- Follow live stats by going to the men's soccer schedule page at OhioStateBuckeyes.com and clicking live stats. All Ohio State men's soccer home matches are streamed live on B1G+, unless otherwise indicated. Parking and admission are free to all Ohio State regular-season home matches.
- Ohio State will recognize its senior class in pregame ceremonies Tuesday. Parker Grinstead, Tommaso Villa, Deylen Vellios, Anthony Samways, Siggie Magnusson, David Wrona and Michael Adedokun are playing their final regular-season home match in the game against the Spartans.
- Adedokun leads the Big Ten in points with 25. He's scored eight goals to go with nine assists to lead the Buckeyes in both categories. He also leads the league in shots (58) and is third in shots on goal with 22.
- The Buckeyes are No. 1 in the 16-team NCAA Division 1 Men's Soccer Rankings used to seed the field in the

2024 NCAA 48-team tournament. It's the highest ranking in program history. The United Soccer Coaches Poll agreed by ranking the Buckeyes as its unanimous No. 1 last week, also the highest ranking the Buckeyes have achieved.

- The 2024 Big Ten Tournament quarterfinal and semifinal rounds will be held in Bridgeview, Illinois, at SeatGeek Stadium. The quarterfinals will be held Nov. 7 (1/3:30/6 p.m./B1G+) between seeds 2-7. The No. 1 seed will get a bye to the semifinals Nov. 10 (3/5:30 p.m./BTN). The highest remaining seed after the semifinals will host the finals on its campus Nov. 17 (3 p.m./BTN).
- Top Drawer Soccer release a couple Top 100 lists with the Buckeyes well represented. In the Midseason Top 100, Michael Adedokun (5), Deylen Vellios (21), Siggie Magnusson (68) and Marko Borkovic (92) all made the list. In the Midseason Top 100 Freshmen, David Ajagbe (25), Patrick McLaughlin (94) and Nick McHenry (97) were recognized.
- At 11-1-2 and winners in 11 of the last 12 matches, Ohio State started

the season undefeated, the best start in program history, before a 2-1 setback at UCLA. The last time the Buckeyes enjoyed a stretch of 11 games without a loss was in 2007 when over a 15-match stretch, Ohio State posted a record of 12-0-3 on its way to the national title match vs. Wake Forest (L, 1-2, 12/16/2007).

- After posting wins at Michigan (6-3) and over Washington at home (2-0), three Buckeyes were named players of the week by the Big Ten Conference. David Wrona scored two match winners and three goals overall to go with two assists to earn offensive POW Oct. 8. Saggi Magnusson was named the defensive POW and Max Trejo (5-0-1) claimed goalkeeper of the week, his second award of the year.
- After a pair of shutout wins to open the Big Ten season over Penn State (5-0) and Rutgers (3-0), junior Luciano Pechota and freshman Nick McHenry were awarded the Big Ten Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week awards, respectively. Pechota had three goals in the wins.
- For the second time in three seasons, Ohio State finished the non-conference portion of the regular season without a loss. Ohio State was 5-0-3 in 2022 against out-of-league foes on its way to an 11-3-6 overall record and a trip to the second round of the NCAA tournament.
- The Buckeyes earned a 5-0-1 record during the 2024 non-conference schedule.



- Ohio State posted a seven-match win streak entering the game against Indiana (2-2). The last time Ohio State had posted seven-consecutive wins was during the 2015 campaign during an eight-match win streak.
- In the first United Soccer Coaches poll of the season, Ohio State, unranked in the preseason poll, was tabbed the No. 20 team nationally. In the most recent poll, the Buckeyes are ranked No. 1 their

highest ranking in program history.

- Ohio State opened 2024 Big Ten Conference play with a 5-0 win at Penn State. It's the most goals against the Nittany Lions in the series history. Then, against Michigan, Ohio State scored six times on the road in a 6-3 victory. Ohio State's total was the most against the Wolverines in series history.
- Prior to the Penn State game this year, the last time Ohio State scored five or more goals against a Big Ten opponent was at Wisconsin Oct. 3, 1999 in a 7-3 victory against the Badgers. The Buckeyes also defeated Northwestern at home that season 5-0 Sept. 12.
- The six goals against the Wolverines marked just the eighth time Ohio State scored five or more against a Big Ten opponent.

