THIS IS AN ENTRY FEE, NOT A COMPETITION FEE—There are no refunds for non-accepted entries, scratches or no-show athletes.

**Entry Deadline:** Every team and individual MUST be entered and have paid on Direct Athletics by 12:00 PM (EDT), April 16, 2024 or your entries will not be accepted.

**Entry Standards**: Are for everyone. If you have not met the standards listed (or granted permission by meet management) you may be cut from the meet and there are no refunds. All payments must be made on Direct Athletics at the time of your entry.

Entry marks will be verified and must be from 2022-23 or later. If your entries have not reached the qualifying marks, they may not be allowed in the meet.

ALL ENTRIES ARE AT THE DISCRETION OF MEET MANAGEMENT.

#### Unattached

- Unattached athletes are permitted to compete at the discretion of meet management. The entry request needs to be completed on the following Google Doc:

- 2. Entry request does not guarantee that your entry will be accepted.
- 3. The verifiable mark must meet the published entry standard in order to be considered.
- 4. Unattached Entry Fees \$60/athlete. Fee waived for enrolled OSU students with a valid University ID who also meet the objective standard of performance requirement.

#### **WORLD ATHLETICS / USATF CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFYING:**

New World Athletics and USA Track & Field policies require that marks to be considered for qualification to their championships may only come from competitions that are sanctioned through World Athletics / USATF and abide by their rulebook. While this meet will be conducted under NCAA rules, it is also sanctioned by World Athletics and USATF. Results will be reported both to TFRRS (the NCAA results reporting system) and to World Athletics / USATF, with notations of any rule violations from the World Athletics rulebook.

The two areas in which NCAA rules and World Athletics/USATF rules differ, where result notations (disqualifications) may be submitted to World Athletics are:

- 1. Lane Violations: World Athletics / USATF and NCAA rules differ in number of steps permitted on or over the lane line. An athlete could potentially be disqualified by World Athletics / USATF rules but not NCAA rules. Results will be submitted to each organization accordingly.
- 2. Footwear: World Athletics / USATF requires that all shoes be in compliance with their approved shoe list (<a href="https://www.worldathletics.org/about-iaaf/documents/technical-information">https://www.worldathletics.org/about-iaaf/documents/technical-information</a>). Shoes will be randomly checked for compliance at clerking and field event check in. Those athletes not in compliance with the approved shoe list will be noted and result will be disqualified from World Athletics / USATF. Once again, an athlete could potentially be disqualified by World Athletics / USATF rules but not NCAA rules. Results will be submitted to each organization accordingly.
