### THE OPENING KICK

The Ohio football team is set to open the 2025 season when it takes on Rutgers on Thursday, Aug. 28, at SHI Stadium. Kickoff is set for 6 p.m. ET and can be seen on the Big Ten Network with Jason Horowitz, Brock Vereen and Caroline Hendershot on the call.

The Bobcats' matchup can also be heard on the Ohio Sports Network from Learfield, presented by Holzer Health System. Veteran Ohio radio personality Marty Bannister is reprising his role as Ohio's play-by-play broadcaster. Bannister will be joined by color analyst Rob Cornelius, who has been a part of the broadcasts for more than two decades.

### SERIES HISTORY VS. RUTGERS

The Bobcats and the Scarlet Knights have met three times: 1937, 2006 and 2011. Under

Don Peden, Ohio snagged a 13-0 win but fell short twice with Frank Solich at the helm.

The teams' last matchup featured multiple record-setting Bobcats, with two of the top three single-season receivers—No. 2 La'Von Brazill and No. 3 Donte' Foster—and highly decorated quarterback Tyler Tettleton leading the charge. Tettleton holds the single-season and career passing records for yards, attempts, completions and touchdowns.

### SCOUTING RUTGERS

Head Coach Greg Schiano enters his 17<sup>th</sup> season with the Scarlet Knights where he has amassed a program record 94 wins. In 2024 with Rutgers, Schiano led his team to a second consecutive bowl appearance for the first time since 2009.

Senior quarterback Athan Kaliakmanis enters his second season with Rutgers after recording 13 starts in his last season. In 2024 with the Scarlet Knights, Kaliakmanis recorded 2,696 passing yards with 18 touchdowns and seven interceptions. In 2024, Kaliakmanis was the only quarterback in the Big 10 to attempt every passing attempt for his respective team.

On the defensive end, Rutgers returns one of its 2024 sack leaders in Jordan Walker, who had four sacks and seven tackles for a loss last season. The defense also returns leading tackler Dariel Djabome who was voted Third Team All-Big 10 at the conclusion of the 2024 season. Djabome was also honored as a Second Team All-Big 10 selection by Phill Steele magazine for 2025.

Among other notable players for the Scarlet Knights are four other Phil Steele Preseason All-Big-10 selections in offensive lineman Kwabena Asamoah (fourth team), running back CJ Campbell Jr. (fourth team), wide receiver DT Sheffield (fourth team) and defensive lineman Eric Oneil (Fourth Team).

In 2024 Rutgers completed its season 7-6 after a 44-41 bowl game loss to Kansas State in the Rate Bowl.

## THE 11<sup>TH</sup> WIN

The Ohio football program wrapped up its 2024 season at the StaffDNA Cure Bowl with a historic 30-27 victory over the Jacksonville State Gamecocks at Camping World Stadium Friday afternoon (Dec. 20). Graduate student quarterback **Parker Navarro's** standout performance earned him game MVP accolades.

This win marked Ohio's first time in program history recording an 11-win season as well as the program's sixth-straight bowl victory, becoming the first Mid-American Conference program to win six-straight bowl games.

The win also marked head coach **Brian Smith's** first win at the helm of the Bobcats.

The offense saw multiple individual

records set, led by graduate student wide receiver **Coleman Owen** becoming the Bobcats' all-time single season receiving yards leader (1,216). Additionally, Navarro became the second quarterback in program history to log over 1,000 rushing yards in a single season (1,054), an accomplishment an Ohio quarterback hasn't claimed since Kareem Wilson (1996, 1,072 yds). Notably, he is the second Bobcat to run for over 1,000 yards this season, joining graduate student running back **Anthony Tyus III**, and he is the first quarterback in program history to record over 2,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards in the same season.

Navarro finished the game 19-for-28 with one touchdown on 227 yards in the air. On the ground, Navarro logged all three of the Bobcats' rushing touchdowns on 15 carries and 119 yards. Navarro's four total touchdowns tied a Cure Bowl record for touchdowns in a game. Tyus led the rushers with 123 yards on 26 touches. He also snagged Ohio's lone receiving touchdown of the game, logging three receptions on 34 yards.

