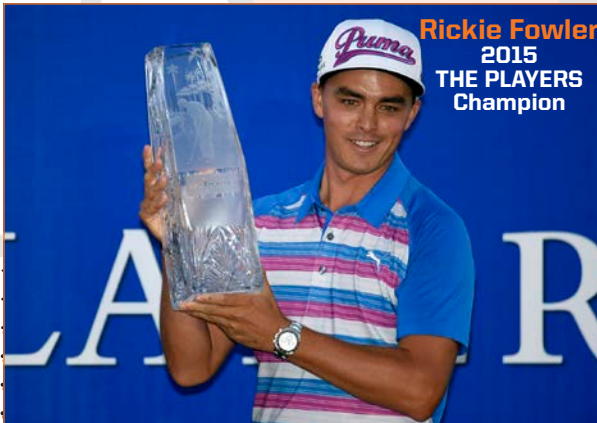

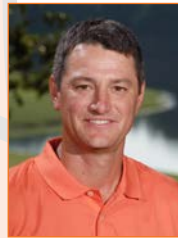
I'd like to invite you to join us for a great day of golf at Karsten Creek as we host the 43rd edition of The Cowboy Pro-Am on October 2nd.

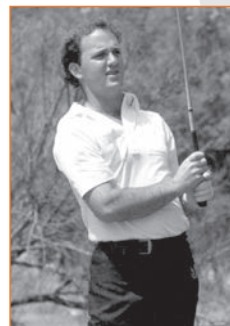

Donors contributing at this level for five years will receive naming rights and priority usage for the lodge. The Boone Pickens lodge was completed in the fall of 2002 at a cost of \$1.3 million. The Sherman Smith lodge was finished and opened in April 2006, while the Jerry Walsh lodge was completed in 2010. All three properties consist of six bedrooms on two levels. The top level has four bedrooms, each with a private entrance and a common area, featuring a full kitchen, dining area and living area. The bottom level resembles the top, but has only two bedrooms. There is enough land to accommodate four to five additional lodges.
