RALLY POINTS

- Ole Miss volleyball opens the season at home, taking on a pair of top-20 opponents in No. 9 Georgia Tech Friday at 4 p.m. CT and No. 17 Illinois Sunday at 1 p.m.
- The Ole Miss Invitational will mark the third-ever matchup between the Rebels and both schools. The all-time series is tied 1-1 with Georgia Tech, while Illinois leads 2-0.
- The Rebels are coming off one of their best seasons in school history, notching its first 20-win regular season since 2013 and finishing tied for fifth in the SEC with 10 conference victories.
- Middle blocker Sasha Ratliff was one of 15 student-athletes named to the Preseason All-SEC Team. She earned all-conference honors last year after a breakout sophomore campaign.
- Gone from the 2021 squad are AVCA All-Region and All-SEC performer Kylee McLaughlin, outside hitter Lauren Thompson, middle blocker Aubrey Sultemeier and libero Sam Burgio.
- The Rebels return 12 members from last season's NCAA Tournament team, including leading attacker and AVCA All-Region Honorable Mention outside hitter Anna Bair.
- Ole Miss finished 1-5 against top-25 teams last season, with the lone win coming at No. 15 Western Kentucky.
- In year two, Kayla Banwarth and the Rebels saw a 65 percent increase in winning percentage, the best turnaround in Division I Volleyball.

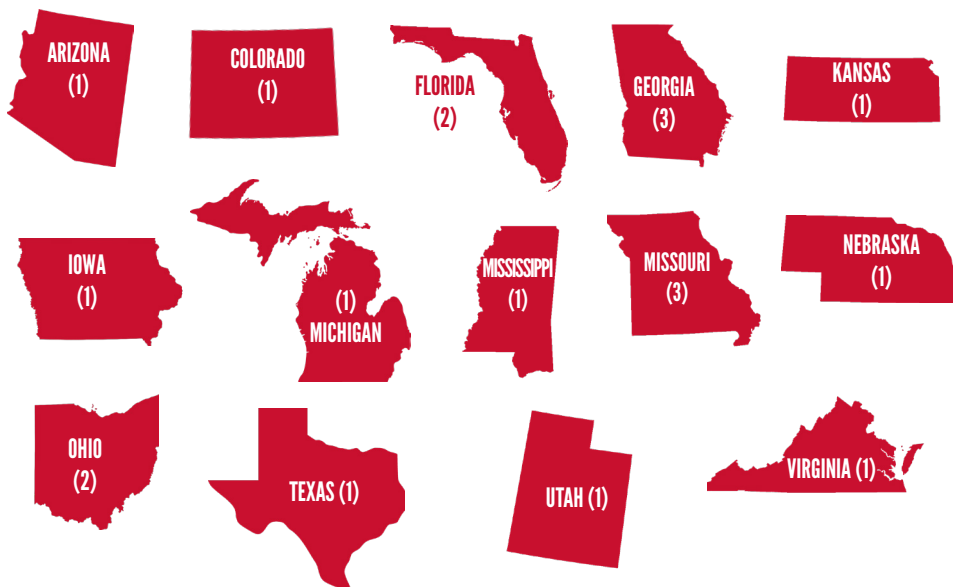

SCOUTING THE FIELD

Reigning AVCA East Coast Region Coach of the Year Michelle Collier is in her ninth season with the Jackets. Georgia Tech boasts 13 returners from last year's 26-6 Elite Eight squad, including reigning ACC player of the year and first team all-American Julia Bergmann, along with All-ACC Second Team selection Breland Morrisette and ACC All-Freshman Team member Bianca Bertolino. Georgia Tech checked in at No. 9 in the AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Preseason Poll. As a team, the Jackets hit .291 last season, the sixth-best mark nationally and led the country with 15.2 kills per set.

Illinois finished last season with a 22-12 overall record and its third NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in the last five years under head coach Chris Tamas. The Illini return 12 members from last season's squad and welcome in one transfer and three freshmen. Illinois takes a No. 17 AVCA Preseason ranking into the weekend's matchups. As a team, Illinois ranked inside the top-10 nationally in assists per set (sixth, 13.55), digs per set (sixth, 17.64) and kills per set (fourth, 14.91).

