2023-2024 SEASON

The Bobcats concluded the 2022-23 reason with an 11-19 overall record in 8-10 in conference competition. The team was victorious during game one of the battle of the brick as they took down the Miami Redhawks, 71-55. The Bobcats also earned non-conference wins over Dayton (67-61), IUPUI (75-71) and Indiana State (65-62). Ohio achieved a 2.7 turnover margin and forced its opponents to give up an average of 21.3 turnovers per game. The Bobcats averaged 11 steals per game in comparison to their opponents' nine steals per game. At the end of the season, Ohio ranked first in the conference for steals per game and second for total steals. At the end of the season, Bailey Tabeling ranked third in the MAC for 3PT FG%, sixth for total 3PT FG's, third for 3PT FG's per game, seventh for steals per game and 10th for total steals. Kennedi Watkins ranked 16th in the MAC for points per game, 12th for FT% and 16th for steals. Monica Williams ranked 13th in the MAC for FT%, 15th for steals, 17th for assists and assists per game.

SCOUTING BALL STATE

Ball State has a 16-4 overall and 8-0 conference record heading into its matchup at Ohio.

The Cardinals average 75.2 PPG; shooting 45.7 percent from the field, 29.6 percent from the arc and 72.8 percent from the line. The team averages 37.6 rebounds, 16.3 assists and 10.4 steals per game. Ball State has forced 19.1 turnovers per game and averages 20.7 points off turnovers.

Ball State's opponents average 60.5 PPG; shooting 38.2 percent from the field, 29.5 percent from the arc and 75.7 percent from the line. Opponents average 33.7 rebounds, 11.9 assists and 6.9 steals per game. Opponents have forced Ball State to give up 14.8 turnovers per game and average 13.4 points off turnovers.

Ally Becki leads the team in scoring with a total of 293 points, has a team-high 117 assists and 45 steals. Marie Kiefer ranks first on the team for rebounds (125) and blocks (32).

SCOUTING OHIO

Ohio has a 4-14 overall and 2-6 conference record heading into its matchup with Ball State.

The Bobcats average 59.0 PPG; shooting 37.4 percent from the field, 28.3 percent from the arc and 67.4 percent from the line. The team averages 32 rebounds, 10.9 assists and 8.1 steals per game. Ohio has forced 16.3 turnovers per game and averages 11.9 points off turnovers.

Ohio's opponents average 72.9 PPG; shooting 41.7 percent from the field, 30.3 percent from the arc and 71.7 percent from the line. Opponents average 42.7 rebounds, 16.9 assists and 9.6 steals per game. Opponents have forced Ohio to give up 18.8 turnovers per game and average 19.3 points off turnovers.

Kennedi Watkins leads the team in scoring with a total of 255 points. Bailey Tabeling ranks first on the team for rebounds (86), assists (49) and steals (37). Kate Dennis has a team-high 11 blocks.

ALL TIME VS BALL STATE

The Bobcats lead the Cardinals in their all-time series, 39-34.

LAST TIME VS BALL STATE

The Bobcats and the Cardinals last met during the 2023-24 season. In the teams' last meeting, Ball State earned a 77-53 win over Ohio.

LAST TIME OUT

The Ohio women's basketball team (4-14, 2-6 MAC) earned a 69-59 victory over Eastern Michigan (1-17, 0-8 MAC) on Saturday, Jan. 25.

The game served as Ohio's Turn It Gold event in support of childhood cancer awareness. "We got the chance to play for something bigger than ourselves, and our players did a great job of that today," head coach Bob Boldon said.

This victory also celebrated Coach Boldon's 200th win at Ohio. "I'm happy that we won and will be grateful looking back on this moment," Boldon said. "I have a lot of kindhearted and selfless staff, and we all work hard to make our players succeed."

Senior Kennedi Watkins (Ballwin, Mo.) was recognized before the game for reaching the 1,000-point career milestone in Ohio's previous contest against Buffalo.

Sophomore Bailey Tabeling (Seymour, Ind.) recorded her first career double-double with a team-high 21 points and career-best 10 rebounds. Tabeling finished 7-of-14 from the field, 3-of-9 from beyond the arc, and 4-of-8 from the free-throw line. Tabeling also tallied a team-high four steals and three assists.

