

## #22 Oklahoma State (2-5) vs. Incarnate Word (3-4)

Allie P. Reynolds Stadium (4,000) Stillwater, Okla.





#### Oklahoma State

Oklahoma State opens its 2016 home schedule this week with five games at Allie P. Reynolds Stadium, beginning with a pair of midweek contests against Incarnate Word. The 22nd-ranked Cowboys are 2-5 on the season, with each of those losses coming by one run, and are looking to snap a four-game losing streak. OSU hosts UIW Tuesday and Wednesday, with each game starting at 4 p.m.; admission is free to both games.

Led by Donnie Walton and his .423 batting average, the Cowboys are hitting a collective .239 while the pitching staff owns a 3.23 ERA.

OSU is 3-0 in season home openers under head coach Josh Holliday, and the Cowboys are 31-3 all-time in season home openers at Reynolds Stadium (only losses in 1984, 2000 and 2004).

The Cowboys are coming off a 38-20 season in which they made their third consecutive NCAA Regional appearance, and expectations are again high. OSU was ranked in the top 10 nationally in four different preseason polls and returns seven starters from 2015, including All-Big 12 Conference performers Donnie Walton, Ryan Sluder and Corey Hassel.

The 2016 season will mark OSU's fourth under Holliday, who compiled a 127-57 record in his first three seasons at his alma mater

#### **About The Cardinals**

Incarnate Word is 3-4 on the season and comes to Stillwater on a two-game losing streak. The Cardinals are hitting .237 as a team, while their pitching staff sports a 5.00 ERA.

Tuesday - LHP Austin Preiss (0-0, 4.76)

Wednesday - RHP John Shull (0-0, 3.00)

Oklahoma State won its only previous meeting with Incarnate Word, which came in the 2014 season opener at the UTA/Hilton Invitational in Arlington, Texas. The Cowboys were 10-5 victors in that game.

#### In The Polls

OSU is ranked as high as No. 22 in this week's national polls, earning that spot from *Baseball America*. The Cowboys are also ranked 24th by Perfect Game and 25th by *D1Baseball.com*. (Neither a *USA Today* coaches or NCBWA poll has been released yet this week).

OSU has been ranked in at least one national poll for 54 consecutive weeks dating back to 2013, when the Cowboys were in the polls for the final 14 weeks of the season. During that time, they have spent 16 weeks in the Top 10 and been ranked as high as No. 3 (by the NCBWA in 2014). They finished the '14 season ranked 10th in each of the final polls, marking the 19th time in program history OSU ended the season in the top 10 in the national polls.

#### 2.500 Club

Oklahoma State is one of just 18 programs in Division I history to reach 2,500 victories and began 2016 with 2,513 alltime wins. Of those achieving that feat, only one has played fewer season's than OSU's 104 (Florida State with 68). OSU entered the 2016 season ranked sixth all time in NCAA history with a .665 winning percentage.

#### The Century Mark

In his third season as head coach at his alma mater, Josh Holliday became the sixth skipper to record 100 career wins at Oklahoma State. Holliday's 100th win came on March 13, 2015, against Grand Canyon in his 143rd game, making him the second-fastest Cowboy boss to reach 100 victories.

#### **Omaha**

The Cowboys' coaching staff is no stranger to the College World Series, with Josh Holliday and Rob Walton combining for nine CWS appearances as either a player or coach.

Holliday played on a pair of CWS teams at OSU (1996 & 1999) and has coached in the CWS as an assistant at Georgia Tech (2006), Arizona State (2009) and Vanderbilt (2011).

Walton spent four seasons as a pitcher at OSU from 1983-86, and each of those teams appeared in the CWS.

#### **Baseball In Their Blood**

Baseball — and Oklahoma State — is definitely a family affair for Josh Holliday.

Josh's father, Tom, served as an OSU assistant coach for 19 years then took over as the Cowboys' head coach from 1997-2003, leading the program to its last College World Series appearance in 1999 (and coaching Josh in his final three collegiate seasons). Tom has spent four decades as a collegiate coach and was inducted into the Cowboy Baseball Hall of Fame in 2016.

Josh's younger brother, Matt, is an outfielder for the St. Louis Cardinals. In 12 major league seasons, Matt has been named to seven MLB All-Star teams.

Josh's uncle, Dave Holliday, was an OSU assistant coach from 1981-88 and has since held a variety of roles in Major League Baseball, including his current spot as a professional scout for the Atlanta Braves.

#### **Home Sweet Home**

Allie P. Reynolds Stadium has been home to Oklahoma State baseball since April 4, 1981, and in those 34 seasons, the Cowboys have been nearly unbeatable on their home field.