SERIES HISTORY

Friday's matchup with Georgia Tech to open the 2022 season marks the third-ever meeting between the two schools. The series between the Rebels and Yellow Jackets is tied at one game apiece, with Ole Miss winning 3-1 in 1991 and Georgia Tech taking the 2008 match in five sets. On Sunday, the Rebels will look for their first win over Illinois. The Illini lead the all-time series 2-0, winning in 1995 and 2006.

PUTTING THE LEAGUE ON NOTICE

Ole Miss junior middle blocker Sasha Ratliff was one of fifteen student-athletes selected to the 2022 Preseason Volleyball All-SEC Team. Ratliff established herself as one of the top middle-blockers in the SEC last season, earning an all-conference nod as well as AVCA All-Region honors. The Atlanta, Georgia, native paced the team with a school record 113 assisted blocks and was one shy of the single-season total block record with 129. Ratliff was also a top offensive contributor, ranking third in the conference and 28th nationally at a .385 hitting clip.

FROM 1-19 TO THE BIG DANCE

Last season, Kayla Banwarth and the Rebels did something no one thought they could. Following a 1-19 showing during the 2020-21 season, Ole Miss flipped the script and recorded its first 20-win season since 2017 and made the NCAA Tournament for just the fourth time in school history. The turnaround by the Rebels was the best in Division I Volleyball in terms of winning percentage (a 65 percent increase). Ole Miss was also one of two Power Five teams and five programs nationally to see a 20-plus win improvement from the previous year. Heading into year three, Banwarth and the Rebels have made it clear that they want to repeat and build on last season's success and take the program to new heights.

HOT HANDS

Coming off a program record .255 hitting percentage last season, the Ole Miss offense is primed for another big season on the attack. The .255 mark ranked fourth in the SEC and was 33rd in the NCAA. The Rebels return 71.7 percent of their kills from 2021, led by AVCA All-Region honorable mention outside hitter Anna Bair. Returners Samantha Schnitta, Julia Dyess and Katie Corelli are also back and looking to continue last season's attacking success. Middle blockers Sasha Ratliff and Payton Brgoch are also major offensive contributors, with both racking up over 150 kills and hitting above .320 last season.

MEET YOU AT THE NET

A year ago, Ole Miss was a dominant force at the net, breaking the single-season program records for block assists (427) and total blocks (265.5). The Rebels were one of the SEC and nation's best when it came to stuffing opposing attackers. As a team, they ranked fourth in the conference and 54th nationally with 265.5 total blocks. Leading the charge for Ole Miss was the middle duo of Sasha Ratliff and Payton Brgoch. The two have big plans for their junior season after averaging 1.17 and 1.12 blocks per set, respectively, last season.

ROOKIES IN THE RANKINGS

Head coach Kayla Banwarth added top talent to the Rebels' 2022 class with the addition of six signees, including multiple Prep Volleyball Top-150 honorees. Five of the six new Rebels received AVCA High School All-America honors their senior year, tied with Florida for the most in the nation.

Aly Borellis makes her way to Oxford as a four-year letterwinner at Notre Dame Preparatory and a member of the Prep Volleyball Top-150 list. She helped guide her high school to the State Championship all four years, taking home the title in 2021 while picking up All-State honors in 2019 and 2020. A decorated setter out of Rochester, Michigan, Borellis has racked up multiple All-American honors in her high school career, including a pair of PrepVolleyball First Team honors, AAU All-American laurels and 2021 AVCA First Team All-American honors. She finished her prep career with over 2600 assists, 1800 kills and 1300 digs.

Middle blocker Tessa Jones joins the Rebels as a Prep Volleyball Top-150 recruit and 2021 AVCA Honorable Mention High School All-American. In her four-year career at Seton High School in Cleves, Ohio, Jones tallied 606 kills and racked up 144 total blocks.

Outside hitter Shayla Meyer closed out her high school career with over 1,700 kills. The Superior, Nebraska, native was named first team All-Conference three years in a row, found a spot on the C-2 Volleyball All-State first team in 2020 and 2021 AVCA Honorable Mention All-American honors.