In the air, Owen finished the game with 11 catches for 111 yards, while Tyus added his three catches for 34 yards and a touchdown. Redshirt freshman tight end Mason Williams added one catch for 18 yards.

Defensively, the Bobcats held a Jax State squad— who averaged 267.3 this season on the ground— to 40 total rushing yards.

Graduate student linebacker **Blake Leake** finished with nine total tackles, .5 sacks for three yards and one interception for 17 yards. Senior cornerback **Tank Pearson** finished with 11 tackles, while redshirt junior defensive end **Bradley Weaver** finished with five tackles, 1.0 tackles for loss, .5 sacks and one fumble

recovery.

Navarro struck late in the first quarter, wrapping up a seven-play, 79-yard drive with a 24-yard rushing touchdown. The quarterback logged his second rushing touchdown of the day the next drive, rushing up the middle eight yards into the end zone. The Gamecocks bounced back quickly, cutting Ohio's lead to 14-7 with 1:12 remaining in the first quarter with a 75-yard receiving touchdown.

Ohio's offense ended a 6:12 drive with Navarro's third rushing touchdown of the day, extending their lead to 20-7. After the following Jacksonville State drive ended in a failed field goal attempt, the Bobcats quickly extended their lead with an 11-yard pass to Tyus, marking the first passing touchdown of the game and Tyus' second on the season.

The Gamecocks scored the only touchdown of the third quarter, putting the score at 27-14 with 9:36 remaining in the quarter. Sophomore kicker **Gianni Spetic** opened the fourth quarter with a 48-yard field goal, extending Ohio's lead to 16 points. Jacksonville State scored two more rushing touchdowns, cutting their deficit to just three points, but Ohio maintained possession for the final drive of the game, taking victory formation to solidify their 30-27 victory.

## 2024 MAC CHAMPIONSHIP

For the first time since 1968, the Ohio football team won the Mid-American Conference Championship (Dec. 7). Ohio defeated Miami 38-3, marking the largest margin of victory in a MAC Championship. It was also the first time a team had ever been held to no touchdowns in a Championship game.

Miami's longest drive of the first half came right after kickoff, but after

that lone field goal, Ohio was off to the races. Ohio possessed the ball for just over 13 minutes of the first half, with all three drives resulting in touchdowns.

The Bobcats' first touchdown was a 4-yard keeper by graduate student quarterback **Parker Navarro**. The second, also by Navarro, came on a 1-yard rush. The second touchdown was also the result of Ohio's longest drive of the season – 18 plays for 82 yards over 10 minutes and 14 seconds.

Navarro ended the afternoon 20-for-27 in the air for 235 yards and two touchdowns. He also collected 73 yards and the two touchdowns on the ground. Navarro was the Offensive Player of the Game.

That drive was made possible with the legwork of graduate student running back **Anthony Tyus III**, who charged through the RedHawks' defense for 34 yards on eight carries. Tyus ended the afternoon with 151 total rushing yards on 27 attempts.

Miami's most substantial drive of the second quarter ended in one set of

downs.

Ohio came out of the locker room with the same fire in the second half. For the fourth-straight drive, Ohio found the endzone on a 25-yard reception by graduate student **Coleman Owen**.

The Bobcats scored on the next drive, too. However, this time it was a career-long field goal for sophomore kicker **Gianni Spetic**. His 52-yard boot beat his previous best of 46 yards, set earlier this season at Central Michigan. Spetic ended the afternoon 1-for-1 and 5-for-5 in PATs and was named the Special Teams Player of the Game.

Ohio's offensive prowess was aided in part by its defense. Graduate student linebacker **Blake Leake** led Ohio with eight tackles. Redshirt junior linebacker **Shay Taylor** and redshirt senior cornerback **Roman Parodie** followed close behind with five each. Redshirt junior defensive end **Bradley Weaver** earned the Defensive Player of the Game nomination for his contributions as well, which included a tackle for a loss of four yards.

Senior cornerback **Tank Pearson's** interception saved what would have been a Miami touchdown in the beginning of the fourth quarter. That made way for Tyus, who scurried into the endzone to punctuate the Bobcats' victory.

