Quick Hits

- In combination with Central Oklahoma, Oklahoma Baptist will welcome 12 teams to Shawnee for the Great American Conference-Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association Crossover
- The Crossover will pit Central Region teams from both the GAC and MIAA against each other and should have a significant effect on regional rankings down the road
- Over the course of two days, the Noble Complex will have hosted 16 matches. Oklahoma Baptist will complete in two matches per day, looking to move back above .500

Scouting the Gorillas (0-8)

- Pittsburg State enters the Crossover without a win to their credit all season. They've already lost to three GAC foes: Arkansas Tech, Henderson State and Ouachita Baptist
- The Gorillas are swinging .146 as a team and averaging 10.7 kills per set. Peyton Walker is averaging a team-high 2.89 kills/set while hitting .208
- Carolina VanBuskirk has a team-best 6.46 assists per set
- Ashlen Schwartz leads the team on the back row with an average of 4.00 digs per set. Taylor Unke has a team-leading 21 total blocks, including seven solo efforts

Scouting the #14 Ichabods (6-2)

- Washburn comes to Shawnee holding a 6-2 record, and is ranked No. 14 in Division II by the American Volleyball Coaches Association
- The Ichabods are averaging 13.04 kills/set, led by Leanna Willer at 3.04 kills/set. Two other Ichabods have better than 2.40 kills/set
- Natalie Bates leads the team in assists at a 7.96 assists/set clip
- Alyssa Carney is posting 4.86 digs/set to lead the squad, while Sarah Vicory is averaging .82 blocks per set

Scouting the Bearcats (2-6)

- The Bearcats are 2-6 as they enter the GAC-MIAA Crossover, including a loss to GAC member Harding
- Southwest Baptist is averaging just 9.40 kills/set, and is led by Dana Neal who is hitting .062 while recording 2.30 kills/set
- Serena Mar is averaging 4.07 assists/set and leads SBU in the category
- Bailey Baumann leads the team with 4.83 digs/set, and Katie Robinson is averaging .93 blocks/set

Scouting the Hornets (5-3)

- The Hornets head to Shawnee owning a 5-3 record after two weeks of action
- Emporia State are swinging .194 and laying down 11.03 kills/set. Josie Williams leads all Hornets with 2.57 kills/set in a fairly balanced attack
- Kimberly Bell owns the team lead for assists at 4.40 assists/set
- Defensively, Allie Maloney has a team-best 4.33 digs/set. At the net, Shayla Cotman is averaging 1.03 blocks/set over 30 sets

Lady Bison Open GAC Play in Victory

- The Lady Bison kicked off Great American Conference play with a straight-set victory over Northwestern Oklahoma State on Tuesday night inside the newly-renovated Noble Complex
- Shekinnah Sharpe led the way with 11 kills, while Cadyn Laing had eight and Nicole Fleitman six

2016 LADY BISON VOLLEYBALL NOTES

- Kynneddy Myers averaged over eight assists per set, while also contributing four kills to the win
- Sierra VeraCruz accounted for 22 of the Lady Bison's 71 digs on the night. Sharpe was second on the team with 14
- The Lady Bison outblocked the Rangers 12-4, led by Laing and Taylor Williams with six blocks each
- It was OBU's first win following a six-match losing skid

Lady Bison Notes

- The Lady Bison are swinging .160 as a team, the ninth-best clip in the league, while turning in 11.39 kills/set. Mikayla Watson narrowly owns the team lead at 3.10 kills/set, though Fleitman is just behind at 3.09 kills/set
- VeraCruz set a single-match career record with 22 digs on Tuesday night. She currently leads the team at 3.38 digs/set. Sharpe is second on the team at 3.32 digs/set
- Making her first appearance after a five-match absence, Sharpe posted her first career double-double with 11 kills and 14 digs
- Oklahoma Baptist is second in the GAC at 1.97 service aces per set, led by Myers with .30 aces/set
- Laing ranks fourth in the conference, blocking at a .97 block/set average. Her 10 solo blocks are the second-best total among GAC players
- The Lady Bison attack is one of the hardest to block in the conference, with opponents averaging 1.39 blocks/set against OBU, the third-lowest average among the 12 GAC schools
- With 8.58 assists/set, Myers is eighth amongst GAC setters
- After averaging just .64 digs/set in her first five matches, Darby Maclea is finding her groove and averaging 2.54 digs/set over her last four matches

