- ► Transferred to Oklahoma State after UAB disbanded its program in 2014
- ► A two-year starter at left tackle for the Blazers in 2013 and 2014

### LG 74 MICHAEL WILSON

6-6 | 305 | RJr. | Aledo, TX/Aledo

▶ Versatile performer who started at four of the five offensive line positions in 2014

### C 71 BRAD LUNDBLADE

6-3 | 300 | So. | Argyle, TX/Liberty Christian

- ▶ Walked on in 2014 and soared up the depth chart, earning a start at Baylor
- ▶ Put on scholarship prior to the opening of 2015 fall camp

### **RG 57 PAUL LEWIS**

6-3 | 295 | RJr. | Houston, TX/North Shore

- ► Has played both center & guard during his time at OSU, earning 15 career starts
- ▶ Started all 13 games in 2014, with 12 of those starts coming at center

### RT 60 ZACH CRABTREE

6-7 | 305 | RSo. | Mansfield, TX/Mansfield

- ➤ 2014 Second-Team Academic All-Big 12
- ► Started eight games in 2014. In those games, OSU averaged 36.5 ppg and 438.0 ypg. In the five games he didn't start, OSU averaged 13.4 ppg and 284.2 ypg

### **WR 3 MARCELL ATEMAN**

6-4 | 210 | Jr. | Dallas, TX/Wylie East

- ► Scored his first career touchdown on an 18-yard catch in the season opener and ranks second on the team in both receptions (8) and receiving yards (121)
- Named OSU's offensive player of the week for week one
- ▶ Big-bodied receiver who started seven games in 2014 and the both games so far in 2015
- ► Set career highs with six catches and 130 receiving yards vs. Texas Tech in 2014

### WR 13 DAVID GLIDDEN

5-8 | 185 | RSr. | Mustang, OK/Mustang

- ➤ Shifty, quick-twitch receiver who was OSU's offensive MVP in 2014, leading the team with 42 catches
- ► Team leader in receiving yards (216), all-purpose yards (216), receptions (9) and receiving touchdowns (2). Among the top 16 nationally in receiving yards, receiving TDs, receiving YPG and YPR
- ► Had three receptions of at least 30 yards vs. Central Arkansas, totaling a career-best 145 yards and earning OSU's offensive player of the week honors for the game
- ▶ Team leader who was a member of OSU's Big 12 champion squad in 2011

### WR 7 BRANDON SHEPERD

6-1 | 195 | Sr. | St. Louis, MO/Parkway Central

- Has at least one catch in 18 consecutive games
   Ranked third in the Big 12 and 20th nationally with
- ▶ Ranked third in the Big 12 and 20th nationally with 18.9 yards per catch in 2014
- ► Led the Cowboys with 737 receiving yards in 2014
- ▶ Big-play threat who led the team with 11 plays of 20 yards or longer in 2014

## WR 28 JAMES WASHINGTON

6-0 | 200 | So. | Stamford, TX/Stamford

- ► Ranks third on the team with 78 receiving yards
- ➤ 28 catches for 456 yards and a team-best six TDs as a true freshman in 2014
- ▶ Offense's top newcomer in 2014, as judged by the coaching staff
- ▶ District MVP in basketball & first-team all-district and all-region in tennis in HS

### CW 47 BLAKE JARWIN

6-5 | 242 | RJr. | Tuttle, OK/Tuttle

- ▶ One-time walk-on who was put on scholarship prior to fall camp this year
- ▶ Played in every game and earned two starts in 2014

## CW 44 JEREMY SEATON

6-2 | 250 | RSr. | Cashion, OK/Cashion

- Versatile player who can play either tight end or fullback
- ▶ Started eight games as a junior in 2014 and both games so far in 2015, catching a TD last week
- ► Three-time academic all-Big 12 selection

## RB 32 CHRIS CARSON 6-2 | : ▶ 2015 Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year by the media

6-2 | 202 | Jr. | Lilburn, GA/Butler CC

- ► Leads the team in carries (36) and rushing yards (131), scored his first TD last week vs. UCA
- ► Ranked as the No. 4 JUCO RB in the nation by 247Sports after averaging 7.2 yards per carry at Butler CC in 2014

