JUMP BALL

- The Ohio men's basketball team (15-15, 9-8 MAC) concludes the 2025-26 regular season on Friday, March 6 when the Bobcats host No. 19 Miami (30-0, 17-0 MAC) for a nationally televised 'Battle of the Bricks.' Tip-off is set for 9 p.m. ET inside the Convocation Center and can be seen on ESPN2 where Eric Rothman, Mark Adams and Jen Lada will have the call.
- The Bobcats' matchup can also be heard on the Ohio Sports Network from Learfield, presented by Holzer Health System. Jason Toy begins his second season on the mic for the Bobcats and will be joined by veteran college basketball analyst Dave Cecutti. WXTQ (Power 105) in Athens returns as the 11-station network's flagship and can be heard on the Varsity Network App.
- This is the 218th all-time meeting between Ohio and Miami.
- Ohio leads the all-time series, 120-97.
- Ohio and Miami met in Oxford on Feb. 13, with Miami winning, 90-74
- Ohio and Miami met twice last season, splitting the two games. Miami took the first game in Oxford, 73-69, before Ohio took the second game in Athens, 75-66.
- Ohio is 26-9 against Miami since 2009-10, while the Bobcats are 9-3 against the RedHawks under Jeff Boals.
- Ohio has not dropped a contest to Miami in Athens since Jan. 9, 2011 when Miami won in triple overtime, 92-88.
- This is the first time since 2019 since that Ohio has hosted a ranked MAC team, when on March 5, 2019, Buffalo was ranked 19th.
- Ohio is 12-62 all-time against ranked opponents.
- Ohio has registered an impressive 588-190 (.756) all-time record at the Convocation Center, which opened in 1968.
- Ohio is 83-22 in the Convocation Center under Boals in the last seven seasons.
- The Bobcats are currently ranked 227 in the latest NET

- Last time out, the Bobcats fell on the road to UMass, 94-82 on March 3.
- On March 3 at UMass, senior guard Jackson Paveletzke had 24 points, three rebounds and seven assists.
- Against Toledo on Feb. 28 redshirt junior forward Javan Simmons scored a team-high 20 points and grabbed 12 rebounds, while senior forward Aidan Hadaway added another double double with 12 points and 12 rebounds.
- On Feb. 21 at NIU, redshirt junior forward Javan Simmons scored a game-high 23 points, going 9-of-10 from the line with seven rebounds in the road win.
- Against Ball State, senior forward Aidan Hadaway scored 18 points and grabbed eight rebounds, while senior guard Jackson Paveletzke added 18 points, six assists and four rebounds.
- Against #23 Miami on Friday, senior guard Jackson Paveletzke scored a game-high 22 points.
- Redshirt junior forward Javan Simmons recorded a career-high 24 points and grabbed a season-high 13 rebounds on Jan. 31 in Ohio's win at Buffalo.
- In the Bobcats game at Kent State on Jan. 27, Ohio forced the Flashes to turn over the ball 20 times, recording 13 steals in the process.
- Freshman guard JJ Kelly finished the game against NIU with a career-high 17 points and nine rebounds.
- Against Buffalo on Jan. 10, senior forward Aidan Hadaway had 27 points and 10 rebounds, while senior guard Jackson Paveletzke finished with 23 points, six rebounds and eight assists.
- Redshirt junior forward Javan Simmons is recorded his 1,000 career point on Jan. 6 against UMass.
- Redshirt freshman guard Jesse Burris recorded a career-high 13 points and hit three 3-pointers against UMass on Tuesday, playing 17 minutes off the bench for the Bobcats.
- Senior guard Ajay Sheldon scored a season-high 13 points and hit three 3-pointers, while recording four steals on Tuesday against UMass.
- Senior guard Jackson Paveletzke scored 14 points, including the game-winning three, at EMU on Jan. 3, while redshirt junior forward Javan Simmons led Ohio with 15 points and six rebounds.

SCOUTING No. 19 MIAMI

Miami is currently 30-0 overall and 17-0 in MAC play and are ranked 19th in this week's AP Rankings. The RedHawks are coming off a 74-72 win over Toledo on Tuesday in Oxford.