Ready for her first season in a Rebel uniform, Vivian Miller comes to campus as a highly touted recruit out of Jupiter, Florida, being named to the Prep Volleyball Top-100, AVCA Phenom List, AVCA Best and Brightest First Team and 2021 AVCA Second Team All-American honors. At Jupiter High School, the outside hitter totaled 500 kills in 154 sets played.

Cammy Niesen, listed as a defensive specialist, hopes to make an impact for the Rebels at the libero position. The 2021 AVCA Second Team High School All-American graduated as the all-time dig leader at Roger Bacon High School, where she led the Miami Valley Conference in digs as a senior. Niesen was also named first team All-District, District Player of the Year and first team All-State in 2020.

Outside hitter Emma Schwieger caps off the freshmen talent. The Bishop Moore Catholic High School grad was tabbed as the No. 5 player and the No. 1 right side in Florida for the class of 2022 and was listed as one of Prep Volleyball's 2022 players to watch. The former Central Florida 4A Player of the Year tallied 621 kills and 469 digs over the course of her career with the Hornets.

RATLIFF, WHITE AND BLUE

After establishing herself as one of the top middle-blockers in the SEC last season, Sasha Ratliff received an invitation to the Women's National Team Open Program in Colorado Springs, Colorado, this past February. The junior spent three days training with some of the top athletes in the nation as part of the selection process for the U.S. Women's National Team and the 2022 U.S. Women's Collegiate National Team.

NEW FACES TO THE BENCH

Back on the bench for year two with the Rebels is Brad Creamer; however, when Ole Miss takes the court this season, he'll have a new role with the program: assistant coach. This offseason, Creamer was elevated to assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the Rebels after assisting them in one of the best seasons in program history. Also added to the staff this offseason was assistant coach Bre Henry, who makes her way to Oxford from Santa Clara University. During her time with the Broncos, Santa Clara produced three AVCA All-Region selections, 12 All-WCC accolades and 10 WCC all-academic nods. Prior to Santa Clara, Henry was a graduate assistant with one of the nation's elite programs at Nebraska alongside Banwarth. Rounding out the new faces is volunteer assistant Douglas Florencio, who just wrapped up his playing career at King University and University of Charleston.

THE SCOOP

In just her second season as a head coach, Kayla Banwarth set the standard for Ole Miss Volleyball, guiding the Rebels to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 11 years. She helped guide the team to an 8-3 mark through its final 11 games and first 20-win regular season since 2013 to earn an at-large bid to the Big Dance.

Banwarth and the Rebels also recorded the best turnaround in Division I Volleyball. Ole Miss improved from 1-19 in 2020-21 to 21-9 in 2021, a 65 percent increase in winning percentage. Further, of the teams who competed during the shortened 2020-21 season, Ole Miss was one of two Power Five teams and five programs nationally to see a 20-plus win improvement from the previous year.

Under Banwarth, the Rebels broke multiple program records, including total team blocks in a season (479), total team block assists (427), team attacking percentage (.255) and winning percentage (.700). Ole Miss opened the season 12-0, the second-best start to a season in program history, to be the last remaining undefeated SEC team. Banwarth led her squad to its first top-15 win since 2010, taking down No. 15 Western Kentucky on the road. As a team, Ole Miss finished tied for fifth in the SEC in 2021 with 10 conference victories, including sweeps of Missouri, South Carolina and Alabama.

She helped Anna Bair, Kylie McLaughlin and Sasha Ratliff earn AVCA South All-Region honors following their 2021 campaign. McLaughlin and Ratliff also received All-SEC honors.

Banwarth completed her first season at the helm of the Ole Miss program in 2020-21. In a year unlike any other that featured a season divided into two segments, the young Rebel squad, which included nine underclassmen, made great strides.

In the fall, freshman GG Carvacho earned the program's first SEC honors of the Banwarth

era, as Carvacho totaled 30 kills in the series against Missouri to be named the SEC Freshman of the Week. This steady growth continued into the spring, as the Rebels tied a single-match program record with 18.0 total blocks in the 3-2 victory over LSU. Freshman Sasha Ratliff jumped into the Ole Miss record book as well, tying the program record for second most single-match block solos with three against the Tigers. A few weeks later, the Rebels snapped No. 3 Kentucky's 38 straight set winning streak in a 25-21 set three victory.