- With a game-winning goal already to his credit, Nick Skubis was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week (9/10/24) after adding an assist in the win over Xavier (3-1, 9/8/24).

- After a team vote, seniors Vellios and David Wrona were named captains for the 2024 season.
- The Big Ten selected three Buckeyes as players to watch in 2024. Adedokun, Siggy Magnusson and Luciano Pechota made the league's preseason list. Ohio State was picked sixth by the conference coaches in the expanded Big Ten Conference.
- Freshmen David Ajagbe, Nick McHenry, Nick Skubis, Johnny Rush, Zsombor Onodi and Patrick McLaughlin all made their first appearances as Buckeyes to date this season. Redshirt sophomores RJ Stoller and Jacob Maisonneuve also made their first appearances this season.
- Ajagbe made his presence felt early in his Ohio State career with four goals over his first eight matches. He got the equalizer in the 1-all draw in the home opener vs. Cleveland State and then put Ohio State out front 1-0 in the 3' at Akron. He added a score in a 4-0 win over SIUE and another in the most recent outing against Rutgers (W, 3-0).
- The Big Ten Conference is made up of 11 teams sponsoring men's soccer with the addition of UCLA and Washington

to the league starting this season. Oregon and USC also were added to the conference but neither sponsors men's soccer. The Buckeyes meet new league members UCLA on the road Oct. 11 after playing host to the Huskies Oct. 7.

- All-American [Laurence Wootton](#), a four-time All-Big Ten selection, was drafted by the Chicago Fire in the 2024 MLS Draft with the 64th overall pick. He is currently on loan with Indy Eleven of the USL Championship.
- With Wootton, the 2022 and 2023 Big Ten Midfielder of the Year, now in the professional ranks, the Buckeyes will look to several returning all-league honorees in 2024. Back are All-Big Ten Second Teamers, Adedokun, Siggy Magnusson and Luciano Pechota along with sophomore Andre Roberts, a member of the 2024 All-Big Ten Freshman Team.
- Several Buckeyes who missed the 2023 season with injury will be available in 2024. Defenders Nathan Demian and Thomas Gilej in addition to midfielder David Wrona return following injuries a season ago. Also back is defender Deylen Vellios, who is using a fifth-year of eligibility.
- Brian Maisonneuve and his coaching staff added several newcomers in 2024 who will vie for playing time as rookies. Ohio natives Nick McHenry (D) and Cole Evans (M) join Luke Laramore (GK, Glenview, Illinois), Nick Skubis (M, Tampa, Florida), London, England, native, Johnny Rush (M) and forward David Ajagbe, who joins the Buckeyes from Surrey, British Columbia.
- In games played at Jesse Owens Memorial Stadium since it opened in 1999, Ohio State is 141-70-39.

Maisonneuve at OSU

Brian Maisonneuve is in his seventh year as head coach of the Buckeyes. Maisonneuve came from Indiana University where he was associate head coach for the Hoosiers. The Buckeyes posted 11 victories, tied for second in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2022.

As one of the top assistants in the country, Maisonneuve guided Indiana to the 2012 NCAA National Title, a NCAA runner-up finish in 2017, the 2010 Big Ten Regular-Season Title as well as the 2013 Big Ten

Tournament Championship. Maisonneuve, a native of Warren, Michigan, is one of the top players in Indiana soccer history, winning the Hermann Trophy in 1994. He spent nine seasons with the Columbus Crew from 1996-2004 and was a member of the United States' 1998 World Cup team. Maisonneuve is assisted by Matt Foldesy, Travis Morris and Corey Brueggeman. Former Buckeye Devyn Etling serves as a program assistant.

Game 1 (Ohio State 1, CSU 1)

Freshman forward David Ajagbe scored his first collegiate goal in the second half to rally the Buckeyes to a 1-all draw against visiting Cleveland State. Ajagbe stole the ball from the Vikings' keeper and scored in the 67'. David Wrona was credited with the assist.