OSU is 880-208 (.809) all time at Reynolds Stadium and has lost more than two consecutive games on their home turf only five times (six in a row in 2007; three straight in 2010, 2012, 2013 and 2014).

The Cowboys were 19-8 on their home field in 2015.

### On The Road Again and Again and

As has become commonplace, OSU will open Big 12 Conference play on the road in 2016.

The Cowboys have begun league play at Allie P. Reynolds Stadium only twice since 2003 (in 2005 and 2013), and this season OSU will open at Kansas State.

The trend will continue in the near future as the conference office has set schedules for 2017 and 2018, and in each of those seasons, OSU opens Big 12 action away from Stillwater.

Since 2004 and spanning through 2018, OSU will have opened conference play on the road 13 times and only two times at home. Since Big 12 baseball began play in 1997, the Cowboys will have opened league play on the road 16 times and just six times in Stillwater.

#### It's Been Awhile

OSU has not lost a three-game Big 12 Conference series at Allie P. Reynolds Stadium since 2012 when it was swept by Texas A&M on the final weekend of the season. Over the last three seasons, the Cowboys have won nine consecutive three-game league series on their home field following a split in a rain-shortened two-game series with Baylor to open league play in 2013. (In 2015 OSU lost its only game vs. West Virginia in Stillwater — the final two games of the series were canceled due to weather).

# Josh Holliday

Head Coach, Fourth Season

Josh Holliday returned home to take over the Oklahoma State baseball program when he was named the 15th head coach in program history on June 8, 2012.

Holliday's hire has paid huge and immediate dividends as he has led the OSU program back to national prominence in his first three years at the helm

Since taking over the reins, Holliday has guided the Cowboys to threestraight NCAA Tournament appearances, the program's first-ever regular season Big 12 Conference championship and its third NCAA Super Regional berth. During Holliday's three-year tenure, the Cowboys have won 127 games, the second-highest win total among Big 12 teams during that span.

The Oklahoma State alumnus and native of Stillwater made an immediate impact in his first season at the helm, leading the Cowboys to a 41-19 record and the finals of the NCAA Louisville Regional.

OSU's 41 wins in 2013 was its most since 2008, and the Cowboys' second-place finish in the Big 12 Conference was also its best in five years

Under Holliday's direction, the Cowboys won five of their eight Big 12 series, including four in a row to end the season, and OSU had 11 players garner All-Big 12 accolades, its most since 2008.

OSU's second season under Holliday was even better, and he became the first-ever Cowboy skipper to be named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year.

In 2014, the Cowboys went 48-18, marking the most wins for the program since 1994. OSU captured the Big 12 regular season crown with an 18-6 mark, then went on to win the NCAA Stillwater Regional championship and advance to the NCAA Stillwater Super Regional, its first Super Regional appearance since 2007.

The 2014 season also saw the Cowboys win their final seven Big 12 Conference series and rank in the top 10 nationally in five categories, including home runs, walks, sacrifice bunts and winning percentage.

Further adding to the accolades, 2014 also saw a pair of Cowboys — Brendan McCurry and Zach Fish — earn All-America honors. Fish was named the Big 12 Player of the Year and was one of 11 Cowboys to garner All-Big 12 accolades, which included a school-record six first-team honorees.

Holliday is the first former OSU player to serve as the program's head coach. A four-year letterwinner for the Cowboys from 1996-99, Holliday was a starter on teams that made four NCAA Tournament appearances and reached the College World Series in 1996 and 1999.

For 11 years, Holliday served as an assistant coach at some of the nation's top baseball programs. He started his coaching career at OSU before serving on the staffs at North Carolina State, Georgia Tech, Arizona State and Vanderbilt. He coached seven NCAA Tournament teams and three of those advanced to the College World Series (Georgia Tech in 2006, Arizona State in 2009 and Vanderbilt in 2011).

A four-year letterwinner who played in 256 games, which ranks second all time at OSU, Holliday compiled a career .311 batting average to go along with 53 home runs, 62 doubles and 237 RBIs. He was inducted into the OSU Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003.

Holliday's name is prominent throughout the OSU record book. He is OSU's all-time leader in base on balls with 225 and ranks in the top five on the Cowboys' career lists in games, at bats, runs, hits, doubles, total bases, RBIs and hit by pitches while ranking seventh in homers.

Holliday was a three-time All-Big 12 performer, earning first-team honors in 1998 (at catcher) and 1999 (at third base). He was a second-team selection as a utility player in 1997 and was named the Big Eight Conference Freshman of the Year and a Freshman All-American in 1996.

#### Big 12's Best

Oklahoma State's .690 winning percentage (127-57) from 2013-15 marked the highest in the Big 12 Conference during that span. TCU came in second at .677, with the Cowboys only trailing the Horned Frogs by one in the win column.