Madelyn Bischoff, Ball State (Sr.) Sammi Mikonowicz, Toledo (Gr.) Watkins contributed 15 points, with 5 field goals, 2 three-pointers, and 3 free throws. Graduate student Anyssa Jones (Westerville, Ohio) added 12 points and three rebounds.

Eastern Michigan led for most of the first half before Ohio tied the game. The Bobcats surged ahead with a three pointer from graduate student Aliah McWhorter (Cincinnati, Ohio) in the second quarter. Ohio then extended its lead as Tabeling hit two free throws and a three-pointer, sending the Bobcats to a 35-25 advantage at halftime.

In the third quarter, Ohio's lead grew to 42-25 after a three-pointer from senior Kate Dennis (Rockford, III.). A layup by Jones cut the lead to 46-36, but Tabeling answered with a steal and another three-pointer to push Ohio's lead back to 11 points.

The Bobcats continued to build their lead in the fourth quarter, with a layup from Watkins keeping Ohio ahead, 61-50. Watkins added a twist layup and a three-pointer to seal the victory.

Ohio finished the game with 31 total rebounds, 14 assists, and 11 steals, while Eastern Michigan had 37 rebounds, 16 assists, and 7 steals.

"We continue to work harder and aren't willing to give up. Being able to see our work pay off feels great," Jones said.

THE WATKINS WAY

Senior Kennedi Watkins has a been an important presence on the court for Ohio this season. Through 16 games, Watkins is averaging 15.9 points and 4.7 rebounds per game. The senior is currently shooting 48.1 percent from the field and 33.9 percent from the arc. This season, Watkins has recorded six 20-point games and has led the team in scoring eight times this season. She also recorded her first double-double as a Bobcats with 20 points and 10 rebounds at Wright State (12/24).

Watkins ranks first on the team for scoring with a total of 240 points. The senior reached the 1,000 career points milestone at Buffalo (1/22).

A NEW ROLE FOR BAILEY TABELING

After finishing her freshman season as one of the top 25 three-point shooters in the NCAA, sophomore Bailey Tabeling's role on the team has shifted to a point guard and playmaker this season.

Tabeling has started and played in every game this season, compiling a teamhigh 568 minutes played. The sophomore currently ranks first on the team for rebounds, assists and steals. Tabeling also ranks second on the team for points. Tabeling tallied a new career-high 28 points in the team's first conference win of the season at Northern Illinois (1/4). The sophomore recorded her first career double-double with 21 points and 10 rebounds versus Eastern Michigan (1/25).

DEPENDABLE KATE DENNIS

Senior Kate Dennis has been a consistent leader for the Bobcats on and off the court. Dennis has started and played in all 18 games this season, averaging 26.2 minutes per game. Dennis recorded her 100th career game at Ohio at Western Michigan (1/8).

The senior has recorded six double-figure point games so far this season and has only tallied eight turnovers, averaging less than one turnover per game. Dennis ranks first on the team for blocks, second for minutes played and third for points.

LAST SEASON'S STANDOUTS

Among Ohio's returning players, several were standouts for the Bobcats during the 2023-24 season. Three Bobcats were recognized with 2023-24 MAC Postseason Honors for their impactful performances on the court last season.

Despite several inuries, junior *Jaya McClure* concluded her sophomore season as one of the Ohio's top performers. The All-MAC Honorable Mention made 21 appearances with 16 starts, ranked first on the team for assists (75), second for points (278) and recorded 35 steals. Throughout the season, McClure tallied a career-high 26 points, 11 FGM, nine assists, seven rebounds and seven FTM. Senior *Kennedi Watkins* made an immediate impact for the Bobcats in her first season at Ohio. Along with McClure, Watkins was named an All-MAC Honorable Mention. She made 26 appearances with 21 starts, ranked first on the team in points (288), blocks (12), averaged 11.1 PPG, grabbed 98 rebounds and ranked eighth in the MAC for steals with 40 total. Watkins recorded a career-high 26 points, five blocks, 10 FGM and seven rebounds.