Around the GAC

- Oklahoma Baptist sits tied for first in the conference standings after opening the GAC slate with a win over Northwestern on Tuesday night
- All six Oklahoma-based members of the league will participate at the GAC-MIAA Crossover this weekend
- The Lady Bison and Rangers were the only GAC schools in Oklahoma to open conference play this week. Every Arkansas team played on Tuesday, with Arkansas Tech, Harding and Ouachita claiming conference wins

Looking Ahead

- Conference action resumes for OBU when they head to Durant, Oklahoma, to take on Southeastern Oklahoma State on Tuesday, Sept. 20 for a 7 p.m. match
- The Lady Bison only dropped one set to the Savage Storm in a series sweep last season

HEAD COACH ANNA HOWLE



Oklahoma Baptist University head coach Anna Howle began her college coaching career at the helm of the Lady Bison in 2008.

During the 2015 season, Howle directed the Lady Bison to a 27-13 record, the program's first season at the Division II level. Her team also reached the the National Championship of the National Christian College Athletic Association before falling in title match. A strong season saw OBU place three on the NCCAA All-American squad, headlined by senior Kaitlyn Lucy, who set a new Division II record for digs in a season (978).

The 2011, 2012, and 2013 Sooner Athletic Conference Coach of the Year, Howle has been featured as an AVCA "Thirty Under 30."

The Lady Bison won four consecutive conference titles from 2010-2013, and won 53 consecutive regular season SAC matches. The Lady Bison also won three SAC tournaments and qualified for the postseason three times, making it to the NAIA National Tournament in 2012 and 2013. The 2011 squad made it to the NAIA Opening Round Tournament.

Since coming to OBU, Howle has coached the team to four seasons with 30 or more wins, and is 180-60 over six seasons. She has coached three Sooner Athletic Conference Freshmen of the Year, a three-time SAC MVP, a SAC Newcomer of the Year, a two-time SAC Libero of the Year, two SAC Setters of the Year, a SAC Hitter of the Year, four All-Americans, six NAIA Scholar Athletes, and 25 All-Conference players.

In addition to her coaching duties, she is the Senior Woman Administrator at OBU. She has also been a camp director for OBU, numerous high school camps, home school camps, and has coached at camps at the University of Arkansas and Northern Iowa. She also teaches kinesiology and leisure studies courses at OBU.

Howle (then Monsen), who played four seasons at the University of Oklahoma, began rebuilding the program at OBU, which had been dormant since 1987. OBU started volleyball in 1975, but the program was discontinued after the 1987 season. Her first Lady Bison team posted a 24-16 record in 2008.

Howle, who is working on her master's degree at OU, served as head coach at Carl Albert High School in 2007, leading the team to its first state tournament appearance. She also coached the Sooner Volleyball Club (13-year-olds) in Norman for two seasons.

While at OU, Howle was Academic All-Big XII from 2004-06 and Co-Libero of the Year in 2006. She was OU's Most Improved Player in 2004. Howle also ran track for the Sooners for one season, earning All-Conference honors in the heptathlon.

Howle played at Stoughton High School in Wisconsin, where she was the school's all-time leader in assists.

She married Tyler Howle in 2009 and the couple has two children.

Graduate Assistant

Carey Strong joined the Oklahoma Baptist volleyball coaching staff in summer of 2016 after a concluding a four-year career competing for the Lady Bison following the 2015 season.

The right-side hitter and setter was instrumental in OBU's run to the National Christian College Athletic Association Championship, earning All-Tournament Team honors. In her senior season, Strong appeared

in 39 matches, starting 35, and held a .222 hitting percentage (4th best on the team) while ranking third on the team in kills and second in assists.

Strong, a native of Wylie, Texas, graduated from Oklahoma Baptist University in 2016 with a Bachelor's in Elementary Education. She resides in Shawnee, where she is an active member of Immanuel Baptist Church.
