrom earn third-team All-America status in back-to-back seasons.

Prior to his stint at Nebraska, Albin was the head coach at Northwestern Oklahoma State for three seasons, winning the NAIA national championship in 1999 with a 13-0 record. He was named NAIA Football Coach of the Year by Rawlings and American Football Coach Magazine as the Rangers recorded their first undefeated season in history. Six of his players earned NAIA All-America honors. Albin's three squads improved every season going from 5-5 in 1997 to 7-3 in 1998.

Returning to his alma mater in 1994, Albin served as Northwestern Oklahoma State's offensive coordinator and head men's and women's cross country and track and field coach prior to his promotion to head coach of the football program.

He earned Oklahoma Intercollegiate Conference Coach of the Year honors twice for his work with the men's track program, leading them to back-to-back league titles. Albin got his start in coaching at Northeastern State (Okla.) in 1989 where he won two conference titles as an assistant football coach and two more as head of the men's track program.

As a player, Albin was a first-team All-Oklahoma Intercollegiate Conference selection as a wide receiver in each of his final three seasons as a member of the Northwestern Oklahoma State squad. He added to those honors by becoming the first Rangers' player to earn All-District IX status three times.

Albin received his bachelor's of science in business administration from Northwestern Oklahoma State in 1989 and a master's of science from Northeastern State in 1991. A native of Woodward, Okla., Albin was born on Sept. 13, 1965. He and his wife, Brooke, have two children - daughter Tori, and son Treyce.
