

BOBCAT HISTORY

Women's Inter-Collegiate Athletics

As a charter member of the Women's Sports and Recreation Department (WRA) of Ohio University, the women's basketball team first took to the court in 1965 under the direction of head coach Bev Smith.

According to the 1965 *Athena*, the WRA was created "to provide for and encourage the development of permanent interest in wholesome recreational activities" such as tennis, hockey, softball, basketball and golf. Contests were held between dormitories and sororities to determine champions.

It wasn't until the 1973-74 season that the program became part of the Women's Intercollegiate Athletics (WICA) organization and began to receive funding not from education, but from athletics, that women's basketball truly became its own entity at Ohio. But it wasn't without a fair amount of financial struggles early on.

In that first season, the Bobcats went 8-6 under head coach Judy Cole. At the time, nine sports in the WICA had to spread around a \$3,500 operating bud-

get and a \$13,500 budget for salaries. The 1972-73 women's basketball squad picked up wins against Cincinnati and the Ohio State branch at Newark while limiting opponents to 43.6 points per game compared to its average of 45.5 points.

The women enjoyed their second consecutive winning season the very next year with a 14-6 record and a third-

place finish at the state tournament thanks in part to the efforts of freshman Pat Lilienthall and junior Julie Cole. Cole averaged 16 points a game to lead the Bobcats as the team earned an at-large bid to the regional tournament.

The 1975-76 season was a sig-

nificant one in the history of the program because of Title IX, which gave the WICA a huge financial boost. Behind the new budget of \$48,000, the program was then able to grant athletic scholarships. Under new head coach Nancy Schaub, a young, inexperienced Ohio team suffered its first losing season with a 2-10 record.

Kathy Martin coached the team for one season (5-8) in 1977 before giving way to Gwen Hoover in 1978. The Bobcats went 10-8 during her first year and 16-29 over the next two seasons – the program's last years as a member of the WICA.

Head coach Becky DeStefano guided the first Ohio team as a member of the newly created Mid-American Conference in 1981. The Bobcats struggled early in their new conference with an eighth-place finish (9-16, 3-7) during the 1981-82 season before improving significantly by placing fourth (15-12, 11-7) and qualifying for the school's first trip to the MAC Tournament in 1982-83.

Leading the way that historic season





was a 5-foot-11, freshman from Coshocton named Caroline Mast, who would go on to become the school's all-time scoring leader, in addition to setting eight other career records, with 2,449 points during her four-year career. Mast was named to the Freshman All-American team.

The Bobcats improved on their fourth-place finish the following year with a 13-5 MAC record (14-13 overall) and a second-place finish behind Toledo in the conference. As a reward, Ohio hosted its first MAC Tournament game.

Again, it was Mast leading the way with 22.8 points and 11.3 rebounds per game. The sophomore also holds the distinction of being the first Bobcat to be named MAC Player of the Year. But she didn't do it alone.

Sophomore guard Marti Heckman, who remains the school's all-time assists leader with 810, led the MAC in assists (249) and free throw percentage (.806) that year and senior co-captain Jackie Bonus set what was then the all-time scoring mark at Ohio with 1,150 career points. Amy Prichard, a 23-year-old native of Lima, became the

Bobcats' seventh head coach the following year as the Bobcats sunk to their lowest finish in the MAC (seventh) in three years. But it was not an indication of things to come as Prichard and Ohio rebounded to produce perhaps the greatest season in the program's 37-year history.


The 1985-86 Bobcats went 24-2 during the regular season, including a 16-2 mark in the MAC, on route to their first ever MAC regular-season and tournament titles. Mast averaged 23.2 points and 8.8 rebounds a game during her final

season at Ohio while sophomore Kim Walton chipped in 10.5 points and 6.9 rebounds a contest. Junior guard Kathy Detillion added 10.4 points a game and Heckman averaged 7.75 assists as a senior.


The Bobcats defeated Central Michigan, 92-85, in the MAC tournament championship game before falling to Illinois in the NCAA Tournament. That Ohio team set 10 school records that still stand today. At the conclusion of the season, Prichard became the first Ohio head coach to win MAC Coach of the Year honors.

Marsha Reall replaced Prichard in 1990 to become the program's eighth head coach.

After back-to-back 7th-place finishes in the MAC during her first two seasons, Reall began to turn the program around in 1993. The Bobcats went 17-10 during the 93-94 season behind and finished second with a 13-5 mark in the MAC. For her efforts, Reall was named MAC Coach of the Year.

Holly Skeen, a junior center, averaged 15.8 points and 7.5 rebounds a game and was named second team All-MAC. But the best was yet to come for the young Ohio team.

The Bobcats won their second MAC championship the following year with the second-most wins

in the school's history (23). It was also the second straight MAC Coach of the Year award for Reall. Molly Sito, a junior forward from Edgerton, led the team with a 15.3 points per game average followed by Skeen's 14.1 points and 7.0 boards per contest.

Lynn Bria took over the helm for the Bobcats in 1999. The native of Charleston, W.Va., resigned in March 2006 after posting a 77-123 overall record.

Sylvia Crawley was named Head Coach in April 2006. Reigning MAC Freshman of the Year, Rachel Frederick highlights the talented Bobcat team. The Bobcats went 4-9 in The Convo last season, and with the addition of a new coaching staff they'll hope to improve on that record as they work toward "putting the pieces together."