Overall, Miami averages 9.3 points per game, while shooting 52.6 percent from the field, 39.2 percent from three and 74.9 percent from the line. Meanwhile, opponents are averaging 73.8 points per game, while shooting 43.1 percent from the field, 32.2 percent from three and 73.4 percent from the line.

Miami is averaging 35.5 rebounds, 16.2 assists, 7.6 steals and 3.4 blocks a game, while forcing opponents to turn the ball over an average of 13.1 times a game. Miami opponents are averaging 35.5 rebounds, 16.2 assists, 7.6 steals and 3.4 blocks a game, while forcing 10.6 turnovers a contest.

The Bobcats also add 33.6 rebounds a game, while dishing out 13.6 assists and recording 6.3 steals a contest. Ohio is also forcing opponents to turn the ball over 12.2 times a game, scoring on average 14.0 points off them.

OHIO WELCOMES FOUR TRANSFERS

Ohio welcomes four transfers to the roster for the 2025-26 season, with redshirt senior forward Jalen Breath, senior guard Dior Connors, redshirt junior forward Javan Simmons and junior guard Carter Reese.



Ohio Men's Basketball Game Notes

BREATH: Breath played three seasons at UNC Greensboro. The Oklahoma City native played in 87 games, while making 61 starts as a Spartan. On his career, Breath averaged 5.5 points and 5.4 rebounds a game, while shooting 51.8 percent from the field and 58.3 percent from the line. He also has 30 career blocks and 34 career steals.

CONNERS: Conners played last season at App State where he saw action in 31 games, while making 26 starts. He averaged 8.0 points a game, while shooting 40.8 percent from the field, 40.1 percent from three and 76.0 percent from the line. He added 1.8 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game, while snagging 13 steals.

SIMMONS: Simmons comes to Ohio after spending three seasons at Toledo. In two seasons, Simmons started all 65 games he played in. Simmons averaged 12.4 points and 5.9 rebounds a game, while shooting 55.1 percent from the field, 32.3 percent from three and 74.2 percent from the line. He was also the 2023-24 MAC Freshman of the Year, an All-MAC Honorable Mention in 2024-25 and is a two-time Academic All-MAC selection.

REESE: Reese comes to Ohio after two seasons at Ohio Northern. He played in all 25 games with 21 starts and was named Honorable Mention All-OAC. He led the team in scoring at 14.5 points per game and in three-point shooting with 57 threes. He was second on the team with 63 assists and was third with 37 steals and scored in double figures in 19 games, with seven games of 20 or more points.

FRESHMAN CLASS

The Bobcats welcome three freshmen to Athens for 2025-26.

JJ KELLY: Kelly comes to Athens from Chambersburg, Pa. and played at Chambersburg Area. The guard was named 2025 PennLive Big 15 First Team, 2025 PennLive Big 15 All-Defensive Team, 2025 Mid Penn Commonwealth Conference First Team and 2025 All-State (Pennsylvania) Third Team. Kelly also averaged 21.8 points, 7.1 rebounds and 2.6 assists during his senior season.

JORDAN FISHER: Fisher, a Pickerington, Ohio native played at Reynoldsburg. Fisher became the all-time leader in career points in Reynoldsburg history with 1,306 points during his senior season. He was named 2025 All-Ohio First Team., 2025 Columbus Dispatch All-Metro First Team, 2025 All-Central District First Team and 2025 OCC First Team and Super Team. He helped lead Reynoldsburg to the 2025 Regional + District Championship (Division 1) and 2025 OCC Championship.

ZAY MOSLEY: A four-year varsity letterman and 1,000-point scorer, while helping lead his team his junior year to a 27-2 record and advance to the state final four. Mosley will miss the 2025-26 season due to an injury his senior season.

OHIO RETURNERS

Ohio returns seven total from last year's roster, including four who saw time in the starting lineup last season.

