THE OPENING KICK

The Ohio football team (5-1, 2-0 MAC) is set take on the Northern Illinois Huskies (2-4, 1-1 MAC) this Saturday (Sept. 23) in DeKalb, Ill. Kickoff is set for 4 p.m. ET at Huskie Stadium. The game can be seen on ESPNU with Drew Carter and Dustin Fox on the call.

The Bobcats' matchup can also be heard on the Ohio Sports Network from Learfield. Russ Eisenstein returns for his 16th season as the "Voice of the Bobcats" and will be joined by Ohio alum Rob Cornelius, who has been a part of the broadcasts for two decades.

SERIES HISTORY VS. NIU

The Bobcats have a record of 24-11-14 against the Huskies, meeting for the first time in 1968.

Northern Illinois and Ohio last faced off on Oct. 22, 2022 on Frank Solich Field at Peden Stadium.

After the Bobcats took an early lead, NIU tied the game, 17-17, with a two-point conversion in the third quarter.

With seven minutes remaining in the game, a 22-yard receiving touchdown by Sam Wiglus followed by a

successful PAT gave the Bobcats a 24-17 lead. After four consecutive NIU incomplete passes, Ohio went into victory formation, solidifying their fourth home win of the season.

SCOUTING NIU

The Huskies are currently 2-4 on the season and 1-1 in MAC play, defeating Akron last week, 55-14. Saturday's matchup against the Bobcats marks their first home conference game of the season as well as Homecoming.

On the season, Northern Illinois averages 25.2 points on 164.7 rushing yards and 194.8 passing yards per game.

Individually, junior running back Antario Brown leads the team on the ground, netting 616 rushing yards on 93 carries. So far this season, he's recorded five rushing and one receiving touchdown.

In the air, redshirt senior quarterback Rocky Lombardi is 82-for-146, throwing five touchdowns and four interceptions in 1,015 yards over six games. Lombardi also has two rushing touchdowns on the season.

Rutkiewicz currently has a team-best 20 receptions and two touchdowns on 313 yards while redshirt junior wide receiver Trayvon Rudolph has one touchdown in 15 receptions.

Senior defensive end Raishein Thomas has 34 tackles, highlighted by 19 solo stops and four tackles for loss. Junior safety Nate Valcarcel leads the team in interceptions with two.

Redshirt sophomore kicker Kanon Woodill is currently 11-for-11 in PATs and 2-for-3 in field goals, with his longest clocking in at 49 yards.

LAST TIME OUT

The Ohio football team (5-1, 2-0 MAC) continued their winning streak on Frank Solich Field at Peden Stadium, defeating the Kent State Golden Flashes 42-17. This victory protected their undefeated record on Frank Solich Field and marked the first time the team kicked off MAC play 2-0 since 2016.

In the air, graduate student quarterback Kurtis Rourke went 20-for-32 with 300 passing yards and three touchdowns. On the ground, Rourke finished the day with one touchdown on 26 rushing yards.

Graduate student quarterback Parker Navarro finished the game with a team-best 65 rushing yards, highlighted by a 52-yard gain. Redshirt sophomore running back Sieh Bangura had another stellar Homecoming performance, scoring his first two rushing touchdowns of the season on nine carries.

Junior wide receiver Miles Cross finished the game with a season-best 125 yards and two touchdowns, making the most of his seven receptions. His performance earned him his first MAC East Offensive Player of the Week title. Graduate student wide receiver Sam

Wiglusz also scored, finishing the day with 4 yards on four receptions.

Defensively, graduate student linebacker Bryce Houston led the charge against the Falcons, recording a team-best 10 tackles and snagging the only interception of the day. Graduate student safety Walter Reynolds was right behind Houston, finishing with seven total tackles.

Freshman kicker Gianni Spetic went 6-for-6 in PATs, setting a personal record.

After a scoreless first quarter, Cross put the Bobcats on the board with a 25-yard passing touchdown. Kent State evened the score, but a 30-yard throw to Wiglusz and a four-yard rushing touchdown from Rourke gave Ohio a 14-point lead heading into halftime.

The Golden Flashes kicked off the third quarter with a 37-yard field goal, putting the score at 21-10. Cross's second touchdown of the day followed by Bangura's first rushing touchdown of the season extended Ohio's lead to 20 points.