A standout volleyball player at the University of Nebraska and for Team USA, Banwarth is a rising star in the coaching ranks and has taken her championship pedigree to Ole Miss, as she was announced as the Rebels' eighth head coach in program history on Dec. 21, 2019.

Banwarth brings a wealth of success, both on the playing and coaching levels, to Oxford. As a player and assistant coach, she helped guide Nebraska to four conference championships, three Final Four appearances and a national title. Her illustrious career with Team USA garnered eight medals in international competition, including a bronze at the 2016 Olympic games.

Banwarth spent three seasons as an assistant coach at her alma mater, where she focused on liberos and passers in addition to leading the Huskers' recruiting efforts. She helped direct Nebraska to a national championship in 2017 and a repeat appearance in the title match in 2018.

In April 2019, Banwarth was named one of the American Volleyball Coaches' Association's 30 Under 30, one of just 11 female coaches in NCAA Division I to be recognized.

In her first season as a Husker assistant, Nebraska won the 2017 NCAA Championship and repeated as Big Ten champions with a 32-4 overall record and 19-1 mark in con-

ference play. Under her guidance, setter Kelly Hunter was named the NCAA Championship co-most outstanding player, an AVCA first-team All-American and the Big Ten Setter of the Year. She was also the PrepVolleyball.com Player of the Year, while libero Kenzie Maloney was a PrepVolleyball.com first-team All-American and an NCAA Championship All-Tournament selection.

In 2018, the Huskers reached the NCAA Championship match once again, and Maloney was an NCAA Championship All-Tournament selection. Nebraska's defense was one of the best in the nation, in large part thanks to the Huskers' back-row passers. Nebraska finished the season with a .144 opponent hitting percentage, which ranked third in the nation, first in the Big Ten, and was the Huskers' best mark since 2005. Maloney was an AVCA third-team All-American and an All-Big Ten selection.

The Huskers were one of the top defensive units in the nation once in again 2019, holding opponents to a .153 opponent hitting percentage, which ranked eighth in the nation and first in the Big Ten. Nebraska reached the Elite Eight for the eighth straight year, and freshman libero Kenzie Knuckles was an All-Big Ten Freshman Team member.

Before returning to Lincoln, Banwarth served as a volunteer assistant for two seasons for the men's volleyball team at Pepperdine in 2015 and 2016. In her first season, the squad went 13-11, and she helped lead the Waves' back line to rank 36th nationally with 7.69 digs per set.

After walking on at Nebraska in 2007, Banwarth became the starting libero midway through her freshman season and remained in that role through 2010, receiving All-Big 12 honorable mention as a junior and senior. She led the Huskers to the NCAA semifinals in 2008 and three Big 12 titles. She was Nebraska's all-time career leader in digs, with 1,706 until 2016. Banwarth was also a two-time academic All-Big 12 selection and a three-time Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week.

In 2011, Banwarth embarked on a professional playing career that featured six years on the U.S. National Team. She also played professionally overseas in Azerbaijan.

Banwarth was named the Best Receiver at the 2015 NORCECA Championship and helped Team USA win gold there and at the FIVB World Grand Prix in 2016. In 2014, she aided Team USA to the FIVB World Cham-

pionship, the first gold medal for the U.S. at a major tournament. In 2016, Banwarth anchored the squad at the Olympic Games in Rio De Janeiro, helping the U.S. to the bronze medal.

In 2013 Banwarth was named USA Volleyball's Female Indoor Most Improved Player of the Year, and in 2012 and 2013, she led the team to gold medals in consecutive Pan American Cups. Also, in 2013, she was the runner-up in the Best Digger category at the FIVB World Grand Champions Cup after posting 3.19 digs per set. In her first international competition in 2011, Banwarth helped USA to a bronze medal at the Pan American Games.

Born Jan. 21, 1989, Banwarth is a native of Dubuque, Iowa and earned her bachelor's degree in English from Nebraska in 2012.

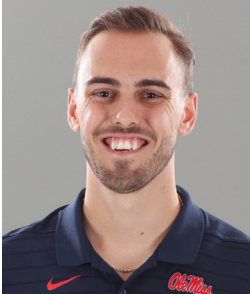