Sophomore *Bailey Tabeling* ended her debut season at Ohio as one of the top three-point shooters in MAC and NCAA. She was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team after ranking third on the team for points (260), second for steals (48), grabbing 75 rebounds and recording 32 assists. Tabeling ranked third in the MAC for three-point percentage, fourth for 3FGs per game and seventh for steals. The sophomore also ranked 24th in the NCAA for three-point percentage at the end of the season.

VETERAN BOBCATS

The Ohio women's basketball team has nine players returning for the 2024-25 season including the previously named standouts; *Jaya McClure (Jr.), Kennedi Watkins (Sr.)* and *Bailey Tabeling (So.)*.

Guards *Kate Dennis (Sr.)* and *Monica Williams (So.)* were important contributors for the team and consistently part of Ohio's starting lineup last season. Both

Bobcats started and played in all 30 games during the 2024-25 season. Dennis played 697 minutes across 30 games. She finished the 2022-23 season with 183 points, 57 rebounds, eight assists, eight blocks and 17 steals. Dennis ranked second in three-pointers (47), 3PT % (.343), blocks and first for FT%. The senior averaged less than one turnover per game with 21 total last season. Dennis recorded multiple career bests last season including 14 points versus Kent State (2/21/24), four steals versus IUPUI (11/26/23) and four blocks at App State (11/11/23).

Williams played a team-high 788 minutes, averaging 26.3 minutes per game across 30 games. In her debut season with Ohio, she recorded 247 points, 68 assists, 101 rebounds, 42 steals and seven blocks. Williams ranked second on the team for assists, third for steals, blocks and fifth for blocks. The sophomore netted a season-high 15 points at Kent State (1/6/24), recorded a season-high eight rebounds versus Eastern Michigan (1/20/24), a season-high five assists & seven steals versus Central Michigan (3/2/24) and three blocks versus Kent State (2/21/24).

Coming off the bench last season, *Asiah Baxter (So.)* played 73 minutes across 12 games as a guard for Ohio. Baxters netted 13 points and shot 41.7 percent from the field. She also totaled 10 rebounds and two assists. Baxter played a season-high 21 minutes at Ball State (2/3/24)

Cassidy Lafler (Jr.), Emma Barnett (So.) and Aja Austin (Sr.) are Ohio's three returning forwards. All three Bobcats missed a large portion or the entirety of the 2023-24 season due to injuries.

Cashell received the Sharon Huesman Memorial and OCC Byron Prushing scholarships.

Anyssa Jones (Graduate Student; Westerville, Ohio): Prior to Ohio, Jones started her collegiate career at Ohio State before transferring to Dayton and playing for the Flyers for two seasons. At Dayton, the 5-10 guard appeared in 59 games, made 43 starts and averaged 27.8 minutes per game. In two seasons with the Flyers, she amassed a total of 541 points, 288 rebounds,



52 assists and 55 steals in her two seasons with the Flyers. At Ohio State, Jones appeared in 15 games, was two-time Scholar-Athlete Award recipient and earned 2021-22 Academic All-Conference honors.

Madison Lim (Redshirt Freshman; Marysville, Ohio): A 5-10 guard, Lim was a four-year letterwinner for basketball at Mechanicsburg High School where she served as team captain. She was a recipient of the 2022-23 Scholar-Athlete Award. She helped her team to two conference championship titles and a birth to the 2023 District Semifinals. Lim started in all 25 games during senior season.

Aliah McWhorter (Graduate Student; Cincinnati, Ohio): A 6-1 guard, McWhorter enters her first year with the Bobcats spending four seasons playing at Wake Forest. She did not see action for two seasons due to injury. In total, McWhorter played in 19 games and made for start for the Demon Deacons. During the 2023-24 season, McWhorter appeared in 14 games, made one start versus North Carolina (2/18) and tallied 45 total minutes on the court.

Olivia Rinard (Freshman; Williamstown, W. Va.): A 5-5 guard, Rinard was a four-year letterwinner for basketball and soccer in high school. Rinard attended Williamstown High School for two years before transferring to Marietta High School for her junior and senior years. During her freshman season, Rinard's team competed at the West Virginia State Final Four.