### FAMILIAR FACES

Leading Ohio in the quarterback room will be 2024 MAC Championship Game Offensive MVP and Phil Steele preseason All-MAC First Team selection **Parker Navarro**. Navarro enters 2025 with 21 career games as a Bobcat where he has tallied 2,423 passing yards, 16 passing touchdowns, 1,054 rushing yards and 18 rushing touchdowns. Backing up Navarro will be fellow

returning quarterback **Nick Poulos** who appeared in eight games last season.

Catching passes for Navarro will be three returning wide receivers in junior **Chase Hendricks**, redshirt junior **Rodney Harris** and redshirt senior **Max Rodarte**. Hendricks was among Ohio's 11 players named to the Phill Steele Preseason All-MAC Team with a fourth-team selection after tallying 471 receiving yards and one touchdown in his sophomore season. The Bobcats will have plenty of depth behind Hendricks, Harris and Rodarte as the team also returns graduate students **Caleb Gossett** and **Eamonn Dennis** and redshirt sophomore **Eian Pugh**, all of whom recorded multiple receptions in 2024.

In the tight end room, Ohio retained 2024 FWAA Freshman All-American **Mason Williams**, who caught 19 passes for 211 yards and two touchdowns in 2024.

Ohio's top returning running back in sophomore **Duncan Brune** from Cologne, Germany. Brune recorded 14 games played for Ohio in 2024 as a running back and on special teams. His first career touchdown came against Central Michigan on October 12, 2024.

On the offensive line, team captain **Davion Weatherspoon** returns to lead an almost entirely new group of

blockers for Navarro and the offense. Weatherspoon enters 2025 with 25 games played as a Bobcat – the most among any offensive lineman on the roster. Senior offensive lineman **Trent Allen** returns with Weatherspoon after making four starts and 12 appearances for the Bobcats in 2024.

On the defense, Ohio brings back three elite defensive backs in **Adonis Williams Jr., DJ Walker** and **Tank Pearson**. Both Pearson and Walker were named to the Jim Thorpe preseason award watchlist after spectacular 2024 seasons. Williams and Walker will both serve as team captains on the 2025 Ohio defense.

Pearson impressed in 2024 with a team-leading four interceptions which included a two-interception game against Eastern Michigan on November 13, 2024. Walker enters his sophomore season looking to be one of the best underclassmen defenders in the country after recording seven pass break-ups, seven tackles for

loss and one interception during his freshman season.

On special teams Ohio returns kick returner **Eamonn Dennis** who once earned MAC Special Teams Player of the Week Honors for a 96-yard kick return against Kent State on November 6, 2024. Dennis was selected to the Phill Steele Preseason All-MAC Team as a kick returner on the third team.

## NOTABLE NEWCOMERS

To help Ohio's returning players on the offensive end are newcomers **Shedrick Rhodes Jr., Nick Marinaro** and **Sieh Bangura**. Both Rhodes and Bangura enter the first year of their second stint as a Bobcat.

Bangura, the former MAC freshman of the year, will be leading the running backs room. Last year with Minnesota, Bangura saw limited action but has still recorded 1,994 career rushing yards and 22 career touchdowns.

Both Rhodes and Marinaro are expected to start on the offensive line for Ohio. Rhodes spent 2024 with Ohio opponent Rutgers but enters his fifth season as a Bobcat. Marinaro will be looking to fill the shoes of **Parker Titsworth** at the center position after spending the first four seasons of his career with Dartmouth. In 2024, Marinaro was named All-Ivy League Honorable Mention.

Bangura and Rhodes were honored on the Phil Steele Preseason All-MAC Team with second team selections.

Other notable newcomers for Ohio on offense include Tulsa transfer quarterback **Tim Carpenter** and Rice transfer running back **Doe Boyland**, who will provide depth behind Bangura and Brune.

Ohio's defense is expected to feature a plethora of new faces with a slew of

incoming transfers. On the defensive line, Central Michigan transfer **Pius Odjugo**, Arkansas Pine Bluff transfer **Anas Luqman** and Walsh transfer **Cameron Hollobaugh** are all expected to play a significant role. Hollobaugh is a former two-sport athlete, appearing in over 140 games for Walsh's baseball team. He held the 2025 squad's third-highest batting average (.319), leading the team in home runs (9) while starting in all 46 games.

