- ▶ Walked on in 2014 and soared up the depth chart, earning a start at Baylor
- ▶ Put on scholarship prior to the opening of 2015 fall camp

RG 57 PAUL LEWIS

6-3 | 295 | RJr. | Houston, TX/North Shore

- ► Has played both center & guard during his time at OSU, earning 14 career starts
- ▶ Started all 13 games in 2014, with 12 of those starts coming at center

RT 60 ZACH CRABTREE

6-7 | 305 | RSo. | Mansfield, TX/Mansfield

- ▶ 2014 Second-Team Academic All-Big 12

- ► Set career highs with six catches and 130 receiving yards vs. Texas Tech in 2014

- ► Shifty, quick-twitch-style receiver who was OSU's offensive MVP in 2014
- ► Team-high five receptions in the opener at Central Michigan
- ▶ Led the Cowboys with 42 receptions in 2014
- Team leader who was a member of OSU's Big 12 champion squad in 2011

WR 7 BRANDON SHEPERD

6-1 | 195 | Sr. | St. Louis, MO/Parkway Central

- ▶ Ranked third in the Big 12 and 20th nationally with 18.9 yards per catch in 2014
- ▶ Led the Cowboys with 737 receiving yards in 2014
- ▶ Big-play threat who led the team with 11 plays of 20 yards or longer in 2014

WR 28 JAMES WASHINGTON

6-0 | 200 | So. | Stamford, TX/Stamford

- ▶ 28 catches for 456 yards and a team-best six TDs as a true freshman in 2014
- ► Offense's top newcomer in 2014, as judged by the coaching staff

- ▶ 2015 Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year by the media

- ▶ Ranked as the No. 4 JUCO RB in the nation by 247Sports after averaging 7.2 yards per carry at Butler CC in 2014

QB 2 MASON RUDOLPH

6-4 | 220 | So. | Rock Hill SC/Northwestern

- ▶ Third in the Big 12 with a 68.8 completion percentage and in the top 30 nationally with 22 comple-
- ▶ Scored on a career-long 21-yard run in the season opener, also threw an 18-yard touchdown pass and completed at least one pass to 11 different receivers
- ► Ticketed to redshirt 2014, but injury to others forced him into action in week 11
- ▶ In his three starts in 2014, he completed 49-of-86 passes for 853 yards and six TDs and led OSU to wins at Oklahoma and over Washington in the Cactus Bowl
- ▶ Spent the summer working with former OSU QB Zac Robinson at the Texas QB Academy and was also a counselor at the Manning Passing Academy in Louisiana

5-8 | 200 | RSr. | Edmond, OK/NEO A&M JC

► Walk-on who contributed as a special teamer in 2014

WR 15 CHRIS LACY

- ► Highly intelligent player who played in all but one game in 2014
- ► Four receptions for 47 yards as a true freshman last season and one catch in the season opener

WR 81 JHAJUAN SEALES

- Ranks third in the Big 12 with a 21-yard kickoff return average
- Elusive back who averaged 9.6 yards per carry as a senior in high school last year
- One of the top-performing newcomers for OSU during fall camp

QB 4 J.W. WALSH

6-2 | 215 | RSr. | Denton, TX/Guyer

- Scored OSU's first TD of the year on his first play in the season opener ► Veteran performer with 10 career starts to his credit, including the first two games of last season
- before he was lost for the year to injury ► Has five career 300-yard passing games and five career 50-yard rushing games.
- ► His 170.11 quarterback efficiency rating in 2012 not only led the Big 12 and ranked fourth nationally, but was also the fourth-best ever for a freshman QB, trailing only Michael Vick (Virginia Tech), Sam Bradford (Oklahoma) and Rudy Carpenter (Arizona State).

- Ranks fifth on OSU's career list for quarterback hurries (10) and has a realistic chance to set the record with a strong showing this season. Jimmy Bean also has 10.
- 2013 Academic All-Big 12 selection
- Ranked in the top 25 nationally in both sacks per game (15th with 0.85 per contest) and tackles for loss per game (24th with 1.3 per contest) in 2014
- His 11 sacks and 17 tackles for loss in 2014 both represent single-season records for a Cowboy during the Mike Gundy era (2005-present)
- Born in Lagos, Nigeria, and moved to Houston at age nine. Picked up football in the seventh grade
- Has put on 45 pounds since arriving as a freshman at 230 pounds

