QUICK HITTERS

- The Jackets received their highest preseason ranking in program history of No. 9 in the AVCA DI Coaches Preseason Poll.
- Overall, the nine spot ties the sixth-highest ranking Tech has received in its 42-year history. The Jackets' selection marks the second consecutive appearance in the AVCA's top 10 after being tabbed No. 8 at the end of the 2021 season.
- The Yellow Jackets have been listed in 39 straight top 25 polls to date, reaching as high as No. 6 during that time, the highest for the program since 2003 and third best mark all time.
- Tech was picked to finish third in the ACC by the league's coaches for the third consecutive year.
- Senior outside hitter Julia Bergmann, sophomore outside hitter Bianca Bertolino and senior middle blocker Erin Moss were each selected preseason all-ACC.
- Going beyond 2019's NIVC title, Tech has won 58 of its last 70 matches.
- The Jackets boast 13 total returners from 2021's Elite Eight squad heading into the 2022 campaign.
- Joining the incumbents are a pair of transfers, 2021 all-American Tamara Otene (Illinois State) and Marmen (UCF), along with freshmen Cara Bianco, Anna Boezi and Mikayla White.
- Reigning AVCA East Coast Region Coach of the Year Michelle Collier will lead the Jackets for her ninth season.

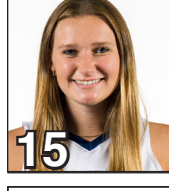

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

Georgia Tech will battle stiff competition on the road to a potential third straight appearance in the Big Dance as 10 of its 2022 opponents competed in the 64-team field of the 2021 NCAA Division I Volleyball Championship, excluding exhibition opponent South Carolina who also advanced to the postseason.

The White and Gold will play 13 total matches against those 10 teams, including four against two Final Four opponents and three against Sweet 16 opponents.

Debarring Dayton who received votes, six of the aforementioned 10 teams finished ranked in the final 2021 American Volleyball Coaches Association Top 25, including two in the top five and three in the top 10.

Tech will play 12 matches against nine teams that are currently ranked or receiving votes in No. 4 Louisville, No. 6 Pitt, No. 7 Ohio State, No. 10 BYU, No. 17 Illinois, Dayton (RV), North Carolina (RV), Miami (RV) and Florida State (RV), all of which advanced to the NCAA tournament.

DANCE WITH WHO BROUGHT YOU

Georgia Tech returned 13 players from 2021's Elite Eight squad, including four regular starters plus the libero, highlighted by Julia Bergmann (2021 AVCA First Team All-American, AVCA East Coast Region Player of the Year and All-Region, ACC Player of the Year and All-ACC First Team).

NEW KIDS ON THE FLATS

The incumbents are joined by five newcomers, including a pair of transfers in all-American Tamara Otene (outside hitter - Illinois State) and Tali Marmen (outside hitter - UCF) along with freshmen Cara Bianco (libero), Anna Boezi (right side/middle blocker) and Mikayla White (outside hitter) to complete this year's team.

OUTSIDE OPINIONS

Tech was slated to finish third in the ACC preseason coaches poll for the third consecutive year as senior outside hitter Julia Bergmann, sophomore outside hitter Bianca Bertolino (2021 ACC All-Freshman) and senior middle blocker Erin Moss (2021 All-ACC Second Team) were each selected preseason all-ACC.

ON THE BRINK

After the Jackets rewrote the program record books in 2021, Bergmann remains on the verge of career and program milestones, including:

Bergmann eclipsed 1,000 career kills in 2021, currently owning 1,193. She needs 1,455 to tie Carla Gartner (1995-98) and crack the top 10 in program history.

On top of that, Bergmann, moved into ninth in program history in career aces currently owning 130. The next highest marks for the Yellow Jackets all time include 131 for eighth (Amanda Medrow - 1996-99), 132 for seventh (Lindsey Gray) and 143 for sixth (Margaret Gales - 1986-89).