Bangura wrapped up the Bobcats' scoring with 13:26 left in the game and Kent State scored their second and final touchdown the following drive, solidifying Ohio's 42-17 Homecoming victory.

SCOUTING OHIO

Currently, the Bobcats are 5-1 overall and 2-0 in MAC play. They average 24.50 points on 144.3 rushing yards and 203.67 passing yards per game.

In the air, quarterback Kurtis Rourke is 76-for-119, throwing eight touchdowns in 909 yards. He's also a threat on the ground and has net

Sam Wiglusz leads the receivers with 25 catches and two touchdowns in 248 yards. while Miles Cross has four touchdowns on 246 yards and 17 receptions. Tight end Will Kacmarek also has two touchdowns on the season.

On the ground, running back Sieh Bangura has 83 carries in 328 rushing yards, scoring his first two rushing touchdowns of the season against Kent State. Running back O'Shaan Allison has 239 yards on 78 carries with one touchdown.

Defensively, linebacker Bryce Houston leads the team, recording 59 tackles, 7.5 tackles for loss and two interceptions on the season. Linebacker Keye Thompson has 32 tackles and one fumble recovery, which he returned for a touchdown against Bowling Green. With eight different defenders snagging interceptions so far this season, the Bobcats are first in the MAC.

Freshman kicker Gianni Spetic has made six field goals off nine attempts, with his longest being 40 yards. He is currently 16-for-16 in PATs.

2-0 IN MAC PLAY FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2016

The last time Ohio opened MAC play 2-0, Athens hadn't met the Rourkes.

The 2016 Bobcats entered conference play 2-2, defeating Miami (Ohio) 17-7 for their first MAC victory of the season. The next week, they defeated Bowling Green, 30-24, not falling behind the Falcons once.

Eastern Michigan snapped their winning streak, taking the lead with 2:49 remaining in the third quarter and tacking on 14 more points in the fourth.

The 2016 squad made it to the MAC Championship, but were unable to catch Western Michigan, falling 29-23 in Detroit.

FIRST VOTES OF THE SEASON IN US LBM COACHES POLL

The US LBM Coaches Poll is conducted weekly throughout the regular season using a panel of 66 head coaches at Football Bowl Subdivision schools. The panel is chosen by random draw, conference by conference plus independents, from a pool of coaches who have indicated to the American Football Coaches Association their willingness to participate. Each coach submits a Top 25 with a first-place vote worth 25 points, second place 24, and so on down to one point for 25th.

As published by US Today on Oct. 1, the Ohio football team received two votes,

marking their first votes of the 2023 season. They received two votes in the Oct. 7 poll as well.

DOMINANT DEFENSE

With opponent offenses averaging just 235.7 yards per game, Ohio's defense is is No. 4 in FBS football.

They currently leads the MAC, allowing an average of only 11.8 points per game a and allowing the least rushing touchdowns (1) this season. Their league-best nine passes intercepted is fourth-best nationally, trailing Oklahoma, Liberty and Iowa State.

The Bobcats's defense was lights out in Boca Raton. As a team, they held the Owls to five rushing yards, averaging only 0.3 yards per attempt. The next week, they held Power 5 opponent Iowa State to just seven points, keeping them scoreless into the fourth quarter. Against Bowling Green, the defense held the Falcons to 206 yards, averaging only 3.8 yards per play.

During their Homecoming game, the Bobcats' defense held Kent State to 17 points on 228 yards of total offense.

Individually, graduate student linebacker Bryce Houston has recorded 59 total tackles. Averaging 9.8 tackles per game, Houston is currently fourth in the MAC and ranked 14th among FBS athletes.

MAC EAST DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Graduate student linebackers Bryce Houston and Keye Thompson have both earned MAC East Defensive Player of the Week honors this season.

Houston helped the defense hold the LIU Sharks, allowing one touchdown and one field goal in the Bobcats' 27-10 victory (Sept. 2). The graduate student linebacker led the team with 11 tackles, four of which were solo, while recorded a team-best two tackles for loss. Houston snagged one of two interceptions of the day and registered one of the team's three sacks.

Houston continued his strong 2023 season, leading the defense as they held the Iowa State Cyclones to seven points in the Bobcats' 10-7 victory over the Power 5 school at Frank Solich Field at Peden Stadium (Sept. 16). The linebacker finished the game with a team-best 15 tackles, matching his career record that he set against Buffalo in 2021. Of his 15 tackles, Houston recorded five solo stops.

