## Oklahoma State Postgame Notes vs. Central Arkansas

:: QB Mason Rudolph, CB Miketavius Jones, CW Blake Jarwin and CW Jeremy Seaton served as Oklahoma State captains for today's game.

The Oklahoma State Win ...

- Improved the Cowboys to 20-3 in their last 23 nonconference games.
- Improved the Cowboys to 39-5 in their last 44 games against unranked opponents, dating back to 2010.
- Marked the Cowboys' 20th straight in a home opener.
- Improved the Cowboys to 81-28-5 all-time in home openers.
- Improved the Cowboys to 9-0 under Mike Gundy in games played against FCS opponents.

## **Notable Streaks**

- Under Mike Gundy, Oklahoma State has never lost to an FCS school (9-0).
- Oklahoma State has won 20 straight home openers.
- Oklahoma State has won 39 of its last 44 over unranked opponents.
- Jimmy Bean and Ryan Simmons have both started 28 consecutive games, which equates to starting every game since the start of the 2013 season.
- Defensive end Emmanuel Ogbah has at least one sack in eight of the last 10 games.
- :: Kevin Peterson returned to make his first start of the year. Mason Rudolph made his first home start after the first four games of his career were played away from home.
- :: David Glidden's 67-yard TD reception in the third quarter was the longest reception of his career and the Cowboys' longest play of the season thus far.
- :: Glidden finished with a career-high 145 receiving yards. It was the most by an OSU receiver since Brandon Sheperd's 156-yard day at Oklahoma last year.
- :: Glidden finished with three receptions of at least 30 yards, two of at least 40 yards and one of more than 60.
- :: Chris Carson scored the first rushing TD of his career on a 21-yard carry in the first quarter.

- :: Miketavius Jones, long known as a great special teams player, recovered a fumble on a punt return in the second quarter. Jones was OSU's special teams MVP last week.
- :: Through the first two games of the year, the Cowboy defense has totaled 18 tackles for loss, including 10 today.
- :: A total of 12 different Cowboys recorded a reception. 11 Cowboys caught a pass last week.
- :: In the first half, OSU outgained UCA in yardage 252-86 and in first downs 12-5.
- :: The Cowboys tallied 10 offensive plays of more than 20 yards, including a 56-yard catch from Jalen McCleskey and a 67-yard catch from David Glidden. Jeff Carr also had a kickoff return of 53 yards.
- :: Mason Rudolph recorded a career-high 401 passing yards. It was also his first career 300-yard passing game.
- :: Rudolph's performance ranks as the third-highest passing yard total for a sophomore in school history. Zac Robinson had 430 yards against Texas in 2007 and Bobby Reid had 411 yards against Kansas in 2006.
- :: That also marks the 12th 400-yard passing game in school history and the first since Wes Lunt's 436-yard game at Arizona in 2012.