New defensive backs include second-time Bobcat **Pierre Kemeni Jr.**, Western Kentucky transfer **Jaymar Mundy**, South Alabama transfer **Rickey Hyatt Jr.** and Montana transfer **Ronald Jackson Jr.**

The Ohio special teams unit will be almost completely revamped in 2025 with UCLA transfer kicker **David Dellenbach** leading the kicking group. Freshman punter **Kolten Bartels** and graduate transfer

**Magnus Haines** from Arkansas State are potential options for Ohio on fourth down. The Bobcats also brought in a new long snapper in **Nick Hemer** from Buffalo and Hutchinson Community College. Tight end **Aiden Lowery** has also been supporting the special teams unit, taking reps as a long snapper.

## HOME SWEET hOUme

Heading into the 2025 season, three former Bobcats decided to follow the brick road back to Athens: running back **Sieh Bangura**, safety **Pierre Kemeni Jr.** and offensive lineman **Shedrick Rhodes Jr.** all transferred back to Ohio after spending at least one season elsewhere.

Bangura spent the 2024 season at Minnesota, where he appeared in three games. 2022 marked Bangura's breakout year with the Bobcats, earning MAC Freshman of the Year accolades after recording 1,078 yards and 13 touchdowns on 222 carries.

Kemeni spent the 2020 and 2021 seasons in Athens before transferring to Texas State and taking a redshirt year. Kemeni played for Garden City Community College in 2023 before transferring to New Mexico for the 2024 season, where he played in 10 games for the Lobos.

Rhodes played for the Rutgers Scarlet Knights in 2024, appearing in two games. While there, he was a part of the offensive line that earned a spot on the Joe Moore Award Midseason Honor Roll (Oct. 10).

## OHIO'S QB1 RETURNS

One of the top returning players in the entirety of the Mid-American Conference returns to Ohio in senior quarterback **Parker Navarro**. In 2024, Navarro was a four-time MAC Player of the Week, a MAC Scholar Athlete of the Week, the MAC Championship Offensive MVP, and was recognized on the Davey O'Brien Postseason

Great-8, also earning an All-MAC Second Team nod.

The list of accolades for Navarro came thanks to a record-breaking season on the field leading the highest scoring offense in the MAC. In 14 starts, Navarro proved his dual threat ability with 2,423 passing yards, 1,054 rushing yards and 31 total touchdowns. He is the second quarterback in program history to log over 1,000 rushing yards in a single season, an accomplishment an Ohio quarterback hasn't claimed since Kareem Wilson (1996, 1,072 yds). Notably, Navarro is the first quarterback in program history to record over 2,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards in the same season.

Navarro scattered his name all over Ohio's record book in 2024 and will look to add to his impressive career as one of the best Bobcat quarterbacks in history during 2025. Going into this season, Navarro ranks ninth in career passing yards, fourth in career total yards per game, sixth in career passing yards per game, second in career yards per play and third in career passing efficiency. Among single-season ranks, Navarro's 2024 season featured the seventh most points scored in an Ohio season, the fourth most total yards per game, the fourth most total yards gained and the ninth most completions in a season ever.

Navarro has proven to show up in the biggest moments for Ohio, with the MAC Championship Game being one of the most impressive performances of his career. Against Miami (OH) in the championship game, Navarro tallied 235 passing yards, two passing touchdowns, 67 rushing yards, two rushing touchdowns and no turnovers.

Prior to the 2025 season, Navarro has been named to a slew of preseason

award watchlists for a handful of prestigious awards that include the Maxwell Award, the Walter Camp 2025 Player of the Year, the Davey O'Brien National Quarterback Award and the Manning Award.

## 2025 PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

Quarterback **Parker Navarro** was featured on multiple preseason watch lists: the Maxwell Award (July 28), the Walter Camp 2025 Player of the Year (Aug. 4), the Davey O'Brien National Quarterback Award and the Manning Award watch list (Aug. 14).

Cornerback **Tank Pearson** and safety **DJ Walker** were both named to the Jim Thorpe Award preseason watch list (July 30). Walker was also featured on the Chuck Bednarik Award watch list (Aug. 11).

Tight end **Mason Williams** earned a spot on the John Mackey Award preseason watch list (Aug. 7).