AJAY SHELDON: Played in 31 games this season and averaged 4.7 points a game while shooting 36.2 percent from the field, 28.4 percent from three and 72.0 percent from the line. He averaged 1.6 rebounds and 1.3 assists a game and grabbed a total of 34 steals

ELIJAH ELLIOTT: Played in 30 games, while making 14 starts after entering the starting lineup midway through conference play. He averaged 5.1 points a game in 16.4 minutes on the floor and shot 43.9 percent from the field, 39.3 percent from three and 61.1 percent from the line. Head coach Jeff Boals is back for his seventh season leading the Green and White.

Boals, a 1995 Ohio University graduate and two-time team captain, was named the head coach of Ohio Men's Basketball prior to the 2019-20 season. Boals has transformed Ohio into one of the best mid-major programs in the country, winning the MAC Tournament in the 2020-21 season and knocking off Virginia, the defending national champions, in the first round.

In 2024-25, Boals coached four Bobcats to All-MAC honors. AJ Clayton and Jackson Paveletzke earned Third Team nods, Shereef Mitchell was tabbed Honorable Mention and Elijah Elliott was named to the All-Freshman squad. Clayton was also named the Lou Henson National Player of the Week and Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week throughout the season. Mitchell and AJ Brown were also named Academic All-MAC, while Paveletzke earned a spot on the Academic All-District squad.

NEW YEAR, SAME STAFF

Head coach Jeff Boals returns five members of last year's staff.

Assistant coaches Kyle Barlow and Lamar Thornton and Director of Basketball Operations Jake Ness return for their seventh season, while assistant coach Lee Martin is back for year six. Graduate assistant Keith Williams is back for his second year.

OHIO ADDS CRAWFORD TO STAFF.

The Bobcats added Casey Crawford to the staff as an assistant coach. Crawford returns to Ohio after spending one year as the Director of Basketball Operations at Stony Brook.

In his one season at Stony Brook, Crawford's responsibilities included leading pre- and post-game film sessions, scout opponents, coordinate video operations and coach and develop post players through position-specific drills.

Prior to his arrival in Long Island, Crawford served as a graduate assistant on Boals' staff at Ohio. In his role with the Bobcats, Crawford maintained NCAA compliant recruiting logs, aided the Director of Operations in meal and operations coordination and assisted with OHIO Basketball Camps.



Ohio Men's Basketball Game Notes



JEFF BOALS

Head Coach

Jeff Boals, a 1995 Ohio University graduate and two-time team captain, was named the head coach of Ohio Men's Basketball prior to the 2019-20 season. Boals has transformed Ohio into one of the best mid-major programs in the country, winning the MAC Tournament in the 2020-21 season and knocking off Virginia, the defending national champions, in the first round.

In 2024-25, Boals coached four Bobcats to All-MAC honors. AJ Clayton and Jackson Paveletzke earned Third Team nods, Shereef Mitchell was tabbed Honorable Mention and Elijah Elliott was named to the All-Freshman squad. Clayton was also named the Lou Henson National Player of the Week and Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week throughout the season. Mitchell and AJ Brown were also named Academic All-MAC, while Paveletzke earned a spot on the Academic All-District squad.

During the 2023-24 season, the Bobcats finished third in the MAC in the regular season and advanced to the MAC Semifinals for the fourth-straight year and his second 20-win season. Boals coached Jaylin Hunter and AJ Clayton to All-MAC honors, while Hunter also earned NABC All-District, Academic All-MAC and NABC Honors Court Recognition. The entire Bobcats squad also earned the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award. He also coached Hunter, Elmore James and Shereef Mitchell to MAC Player of the Week honors.

During the 2022-2023 season, Boals coached Dwight Wilson III to All-MAC and NABC honors and Jaylin Hunter earned All-MAC Honorable Mention. A.J. Brown and Elmore James were named to the All-Freshman Team. Wilson and Ben Roderick were named Academic All-MAC, while Roderick earned a spot on the CSC Academic All-District Team.

In 2021-22, Ohio finished the season with 25 wins and a trip to the CBI Quarterfinals. Ben Vander Plas, Jason Carter and Mark Sears earned All-MAC and NABC All-District Honors, while Sears was named a Lou Henson Award Finalist. Vander Plas, Carter, Ben Roderick and Tommy Schmock earned a spot on the Academic All-MAC Team, while Vander Plas was named an Academic All-American for the second-straight year and was named the Division I Men's Basketball Academic All-America® of the Year.