Bergmann narrowly missed 500 kills last season, finishing with 497.

UP WITH THE WHITE AND GOLD

Coach Michelle Collier earned her 150th win while manning the reins at Georgia Tech over the Citadel in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. She now owns 152 wins at Tech, the third most in program history. For her career as a head coach, Collier owns 191 wins after accumulating 40 wins over her first two seasons as a head coach at Jacksonville.

As a student-athlete at USF, Collier ranks among the greatest collegiate volleyball players of all-time. She ranks fifth in NCAA Division I history with 2,729 career kills and ranks in the Bulls' top-10 in numerous career and single-season categories. She holds the top spot in USF history in two career categories (kills and digs, 1,747) and set three single-season marks during the 2000 season. After coming back from an injury that sidelined her in 1999, Collier compiled 760 kills, 1,873 attacks and 6.28 kills per set.

STACKING UP

Georgia Tech leads Ole Miss in the all-time series, 2-1. The Yellow Jackets claimed the last two matchups, winning in five sets on the road in 2008 before downing the Rebels, 3-1, on The Flats in 2009.

Illinois has taken the previous four meetings against the White and Gold.

VAI BRAZIL!

Georgia Tech has five representatives from the South American country. Junior Julia Bergmann competed for Club Abel (Brusque) in Brazil (along with current professional Mariana Brambilla) on top of her national team experience. Transfers Nicole Drennick and Paola Pimentel also each have experience at the international level for Brazil. Head coach Michelle Collier hails from Recife and assistant coach Claudio Pinheiro is from Sao Paulo. Pinheiro coached the Brazil women's team to Olympic gold medals in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics.

ILLUSTRIOUS ON IG

Between her swarm on The Flats and in Brazil, Bergmann's social presence has grown to over 102,000 followers on Instagram to date (@juliabergmann6).

BERGMANN BULLETS

A preseason all-ACC selection, Julia Bergmann put together one of the most decorated individual seasons in Yellow Jacket history in 2021 before spending her summer with the Brazilian national team, helping propel them to a silver medal.

She finished second in the competition amongst the world's best on serve receive (137) while ranking top five on her squad in points (139), kills (121), blocks (11), aces (seven) and digs (80). Bergmann's junior season in 2021 culminated with being named an AVCA First Team All-American.

Bergmann (along with Mariana Brambilla) became the first Yellow Jacket to be named a First Team All-Americans since Kele Eveland in 2003, previously the only player in ACC history to garner the recognition. Bergmann was also an honorable mention all-American in 2020-21.

Bergmann became the fourth Yellow Jacket in program history to receive the prestigious award as top player in the ACC while naturally garnering unanimous First Team All-ACC honors.

In her career, Bergmann now owns one ACC Player of the Year, three First Team All-ACC honors, one ACC Freshman of the Year and one ACC All-Freshman Team selection.

Bergmann followed her ACC accolades by becoming the first Jacket on record to be voted Region Player of the Year, while also being tabbed All-Region. Bergmann now owns three career All-Region honors and a Region Freshman of the Year award.

Along with her yearly awards from the conference, Bergmann racked up awards on a national scale during the 2021 season, being named AVCA Player of the Week, ACC Player of the Week four times, UCF Challenge MVP and to three all-tournament teams. Her AVCA honor as the best player in the nation for the week marked the first time a Yellow Jacket has received the award since Kele Eveland on Sep. 15, 2003.

After receiving the honor in back-to-back weeks, Bergmann became the first student-athlete in the conference to receive ACC Player of the Week four times in a season since 2015.

In addition to last season's accolades, Bergmann has received five career ACC Player of the Week honors and seven total Atlantic Coast Conference weekly awards after earning ACC Freshman of the Week twice in her first season on The Flats.

Bergmann's numbers backed up her accolades as she finished among the nation's best in multiple categories. The veteran led the Jacket attack with 497 kills (4.44 per set) and 36 service aces along with pitching in on the defensive end with 292 digs and 67 total blocks (22 solo, 45 assisted). She also eclipsed 1,000 career kills this season, owning 1,193 to date.