## QB 2 MASON RUDOLPH

6-4 | 220 | So. | Rock Hill SC/Northwestern

- ▶ Ranks 10th nationally with 333.5 passing yards per game, 18th nationally with 14.82 yards per completion and 13th nationally with 340 yards of total offense per game
- ▶ Became just the sixth OSU QB to throw for 400 yards in a game, throwing for 401 yards vs. UCA
- ► Scored on a career-long 21-yard run in the season opener, also threw an 18-yard touchdown pass and completed at least one pass to 11 different receivers
- ▶ Ticketed to redshirt 2014, but injury to others forced him into action in week 11
- ▶ In his three starts in 2014, he completed 49-of-86 passes for 853 yards and six TDs and led OSU to wins at Oklahoma and over Washington in the Cactus Bowl
- ► Spent the summer working with former OSU QB Zac Robinson at the Texas QB Academy and was also a counselor at the Manning Passing Academy in Louisiana

- ▶ Developing prospect who has been a second-teamer since the middle of 2014
- Saw his first collegiate actoin in the home opener vs. Central Arkansas

6-6 | 310 | RSo. | Bedford, TX/L.D. Bell

Athletic underclassman who is a viable option; played late against UCA

▶ Junior college transfer joined the program in 2013, played late against UCA

▶ Junior college transfer who missed most of last season due to injury. Saw his first game action vs. Central Arkansas

**WR 17 AUSTIN HAYS** 

6-2 | 190 | RJr. | San Antonio, TX/Reagan

- ▶ Injuries have slowed him the past two seasons, but he's at full speed for 2015
- ► Has three catches for 30 yards through the first two games
- ➤ Started as a true freshman in 2012
- Versatile receiver who is equally effective both outside and in the slot

WR 84 JALEN MCCLESKEY

5-10 | 156 | Fr. | Covington, LA/St. Paul's

- ► One of four true freshmen to play so far in the 2015 season
- ▶ Has one catch in each game of his career, including a 56-yard grab last week against UCA
- ► The son of former NFL defensive back J.J. McCleskey

### WR 15 CHRIS LACY

6-3 | 195 | So. | DeSoto, TX/DeSoto

- ► Highly intelligent player who played in all but one game in 2014
- ▶ Four receptions for 47 yards as a true freshman last season and one catch in the season opener

## WR 81 JHAJUAN SEALES

6-2 | 198 | RJr. | Port Arthur, TX/Memorial

- ► Ranks among OSU's active leaders in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns
- ➤ Six career games with 70 or more receiving yards

### CW 86 ZAC VEATCH

6-4 | 270 | RJr. | Broken Arrow, OK/Broken Arrow

- ▶ Has played tight end and offensive line during his time as a Cowboy
- ▶ Started the first 10 games of last season at guard before returning to tight end, the position he played in high school

## CW 85 JORDAN FRAZIER

6-5 | 255 | RFr. | Springfield, MO/Lighthouse Christian

Developing prospect who redshirted last season and made his first career catch vs. UCA

### RB 23 RENNIE CHILDS

5-10 | 205 | Jr. | Houston, TX/Cypress Ridge

- Led all rushers with 50 yards in the UCA game, including a 35-yard run that marks OSU's longest rush of the season so far
- ► A second-team Academic All-Big 12 selection in 2014
- ► OSU's third-leading rusher in 2014 with 294 yards

## RB 20 JEFF CARR

5-7 | 168 | Fr. | Temple, TX/Temple

- One of four true freshmen to play so far in the 2015 season and OSU's third-leading rusher
   Fourth in the Big 12 and 23rd nationally with a 26.5-yard kickoff return average, including a 53-yard
- return vs. UCA

  Elusive back who averaged 9.6 yards per carry as a senior in high school last year

## QB 4 J.W. WALSH

6-2 | 215 | RSr. | Denton, TX/Guyer

- Scored OSU's first TD of the year on his first play in the season opener and added a passing touchdown last week vs. UCA
- Veteran performer with 10 career starts to his credit, including the first two games of last season before he was lost for the year to injury
- ► Has five career 300-yard passing games and five career 50-yard rushing games.
- ► His 170.11 quarterback efficiency rating in 2012 not only led the Big 12 and ranked fourth nationally, but was also the fourth-best ever for a freshman QB, trailing only Michael Vick (Virginia Tech), Sam Bradford (Oklahoma) and Rudy Carpenter (Arizona State)

#### **38 EMMANUEL OGBAH** DE

6-4 | 275 | RJr. | Houston, TX

- Second in the Big 12 and 19th nationally with 1.25 sacks per game. Also has six QB hurries
- Has recorded at least one sack in eight of his last 10 games
- Ranks fourth on OSU's career list for quarterback hurries (13) and has a realistic chance to set the record with a strong showing this season
- 2014 Big 12 Defensive Lineman of the Year and All-Big 12 first team
- Ranked in the top 25 nationally in both sacks per game (15th with 0.85 per contest) and tackles for loss per game (24th with 1.3 per contest) in 2014
- His 11 sacks and 17 tackles for loss in 2014 are both single-season records during the Gundy era
- 2013 Academic All-Big 12 selection
- Born in Lagos, Nigeria, and moved to Houston at age nine. Began football in seventh grade
- Has put on 45 pounds since arriving as a freshman at 230 pounds
- Named OSU's defensive player of the week vs. Central Arkansas