## 11 BOBCATS NAMED TO PHIL STEELE'S PRESEASON ALL-MAC TEAM

The Ohio football program landed 11 student-athletes on Phil Steele's 2025 Preseason Mid-American Conference Team.

Graduate student quarterback **Parker Navarro** and senior cornerback **Tank Pearson** both earned Preseason First Team accolades, while redshirt senior running back **Sieh Bangura**, redshirt sophomore tight end **Mason Williams**, graduate student **Shedrick Rhodes Jr.** and redshirt sophomore **DJ Walker** made the Preseason Second Team. Junior wide receiver **Chase Hendricks**, redshirt senior offensive lineman **Davion Weatherspoon** and graduate student wide receiver **Eamonn Dennis** were named to the Preseason Third Team; redshirt senior linebacker **Cameron Hollobaugh** and senior safety **Adonis Williams Jr.** rounded out the Bobcats on Fourth Team.

## YEAR ONE FOR SMITH

After serving as the interim head coach in the weeks between 2024 postseason games, **Brian Smith** was named Ohio's 30th head coach in program history (Dec. 18, 2024). Heading into his first season at the helm, he boasts a 1-0 record.

Smith joined Ohio's staff as the running backs coach in 2022, quickly becoming an associate head coach before the 2023 season. In 2024, he began calling Ohio's plays as the offensive coordinator.

Smith's offense in 2024 led the Mid-American Conference in points per game at 29.2, yards per game at 399.8, total yards at 5,198 and rushing yards at 2,758. Running back **Anthony Tyus III** led the MAC with 1,111 yards this season, while quarterback **Parker Navarro** sits top-10 in the nation in quarterback rushing yards with 943.

In the 2024 MAC Championship, Smith's offense produced 467 yards in Ohio's historic 38-3 win over Miami. Ohio had 232 yards on the ground, while Navarro was 20-of-27 with 235 yards passing and four total TDs.

With Smith on staff at Ohio, the Bobcats have produced 11 All-MAC offensive honorees, one offensive MAC Player of the Year (**Kurtis Rourke**) honoree and one MAC Freshman of the Year (Sieh Bangura) honoree in just three seasons.

## DC JOHN HAUSER PROMOTED TO ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Defensive Coordinator **John Hauser** added associate head coach to his title before the 2024 StaffDNA Cure Bowl (Dec. 20, 2025). The announcement came on the heels of **Brian Smith's** head coach appointment, with Smith announcing the promotion in a pre-kick interview in Orlando, Fla.

Hauser joined Ohio in 2022 after serving as the co-defensive coordinator for Miami (Ohio) for eight seasons. Hauser was promoted to defensive passing game coordinator in 2023 and defensive coordinator before the 2024 season.

Under Hauser in 2024 during the regular season, Ohio led the Mid-American Conference and was fifth nationally in rushing defense, allowing just 94.3 yards per game. Ohio allowed just 17.46 points per game this season, which was 11th in the nation and also led the MAC. In total defense, Ohio was eighth in the nation at 295.2 yards per game allowed.

## REPRISING ROLES

In addition to retaining defensive coordinator **John Hauser**, first-year head coach **Brian Smith** retained five coaches from the 2024 staff.

**Andre Allen** joined the Bobcats as their wide receivers coach prior to the 2024 season, quickly making an impact. Under his guidance, wide receiver **Coleman Owen** became the program's leading single-season receiver (1,216 yds), passing **LaVon Brazill** and **Donte' Foster** in single-season receiving yards and becoming one of three Bobcats in program history to record over 1,000 receiving yards in a season.

Offensive Coordinator **Scott Isphording** is entering his 13th season as an assistant coach at Ohio. Isphording began his second tour of duty in Athens and his first as the Bobcats' quarterbacks coach in 2014. He is responsible for developing multiple of Ohio's most prolific quarterbacks, including **Parker Navarro**, **Kurtis Rourke** and two-time Cornish Award recipient **Nathan Rourke**.

**Tremayne Scott**, a staple on Ohio's

defensive line from 2009-12, joined the Bobcats' coaching staff in 2018 as the defensive tackles Coach. He was promoted to defensive line coach and assumed the responsibilities of the running game coordinator in spring 2024.