Game 2 (Ohio State 2, Akron 0)

David Ajagbe, in his first career start, scored in the 3' from an Anthony Samways feed to help the Buckeyes to a 2-0 road win over Akron. Luciano Pechota added an insurance goal in the 29' from Deylen Vellios to secure the win. Redshirt freshman keeper Patrick McLaughlin, in his first appearance, started and earned the shutout win.

Game 3 (Ohio State 4, SIUE 0)

Deylen Vellios scored in the 11' to give Ohio State a 1-0 lead that was never challenged the rest of the way in a 4-0 win over the Cougars in the 2024 Wolstein Classic. Michael Adedokun, David Ajagbe

and Marko Borkovic also scored in the victory. Redshirt freshman keeper Patrick McLaughlin shared the shutout win with RJ Stoller. Both saw their first action as Buckeyes

Game 4 (Ohio State 3, UNLV 2)

Freshman Nick Skubis came off the bench to score the match winner in the 77' in a 3-2 victory over the Rebels in the final match of the 2024 Wolstein Classic in Columbus. The teams traded goals with Michael Adedokun scoring first in the 32' and Parker Grinstead adding a penalty kick goal just before the half around a UNLV score. The Rebels tied it in the 63' to set up Skubis for the win.

Game 5 (Ohio State 3, Xavier 1)

Michael Adedokun scored the first goal of the game and then added an assist on the match-winning score to keep the Buckeyes unbeaten in a 3-1 home win over Xavier. Graduate David Wrona put Ohio State up 2-1 before junior Marko Borkovic added an insurance goal late. Redshirt freshman keeper Patrick McLaughlin improved to 3-0 on the year in net.

Game 6 (Ohio State 1, Butler 0)

Ohio State and Butler were scoreless well through the second half before freshman Nick Skubis took a pass from senior defender Deylen Vellios and found the net just inside the far right post to give the Buckeyes the lead and eventually the win in the 73'. Skubis, the reigning Big Ten Freshman of the Week, scored his second match-winning goal on just his second shot of his Ohio State career.



Game 7 (Ohio State 5, Penn State 0)

The Buckeyes outshot the Nittany Lions 22-5 while holding an 18-1 advantage in corner kicks on their way to a 5-0 road win, the most goals scored by Ohio State in the series with the Nittany Lions. Luciano Pechota scored twice with Marco Borkovic and Siggy Magnusson also scoring around a Penn State own goal. Patrick McLaughlin improved to 4-0 on the year in goal.

Game 8 (Ohio State 3, Rutgers 0)

The Buckeyes recorded their third-consecutive shutout with a 3-0 win over visiting Rutgers. Parker Grinstead scored the game-winner in the first half while David Ajagbe and Luciano Pechota provided insurance goals in the second. Max Trejo got the start in goal and responded with seven saves for his second shutout of the year. Ohio State tied a program record for most wins (7-0-1) over the first eight matches of the season with the 1977 squad (7-1-0).

Game 9 (Ohio State 2, Indiana 2)

Michael Adedokun opened the scoring with a first half goal before Siggy Magnusson added another on a header in the second in a 2-all draw with the visiting Hoosiers. The match was played through high winds and periods of heavy rain. The draw extended Ohio State's best start to a season in program history at 7-0-2.

Game 10 (Ohio State 6, Michigan 3)

Marko Borkovic and David Wrona each scored twice while Ashton Bilow added three assists in a 6-3 road win over the Wolverines, the most goals scored by Ohio State in the series. Max Trejo left the net for the Buckeyes after the 81' leading 6-1 to earn the win. He was credited with three saves.

Game 11 (Ohio State 2, Washington 0)

Max Trejo got the call for the second-consecutive game in net and responded with his third shutout of the season in a 2-0 win over the visiting Huskies. David Wrona scored the match winner in the second half, his third goal in the last two matches. Michael Adedokun added an insurance goal, his six of the season, to help the Buckeyes remain undefeated.