#### DT **56 MOTEKIAI MAILE**

6-4 | 305 | Jr. | Euless, TX

- Powerful figure up front was one of the top JUCO defensive linemen in the nation last season and had offers from TCU, Arizona State and Mississippi State, among others
- The most recent of an influx of Polynesian players to play for Mike Gundy at OSU

#### **96 VINCENT TAYLOR** DT

6-3 | 300 | RSo. | San Antonio, TX

- Recorded his first career sack in the season opener and ranks sixth in the Big 12 in tackles for loss per game (1.8)
- Ranks second on the team in both tackles (11) and tackles for loss (3.5)
- Developing prospect who saw his first significant game action last year, but was one of the standouts of the spring
- Registered 13 tackles as a freshman last season

#### **92 JIMMY BEAN** DE

6-5 | 250 | RSr. | Denton, TX

- Named OSU's defensive player of the week against Central Michigan.
- Steady veteran who started every game each of the past two seasons and this year

The contest will also be carried live on the Cowboy Radio Network, with Dave Hunziker handling play-by-play, John Holcomb providing analysis and Robert Allen reporting from the sideline. ### IN THE POLLS

Oklahoma State is ranked No. 25 in both the Associated Press and the Amway Coaches Polls. UTSA is unranked in both polls. Since 2008, Oklahoma State has been ranked in the Associated Press poll in 68 of its last 93 games played.

## **OKLAHOMA STATE FROM A DISTANCE**

Two weeks into the season, Oklahoma State has shown itself as a very good defensive squad that is also effective in the passing game and in punt coverage. Youth, balance and speed rank among OSU's primary traits.

Offense: The Cowboys rank in the top 25 nationally in passing offense, pass efficiency, passing yards per completion and fewest turnovers lost. The Pokes piled up 578 yards of total offense and 25 first downs last week. Sophomore quarterback Mason Rudolph ranks 10th nationally with 333.5 passing yards per game and has completed 67.2 percent of

Defense: OSU ranks in the top 25 nationally in scoring defense, rushing defense, tackles for loss and sacks. The Cowboys have defended 24 possessions this season, with 17 of those 24 possessions resulting in punts, two resulting in turnovers and two resulting in the end of a half. Just two weeks into the season, preseason All-America defensive end Emmanuel Ogbah 3.5 tackles for loss, 2.5 sacks and six quarterback hurries. Fellow defensive end Jimmy Bean has 4.0 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks and two quarterback hurries. Sophomore defensive tackle Vincent Taylor ranks second on the team in tackles (notable for a defensive tackle), and has 3.5 tackles for loss and a sack to his credit.

Special Teams: Oklahoma State ranks fifth in the nation in net punting and is 21st nationally in kickoff returns. How good has the OSU punt coverage unit been to this point? OSU has punted 10 times, with the opponent only able to return one of those punts, and that one return was for minus-three yards. Redshirt freshman punter Zach Sinor ranks 17th nationally with 45.1 yards per punt. Half of his 10 punts have been downed inside the 20 yard line. True freshman running back Jeff Carr ranks 23rd nationally by averaging 26.5 yards per kickoff return. If there is an area for improvement, however, it's placements, where OSU is 3-for-5 on field goals and 5-for-7 on PATs.

### **THE SERIES**

Oklahoma State and UTSA have met each of the past two seasons, with the Cowboys taking a 56-35 win in San Antonio two years ago and a 43-13 victory in Stillwater last year. Those are the only two meetings between the two schools.

Since Mike Gundy took over as head coach at Oklahoma State in 2005, the Cowboys have compiled a 32-7 record in the month of September (82.1 pct).

## **OKLAHOMA STATE IN NON-CONFERENCE GAMES**

Oklahoma State is 20-3 in its last 23 non-conference games, dating back to the start of the 2010 season. Included in those 20 wins are victories over Stanford, Arizona (twice), Washington and Washington State from the Pac-12, Mississippi State from the SEC and Purdue from the Big Ten.

## **OKLAHOMA STATE VS. UNRANKED OPPONENTS**

Since the start of the 2010 season, Oklahoma State is 39-5 against teams not ranked in the Associated Press Top 25. The Cowboys have won 27 of their last 28 home games over unranked opponents. The only unranked team to beat OSU in Boone Pickens Stadium since 2010 was Texas last season.