**De'Angelo Smith** joined Ohio's coaching staff in 2017 as the cornerbacks coach. Since then, Smith has added director of player development to his title and in 2024, he assumed the responsibility of the passing game coordinator. Following his performance in the 2022 season, redshirt freshman cornerback **Torrie Cox, Jr.** earned College Football News Freshman All-American Team Third Team accolades

Assistant Coach and Director of High School Relations **Joe Tresey** initially joined the Bobcats as a recruiting assistant in Aug. 2024, coming to Ohio by way of Walsh University, where he was an assistant coach during the 2023 season after he briefly returned to high school coaching at Canton McKinley (2021-22). He brings with him over three decades of coaching experience, making multiple stops at Mid-American Conference schools.

## WELCOMING NEW STAFF

First-year head coach Brian Smith added six to his staff prior to the 2025 season.

Special Teams Coordinator and Running Backs Coach **Blair Cavanaugh** came to Ohio by way of Incarnate Word, where he served as the special teams coordinator from 2022-24. The 2024 special teams squad was ranked No. 2 in among FCS teams by Hero Sports and No. 10 by Pro Focus Football (PFF). Notably, the 2022 squad led the Southland Conference in punt return averages and punt return touchdowns, finishing the season with three punt return touchdowns.

General Manager **Logan Meyer** came to Ohio by way of Northern Iowa, where he served as the director of football operations for the duration of the 2024 season before he was promoted to general manager. He also held the same title at Marshall from March 2023 to Jan. 2024, helping the coaching staff evaluate talent and prioritize needs as he oversaw recruiting operations for the Thundering Herd, including campus visits and coaching travel schedules.

A member of Ohio's staff since 2019, Tight Ends Coach **Kyle Obly** is far from new to Athens. He supported various units for the ensuing six seasons, highlighted by three years as an offense graduate assistant. Notably, Obly was the assistant quarterbacks coach and offensive skill graduate assistant for the 2024 season, where he was responsible for on-field coaching for quarterbacks on game day, including five-time Mid-American Conference Player of the Week and All-MAC Second Team Parker Navarro.

Pass Rush Specialist and Defensive Ends Coach **Jeff Phelps** came to Ohio by way of Wyoming, where he was the defensive tackles coach for the 2024 season. He spent the season prior overseeing North Dakota State's defensive tackles as well as their field block team. Under his guidance, a blocked field goal earned the Bison a spot in the FCS Semifinals.

Offensive Line Coach **Tavita Thompson** came to Ohio by way of Central Michigan, where he served as an assistant coach for the past seven seasons. Most recently, Thompson was CMU's run game coordinator and offensive line coach, guiding Brayden Swartout to his second All-MAC Second Team nod.

Linebackers Coach **Chris Woods** brings with him over 30 years

of coaching experience at both the collegiate and professional levels, experiencing success as a coordinator, head coach and analyst. He came to Ohio by way of the United Football League, where he served as the linebackers coach for the Arlington Renegades.

## A FAMILIAR FACE ON THE OPPOSING SIDELINE

A familiar face for Ohio will patrol the opposing sidelines in Week One when the Bobcats take the field in Piscataway, N.J. Former Ohio defensive end **Bradley Weaver** will be in uniform for Rutgers after entering the transfer portal following the 2024 season.

For Ohio, Weaver was one of the Bobcats' most decorated defenders. In 2024, Weaver earned All-MAC First team honors, along with winning the MAC Championship Defensive MVP.

As a Bobcat, Weaver recorded 14.5 sacks, 29.5 tackles for a loss and four forced fumbles in 36 total games played.

Despite Bradley Weaver's departure, the Weaver name remains in Athens as his brother, Brandon, is a current freshman with the Bobcats.

## 2025 TEAM CAPTAINS

The Ohio football program named graduate student quarterback **Parker Navarro**, redshirt sophomore safety **DJ Walker**, graduate student offensive lineman **Davion Weatherspoon** and senior safety **Adonis Williams Jr.** as captains for the 2025 season.

Both Navarro and Williams Jr. are entering their second season as captains.

## HEAD COACHES POLL

The 2025 Ohio football program was selected to finish third in the 2025 Mid-American Conference Head

Coaches Preseason Poll, the league announced today (July 24). The poll was determined by the league's 13 head coaches.