On a national scale, those marks placed her 12th in the NCAA in points (577.5) and 13th in the country in kills (497) as she led the league in both categories. Other notable numbers for the powerful outside hitter include ranking 16th in the country in points per set (5.16) and 21st in the nation in kills per set (4.44), ranking second in the conference in both categories.

As Bergmann has spearheaded the Jacket attack, some of her biggest performances came in the biggest moments as she earned her AVCA weekly honor and first ACC Player of the Week on the year after Tech downed No. 17

Penn State (previously No. 12) and picked up her second ACC Player of the Week recognition after the Jackets' historic win over Pitt.

In one of Tech's biggest wins in program history, the heavy hitter piled up 24 kills at a solid .386 clip, including a pair of aces as well as six digs and four total blocks (one solo, three assisted) in the triumph over Pitt.

The week before, she compiled 30 kills against Notre Dame, the highest total by not only any Yellow Jacket on the season, but also any player in the ACC in 2021.

SPREADING THEIR WINGS

Along with Bergmann, Bertolino and incoming graduate transfer outside hitter Tali Marmen have both gained experience at the international level. Bertolino, an ACC All-Freshman Team honoree in her first collegiate season, trained and competed with Argentina's national team while Marmen helped Israel's national team win the 2022 Maccabiah Games.

FRESH START

Sophomore outside hitter Bianca Bertolino staked her claim as one of the top freshman in the conference last season, being named to the ACC All-Freshman Team.

Throughout the year, she won ACC Freshman of the Week a league-high five times, including back-to-back honors in the first two weeks of her collegiate career and three times since. The Argentinian also was selected to two all-tournament teams and picked up 10 double doubles in 2021.

YOU GOT MOSS'ED

Junior middle Blocker Erin Moss was one of the most efficient attackers in Georgia Tech history from the middle over the past two seasons.

In 2020-21, she posted a .411 attacking percentage to rank third all-time on The Flats.

She carried that consistency into 2021, ranking third in the ACC and 34th in the NCAA in hitting percentage at a 0.381 clip. That percentage again ranked among the best in a season for the program, placing seventh all time in single-season hitting percentage.

SWARMING THE NEST

Tech sold out 11 of its 15 home matches in 2021, going 12-3 in front of the raucous home crowd in O'Keefe Gymnasium

FLYING HIGH

To cap the 2021 season, Georgia Tech earned three AVCA All-American honors for Julia Bergmann (First Team All-American) along with the graduated pair of Mariana Brambilla (First Team All-American) and Matti McKissock (Honorable Mention).

Brambilla and Bergmann became the first Yellow Jackets to be named First Team All-Americans since Kele Eveland in 2003, previously the only player in ACC history to garner the recognition. The duo also become Georgia Tech's first pair to earn First Team All-American honors.

Including McKissock's Honorable Mention, the slew of awards marks the second-most All-American honors in a season in program history for the White and Gold, trailing just the 2003 squad with four total honors, including Eveland, Lynette Moster (Third Team), Alexandra Preiss (Honorable Mention) and Lauren Sauer (Honorable Mention).

Bergmann and Brambilla earned back-to-back All-American recognitions after

Brambilla was named Third Team All-American and Bergmann was tabbed Honorable Mention a season ago.

Prior to the AVCA's All-American honors, the Yellow Jackets received five AVCA honors in the East Coast region as coach Michelle Collier was named Region Coach of the Year for a program-high tying second time in her career, junior outside hitter Julia Bergmann became the first Jacket on record to be voted Region Player of the Year and Bergmann, senior outside hitter Mariana Brambilla and senior setter Matti McKissock were all tabbed All-Region.

Bergmann now owns three All-Region honors and a Region Freshman of the Year award, while Brambilla matches Bergmann's three consecutive All-Region honors. McKissock has received two All-Region honors and an Honorable Mention.