Starting with the Cowboys' 2012 Heart of Dallas Bowl win over Purdue, OSU has won 15 of its last 17 overall against unranked opponents.

## **GUNDY-COKER CONNECTION**

Oklahoma State coach Mike Gundy faces one of his mentors in UTSA coach Larry Coker. Coker coached at OSU from 1983-89 and served as offensive coordinator for some of the most potent offenses in school history. Gundy was his quarterback from 1986-89.

## OKLAHOMA STATE'S CONNECTION TO SAN ANTONIO

The Oklahoma State roster is dotted with players from Central Texas and, more specifically, the San Antonio area. In fact, nine Cowboys who are gameday contributors went to high school just a short drive from UTSA. Included on that list are linebacker Ryan Simmons and safety Jordan Sterns (both of whom played for Cibolo Steele HS), defensive tackle Vincent Taylor (James Madison HS in San Antonio), receiver Austin Hays (Ronald Reagan HS in San Antonio), safety Tre Flowers (Judson HS in Converse) and punter Zach Sinor (Medina Valley HS just west of San Antonio).

## **RED RIVER POWERHOUSE**

Oklahoma State is 22-6 in its last 28 games against teams from the state of Texas, dating back to 2009. The Cowboys have won eight of their last 10 against teams from the Lone Star State, dating back to 2013.



## **Team Notes**

### **WIN INDICATORS**

There are many things that go into whether a team wins a game or not, but a long-term look at the trends during Mike Gundy's tenure at Oklahoma State shows that winning the turnover battle and winning the run game are two of the easiest ways to predict an OSU win or loss.

Since 2005, when the Cowboys win the turnover battle, they are 49-5 (90.7 pct.) They are 22-0 in games when they commit zero turnovers. OSU is 68-19 under Gundy when outrushing the opponent (78.2 pct.) and is 30-4 when holding the opponent under 100 yards on the ground.

History also shows that OSU is tough to beat when it takes a lead into halftime, as the Cowboys are 69-6 when leading at intermission under Gundy (92.0 pct.).

## **INCREASED EXPERIENCE ON THE DEPTH CHART**

A comparison of Oklahoma State's current depth chart against the final regular season depth chart of 2014 shows a significant increase of upperclassmen. Last year's squad featured 24 upperclassmen on the depth chart. This year's boasts 33 - a notable increase. OSU has nine freshmen listed on the depth chart, a total that is way down from the 22 freshmen who played in games last year. The pendulum of experience has now swung in favor of the Cowboys. That said, in OSU's season-opener at Central Michigan, only four of its 22 starters were seniors. A closer look:

### **NEW LOOK COACHING STAFF**

Oklahoma State's coaching staff underwent significant changes during the offseason, with four new coaches now in place. Of the four new coaches, three have NFL experience and the fourth was recognized as the national assistant coach of the year as recently as 2011.

- ▶ The most experienced new member of the staff is offensive line coach Greg Adkins, who came to Stillwater from the Buffalo Bills, where he coached tight ends from 2013-14. A 24-year coaching veteran, Adkins has made college coaching stops at Georgia, Tennessee and Syracuse and Marshall.
- ▶ New running backs coach Marcus Arroyo coached quarterbacks and called plays for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers last season. Arroyo originally went to Tampa to coach quarterbacks, but with offensive coordinator Jeff Tedford out due to health issues, Arroyo was thrust into the role of NFL playcaller. Prior to his one season with the Bucs, he served as offensive coordinator at California and at Southern Miss.
- ▶ In his first year coaching the OSU safeties is Dan Hammerschmidt, who has extensive experience coaching on both sides of the ball. Hammerschmidt spent the bulk of his career at Colorado State, but served as an offensive assistant with the Houston Texans from 2012-13. He coached running backs at the University of Houston last season.
- ► Rounding out the new crop of OSU assistant coaches is Jason McEndoo, who coaches the Cowboy Backs (a tight end/fullback hybrid). McEndoo coached offensive line at Montana State from 2003-14 and was honored as the FCS national assistant coach of the year in 2011.

### **IMPACT TRANSFERS**

Oklahoma State picked up a few FBS transfers who figure to have an immediate impact. A look:

- ▶ Junior offensive lineman Victor Salako was a two-year starter at UAB and chose OSU after the Blazers program was disbanded after the 2014 season. He has started at left tackle each game in 2015 and looked more than capable.
- ► Senior cornerback Michael Hunter was a two-year starter at Indiana who earned his degree in exercise science and enrolled at OSU for grad school. Hunter followed the same path to Stillwater as graduate transfers Tyler Patmon (from Kansas in 2013) and Josh Furman (from Michigan in 2014). He has already made an impact in the first two games.
- ► Sophomore linebacker Chad Whitener sat out last season after transferring from California, where he saw limited action as a freshman in 2013. Whitener is listed as OSU's second-team middle linebacker, but the native Texan has earned a role that should include a good amount of playing time.