#### DT **56 MOTEKIAI MAILE**

6-4 | 305 | Jr. | Euless, TX

- Powerful figure up front was one of the top JUCO defensive linemen in the nation last season and had offers from TCU, Arizona State and Mississippi State, among others
- The most recent of an influx of Polynesian players to play for Mike Gundy at OSU

#### DT **96 VINCENT TAYLOR**

6-3 | 300 | RSo. | San Antonio, TX

- Recorded his first career sack in the season opener and ranks third in the Big 12 in sacks (1.0) and tackles for loss (2.5)
- Developing prospect who saw his first significant game action last year, but was one of the standouts of the spring
- Registered 13 tackles as a freshman last season

#### 92 JIMMY BEAN DE

6-5 | 250 | RSr. | Denton, TX

- Named OSU's defensive player of the week for week one
- Steady veteran who started every game each of the past two seasons
- Ranks fifth on OSU's career list for quarterback hurries (10) and has a realistic chance to set the record with a strong showing this season. Emmanuel Ogbah also has 10.

#### **20 JORDAN BURTON** SLB

6-3 | 215 | RJr. | Longview, TX

- JUCO transfer who the OSU coaches think very highly of
- Averaged more than 10 tackles per game at Kilgore JC last season
- Started his career at Stephen F. Austin, where he made 74 tackles as a freshman in 2013

#### THE BASICS

Oklahoma State (1-0 overall; 0-0 Big 12) opens the 2015 home slate when it welcomes Central Arkansas (0-1 overall; 0-0 Southland Conference) at 6:30 p.m. Saturday in Boone Pickens Stadium.

#### ON THE AIR

The game will be televised by Fox Sports Net with Mike Morgan, JC Pearson and Steffi Sorensen calling the action. The contest will also be carried live on the Cowboy Radio Network, with Dave Hunziker handling play-by-play, John Holcomb providing analysis and Robert Allen reporting from the sideline.

#### IN THE POLLS

Oklahoma State is receiving votes in both the Associated Press and Amway Coaches polls. Central Arkansas is not ranked or receiving votes in the FCS polls.

#### **OKLAHOMA STATE FROM A DISTANCE**

Youth and balance are among Oklahoma State's primary traits. Through one week of the season, a look into both: **Youth**: In the Cowboys' week one victory at Central Michigan, just four of OSU's 22 offensive and defensive starters were seniors and 14 players saw the field in an Oklahoma State uniform for the first time.

**Balance**: Against the Chippewas, sophomore quarterback Mason Rudolph spread the ball around to his playmakers effectively, completing 22 passes to 11 different receivers. Also, OSU had seven offensive plays from scrimmage that went for 20 yards or longer. Those seven explosive plays were made by six different players (a 49-yard reception by Marcell Ateman, receptions of 26 yards and 20 yards by David Glidden, a rush of 26 yards by Rennie Childs, a reception of 23 yards by Chris Carson, a 21-yard reception by Jhajuan Seales and a 21-yard touchdown rush by Mason Rudolph). Defensively, six different Cowboys recorded tackles behind the line of scrimmage.

From an individual standpoint, Oklahoma State's top honors candidates include junior defensive end Emmanuel Ogbah (a 2015 preseason All-America selection by multiple outlets who was the 2014 Big 12 Defensive Lineman of the Year and a first-team All-Big 12 selection according to both the coaches and the media last season), linebacker Ryan Simmons and cornerback Kevin Peterson, both of whom were preseason first-team All-Big 12 selections. Both Ogbah and Simmons are on the watch list for the Rotary Lombardi Award and Peterson is on the watch list for the Jim Thorpe Award. Junior running back Chris Carson was the preseason selection as Big 12 offensive newcomer of the year.

#### STRONG STARTS UNDER GUNDY

Since Mike Gundy took over as head coach at Oklahoma State in 2005, the Cowboys have compiled a 31-7 record in the month of September (81.6 pct).

#### **OKLAHOMA STATE IN NON-CONFERENCE GAMES**

Oklahoma State is 19-3 in its last 22 non-conference games, dating back to the start of the 2010 season. Included in those 19 wins are victories over Stanford, Arizona (twice), Washington and Washington State from the Pac-12, Mississippi State from the SEC and Purdue from the Big Ten.

#### OKLAHOMA STATE VS. FCS SCHOOLS

Oklahoma State sports a 24-5-1 record against schools currently playing in the Football Championship Subdivision and has won 18 straight. The Cowboys have not lost to an FCS opponent since a 20-0 setback to William and Mary in the 1949 Delta Bowl.