Game 12 (UCLA 2, Ohio State 1)

The Buckeyes scored first on the first goal of the year for Ashton Bilow but the Bruins rallied to score twice in less than two

minutes in the second half to defeat the No. 2 Buckeyes in Los Angeles. It was the first loss of the season and marked the first time Ohio State scored first and suffered a defeat (9-1-1).

Game 13 (Ohio State 3, Wisconsin 2)

Ohio State rallied to overcome a pair of Wisconsin penalty shot goals to defeat the Badgers 3-2 in Madison. Michael Adedokun scored once and assisted on the two other goals to improve his team lead in goals (7) and assists (8). Patrick McLaughlin improved his record in net to 5-1-1.

Game 14 (Ohio State 2, Northwestern 0)

Before 3,355 fans, the second largest crowd in Ohio State history, the No. 1 Buckeyes used a second-half surge to blank the visiting Wildcats, 2-0. Freshman David Ajagbe scored first before senior Micael Adedokun added a score for security. Keeper Max Trejo remained undefeated at 6-0-1 with his fourth shutout of the season.



BRIAN MAISONNEUVE HEAD COACH

7TH SEASON, INDIANA '95



Brian Maisonneuve, a former member of the U.S. National Team and Columbus Crew, was named head men's soccer coach at The Ohio State University April 23, 2018.

Maisonneuve was one of the top assistants in all of college soccer at Indiana for the decade prior to him taking over at Ohio State. Wherever Maisonneuve has coached, success has followed. He helped guide the Hoosiers to the 2012 NCAA National Championship, a NCAA runner-up finish in 2017, the 2010 Big Ten Regular Season Title as well as the 2013 Big Ten Tournament Championship.

In all, Maisonneuve helped lead Indiana to eight NCAA Tournament appearances, including two College Cups and four NCAA Sweet 16 appearances. An All-American during his playing days for the Hoosiers (1991-94), Maisonneuve was part of Todd Yeagley's staff for nine years, coaching nine All-Americans as well as 22 players who went on to play professional soccer, including 14 in MLS.

Maisonneuve, who replaced John Bluem (retired in March of 2018), was named the NSCAA Assistant Coach of the Year for the Great Lakes Region in 2012 and 2015. In 2016, Maisonneuve was named one of the Top 12 assistants in the nation for the third-consecutive year and fifth time in his career. From 2010-17, the Hoosiers had 21 players named first team All-Big Ten and 50 student-athletes earn Big Ten honors. IU players also earned nine conference player of the year accolades in that time. The Hoosiers excelled in the classroom, compiling 102 Academic All-Big Ten honors.

Prior to his return to Bloomington, Maisonneuve was on staff at the University of Louisville from 2008-09. During his two seasons, the Cardinals were 24-11-4

overall and 13-7-1 in Big East play with two NCAA Tournament appearances.

Maisonneuve spent four years as an assistant coach with the U.S. U-17 National Team in Florida. He also served as an assistant coach for the U.S. U-20 National Team in 2007 during the CONCACAF qualification process and coached the U-20s in the 2007 FIFA World Cup in Canada.

Before joining the coaching ranks, Maisonneuve had a decorated playing career. He spent nine seasons with the Columbus Crew from 1996-2004 and was a member of the United States' 1998 World Cup team, appearing in all three matches. He also was a member of the 1996 U.S. Olympic team, leading the squad with a pair of goals in the tournament.

Maisonneuve, a native of Warren, Michigan, is one of the top players in Indiana soccer history. Playing alongside Todd Yeagley, under legendary coach Jerry Yeagley, he earned All-America honors as a junior and senior and was named the Hermann Trophy winner in 1994. A two-time Big Ten Player of the Year, Maisonneuve finished his career with 44 goals and 22 assists and led Indiana to a pair of NCAA College Cup appearances and back-to-back Big Ten regular season titles. During his four years at Indiana the Hoosiers were 73-15-7. He also was a four-time All-Big Ten selection and three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection. Maisonneuve earned his bachelor's degree from Indiana.

Maisonneuve and his wife Dania have two children, Jacob and Emma.