### **SPEAKING OF TRANSFERS...**

While OSU added three FBS transfers, it also picked up a pair of junior college standouts who started on the first day of the season.

- ▶ Junior running back Chris Carson was ranked as the No. 4 junior college running back in the nation after averaging 7.2 yards per carry and scoring nine touchdowns for Butler CC in Kansas. A native of Lilburn, Ga. (about an hour west of Athens), Carson's work last season earned him a scholarship offer from Georgia, but after originally committing to the Dawgs, he spurned his hometown favorite for the opportunity to play in Oklahoma State's offensive attack. Carson, the preseason Big 12 offensive newcomer of the year, scored his first rushing touchdown for the Cowboys last week and leads the team with 131 yards and 36 carries.
- ► Similar to Carson, junior defensive tackle Motekiai Maile had his choice of several strong programs coming out of Tyler JC, but decided on Oklahoma State. Maile brings raw power and strength to the interior of the OSU defensive front.

## **WEEK THREE TALKING POINTS - OFFENSE**

- ▶ Productive offenses have been the norm during the Mike Gundy era at Oklahoma State. The Cowboys rank in the top 10 nationally in scoring offense, yards per play, total offense and passing offense since 2010.
- ► Explosive plays were the name of the game for OSU against Central Arkansas. The Cowboys totaled 10 offensive plays of at least 20 yards last week - seven passes and three rushes. For comparison, the Cowboy offense of 2014 averaged 4.9 explosive plays per game.
- Receiver David Glidden had a career day against UCA, racking up 145 yards and two touchdowns on four receptions. The senior Oklahoma native tallied three receptions of at least 30 yards, including a career-long 67-yard touchdown grab, a 41-yard grab to set up a Cowboy touchdown and a 31-yard reception that ended with a dive into the endzone for another score.
- ► Playing in the fifth game of his career and the first home game - sophomore quarterback Mason Rudolph became just the sixth Oklahoma State quarterback to throw for 400 yards in a game when he completed 23-of-35 passes for 401 yards and two touchdowns in the Cowboys' 32-8 win over Central Arkansas. Rudolph completed 66 percent of his passes, averaged 16.6 yards per completion and completed passes to 12 different receivers in the contest. Through two games, Rudolph ranks 10th nationally with 333.5 passing yards per game and is 18th nationally with 14.82 yards per completion.

## **OFFENSIVE BENCHMARKS**

Among the statistical categories that the OSU coaches prioritize when grading their own offense are the following: rushing yards per carry, explosive plays (20 yards or longer), minimizing turnovers and avoiding negative yardage plays. A look at how the Cowboys grade out in those areas

### **WEEK THREE TALKING POINTS - DEFENSE**

- ▶ The overall speed of the group and depth at defensive end and cornerback are the signature traits of the Cowboy defense. All of those were evident in week two as the Cowboys held UCA to only 92 total rushing yards and only 220 total offensive yards in the game.
- ▶ Junior defensive end Emmanuel Ogbah is a legitimate All-America candidate. The 2014 Big 12 defensive lineman of the year and first-team All-Big 12 honoree earned preseason All-America honors from *Lindy's*, *Athlon* and *Phil Steele*, among others. Ogbah and senior defensive end Jimmy Bean present a formidable defensive end duo. Both have been big contributors in the Cowboys' first two wins, with Ogbah logging 2.5 sacks and six QB hurries and Bean adding two sacks and two QB hurries of his own.
- ► OSU's linebacking corps is as deep as ever, with veterans Ryan Simmons and Seth Jacobs joined by up-and-comer Jordan Burton in the starting group. Chad Whitener, Devante Averette and Gyasi Akem are contributing as well.
- ▶ Between Kevin Peterson, Ashton Lampkin, Michael Hunter and Ramon Richards, OSU has four cornerbacks who have all logged a substantial amount of high-pressure game reps. Included on the watch list for the Jim Thorpe Award presented to the nation's top defensive back, Peterson is the leader of the group.
- ▶ Junior safety Jordan Sterns is a hidden standout in college football. He may not be a household name yet, but he has positioned himself well to make a substantial leap in 2015. He holds the team lead in tackles after two games and is a formidable presence in the defensive backfield.

## **DEFENSIVE BENCHMARKS**