Toledo was selected to finish first with 135 points, followed by Miami (Ohio) with 131 points. The Bobcats garnered 123 points to place third, finishing ahead of Buffalo (115), Northern Illinois (94) and Bowling Green (81).

Toledo was selected to win the MAC with six votes, while Miami (Ohio) and Ohio trailed with four and three votes, respectively.

## OHIO IN THE MAC CHAMPIONSHIP

In program history, the Bobcats have won six MAC Championships, four of which were under Bill Hess' guidance.

Ohio won its first championship in 1953 under Carroll Widdoes. Seven years later, Hess' team won the first of four championships in 1960. Hess's squads were also crowned champions in 1963 and 1968 with a first-place tie in 1967.

In the first year without divisions, the 2024 MAC Championship also marked the 101st Battle of the Bricks when Ohio and Miami (Ohio) faced off for the second time that season. The Bobcats put on a dominant performance, breaking the 56-year drought and walking away with the program's sixth championship title.

## BOBCATS IN THE NFL

Multiple former Ohio football student-athletes are representing the Bobcats at the highest level of the sport.

Running back **Anthony Tyus III** was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Detroit Lions following the 2025 NFL Draft. He has since signed with the Seattle Seahawks (Aug. 5, 2025).

Cornerback **Roman Parodie** signed

with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers as an undrafted free agent on April 26, 2025. During the Buccaneers' preseason game against the Tennessee Titans (Aug. 9, 2025), Parodie snagged one of three interceptions, running 39 yards into the end zone for a pick-six.

Wide receiver **Coleman Owen** signed with the Indianapolis Colts as an undrafted free agent (April 26, 2025). He's made appearances in all of the Colts' preseason games, scoring in the third quarter of Indianapolis' matchup with Cincinnati (Aug. 23).

Quarterback **Kurtis Rourke** was drafted in the seventh round of the 2025 NFL Draft. Going to the San Francisco 49ers, Rourke was the 227th overall pick.

Prior to his return to the CFL, quarterback **Nathan Rourke** spent the 2023 season with the Jacksonville Jaguars. He was claimed off waivers by the New England Patriots in Dec. 2023, who released him in May 2024. Rourke was signed by the New York Giants and the Atlanta Falcons before re-signing with the CFL's BC Lions.

## BOBCATS IN THE CFL

Quarterback **Nathan Rourke** returned to the BC Lions for the 2024 season after spending 2023 in the NFL. In his first stint with the CFL (2021-22), Rourke was named Most Outstanding Canadian (Nov. 17, 2022). He is the first BC Lions' quarterback and the third quarterback in CFL history to earn the honor. Upon his return, Rourke became the highest-paid CFL athlete, signing a lucrative contract that includes \$200,000 of marketing money, which does not count toward the CFL's salary cap.

Running back **AJ Ouellette**, who quickly became a CFL household name, is currently playing for the Saskatchewan Roughriders.

Previously, Ouellette played for the Toronto Argonauts, who are the 109th Grey Cup Champions. Defensive tackle **Casey Sayles**, who was a member of the Winnipeg Blue Bombers at the time, competed in the same Grey Cup. Both Sayles and Ouellette were named 2023 CFL Division All-Stars. Currently, Sayles is on the Hamilton Tiger-Cats.

Ohio football alumnus **Chip Cox** is a part of the 2022 CFL Hall of Fame class, earning the honor in his first year of eligibility. Cox played 13 seasons for the Montreal Alouettes, wrapping up his career with the fourth-highest total defensive tackles in CFL history (979).

Although currently active in the NFL, quarterback **Kurtis Rourke** was the Saskatchewan Roughriders' third-round pick in the 2025 CFL Draft. Rourke was selected 25th overall.

## BOBCATS IN THE UFL

Wide receiver **Sam Wiglusz** initially signed with the St. Louis Battlehawks on Dec. 14, 2024; he was re-signed on May 6, 2025. Previously, Wiglusz was signed by the Los Angeles Rams as an undrafted free agent following the 2024 NFL Draft. He was re-signed to the practice squad in Aug. 2024.