Thompson played an integral part in Ohio's strong defensive performance against Bowling Green (Sept. 23), holding the Falcons to just seven points. The graduate



student finished the game with four tackles, half of which were solo stops, but more notably snagged one interception and one fumble recovery. After recovering the ball, Thompson ran 71 yards to score his first career touchdown and give the Bobcats a 21-point lead before the end of the first quarter.

MAC EAST OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Reigning MAC Freshman of the Year Sieh Bangura has already been named MAC East Offensive Player of the Week once junior wide receiver Miles Cross earned the title for the first time this season.

Ohio's first home game of the 2023 season marked their first win and Bangura's first game of the year passing 100 rushing yards. The redshirt sophomore running back net 107 yards on 19 carries, leading the Bobcats on the ground. His longest rush was 20 yards and he averaged 5.6 yards per attempt.

Cross blazed the trail during the Bobcats' Homecoming game against Kent State (Oct. 7), scoring two of their six touchdowns in the 42-17 victory. He led the receivers with a season-best 125 yards on seven receptions and was one of two Bobcats to score two touchdowns.

TIGHT END TDs

Redshirt sophomore tight end Will Kacmarek recorded his first collegiate touchdown last Saturday (Sept. 9), wrapping up an 11-play, 75-yard drive with a picture-perfect catch to cut FAU's lead to three points.

Kacmarek isn't the only Bobcat recording career-firsts. Redshirt sophomore tight end Bryce Butler and freshman tight end Mason Williams both scored for the first time as Bobcats during Ohio's 27-10 victory over LIU (Sept. 2).

O'SHAAN IN THE END ZONE

Running back O'Shaan Allison is back on the field after an injury early in 2022 Fall Camp sidelined him for the entire season.

Allison scored his first touchdown since 2019 against FAU (Sept. 9), giving the Bobcats their first lead of the game with a five-yard rushing touchdown in the third quarter.

ROURKE'S RETURN

After a season-ending injury in the Bobcats' 11th game of the 2022 season, Kurtis Rourke is set to return as Ohio's first-string quarterback.

In the air, Rourke went 244-for-353, throwing 25 touchdowns in 3,256 yards over 11 games. The he made program history against Fordham (Sept. 24), going for 527 yards

in the air, breaking a record that was set in 1983. He is also second in program history in passing yards in a season as well as passing touchdowns in a season.

Rourke's performance earned him numerous accolades, highlighted by being named the MAC Offensive Player of the Year, earning the Vern Smith Leadership Award and getting named the 2022 Cornish Trophy runner-up as well as earning First Team All-MAC honors. He was named one of the Manning Award "Stars of the Week" twice, was a Davey O'Brien Award semifinalist and was also named to the 2022 Phil Steele First Team Offense in addition to earning MAC Offensive Player of the Week three times. Off the field, he was named Academic All-MAC, 2022 Academic All-America® Second Team and earned MAC Scholar Athlete of the Week honors once.

So far this pre-season, Rourke has made four watch lists: Allstate Sugar Bowl Manning Award, Davey O'Brien, Maxwell Award and Walter Camp Player of the Year.

DEPTH IN THE RUNNING BACK ROOM

Rourke isn't the only Bobcat set to make an appearance in 2023. After getting hurt early in 2022 Fall Camp, running back O'Shaan Allison missed the entire 2022 season.

Allison hit the ground running in 2023 Fall Camp and has returned to the Bobcats' depth chart, now behind 2022 MAC Freshman of the Year Sieh Bangura.

NO. 1 CFL DRAFT PROSPECT

Graduate student quarterback Kurtis Rourke headlines the Fall Edition of the Canadian Football League (CFL) Scouting Bureau. The native of Oakville, Ont., sits in the No. 1 spot among prospects eligible for the 2024 CFL Draft.

The CFL Scouting Bureau, comprising CFL scouts, as well as player personnel directors and general managers from the league's nine clubs, annually releases its rankings in the fall, winter and, for a third and final time, in the spring ahead of the coming draft.

HOUSTON NOMINATED FOR WILLIAM V. CAMPBELL TROPHY

The National Football Foundation (NFF) and College Football Hall of Fame announced 2023 William V. Campbell nominees (Sept. 5). Representing Ohio is graduate student linebacker Bryce Houston.