Georgia Tech earned six yearly ACC honors, highlighted by junior outside hitter Julia Bergmann being named ACC Player of Year. Bergmann became the fourth Yellow Jacket in program history to receive the prestigious award.

Along with Bergmann's nod for best in the league, the powerful outside hitter also garnered unanimous First Team All-ACC honors. Senior outside hitter Mariana Brambilla was also unanimously named First Team All-ACC, while senior setter Matti McKissock was tabbed First Team All-ACC as well. Senior middle blocker Breland Morrisette was named Second Team All-ACC, and freshman Bianca Bertolino was selected to the ACC All-Freshman Team.

While Morrisette and Bertolino earned their first year ACC awards, Bergmann (ACC Player of the Year, 3x First Team All-ACC, ACC Freshman of the Year and ACC All-Freshman Team), Brambilla (3x First Team All-ACC, ACC All-Freshman) and McKissock (ACC Setter of the Year, 2x First Team All-ACC, Second Team All-ACC) each piled onto their already decorated career tallies.

At 26-6 overall and 14-4 in ACC play, Tech finished at No. 8 in the final AVCA Top 25 poll, tying 2003's Yellow Jackets for the highest ranking in program history at a season's end.

Tech was in the top 15 for the eight consecutive weeks to close out the 2021 season.

Since appearing in the Top 25 at No. 12 on Sept. 30, 2020, Georgia Tech has been listed in 39 straight top 25 polls to date.

The Yellow Jackets steadily climbed up the NCAA's Rating Percentage Index this season, ranking as high as No. 6 for three consecutive weeks and finishing at No. 7.

Bergmann is the first student-athlete in the conference to receive ACC Player of the Week four times in a season since 2015, and Bertolino led the league in ACC Freshman of the Week honors with five.

The Jackets racked up 12 ACC weekly awards on the year, the most in program history on record. The staggering tally led the league this season.

Georgia Tech had at least one recipient of an ACC weekly award in eight of the 14 weeks the conference has recognized winners this season.

Of the Jackets' 26 wins on the season, 16 were sweeps, including nine in ACC play and three in the NCAA tournament.

As a whole, Tech finished with exactly 1,700 kills as a team in 2021, good for seventh in program history in team kills in a season.

The Jackets earned a dominant aggregate sets record, leading opponents

83-29. Tech led 22-10 in set one, 28-4 in set two, 23-9 in set three and 9-5 in set four while tying 1-1 in five-set contests

Georgia Tech went on a winning streak as high as 10 matches in ACC play last season.

Tech was 10-2 in true road matches this season, going 8-1 away from The Flats in ACC play. The .833 win percentage away from The Flats marks the second-highest highest road winning percentage in program history. The 10 road wins were also the third highest mark in the ACC in 2021.

The Yellow Jackets previously won nine consecutive true road matches, marking the best start on the road in program history.

Going beyond 2019's NIVC title, Tech has won 58 of its last 70 matches.

The Jackets have won 35 of their last 40 matches on The Flats in O'Keefe Gymnasium.

Georgia Tech finished with some of the top numbers in the country, pacing the nation in kills per set (15.18) and assists per set (13.90). Based on the 2021 NCAA record book, Tech's kills per set mark is set to become an NCAA record as one of the top marks in the history of the sport. The Jackets were also sixth in the NCAA and second in the ACC in hitting percentage (0.291). Other notable numbers include ranking second in the ACC and 10th in the NCAA in kills (1,700), second in the conference and 14th in the country assists (1,557) and third in the league in digs per set (15.15).

In a sweep of North Carolina, Tech averaged a .490 hitting percentage, good for 9th in program history.

The Jackets have also tallied seven solo blocks four times this season (against UCF, Indiana, Oklahoma and Wake Forest), tying seventh in program history in single match solo blocks each time.