Brian Smith was named Head Coach on Dec. 18, 2024 after serving as the Associate Head Coach (spring 2023) and Offensive Coordinator (spring 2024). Smith joined the Bobcats as the Running Backs Coach and Passing Game Coordinator prior to the 2022 season.

The Bobcats won their first game with Smith at the helm, capping off the 2024 campaign with a 30-27 victory over Jacksonville State in the 2024 StaffDNA Cure Bowl. This win marked Ohio's first time in program history recording an 11-win season as well as the program's sixth-straight bowl victory, becoming the first Mid-American Conference program to win six-straight bowl games. On the road to an 11-win season, the Bobcats picked up their first conference championship since 1968, defeating rival Miami (Ohio) by the largest margin of victory in a MAC Championshipship (38-3).

The Bobcats saw two 1,000 yard rushers in the 2024 season in quarterback Parker Navarro and running back Anthony "Tre" Tyus III. Both earned Second Team All-MAC accolades following their regular-season performance, with Navarro also earning MAC Offensive MVP accolades following their victory in Detroit and StaffDNA Cure Bowl MVP accolades to close the season. Navarro is the second quarterback in program history to log over 1,000 rushing yards in a single season (1,062), an accomplishment an Ohio quarterback hasn't claimed since 1996. Notably, Navarro is the first quarterback in program history to record over 2,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards in the same season. Additionally, wide receiver Coleman Owen became just the third Bobcat to log over 1,000 receiving yards in program history, breaking the Bobcats' record for most receiving yards in a season at the 2024 StaffDNA Cure Bowl to finish the season with 1,245 yards in the air. Tyus and Owen mark the program's first 1000 yard rusher/receiver duo.

Smith has a proven record in developing young talent. In 2023, he coached freshman Rickey Hunt Jr., who led the Bobcats in their 41-21 victory over Georgia Southern in the 2023 Myrtle Beach Bowl. Hunt not only scored his first rushing and receiving touchdowns during the bowl game, but set a program record for most touchdowns scored in a single game (5) and tied the NCAA record for number of touchdowns scored in a bowl game. With Smith's guidance, redshirt freshman running back Sieh Bangura earned 2022 MAC Freshman of the Year honors.

Bangura finished the season fourth in the league with 1,078 total rushing yards and was third in total rushing touchdowns (13). In MAC play, Bangura recorded a conference-best 11 rushing touchdowns.

Smith was Washington State offensive coordinator and running backs coach prior to being promoted to associate head coach. In 2020, he saw five student-athletes earn All-PAC 12 Conference honors and produced the PAC-12's top red zone offense and third-best passing attack. Smith also coached the 2021 PAC-12 Freshman of the Year, Jayden de Laura.

Prior to Pullman, Smith was the University of Hawaii's associate head coach and offensive coordinator, working specifically with running backs and tight ends from 2016-19, where he previously coached from 2008-11. In 2018, he oversaw the No. 9 ranked passing offense, averaging 310 yards per game, and mentored nationally ranked quarterback Cole McDonald, who was No. 6 in passing touchdowns (36) and No. 8 in total passing yards (3,875). Smith directed the 2016 offense, which scored 40 or more points on three occasions, highlighted by a 52-35 Hawaii Bowl victory.

From 2013-15, Smith was Occidental College's offensive coordinator and offensive line coach. The 2015 team averaged 33.8 points and 480.6 yards total of offense per game. Under Smith's leadership, quarterback Bryan Scott was named the 2013 SCIAC Newcomer of the Year and running back Kwame Do was named the 2015 SCIAC Offensive Player of the Year. Prior to Occidental, Smith served as the offensive line coach at California Lutheran in 2012 after his first coaching stint at Hawaii. While there, he led the Kingsmen to a league championship and the second-best scoring offense in NCAA Division III. Smith previously coached California Lutheran in 2005, where he worked with running backs and receivers.

In 2007, Smith took a position with Portland State as an offensive line coach after spending 2006 as a graduate assistant at Oregon State.

Smith was a long snapper and center at Hawaii from 1998-01 before signing professional contracts with the Baltimore Ravens (2002) and Green Bay Packers (2003). He earned his bachelor's degree from Hawaii and continued his education at California Lutheran, earning his master's degree. Smith and his wife, Liane, have one daughter, Chloe.