Danni Scully (Freshman; Park Ridge, Ill.): A 6-1 forward, Scully was a four-year letterwinner for basketball at Nazareth Academy. She was a team captain, two-time All-Conference, a Montini Christmas First Team All-Tournament selection and named an All-State Honorable Mention. In 2023, Scully received the MVP Award in the state semi-final game. Scully helped her team to a 2022 State Runner Up finish and a 2023 State Championship title.

2024-25 MAC PRESEASON POLL

The Ohio women's basketball team was selected to finish sixth, tied with NIU, in the 2024-25 MAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, as announced by the league on Tuesday, Oct. 22. Ohio earned 64 points and was chosen to finish above Miami (OH) (44), Akron (43), Western Michigan (34), Eastern Michigan (23) and Central Michigan (20). Ball State (120) was selected to finish first in the conference with 10 first-place votes. Kent State (104) also received two first-place votes and was chosen to finish second in the conference. Ball State (8) was also selected to win the 2025 MAC Tournament, followed by Bowling Green (1), Buffalo (1), Kent State (1) and Toledo (1).

2024-25 PRESEASON ALL-MAC

Junior guard Jaya McClure was selected to the Preseason All-MAC Second Team, as announced by the league on Tuesday, Oct. 22. Last season, McClure was named an All-MAC Honorable Mention after appearing in 22 games and making 17 starts. McClure concluded the season with 278 points, 12.6 PPG, 75 assists, 35 steals and 56 rebounds. McClure ranked first on the team for assists and second for points.

After being named head coach on March 28, 2013, Bob Boldon has become the winningest coach in program history, reaching the 100-win mark faster than any women's basketball coach at Ohio. The 2015 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year, Boldon has coached two MAC Freshman of the Year winners, three MAC Defensive Player of the Year winners, one MAC Sixth Player of the Year winner and 17 players on the All-MAC first, second or third team. Boldon broke the program's win record during the 2018-19 season with a win at Miami. Boldon and his teams have taken down seven "Power Five" teams during his time in Athens.

Prior to being named the Bobcats' head coach, Boldon served as the head coach at Youngstown State. There, he inherited a team coming off an 0-30 record. In his third and final season at YSU, Boldon led the Penguins to a 23-win season and first round victory in the WNIT.

Boldon's players have rewritten the Ohio and MAC record book. Kiyanna Black (2012-16) holds the MAC and Ohio record for threes made in a season (126) and is second in the MAC and first in Ohio for threes made in a career at 329. Six of Ohio's top ten three-point field goal makers played under Boldon. Cece Hooks set the career steals record and also sits atop the single-season steals list with 110 in 2018-19.

Boldon's teams are some of the highest-scoring teams in program and MAC history. The 2014-15 Bobcats made a program-high 296 three-pointers, the second-most in MAC history. The highest-scoring team in program history (2,746) came under Boldon in 2018-19, while three of the top-five highest-scoring seasons in program history happened under Boldon.

In 2022-23, Boldon coached the MAC leading scorer Yaya Felder to a All-MAC Second Team season. Felder was one short of the all-time single game scoring record after posting 40 points against Central Michigan. Jaya McClure earned MAC All-Freshman Team honors, and Ohio added three to the Academic All-MAC team.

2021-22 saw Ohio make the WNIT and Cece Hooks win another MAC Defensive Player of the Year award. Hooks was on All-MAC First Team, and was joined by Erica Johnson (Third Team) and Gabby Burris (Honorable Mention). Hooks signed with the Minnesota Lynx of the WNBA after the conclusion of the season.

In 2020-21, Boldon coached Cece Hooks to an Honorable Mention All-America honor, Ohio's first since 1986 when Caroline Mast was named the same. Hooks added the All-America honors to an already impressive list of awards. Hooks was named Mid-American Conference Player of the Year, MAC Defensive Player of the Year, First-Team All-MAC and MAC All-Defensive Team. Hooks finished the year ranked third in the nation in points per game and was just the second player in school history to record a triple-double after scoring 31 points, 11 assists and 10 steals against Miami. Ohio made the WNIT in 2020-21 and won one game in the tournament when they took down Fordham, 81-64. The Bobcats finished the season 15-10.