## **GUNDY VS. THE FCS**

Under coach Mike Gundy, Oklahoma State is 8-0 against FCS schools. The first game of Gundy's head coaching tenure came against FCS Montana State to start the 2005 season - a 15-10 OSU win. In the seven games against FCS schools following Gundy's debut, the Cowboys have outscored the opposition, 387-68. A look at what OSU has done against FCS opposition during Gundy's tenure.

#### OKLAHOMA STATE VS. UNRANKED OPPONENTS

Since the start of the 2010 season, Oklahoma State is 38-5 against teams not ranked in the Associated Press Top 25. The Cowboys have won 26 of their last 27 home games over unranked opponents. The only unranked team to beat OSU in Boone Pickens Stadium since 2010 was Texas last season.

Starting with the Cowboys' 2012 Heart of Dallas Bowl win over Purdue, OSU has won 14 of its last 16 overall against unranked opponents.

#### **Team Notes**

#### **WIN INDICATORS**

There are many things that go into whether a team wins a game or not, but a long-term look at the trends during Mike Gundy's tenure at Oklahoma State shows that winning the turnover battle and winning the run game are two of the easiest ways to predict an OSU win or loss

Since 2005, when the Cowboys win the turnover battle, they are 49-5 (90.7 pct.) They are 22-0 in games when they commit zero turnovers. OSU is 67-19 under Gundy when outrushing the opponent (77.9 pct.) and is 29-4 when holding the opponent under 100 yards on the ground.

History also shows that OSU is tough to beat when it takes a lead into halftime, as the Cowboys are 68-6 when leading at intermission under Gundy (91.9 pct.).

#### **INCREASED EXPERIENCE ON THE DEPTH CHART**

A comparison of Oklahoma State's current depth chart against the final regular season depth chart of 2014 shows a significant increase of upperclassmen. Last year's squad featured 24 upperclassmen on the depth chart. This year's boasts 33 - a notable increase. OSU has nine freshmen listed on the depth chart, a total that is way down from the 22 freshmen who played in games last year. The pendulum of experience has now swung in favor of the Cowboys. That said, in OSU's season-opener at Central Michigan, only four of its 22 starters were seniors. A closer look:

#### **NEW LOOK COACHING STAFF**

Oklahoma State's coaching staff underwent significant changes during the offseason, with four new coaches now in place. Of the four new coaches, three have NFL experience and the fourth was recognized as the national assistant coach of the year as recently as 2011.

- ► The most experienced new member of the staff is offensive line coach Greg Adkins, who came to Stillwater from the Buffalo Bills, where he coached tight ends from 2013-14. A 24-year coaching veteran, Adkins has made college coaching stops at Georgia, Tennessee and Syracuse and Marshall.
- ▶ New running backs coach Marcus Arroyo coached quarterbacks and called plays for the Tampa Bay Buccaneers last season. Arroyo originally went to Tampa to coach quarterbacks, but with offensive coordinator Jeff Tedford out due to health issues, Arroyo was thrust into the role of NFL playcaller. Prior to his one season with the Bucs, he served as offensive coordinator at California and at Southern Miss.
- ▶ In his first year coaching the OSU safeties is Dan Hammerschmidt, who has extensive experience coaching on both sides of the ball. Hammerschmidt spent the bulk of his career at Colorado State, but served as an offensive assistant with the Houston Texans from 2012-13. He coached running backs at the University of Houston last season.
- ► Rounding out the new crop of OSU assistant coaches is Jason McEndoo, who coaches the Cowboy Backs (a tight end/ fullback hybrid). McEndoo coached offensive line at Montana State from 2003-14 and was honored as the FCS national assistant coach of the year in 2011.

#### **IMPACT TRANSFERS**

Oklahoma State picked up a few FBS transfers who figure to have an immediate impact. A look:

- ▶ Junior offensive lineman Victor Salako was a two-year starter at UAB and chose OSU after the Blazers program was disbanded after the 2014 season. He started at left tackle for the Cowboys last week and looked more than capable.
- ► Senior cornerback Michael Hunter was a two-year starter at Indiana who earned his degree in exercise science and enrolled at OSU for grad school. Hunter followed the same path to Stillwater as graduate transfers Tyler Patmon (from Kansas in 2013) and Josh Furman (from Michigan in 2014). He has already made an impact in week one.
- ► Sophomore linebacker Chad Whitener sat out last season after transferring from California, where he saw limited action as a freshman in 2013. Whitener is listed as OSU's second-team middle linebacker, but the native Texan has earned a role that should include a good amount of playing time.