OSU has also finished first or second in the league standings each of the last three years, and the Cowboys are the only Big 12 team over that span to finish over .500 in conference play each year.

#### **Comeback Cowboys**

Come-from-behind victories have become a trend for the Cowboys under Josh Holliday. OSU has overcome deficits to win 61 games in Holliday's three seasons, notching 18 comeback wins in 2013, 28 in 2014 and 15 a year ago.

### **Awards Show**

A number of Cowboys who earned all-conference recognition a year ago return in 2015.

Donnie Walton was named to the All-Big 12 First Team as an infielder last season, while outfielders Ryan Sluder and Corey Hassel each picked up All-Big 12 Second Team honors.

Earning All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades were first baseman Dustin Williams and pitchers Trey Cobb and Remey Reed, while Jacob Chappell was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team.

#### I Feel A Draft

OSU has nine players on its 2016 roster who have been Major League Baseball Draft picks, including a pair of two-time draftees in Conor Costello (2011, Cincinnati, 16th/2015, Pittsburgh 38th) and Donnie Walton (2012, NY Mets, 36th/2015, Milwaukee, 23rd). Other MLB Draft picks include: Garrett Benge (2015, Cleveland, 22nd); Thomas Hatch (2013, Colorado, 32nd); Jon Littell (2014, Washington, 39th); David Petrino (2014, Chicago Cubs, 39th); Andrew Rosa (2013, Boston, 30th); Collin Theroux (2015, Minnesota, 33rd); and Garrett Williams (2013, San Diego, 33rd).

#### **Close Calls**

OSU is 26-18 in one-run games since 2013, and each of the Cowboys' five losses this season are by a single run, including four walk-off defeats. Under head coach Josh Holliday (2013-pres.), 38 of the Cowboys' 62 losses have come by two runs or less. In 2015, 14 of OSU's 20 losses were by two runs or less.

### **Generating Offense Every Which Way**

In 2015, OSU led the Big 12 in on-base percentage (.381), walks (282) and sacrifice bunts (81), and the Cowboys ranked second in runs (380), home runs (41), RBIs (338), stolen bases (89) and sacrifice flies (26).

#### Small Rall

OSU has smashed program records for sacrifice bunts each of the last three years.

In 2014, the Cowboys were third nationally with 88 sacrifice bunts, which trumped the 2013 team's 74 sac bunts to set a program record. Donnie Walton ranked fourth in the NCAA in 2014 with 22 sac bunts, while Gage Green tallied 11.

Last season, OSU led the NCAA with 81 sacrifice bunts and four different Cowboys had at least 10 sac bunts on the

Walton has racked up an OSU career-record 53 sacrifice bunts, a total which ranks 10th on the NCAA's all-time list.

### Strong-Armed

In three seasons under the direction of coach Rob Walton, OSU's pitching staff has turned in impressive numbers.

The Cowboys' success under Walton includes 12 All-Big 12 pitchers, two consensus first-team All-Americans, a Big 12

Pitcher of the Year and a first-round Major League Baseball Draft pick.

Here's just a sampling of how the Cowboys have performed under Walton:

- OSU's pitching staff led the Big 12 in ERA in conference-only games in 2014 (2.43) and 2015 (2.50).
- The Cowboys' 2.84 ERA in 2015 ranked eighth nationally and was the lowest by an OSU pitching staff since 1973.
- OSU recorded seven shutouts in both 2013 and 2014, marking just the fourth and fifth times in program history the Cowboys had reached that mark. In the 26 seasons prior to 2013, the program had reached seven shutouts only once.
- Over the last three seasons, OSU has seen Jason Hursh drafted in the first round of the 2013 Major League Baseball Draft, Brendan McCurry (2014) and Michael Freeman (2015) named first-team All-Americans and Freeman garner Big 12 Pitcher of the Year honors.
  - Freeman's 1.31 ERA ranked sixth in the NCAA in 2015 and was the fifth lowest in a single season in OSU history.
  - McCurry set OSU records for single-season saves (19) and career saves (27).

#### **Back In The Saddle**

Donnie Walton spurned professional baseball last summer to return for his senior season with the Cowboys in 2016. Walton has established himself as one of the Big 12's elite players since arriving on campus in 2013. In 163 career games, the switch hitter owns a .311 batting average to go along with nine home runs, 95 RBIs, 33 doubles and an OSU-record 53 sacrifice bunts (which ranks 10th on the NCAA's all-time list).

Primarily a shortstop throughout his career, Walton is one of just nine players in OSU history to earn All-Big 12 First Team accolades twice (in 2014 & 2015), with no Cowboy ever achieving that status three times.