The 2019-20 season saw Boldon's Bobcats put three on the All-MAC

team in Cece Hooks, Erica Johnson and Amani Burke. Hooks and Johnson were First-Team All-MAC, while Hooks won MAC Defensive Player of the Year for the second-consecutive season after becoming the all-time steals leader in OU history as a junior. Ohio finished the season with a win in the MAC Tournament Semifinals before the tournament and season were canceled due to the COVID-19 crisis. In non-conference play, Ohio took down Ohio State, 74-68, for the first time in program history on the road in Columbus. Ohio's team became the first in program history to have four 1,000-point scorers on one team (Erica Johnson, Cece Hooks, Amani Burke, Gabby Burris) when Erica Johnson scored her 1,000th point in the MAC semifinals win over Western Michigan.

Boldon led the Bobcats to a historic season in 2018-19, becoming the first head coach to win 30 games in one season at Ohio University in either the women's or men's program. The 30 win total has only been reached four times by a MAC team. Boldon guided his team to the Round of Eight in the Women's National Invitation Tournament, the farthest Ohio has ever reached in a postseason tournament. Ohio rewrote the record book in 2018-19, scoring more points (2,746), making more field goals (980) and making more threes (341) than any other team in program history. Ohio's Erica Johnson won Mid-American Conference Sixth Player and Freshman of the Year, while Cece Hooks - who broke the single-season steals record (112) - won MAC Defensive Player of the Year. Hooks ended up making first-team All-MAC, while Johnson and Amani Burke were placed on the third team.

In 2017-18, Cece Hooks won MAC Freshman of the Year as Ohio advanced to the MAC Quarterfinals. The Bobcats placed four on the Academic All-MAC team and picked up a road win against Purdue on the road in West Lafavette.

Ohio followed their 26-win season in 2015-16 with a 22-10 season and a trip to the WNIT in 2016-17. Ohio had a Big Ten win over Illinois, 80-68 in non-conference play. Boldon placed one player – Quiera Lampkins – on the All-MAC Second Team while Jasmine Weatherspoon made the All-MAC Defensive Team. Four players landed on the Academic All-MAC team.

Boldon and the Bobcats had their third 26-win season in program history in 2015-16 and their second MAC regular-season title. The team saw its fourth postseason appearance in program history, where the Bobcats took down Marshall and Virginia Tech to advance to the third round of the WNIT. In the 2015-16 season, junior guard Quiera Lampkins was named the 2016 Mid-American Conference Defensive Player of the Year and earned a spot on the All-MAC Second Team and the All-Defensive Team. Senior guard Kiyanna Black was named to the All-MAC First Team for the second-consecutive season. Senior forward Lexie Baldwin was named All-MAC Honorable Mention and junior forward Jasmine Weatherspoon was also named to the All-Defensive

Boldon and the Bobcats set a then-program record for most wins (27) in a season in 2014-15. Boldon led the `Cats to a MAC Regular Season and Tournament Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament, Ohio's first since 1995. Boldon was named MAC Coach



of the Year after winning both the regular season and MAC Tournament title, when they defeated Eastern Michigan, 60-44. Ohio's 2014-15 team had the second-highest winning percentage in program history and was the fourth-highest scoring team in program history (2,233). Kiyanna Black earned First-team All-MAC honors after averaging 16 points per game and four rebounds per game. Quiera Lampkins also found herself on the All-MAC squad earning third-team honors averaging 12.5 points per game along with 6.7 rebounds per contest. Mariah Byard was also earned All-MAC honorable mention posting 9.7 points per game. Byard and Sophomore guard Yamonie Jenkins garnered Academic All-MAC honors as well.

The 2013-14 season brought the implementation of Boldon's motion offense, and Boldon grabbed his first win of his Ohio Career with a 94-88 win in over Xavier inside the Convocation Center.

Ohio University Director of Athletics Jim Schaus named Boldon as the 10th head coach in program history on March 28, 2013.