The William V. Campbell Trophy is college football's premier scholar-athlete award that annually recognizes an individual as the absolute best in the nation for his combined academic success, football performance and exemplary leadership. Nominees must

be either a senior in his final year of playing eligibility or a graduated player enrolled in school at least three years, have a minimum 3.2 undergraduate GPA, be a starter or a significant contributor on the football field and show exemplary leadership on the field, in the classroom and within the community.

HOUSTON RECEIVES BOB JAMES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Ohio's Bryce Houston was one of two recipients of the 2023 Bob James Memorial Scholarship Award by the Mid-American Conference Faculty Athletics Representatives as announced by the league office today (Aug. 25).

Houston is the first Ohio football student-athlete to receive this award as well as the first Bobcat to be recognized with the Bob James award since 1994.

In its 35th year, the Bob James Memorial Scholarship Award recognizes one female and one male student who have achieved a minimum grade point average of 3.50 and have displayed good character, leadership and citizenship. The students are nominated during the year in which they complete their final season of eligibility. The \$5,000 post-graduate scholarship is awarded in honor of Bob James, the second commissioner in Mid-American Conference history (1964-71).

AYE AYE, CAPTAIN

The Ohio football team named five graduate student captains for the 2023 season — wide receiver Sam Wiglusz, linebacker Keye Thompson, quarterback Kurtis Rourke, linebacker Bryce Houston and defensive tackle Rodney Mathews.

Houston and Rourke are both entering their third season as captains, while Wiglusz, Thompson and Mathews are entering their first. In addition to the five captains, coaches will vote an additional captain every game based on "brickworthy" leadership. "Brickworthy" leaders are those who exhibit the program's core values.

CONTINUITY ON THE COACHING STAFF

With head coach Tim Albin at helm, all 11 coaches returned for the 2023 season.

Additionally, three were promoted. John Hauser is now the Defensive Passing Game Coordinator and Safeties Coach, Brian Metz is the Recruiting Coordinator and Tight Ends Coach and Brian Smith is now the Associate Head Coach, Passing Game Coordinator and Running Backs Coach.

UNDEFEATED ON THE FRANK

The Ohio University Board of Trustees agreed to name the football field in Peden Stadium to honor long-time Ohio head coach

The Bobcats opened the 2022 season against FAU on Frank Solich Field, snagging their first victory of the season and on the newly-named field. Ohio continued this streak, taking a 6-0 record when in Athens, Ohio and closing the regular season with a 38-14 victory over Bowling Green to clinch the MAC East title. This winning streak has continued into the 2023 season, with the Bobcats defeating LIU, Iowa State and Kent State at home, marking the first time Ohio is 2-0 in MAC play since 2016.

Solich owns a career coaching record of 173-101. His 173 overall wins rank as the fourth most among active NCAA FBS head coaches. He is the winningest head coach in Mid-American Conference history with 115 overall victories while his 77 conference-only wins rank second to former Central Michigan head coach Herb Deromedi's 90. His 16 years of service match Deromedi's (1978-93) for the most in MAC history. Ohio is 115-82 during the Solich era. His 115 victories are the second-most in program history behind Don Peden (121; 1924-46). Ohio has gone 77-46 in conference play since Solich's arrival in Athens in 2005.

Ohio has had a run of 12-straight non-losing seasons that has included 11 winning campaigns and six years with at least nine victories -- including a 10-win campaign in 2011. The 2012 season began with the Bobcats earning a signature win at Penn State, upsetting the Nittany Lions by a score of 24-14. Ohio captured division titles in 2006, 2009, 2011 and 2016. Solich led the Bobcats to 11 of their 13 bowl appearances and the first five bowl victories in program history, with back-to-back wins in the 2011 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl and '12 Independence Bowl and back-to-back-to-back victories in the 2017 Bahamas Bowl, '18 DXL Frisco Bowl and '20 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl (2019 season).

YEAR THREE FOR ALBIN

Tim Albin enters his third season as head coach in 2023 after serving as Ohio's offensive coordinator for 16 years under Frank Solich.