In the RPI specifically, Georgia Tech earned wins over No. 3 Pitt in the regular season and No. 10 Ohio State in the Sweet 16, four wins over top 15 teams (adding No. 13 UCLA and No. 14 Miami), six wins over top 25 teams (adding No. 19 WKU, No. 20 Florida State twice, No. 22 UCF and No. 25 Penn State) and 10 wins over top 50 teams (adding No. 26 Mississippi State, No. 32 North Carolina, No. 42 Syracuse and No. 44 Arkansas)

Of the Jackets' 26 wins last season, 16 were sweeps, including nine in ACC play. Of those sweeps, eight came over RPI top 50 opponents including No. 10 Ohio State in the Sweet 16, No. 19 WKU in the second round of the NCAA tournament, No. 20 Florida State (to close out the regular season), No. 25 Penn State, No. 26 Mississippi State, No. 32 North Carolina, No. 42 Syracuse and No. 44 Arkansas.

TECH IN THE TOURNAMENT

With sweeps of The Citadel and No. 17 WKU in the first and second rounds of the NCAA tournament at home in O'Keefe Gymnasium followed by another sweep of No. 9 Ohio State at the Louisville Regional, Georgia Tech advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time since 2003 and second time in program history before falling to undefeated, No. 1 seed Louisville.

The Yellow Jackets are now 13-11 all time in the Big Dance.

Georgia Tech was slated as the No. 8 national seed in the NCAA Tournament, the second highest tournament seed in program history.

Following 2020's run to the second round of the NCAA tournament, the Yellow Jackets made back-to-back tournament appearances for the first time since advancing to the Big Dance five straight years from 2000-04.

The selection marked the second berth in the Big Dance for the Yellow Jackets under head coach Michelle Collier.

With the selection, the Jackets made their 11th NCAA tournament appearance in program history.

Tech's first action in the Big Dance came in 1994 after winning the ACC regular season title. The Jackets would advance to the second round of the tournament that season and follow suit for the next pair of seasons.

Tech reached the second round of the tournament after winning a second consecutive ACC regular season title as well as the ACC Tournament title in 1995 and placing second in the ACC in 1996.

From 1999-2004, Georgia Tech reached five straight NCAA Tournaments, advancing as far as the Elite Eight in 2003 followed by the Sweet 16 in 2004. Over that span, the Jackets claimed three ACC regular season titles and one ACC Tournament title.

Tech reached the first round of the tournament in 2009, and most recently advanced to the second round of the 2020 NCAA tournament a season ago.

MAGIC MOMENTS

Georgia Tech handed No. 3 Pitt (previously No. 2) its first loss of the season in five sets in the first matchup between the two.

Previously facing their highest ranked opponent since No. 1 USC in 2004, the Jackets' triumph marked the highest ranked win in program history.

Tech's monumental win also became the second top-five victory in Georgia Tech history. The Yellow Jackets' previous highest ranked victory also came on the road in five sets over No. 5 Nebraska in 2003.

Along with the historic defeat of Pitt, Tech also owns season-opening victory over another ranked opponent in No. 15 Penn State (previously No. 12). At the time, the win marked the highest ranked triumph for Tech since the 2003 NCAA tournament, the first ranked victory for the program since 2017 and the first win over the Nittany Lions in Georgia Tech history. For Penn State, the defeat marked its first nonconference loss outside the top 10 since 2016.

A NIGHT TO REMEMBER

Going back two seasons, Bergmann led the Jackets with a historic performance in the First Round of the 2020 NCAA Women's Volleyball Championship. In her first career match in the Big Dance, she piled up a career-high 31 kills against Lipscomb for the most ever by a Yellow Jacket in an NCAA Tournament match and the most by a Georgia Tech player in any outing in almost 16 years (Talisa Kellogg – 35 vs. Virginia, Oct. 22, 2005).

Bergmann became only the sixth player in Tech history to ever record as many as 31 kills in a single match.