Boldon came to Athens after spending the previous three years of his head coaching career at Youngstown State. The Northeast Ohio native inherited a program that had posted an 0-30 record during the 2009-10 season and turned it into a Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT) participant at the end of the 2012-13 season, posting two double-digit win seasons and one 23-win campaign along the way. Youngstown State's 2012-13 season was arguably the program's best in 15 years and included a first-round victory in the WNIT. Boldon led the Penguins to a 23-10 mark (11-5 Horizon) en route to earning Horizon League Coach of the Year honors.

Boldon came to Youngstown with an outstanding resume as a player and an impressive track record as a collegiate coach. Prior to his time in Youngstown, Boldon spent three successful seasons as a collegiate head coach and 10 years as a college assistant. Five of those 10 years were at the Division I level, including two seasons at Akron. Two of the coaches he worked with - Jerry Scheve and Karl Smesko - have been voted national coaches of the year.

In his head coaching stint prior to YSU, Boldon orchestrated the best season in school history at Lambuth University, an NAIA school located in Jackson, Tenn. He led the Eagles in 2008-09 to school bests with 29 wins, a final No. 3 national ranking and a .853 winning percentage. Lambuth was the runner-up for the national title, and Boldon was recognized as the Association of Independent Institutions Coach of the Year after the regular season and A.I.I. Tournament.

At the University of Arkansas at Monticello, Boldon showed he can rebuild a program as he helped lead a major improvement for the Division II Cotton Blossoms in the Gulf South Conference. He inherited a team that went 1-15 in GSC play the year prior to his arrival, and he immediately brought them up to an 8-8 mark, which was the school's best conference record in five years. In his two seasons at UAM, the Cotton Blossoms finished third in the GSC each year, made consecutive conference tournament appearances and earned the school's first conference tournament victory since 1998.

Boldon spent four seasons with Smesko, the current head women's basketball coach at Florida Gulf Coast University, and five at Akron. Boldon and Smesko teamed up for a combined record of 85-34 over four seasons, which includes one year at FGCU, two years at IPFW and another at Walsh.

In 2009-10, FGCU went 24-7 and earned an invitation to compete in the WNIT. The Eagles were 17-3 in the Atlantic Sun and went a perfect 14-0 in home contests. Boldon and Smesko were part of a massive rebuilding project at IPFW as the Mastodons competed at the Division II level. IPFW was 2-24 the season before Boldon arrived on campus, and the Mastadons went 13-14 and 19-8 in the two years he was on the bench. Boldon and Smesko first worked together in 1997-98 at Boldon's alma mater, Walsh. The Cavaliers won the NAIA Division II National Championship that season behind a 29-5 record, and Smesko was recognized as the national coach of the year with Boldon's assistance. That Walsh team was part of the 2012 Ohio Basketball Hall of Fame induction class.

At Akron, Boldon was the top assistant coach for the Zips for two seasons from 2006-08. There, he helped lay the foundation for Akron to be competitive again in the MAC. The Zips had won eight games combined in the two years before Boldon and head coach Jodi Kest arrived on campus, and they won 10 games in the first season with Boldon on board. With some of Boldon's recruits, Akron went 18-14 in 2009-10 and advanced to the MAC Tournament semifinals. Boldon also spent two seasons with Kest at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi from 2002-04, leading the Islanders to a combined 34-21 record as a Division I Independent. Boldon and Kest first worked together at Gannon in 2001-02 when the Lady Knights

went 20-8 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

Boldon was an assistant at Wilmington College with Jerry Scheve in 1998-99, helping to lead the Quakers to a 20-4 record and regular season and tournament titles.

Boldon, a native of Louisville, Ohio, graduated from Walsh in 1997 with a bachelor's degree in elementary education. As a student-athlete, he was a two-time All-America selection as a point guard and helped lead the Cavaliers to the Final Four of the NAIA Tournament. A four-year starter, he remains the school record holder in assists (775) while also ranking fourth in scoring with 1,694 points. Boldon was a 2008 inductee to Walsh's Wall of Fame, and his accomplishments were celebrated as one of the program's top 50 players in its 50-year history in 2012. He earned his master's degree in liberal studies from Indiana in 2003.

Boldon resides in Athens with his wife, Rebecca. Boldon has four sons, Andrew, Tyler, Luke and Zach.