The 2022 football team finished the season as MAC East (7-1) and Arizona Bowl Champions with a 10-4 record, marking its first 10-win season since 2011 and the second-best turnaround in FBS football last year. The Bobcats were also undefeated at home, posting a 6-0 record on Frank Solich Field at Peden Stadium, and wrapped up the regular season with a seven-game winning streak.

This performance earned Albin MAC Coach of the Year honors, quarterback Kurtis Rourke MAC Offensive Player of the Year honors as well as the Vern Smith Leadership Award and running back Sieh Bangura MAC Freshman of the Year accolades.

Albin joined the Ohio Football coaching staff as offensive coordinator in 2005, reuniting with Frank Solich after four seasons together at Nebraska. The 2021 season will mark Albin's 17th year in Athens. Since his arrival in Athens, Albin has produced offensive units that have consistently ranked among the top of the Mid-American Conference. He also has directed an offensive attack that has practically rewritten all of Ohio's rushing, passing records, and scoring records. In the past 10 seasons, Albin's offensive units rank No. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 on the Ohio all-time Top-10 single season scoring list. The Bobcats 368 points in 2018 rank fourth on the all-time list.

Albin spent the 2004 season as offensive coordinator and running backs coach at North Dakota State, helping the Bison to an 8-3 record and No. 25 national ranking in their first season at the Division I-AA level. NDSU finished the season averaging 378.5 yards of total offense, including 192.4 on the ground, and had four offensive players named first-team All-Great West Football Conference. Albin served with Solich at Nebraska from 2000 to 2003. He started with the Cornhusker program as a graduate assistant, a position he held for three seasons before being promoted to running backs coach and passing game coordinator for the 2003 season. Prior to his stint at Nebraska, Albin was the head coach at Northwestern Oklahoma State for three seasons, winning the NAIA national championship in 1999 with a 13-0 record. He was named NAIA Football Coach of the Year by Rawlings and American Football Coach Magazine as the Rangers recorded their first undefeated season in history.

BOBCATS IN THE CFL

Three former Bobcats are currently active in the CFL. Defensive tackle **Casey Sayles** is with the Hamilton Tiger-Cats while running back **De'Montre Tuggle** plays for the Ottawa RedBlacks.

Running back **AJ Ouellette** plays for the Toronto Argonauts, who are the 109th Grey Cup Champions. Sayles, who was a member of the Winnipeg Blue Bombers at the time, competed in the same Grey Cup,

While with the BC Lions, **Nathan Rourke** was named Most Outstanding Canadian (Nov. 17, 2022). He is the first BC Lions' quarterback and the third quarterback in CFL history to earn the honor.

Ohio football alumnus **Chip Cox** is apart of the 2022 CFL Hall of Fame class, earning the honor in his first year of eligibility. Cox played 13 seasons for the Montreal Alouettes, wrapping up his career with the fourth highest total defensive tackles in CFL history (979).

BOBCATS IN THE NFL

Multiple former Ohio football student-athletes are representing the Bobcats at the highest level of the sport.

QB **Nathan Rourke** signed to the Jacksonville Jaguars' practice squad after playing in multiple preseason games.

After signing as an undrafted free agent in April 2022, former Ohio quarterback **Armani Rogers** made the Washington Commanders' 53-man roster as a tight end (Aug. 30, 2022).

OL **Austen Pleasants** was signed to the Los Angeles Chargers' practice squad on Nov. 9, 2022. He signed a reserve/futures contract in Jan. 2023. As of Aug. 30, he is on their practice squad.

Tim Albin was named the head football coach at Ohio on July 14, 2021.

The 2022 football team finished the season as MAC East (7-1) and Arizona Bowl Champions with a 10-4 record, marking its first 10-win season since 2011 and the second-best turnaround in FBS football last year. The Bobcats were also undefeated at home, posting a 6-0 record on Frank Solich Field at Peden Stadium, and wrapped up the regular season with a seven-game winning streak.

This performance earned Albin MAC Coach of the Year honors, quarterback Kurtis Rourke MAC Offensive Player of the Year honors as well as the Vern Smith Leadership Award and running back Sieh Bangura MAC Freshman of the Year accolades.

Since his arrival in Athens, Albin has produced offensive units that have consistently ranked among the top of the Mid-American Conference. He also has directed an offensive attack that has practically rewritten all of Ohio's rushing, passing records, and scoring records. In the past 10 seasons, Albin's offensive units rank No. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 on the Ohio all-time Top 10 single season scoring list. The Bobcats 368 points in 2016 rank fourth on the all-time list.