2020-21 saw Ohio return to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in nine years. Ohio won the MAC Tournament after defeating Buffalo, 84-69. In the NCAA Tournament, the Bobcats took down the defending national champion Virginia Cavaliers, 62-58, inside Assembly Hall in Bloomington, Indiana.

Boals coached point guard Jason Preston, who was selected 33rd overall by the Orlando Magic and then acquired by the LA Clippers in the 2021 NBA Draft. Preston - Ohio's 20th Bobcat to be drafted - was Ohio's first NBA draft pick since 2003. Preston was named MAC Tournament MVP, First-Team All-MAC, Academic All-MAC and was a Lou Henson Award Finalist.

Joining Preston on All-MAC teams were Dwight Wilson III and Ben Vander Plas, who were All-MAC Third Team. Meanwhile, freshman guard Mark Sears (Muscle Shoals, Ala.) was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team, while sophomore guard Lunden McDay (Akron, Ohio) was named to the MAC All-Defensive Team. Also in 2021, Ben Vander Plas was named 2020-21 Academic All-America, Ohio's first since Dave Jamerson in 1990. Vander Plas was joined by Preston, Ben Roderick and Dwight Wilson III on the Academic All-MAC team.

2019-20 saw Ohio go 17-15, with Ohio winning the first-round MAC Tournament game against Central Michigan before the season was canceled due to the

COVID-19 pandemic. Jason Preston was named Second Team All-MAC, Ben Vander Plas was named All-MAC Third Team, while Lunden McDay was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

Boals returned to Athens after spending the previous three seasons (2016-19) as the head coach at Stony Brook. He guided the Seawolves to a 55-41, including a 31-17 mark in America East Conference play. Stony Brook had a 24-8 (12-4 AEC) record in 2018-19 and made its second postseason appearance in three seasons. The Seawolves received an invitation to the College Basketball Invitational Tournament in 2017. Stony Brook placed five student-athletes on the America East's All-Conference Teams in 2018-19, with sophomore center Jeff Otchere being named the league's Defensive Player of the Year and redshirt sophomore guard/forward Andrew Garcia being tabbed as Sixth Man of the Year.

A member of Thad Matta's coaching staff from 2009-16, Boals helped guide Ohio State to seven postseason appearances, including six NCAA Tournaments. The Buckeyes, who won or claimed a share of three Big Ten Conference titles, advanced to the Final Four in 2012. Ohio State went 193-62 during Boals' time in Columbus.

Boals was instrumental in bringing some of the top players in the nation to Ohio State, including current NBA stars Jared Sullinger and D'Angelo Russell, along with Aaron Craft, the all-time steals and assist leader in Ohio State history. He also coached the 2010 National Player of the Year, Evan Turner, during his outstanding collegiate career with the Buckeyes.

Prior to Ohio State, Boals spent three seasons at Akron, serving as the team's recruiting coordinator and working with the post players. The Zips advanced to three MAC Tournament championship games, winning the title in 2009 as Akron earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1986. Boals also recruited Anthony "Humpty" Hitchens, a MAC All-Freshman Team performer, and Zeke Marshall, a top-35 national recruit.

Boals spent two seasons (2004-06) at Robert Morris and four years (1999-2003) at Marshall. In his final season at Robert Morris, the Colonials posted their first winning record in 15 seasons. He also spent a total of four seasons at Division II University of Charleston in two different stints.

During his junior season in 1993-94 at Ohio, the Bobcats went 25-8 overall and won the Mid-American Conference regular season championship with a 14-4 mark in league play. The Bobcats capped off a MAC Tournament run with an 89-66 win over archrival Miami in the title game to send Ohio to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in nine years. The Bobcats began Boals' senior season by winning the 1994 Preseason National Invitation Tournament with victories over Ohio State, No. 14 Virginia, George Washington and New Mexico at Madison Square Garden. Boals was a two-time team captain while garnering four varsity letters under the leadership of his head coach, the late Larry Hunter.