#### **SPEAKING OF TRANSFERS...**

While OSU added three FBS transfers, it also picked up a pair of junior college standouts who started on the first day of

- ▶ Junior running back Chris Carson was ranked as the No. 4 junior college running back in the nation after averaging 7.2 yards per carry and scoring nine touchdowns for Butler CC in Kansas. A native of Lilburn, Ga. (about an hour west of Athens), Carson's work last season earned him a scholarship offer from Georgia, but after originally committing to the Dawgs, he spurned his hometown favorite for the opportunity to play in Oklahoma State's offensive attack. Carson, the preseason Big 12 offensive newcomer of the year, began his career last week by starting and tallying 89 yards on 21 carries.
- ► Similar to Carson, junior defensive tackle Motekiai Maile had his choice of several strong programs coming out of Tyler JC, but decided on Oklahoma State. Maile brings raw power and strength to the interior of the OSU defensive front.

#### **WEEK TWO TALKING POINTS - OFFENSE**

- ▶ Productive offenses have been the norm during the Mike Gundy era at Oklahoma State. The Cowboys rank in the top 10 nationally in scoring offense, yards per play, total offense and passing offense since 2010.
- ▶ The OSU backfield, which was largely a question mark following last season, showed promise in week one. Running back Chris Carson showed flashes of high-level talent as he totaled 89 yards on 21 carries. Rennie Childs also showed great quickness and strength with his five carries and quarterbacks J.W. Walsh and Mason Rudolph proved effective on the ground as well.
- ▶ Marcell Ateman showed signs that he is growing into the player OSU coaches hoped he could be when they brought him in. He brought in the Cowboys' longest reception of the game with a 49-yard grab to get the Cowboys well out of their own territory. He also caught a highlight fourth-quarter touchdown pass, going high over a defender to pull the ball out of the air and give the Cowboy offense a needed scoring lift. He led all receivers 75 yards.
- ▶ Mason Rudolph looks like he is ready to pick up where he left off at the end of last season. The Cowboy sophomore was 22-of-32 through the air for 266 yards, one touchdown and no interceptions. After one week, Rudolph ranks third in the Big 12 in completion percentage and among the top 30 nationally in completions per game. He also showed he can do more than pass, scrambling multiple times for key first downs and scoring on a career-long 21-yard run to put the Cowboys ahead for good.

#### **OFFENSIVE BENCHMARKS**

Among the statistical categories that the OSU coaches prioritize when grading their own offense are the following: rushing yards per carry, explosive plays (20 yards or longer), minimizing turnovers and avoiding negative yardage plays. A look at how the Cowboys grade out in those areas:

#### **WEEK ONE TALKING POINTS - DEFENSE**

- ▶ The overall speed of the group, depth at defensive end and depth at cornerback are the signature traits of the Cowboy defense. All of those were evident in week one as the Cowboys held CMU to only 78 total rushing yards and only 136 total yards in the second half.
- ▶ Junior defensive end Emmanuel Ogbah is a legitimate All-America candidate entering the season. The 2014 Big 12 defensive lineman of the year and first-team All-Big 12 honoree earned preseason All-America honors from *Lindy's*, *Athlon* and *Phil Steele*, among others. Ogbah and senior defensive end Jimmy Bean present a formidable defensive end duo. Both were big contributors in the Cowboys' week one win, with Ogbah logging 1.5 sacks and three QB hurries (one of which led to a Tre Flowers interception) and Bean adding a sack and QB hurry of his own.
- ► OSU's linebacking corps is as deep as ever, with veterans Ryan Simmons and Seth Jacobs joined by up-and-comer Jordan Burton in the starting group. Chad Whitener, Devante Averette and Gyasi Akem are contributing as well.
- ▶ Between Kevin Peterson, Ashton Lampkin, Michael Hunter and Ramon Richards, OSU has four cornerbacks who have all logged a substantial amount of high-pressure game reps. Included on the watch list for the Jim Thorpe Award presented to the nation's top defensive back, Peterson is the leader of the group.
- ▶ Junior safety Jordan Sterns is a hidden standout in college football. He may not be a household name yet, but he has positioned himself well to make a substantial leap in 2015. He already holds the team lead in tackles after one game and is a formidable presence in the defensive backfield.

#### **DEFENSIVE BENCHMARKS**