In 2016, the Bobcats had the most pass attempts (458) and second-most completions (250) in school history. The offense totaled 5,492 yards of total offense which is third all-time at Ohio. The Bobcats also compiled the second-most pass yards in school history (3,142) and the fourth most touchdown passes (22).

In 2015, the offense totaled 5,378 yards, which ranks third all-time in program history. The Bobcat quarterbacks passed for 3,026 yards, which ranks third all-time in program history as well.

In 2014, the offense totaled 4,443 yards of offense which ranked fifth all-time in program history. The combination of Derrius Vick and JD Sprague proved to be dynamic through the air as the quarterbacks combined to pass for 2,474 yards for the season which is sixth all-time in program history.

The Bobcat offense found a balanced attack with AJ Ouellette in the backfield. The freshman ran for 785 yards ranking him only behind Kareem Wilson for most yards on the ground for a freshman.

In 2013, under Albin's watchful eye, Ohio's offensive attack averaged 379.4 yards per game and surpassed 400 yards of total offense in seven games during the 2013 campaign. The Bobcats

closed the year with 4,932 yards of total offense. The 2013 campaign also marked the final season of Ohio's most prolific offensive trio in school history as quarterback Tyler Tettleton, running back Beau Blankenship and wide Donte' Foster all concluded their respective collegiate careers.

Albin recruited all three players and all three players flourished in his offensive scheme. At the end of their respective careers, Tettleton, Blankenship and Foster accounted for over 25,000 yards of total offense and 128 touchdowns.

Tettleton finished his career at Ohio with 27 school records and once again passed for over 2,500 yards through the air. He is the only quarterback in school history to pass for over 2,500 yards in three-consecutive seasons.

Blankenship closed his senior campaign with 910 yards rushing and five touchdowns. He finished his career fifth on the all-time rushing list with 2,976 yards.

Foster concluded his senior campaign with his best single-season of his career as he finished with 1,018 yards receiving and seven touchdowns. The Guthrie, Okla., native became just the second wide receiver in school history to surpass 1,000 yards receiving. He also finished his career with the most all-time touchdown receptions (21). Following the year, Foster was selected to the All-MAC Second Team.

In 2012, Albin's offensive unit that accounted for 5,782 yards. In fact, Ohio was one of just four teams in the Mid-American Conference to post 5,500-yards or more of total offense in 2012 (Northern Illinois, Ball State and Toledo). Ohio had seven games in which it surpassed 450 yards of total offense.

Albin's offensive unit played a major role in Ohio's 45-14 victory in the Advocare V100 Independence Bowl. In the win, the Bobcats' 556 yards of total offense served as an Independence Bowl record, while their 45 points tied the Bowl record. Following the game, Blankenship and Tettleton were named Co-Offensive Most Valuable Players of the Independence Bowl.

Ohio's 2012 offensive unit averaged over 30 points per game for the second straight season and the third time in the last six years. In addition, the Bobcats scored 40-or-more points in four different games.

The 2012 campaign also saw Blankenship rush for a single-season school record 1,604 yards and 15 touchdowns. He became the eighth running back in school history to rush for over 1,000 yards in a single season. Following the year, Blankenship was named All-MAC Second Team. Offensive lineman Skyler Allen and Eric Herman joined Blankenship on the All-MAC Second Team. Since taking over as offensive coordinator in 2005, Albin has coached 26 All-MAC players and All-Americans LaVon Brazill (2009) and Joe Flading (2011).

Tettleton once again posted a memorable season under Albin's direction as he passed for 2,844 yards and 18 touchdowns, while throwing just four interceptions in 12 games.



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In April of 2013, Herman became the third offensive player to be selected in the NFL Draft over the last four years as he was drafted by the New York Giants in the seventh round.

In 2011, Albin's offensive scheme led to the most prolific year in school history. Ohio set eight team single-season offensive records, posting school standards for most yards gained (6,241), most passing yards gained (3,482), most offensive plays (1,026), average yards per game (445.8), passing attempts (429), most points scored (427), most passing completions (276) and most passing yards per game (248.7).