A 23rd-round draft pick of the Milwaukee Brewers last June, Walton chose not to sign a pro contract and instead starred in the prestigious Cape Cod Baseball League. He was named the CCBL All-Star Game MVP and then earned the Star of Stars Award as the most valuable player of the CCBL playoffs after leading the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox to the league championship

Walton is one of 50 players on USA Baseball's 2016 Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List. The award is given to the top player in amateur baseball.

#### Hometown Hero

Corey Hassel played in 86 games and hit just .208 in his first two seasons at OSU, but the Stillwater native had a breakout junior campaign for his hometown Cowbovs in 2015.

Used mostly as a late-game defensive replacement and pinch runner in 2013 and 2014, Hassel became a regular starter in the outfield as a junior and led the Cowboys with a .312 batting average. He also topped OSU in multi-hit games (18) and multi-RBI efforts (11) en route to All-Big 12 Second Team honors. In conference play, Hassel hit .344 with two home runs and 18 RBIs and led OSU in numerous offensive categories, including RBIs, hits (31) and doubles (6).

Spending the majority of the time as the Cowboys' leadoff hitter this season, Hassel owns a .296 batting average and is tied for the team lead with two stolen bases.

#### Sluder's Surge

Another breakout star for the Cowboys in 2015 was outfielder Ryan Sluder, who hit .284 with 67 at-bats in 35 games as a freshman but blossomed into an All-Big 12 Second Team performer in 2015.

As a sophomore, Sluder was second on the Cowboys with a .309 batting average, and led the club with 14 doubles and six homers. The Texan went on a tear in league games as he led OSU with a .403 average — the highest in the conference in Big 12 play — to go along with five homers, 10 RBIs and a .710 slugging percentage.

Sluder was named to the 2016 Perfect Game Preseason All-America Third Team.

#### Workhorse

Trey Cobb became the Cowboys' go-to pitcher out of the bullpen in 2015. His team-high 31 appearances marked the third most in a single season in OSU history, and the right-hander compiled a 5-2 record and two saves to go along with a 2.61 ERA. In 58.2 innings — all in relief — Cobb racked up 53 strikeouts, and opponents hit just .221 against him as he earned honorable mention All-Big 12 accolades.

#### **Two-Way Threat**

Conor Costello is another Cowboy who could have begun his professional career in 2015 but instead chose to return to Stillwater for his senior season in 2016 after being drafted in the 38th round by the Pittsburgh Pirates last June.

Costello's role is a big one as he'll be counted on to contribute on the mound and at the plate. In two seasons in an OSU uniform, he's smashed 15 home runs and collected 62 RBIs in 108 games, while also going 2-1 with a save in nine pitching appearances.

Named to the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award Watch List a year ago, Costello is expected to take on an increased pitching role in '16 after a season in which he went 2-0 with a save and a 1.67 ERA in seven outings.

Costello is second on the Cowboys with seven RBIs on the season and has three multi-RBI games.

#### The Injury Bug Took Big Bites

OSU overcame numerous injuries to key players in 2015, with many of those setbacks keeping those players out of the lineup for significant and extended periods of time.

- Donnie Walton missed 19 games with a wrist injury that required surgery to remove his hamate bone.
- Starting catcher Bryan Case missed 13 games with a broken thumb.
- Starting designated hitter Garrett McCain was hitting .313 before a broken bone in his hand required surgery and caused him to miss 19 games.
- Starting right fielder Conor Costello was among OSU's top hitters in Big 12 play before missing six games following an injury that caused him to be hospitalized for four days.
- Pitcher Blake Battenfield, who was 4-0 in 27 games as a freshman in 2014, pitched in only six games last season after an arm injury kept him out of action since March 28.
- Arm surgery limited infielder Andrew Rosa to just nine games in 2015, and Thomas Hatch did not pitch at all due to an arm injury both redshirted.
  - Relief pitcher Michael Mertz missed most of the season coming off arm surgery and pitched in only three games.

### **Building A Winner**

In the first three seasons as head coach at his alma mater (2013-15), Josh Holliday has built quite a resume. Just a few of the highlights:

- OSU's .690 winning percentage was the highest among Big 12 teams from 2013-15;
- OSU has finished first or second in the conference standings each year (1st in 2014, 2nd in 2013 and 2015);
- The Cowboys finished in the top 10 in the national rankings in 2014 after ending the 2013 season ranked as high as No. 19. Counting the 2016 preseason polls, they've been nationally ranked for 52 consecutive weeks.
- In 2014, OSU advanced to the third Super Regional in program history and won its first-ever Big 12 Conference regular season championship;
  - OSU has hosted two NCAA Regionals and been the top-seeded team both times;
  - The Cowboys have earned three NCAA Regional berths and advanced to the regional championship round twice;
  - OSU has won at least five of its eight Big 12 Conference series each season (5 in 2013, 7 in 2014, 6 in 2015).