Under Albin's watchful eye, Tettleton re-wrote the Bobcats' single season record book in his first-year as a starting quarterback as he set 12 school standards, while becoming the first signal caller in program history to throw for over 3,000 yards. In addition, Tettleton accounted for 38 total touchdowns (28 passing and 10 rushing) and nearly 4,000 yards of total offense (3,960) en route to being named All-MAC Third Team.

The 2011 Ohio offensive unit also produced record-breaking performances from Brazill and Donte' Harden as the two combined to set eight single-season records. Brazill would go on to finish his career as the program's all-time leader for receiving yards (2,511) and receptions (189).

At the end of the year, a league-best six Bobcats were named to the MAC's All-League team on the offensive side of the ball.

In April of 2012, Brazill was selected in the sixth round of the NFL Draft by the Indianapolis Colts.

In 2010, Boo Jackson finished his career as Ohio's career leader in completion percentage (.604), pass efficiency (136.3), total offense per play (6.18), passing yards per attempt (7.7) and touchdown passes (38). He also finished the season responsible for 26 touchdowns, 48 in his career, which is fourth all-time, and with 18 passing touchdowns in 2010 (fourth all-time on the single-season list).

Ohio also had the best red zone efficiency among all MAC teams in 2010, converting 88.4 percent of its tries inside the 20-yard line. The Bobcats converted 38 times on 43 occasions, scoring 38 touchdowns and five field goals. Ohio was also outstanding at running the football, finishing second in the conference with 1,416 yards on the ground (177.0 per game average) for the 2010 season and 19 touchdowns.

In 2009, Albin's offense took aim at more of Ohio's all-time marks. Quarterback Theo Scott threw 20 touchdown passes, which stood as a school record until the 2011 season, while receiver Terrence McCrae tied Andrew Mooney's then single-season touchdown reception mark of nine.

The 2009 team also finished with passing yards (2,774), completions (228) and total offense (4,342) all of which rank among the program's top five all-time marks.

Albin mentored running back Calvin McCrae who earned first-team All-MAC honors in 2005, 2006 and 2007. McCrae is the first Bobcat in history to crack the 1,000-yard mark in three straight sea-

sons. Under Albin's tutelage, McCrae rushed for 4,398 yards and 45 touchdowns. McCrae owns the second, fourth and sixth-highest single-season rushing totals in school history after setting the single-season rushing, touchdown and points scored records.

Albin spent the 2004 season as offensive coordinator and running backs coach at North Dakota State, helping the Bison to an 8-3 record and No. 25 national ranking in their first season at the Division I-AA level. NDSU finished the season averaging 378.5 yards of total offense, including 192.4 on the ground, and had four offensive players named first-team All-Great West Football Conference.

Albin served with Solich at Nebraska from 2000 to 2003. He started with the Cornhusker program as a graduate assistant, a position he held for three seasons before being promoted to running backs coach and passing game coordinator for the 2003 season. Working with the Nebraska tight ends as a graduate assistant, Albin helped Tracey Wistrom earn third-team All-America status in back-to-back seasons.

Prior to his stint at Nebraska, Albin was the head coach at Northwestern Oklahoma State for three seasons, winning the NAIA national championship in 1999 with a 13-0 record. He was named NAIA Football Coach of the Year by Rawlings and American Football Coach Magazine as the Rangers recorded their first undefeated season in history. Six of his players earned NAIA All-America honors. Albin's three squads improved every season going from 5-5 in 1997 to 7-3 in 1998.

Returning to his alma mater in 1994, Albin served as Northwestern Oklahoma State's offensive coordinator and head men's and women's cross country and track and field coach prior to his promotion to head coach of the football program.

He earned Oklahoma Intercollegiate Conference Coach of the Year honors twice for his work with the men's track program, leading them to back-to-back league titles. Albin got his start in coaching at Northeastern State (Okla.) in 1989 where he won two conference titles as an assistant football coach and two more as head of the men's track program.

As a player, Albin was a first-team All-Oklahoma Intercollegiate Conference selection as a wide receiver in each of his final three seasons as a member of the Northwestern Oklahoma State squad. He added to those honors by becoming the first Rangers' player to earn All-District IX status three times.

Albin received His bachelor's of science in business administration from Northwestern Oklahoma State in 1989 and a master's of science from Northeastern State in 1991. A native of Woodward, Okla., Albin was born on Sept. 13, 1965. He and his wife, Brooke, have two children - daughter Tori, and son Treyce.
